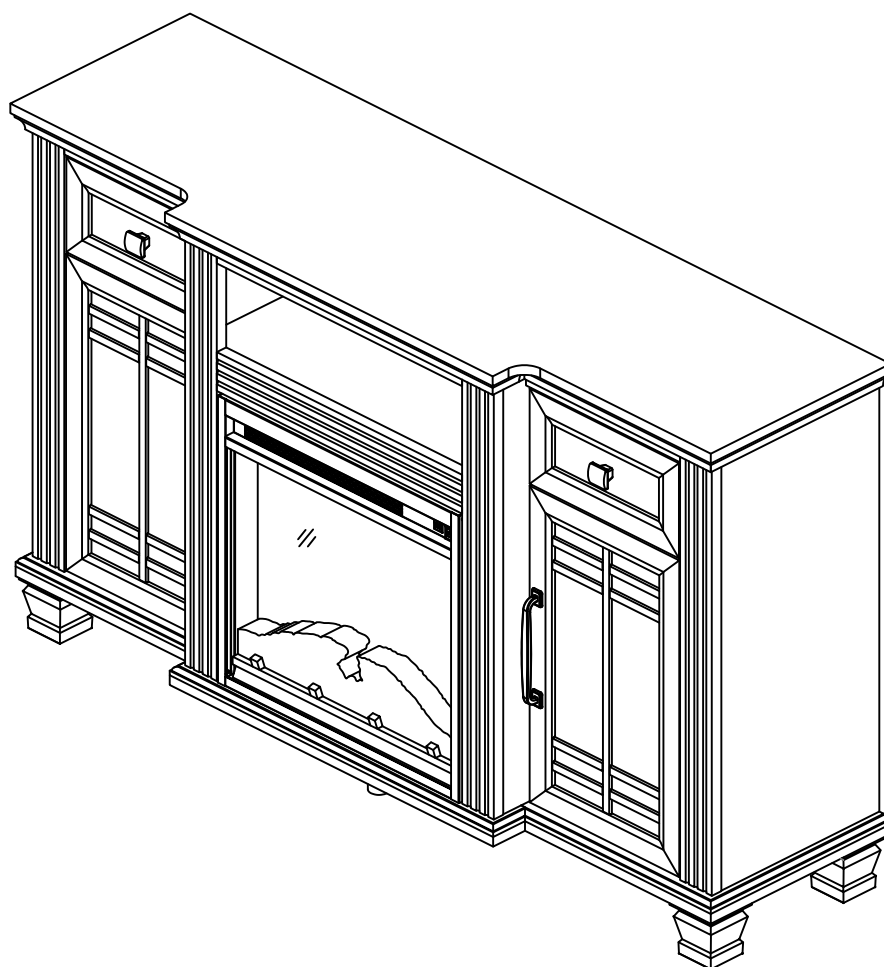

BEFORE STARTING

Before Using Product

Read each step carefully before starting. It is very important that each step is performed in the correct order. If these steps are not followed in sequence, assembly difficulties will occur.

Make sure all parts are included.

Work in a spacious area and near where the unit will be used, preferably on a carpet, or use a piece of the cardboard packaging to protect your floor and product.

For a smooth assembly process, we suggest you keep a lite tightness for all the screws during assembly. After the whole product is assembled, firmly tighten all the screws.

WARNING

Do not allow children to climb on unit.

Avoid sharp objects or corrosive chemicals to prevent damage to the product.

During assembly, keep parts and packaging materials away from children and pets as there could be potential injury and choking hazards.

