## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Due to shipping requirements, this rug may have arrived folded and you may see wrinkles or creases when you first lay it flat. Do not be alarmed, this is not a permanent issue or a defect. Be prepared that it may take several days or weeks for the rug to restore its natural shape and sit on the floor properly.

**Please follow these guidelines to facilitate the flattening of the rug:**

1. Gently open the rug on a **hard surface**.
2. **Slowly vacuum** the rug in **two horizontal directions** (side to side, top to bottom). This may need to be repeated daily until it flattens.
3. To reduce creases, you can re-roll the rug in the **opposite direction**.
4. **Tip for Stubborn Creases or Wrinkles: Flip the rug** over with the pile touching the floor. Place a **moistened towel** over the wrinkled area of the rug. **Using steam**, iron the towel over the crease for **10 seconds**. To avoid harming the rug, never apply the iron directly to the rug.

### How to Restore Crushed Piles

It is common for the legs of furniture to compress the rug piles in a concentrated area. To restore this area rub the crushed piles with a coin or comb it with a vacuum cleaner. It will stand back up.



### Rug Colors & Shading

Colors may vary depending on your lighting, pile direction and perspective. Position your rug to your ideal perspective.



### Vacuum Rug to Clean

Maintain the rug's appearance by frequent vacuum cleaning. Do not be concerned if you vacuum up rug fibers. This is a natural occurrence with woven rugs and is not a defect.



### New Rug Scent

When first opened a new rug may have a strong scent. Expose the rug to fresh air and the scent will dissipate within a few days.



### How to Care for Spills

Simply clean up spills by gently spot cleaning the affected area with a rug cleaner and a kitchen cloth.
