CAUTION: You must read these Assembly Instructions before you proceed.



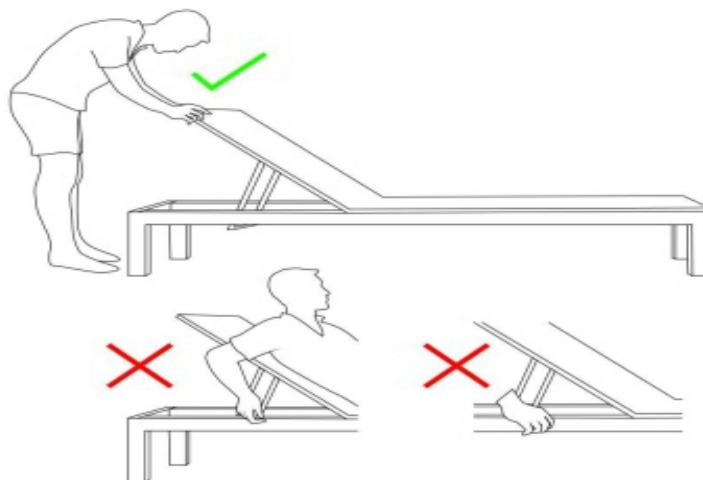
SAFETY WARNING

Never adjust chaise lounge or recliner backrest while seated.

Always make sure the backrest is flat before moving the chaise lounge.

Keep all limbs clear from under the backrest when it is in a raised position.

Serious finger, hand, or other bodily injuries may result from adjusting the chaise lounge backrest position while seated.

Care & Maintenance



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor product minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.



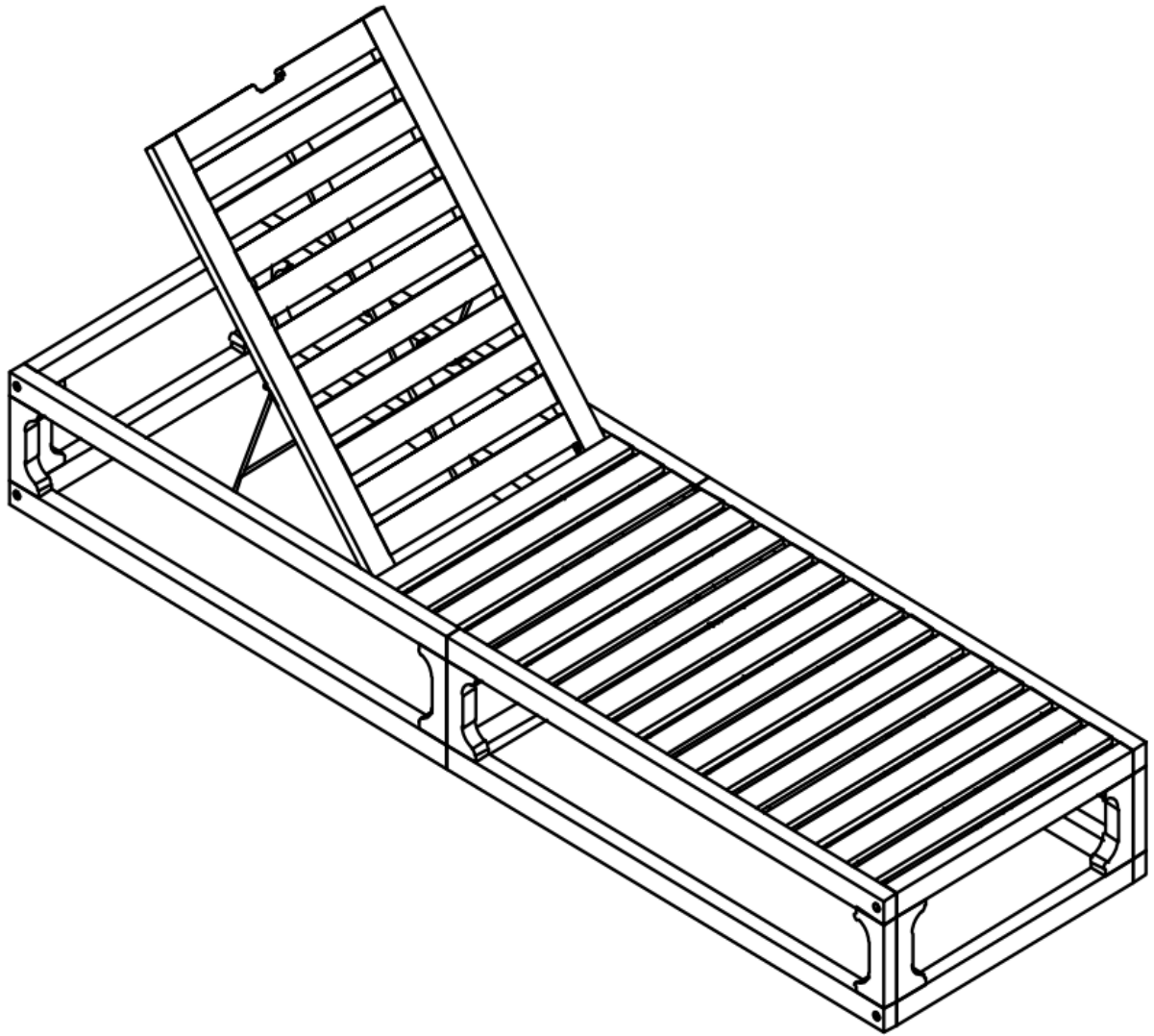
- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



