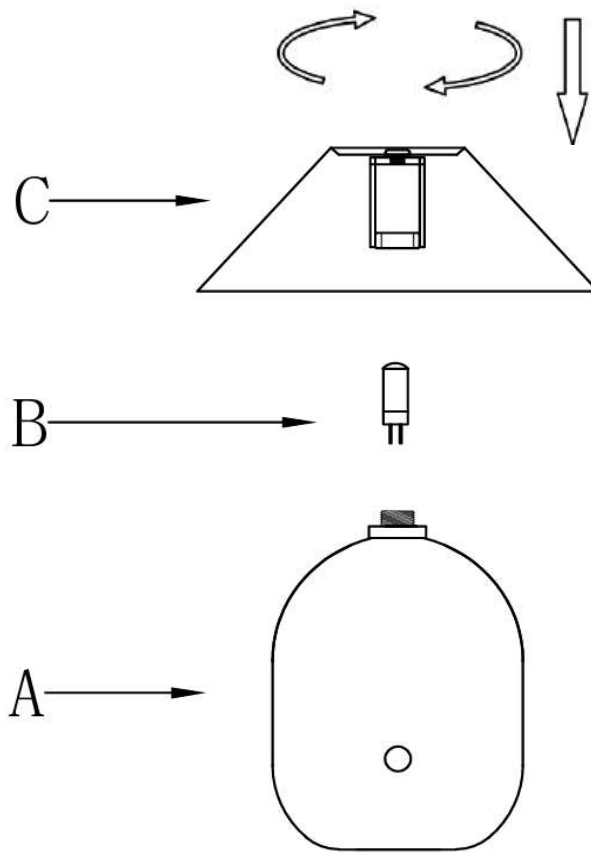


The Table Lamp



ASSEMBLY

1. Plug the LED bulb into the socket by aligning the pins and gently but firmly inserting it straight down. DO NOT attempt to screw or twist, as this will damage the components.
2. Screw the shade onto the socket clockwise.
3. Plug the cord into a US outlet. Review reverse side of this page for important warnings and safety information prior to use.

OPERATION & USE

CHARGING : Before using the lamp, it should be plugged in to a 120v-powered outlet using the provided USB-C to USB-C charging cable. For the very first charge, you'll need to use this cable. For any future charges, both a USB-C to USB-C or a USB-C to USB can be used.

Plug the cord into the lamp to charge. A full charge will take approximately 3.5 hours.

POWER & DIMMING : To turn the lamp on, tap the touch-sensitive metallic button at the top of the lamp's shade. Tap again to turn Off. To dim the lamp, press down on the touch-button and hold. The lamp will begin to decrease in brightness, and you may remove your hand from the switch at any point to stop the progression and set it at your desired brightness. If you do not remove your hand, the lamp will dim all the way down to its lowest setting, and then begin re-brightening.

Once fully charged, the lamp can up to 12 hours on the brightest setting, and over 200 hours on the dimmest setting.

SAFETY & WARNINGS

This product is intended for 110v voltage only, when using the supplied adapter cable. Use with a higher voltage is likely to cause damage to the product as well as the electrical component it is being powered by.

Do not bring this product or any of its components in contact with any water or extreme heat.

Keep between 23 degrees F & 104 degrees F, and below a humidity of 95%.

Do not use this product outside of its intended and advertised use. Do not tamper with internal parts or wiring.

Do not operate if the lamp has been physically damaged in any way.

Brightech is not responsible for any failures associated with modifications to this product or any of its electrical components, or when the product is used with externally purchased parts not manufactured to come with this product.

Note: Never make any temporary or permanent alterations to any parts or components of this product.

■ Light Flashing or Strobging: A malfunction of this sort may suggest a problem with the power adapter cord, necessitating a replacement of this cord.

■ Light Dim or Dead: If the LEDs have dimmed, or the lamp has failed after first not performing at max brightness, this may suggest a failure of the actual LED component, meaning the lamp will need to be replaced.

■ Lights are Dim: If the LEDs have dimmed, or the lamp has failed after first not performing at max brightness, this may suggest a failure of the actual LED component, necessitating a replacement of the full LED bulb. Note: In an effort to be as energy efficient as possible, this lamp uses a special bulb that runs on 12v instead of the standard 120v US voltage. Any bulb replacing the current bulb will also therefore need to run on 12v. A standard 110v or 120v bulb will damage the components, potentially beyond repair.