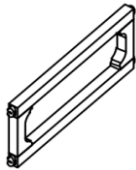
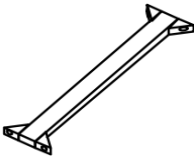
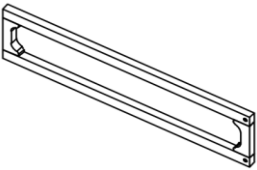
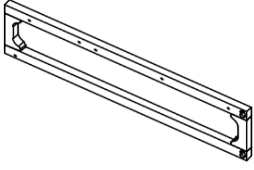
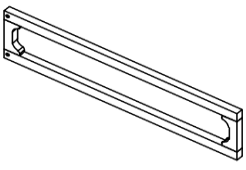
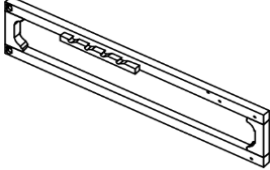
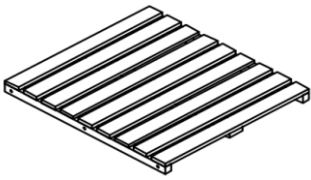
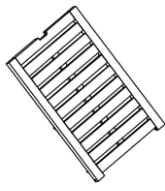
- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

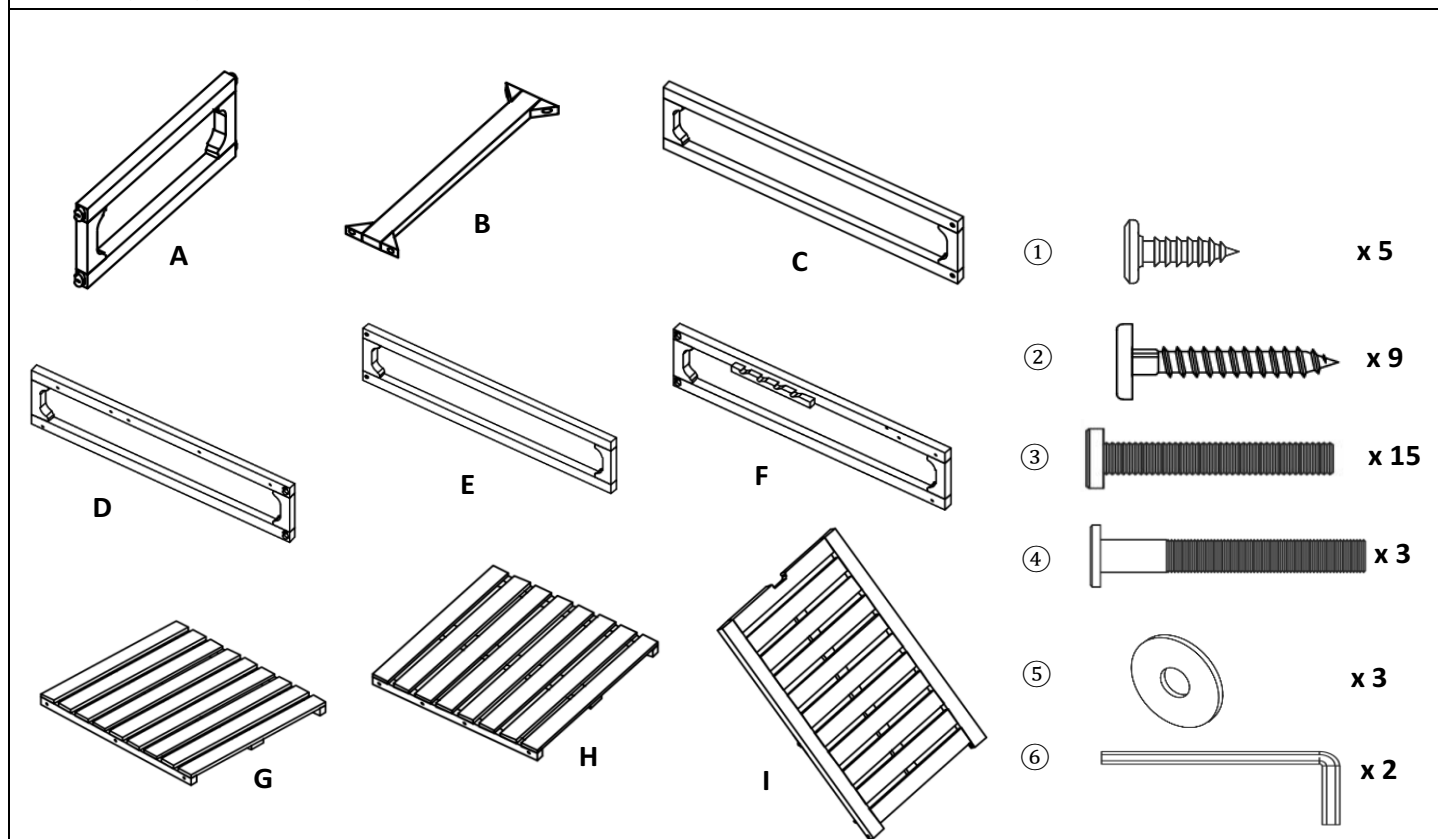

• Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



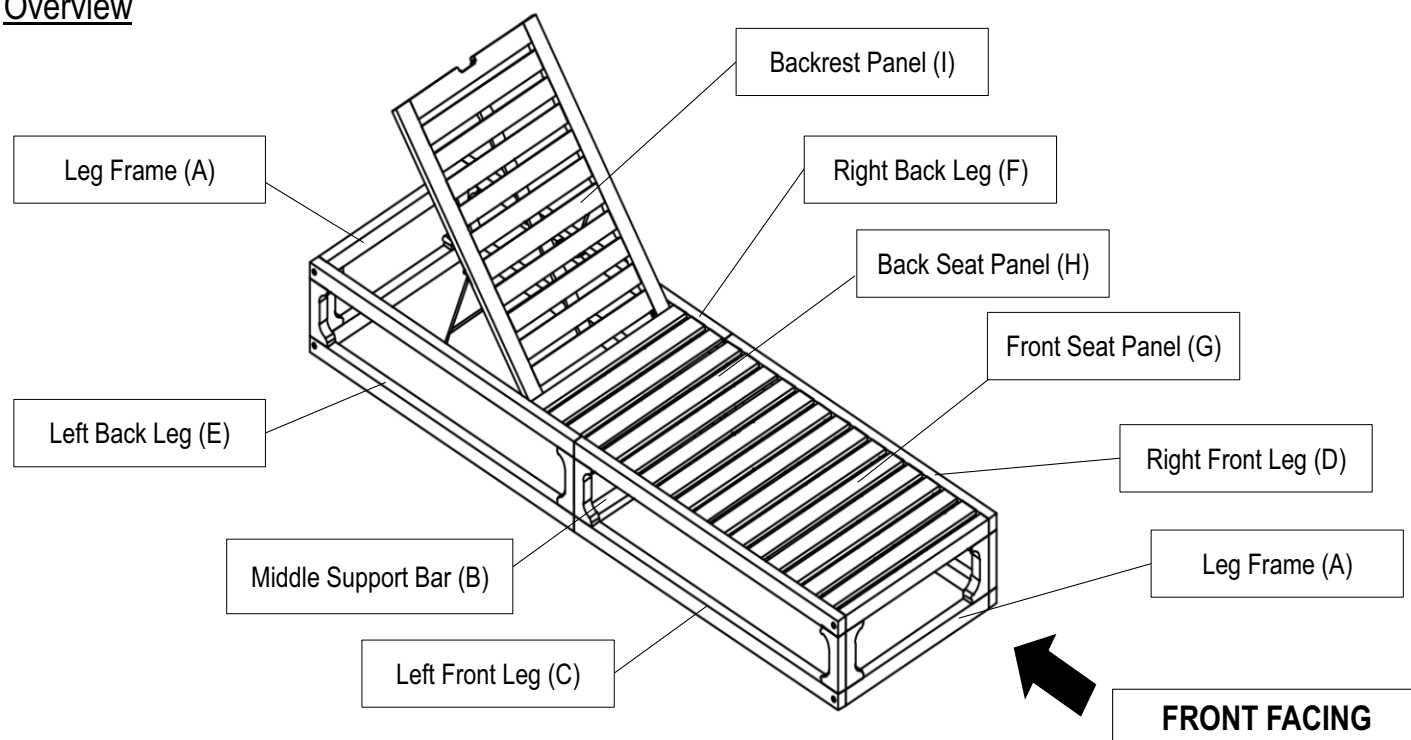
• Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



• Save all packaging until finished-

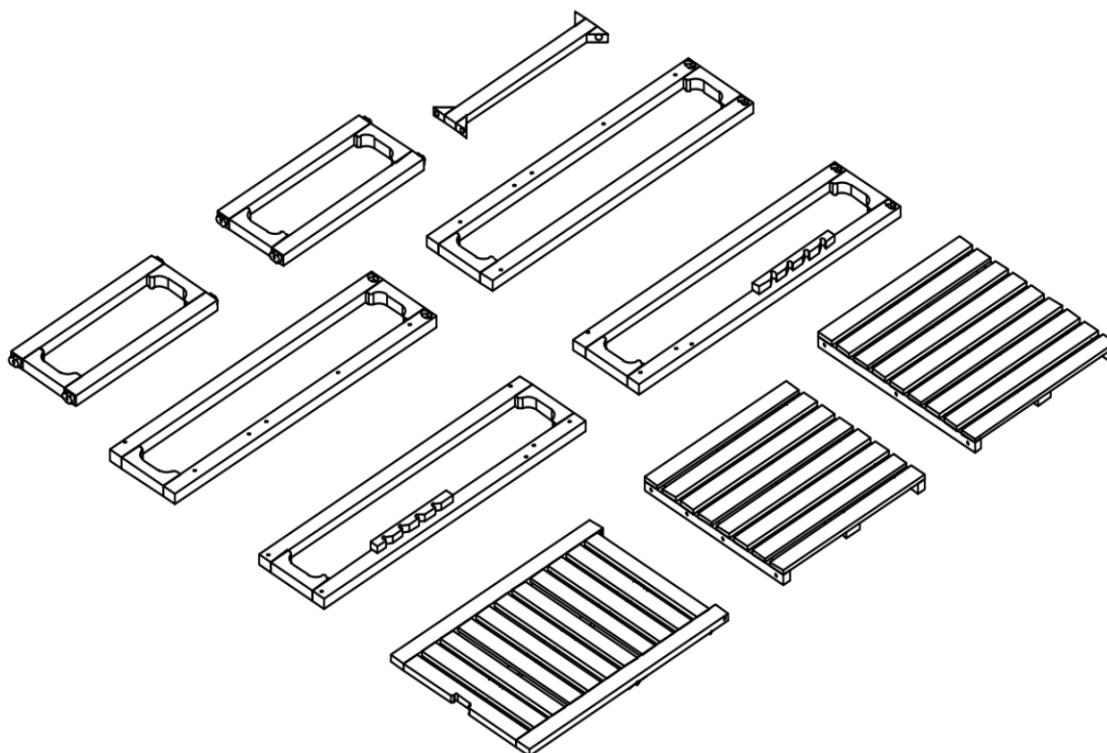
Assembly Steps:

Overview



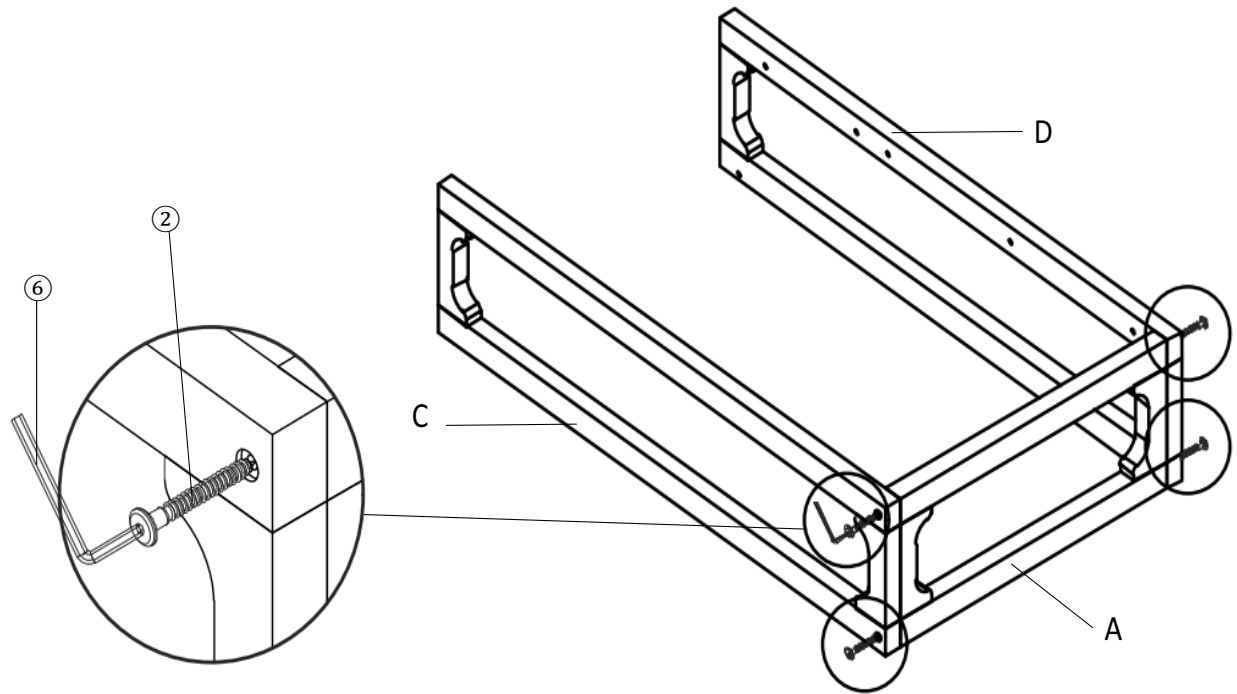
This Chaise Lounge has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chaise Lounger parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

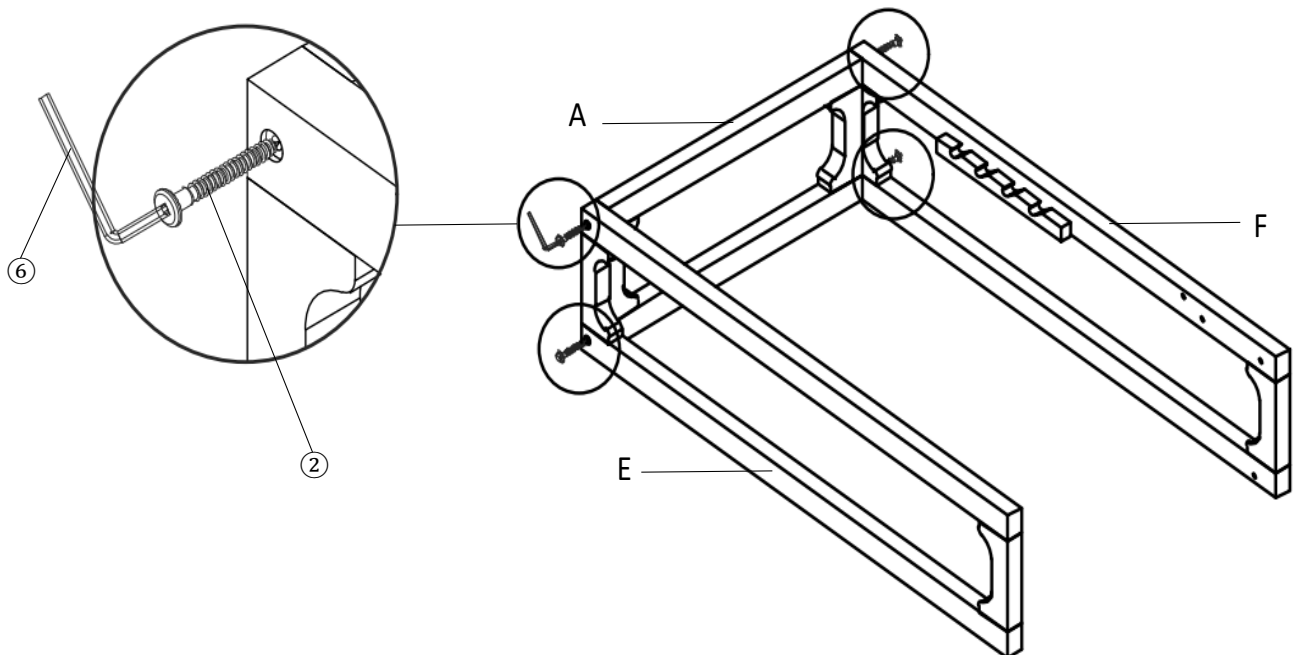
Step 2



With the help of your adult partner, attach both Left Front Leg (C) and Right Front Leg (D) to Leg Frame (A) and secure by using Screws (2) and Allen Wrench (6) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Screws.

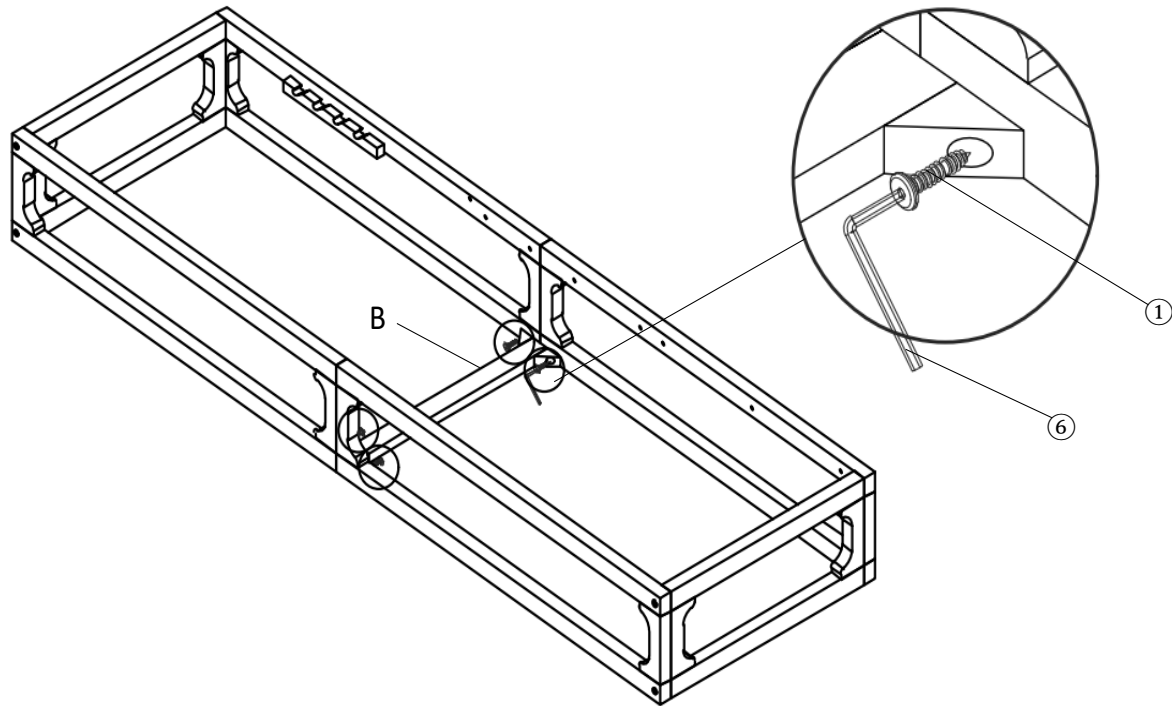
Step 3



With the help of your adult partner, attach both Left Back Leg (E) and Right Back Leg (F) to Leg Frame (A) and secure by using Screws (2) and Allen Wrench (6) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Screws.

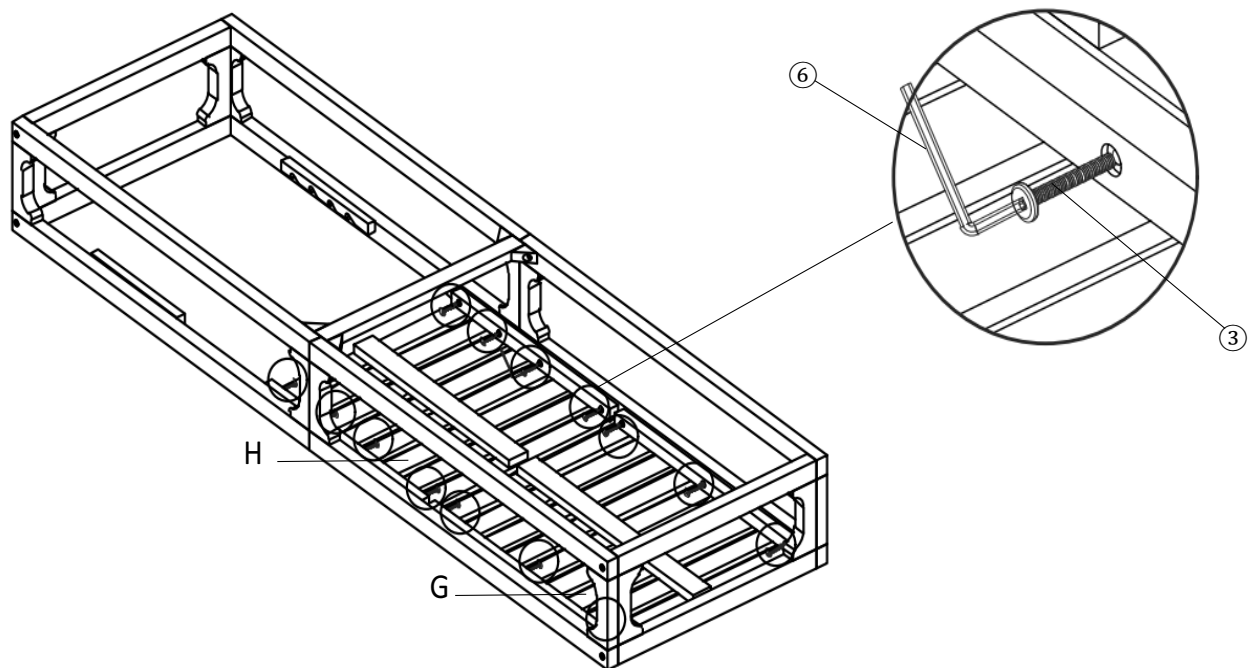
Step 4



With the help of your adult partner, attach Middle Support Bar (B) into the middle of the assembled part in Step 2 & 3 as shown above. Then secure Middle Support Bar (B) to Front Legs (C, D) and Back Legs (E, F) by using Screws (1) and Allen Wrench (6) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Screws.

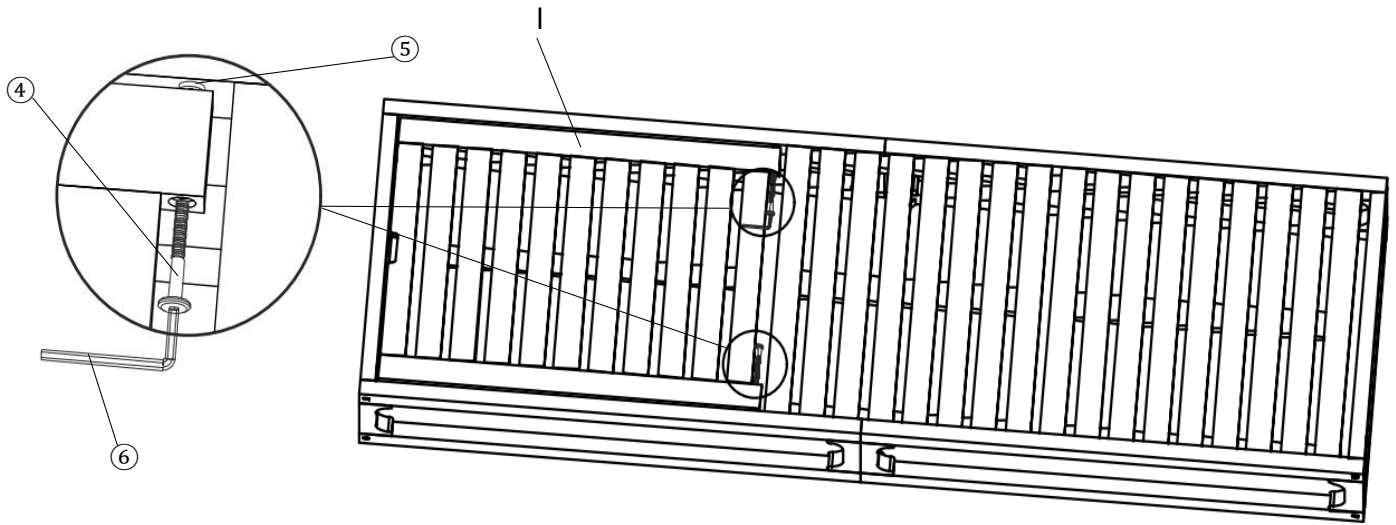
Step 5



With the help of your adult partner, place Front Seat Panel (G) and Back Seat Panel (H) facing down then attach the assembled part in Step 4 to Front Seat Panel (G) and Back Seat Panel (H) then secure by using Bolts (3) and Allen Wrench (6) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

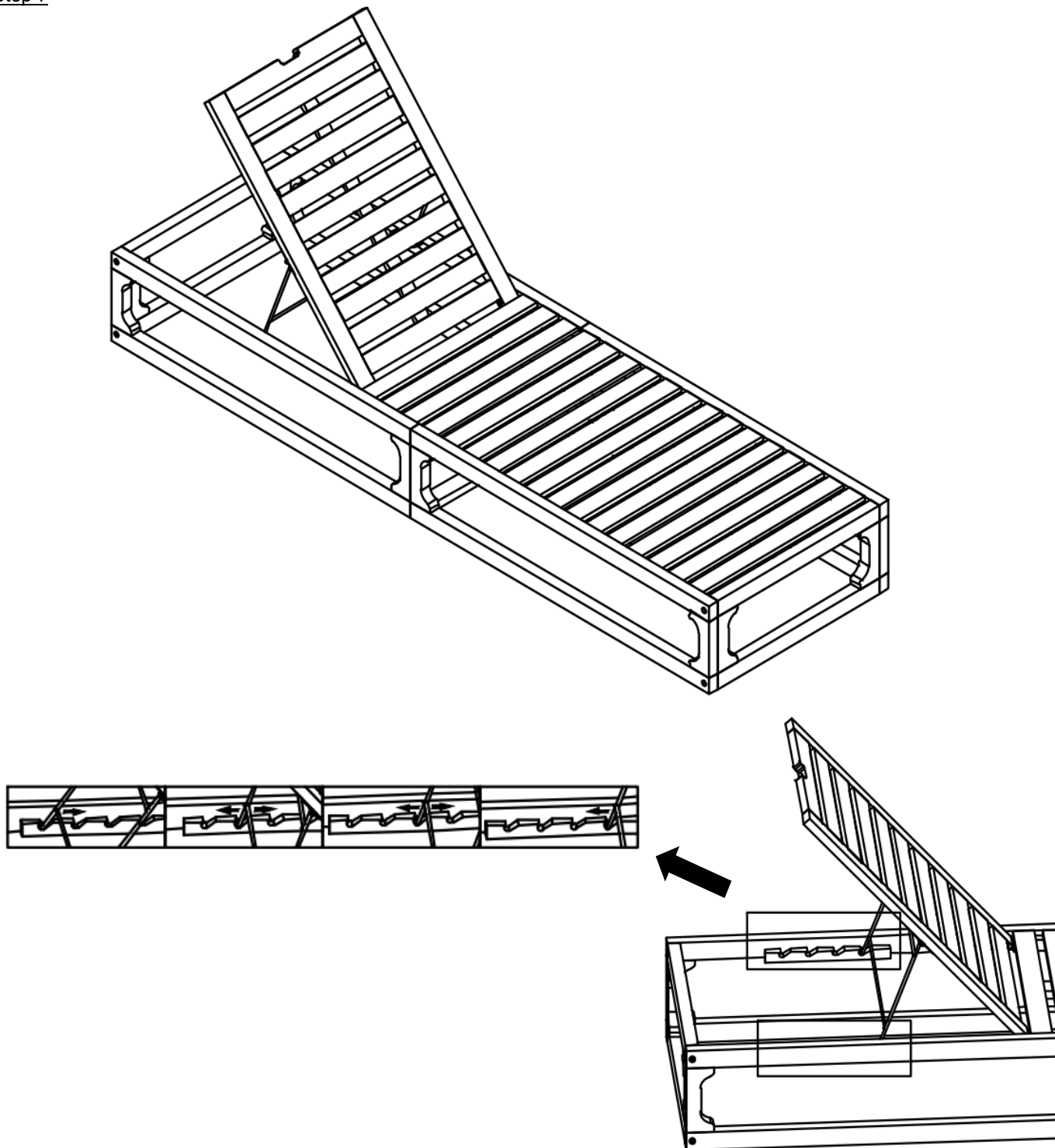
Step 6



With the help of your adult partner, turn the assembled part in Step 5 right side up then attach Backrest Panel (I) to the above frame and secure Backrest Panel (I) to Back Legs (E, F) by using Bolts (④) with Plastic Washers (⑤) and Allen Wrench (⑥) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 7



Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Gently and gracefully, sit onto the Chaise Lounge.

This will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.

Then get off the Chaise Lounge and in a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Bolts, Screws at all joints until evenly connected.

If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts, Screws and execute this same process.

WARNING!! IF CHAISE LOUNGE IS NOT STABLE, IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.

Your Chaise Lounge is ready for use.

This Chaise Lounge can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Note: Align the Backrest of Chaise Lounge in position you want.