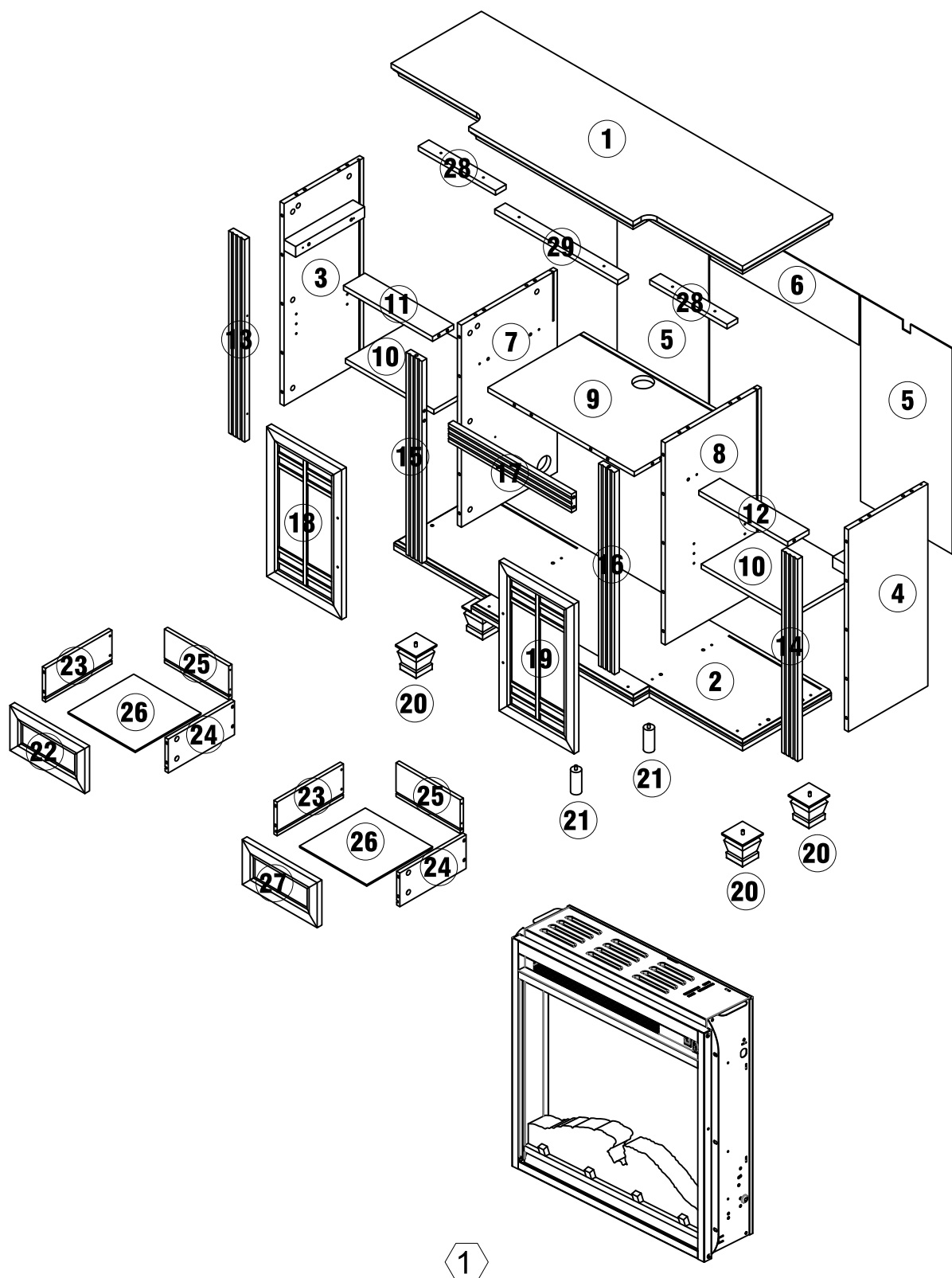
Please make sure that all objects are removed before moving the assembled unit.

The unit must be team lifted, not dragged or pushed. Failure to do so could cause instability, product collapse, and/or serious injury.

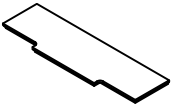
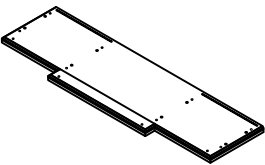
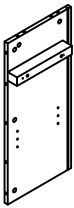
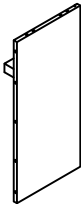
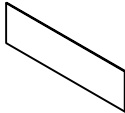
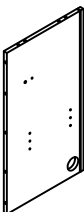
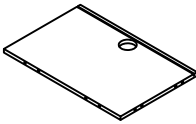
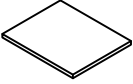
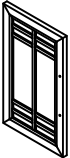

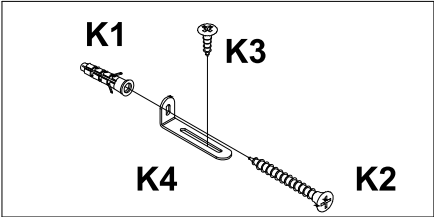
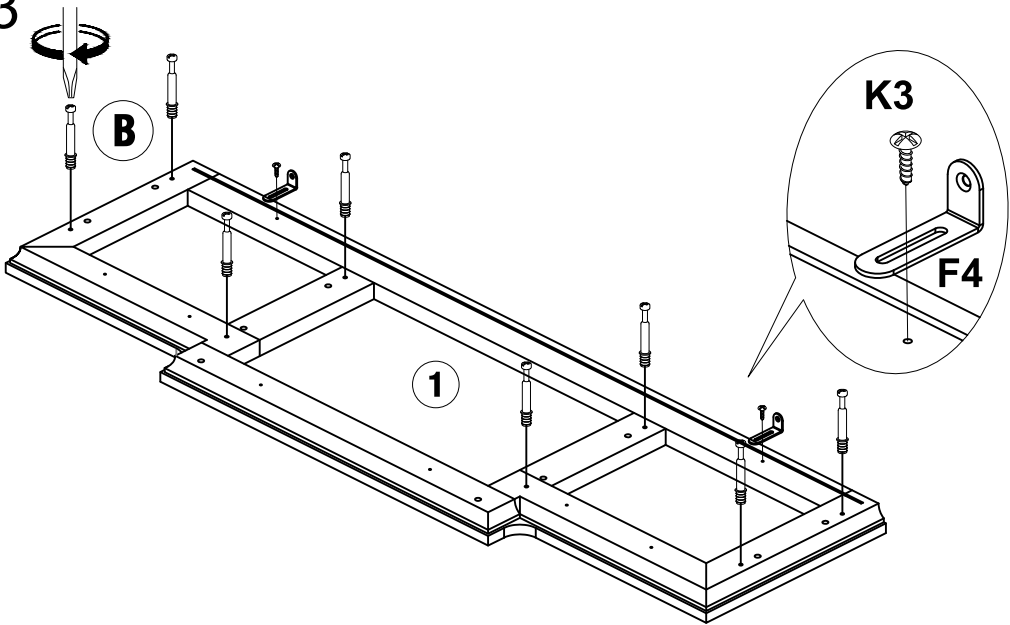
Adjust the height of the screw teeth on the feet appropriately to ensure the product remains perfectly level and more fit the ground.

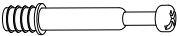

Please be sure to install the mending wedges to prevent the product from becoming unstable or wobbling.

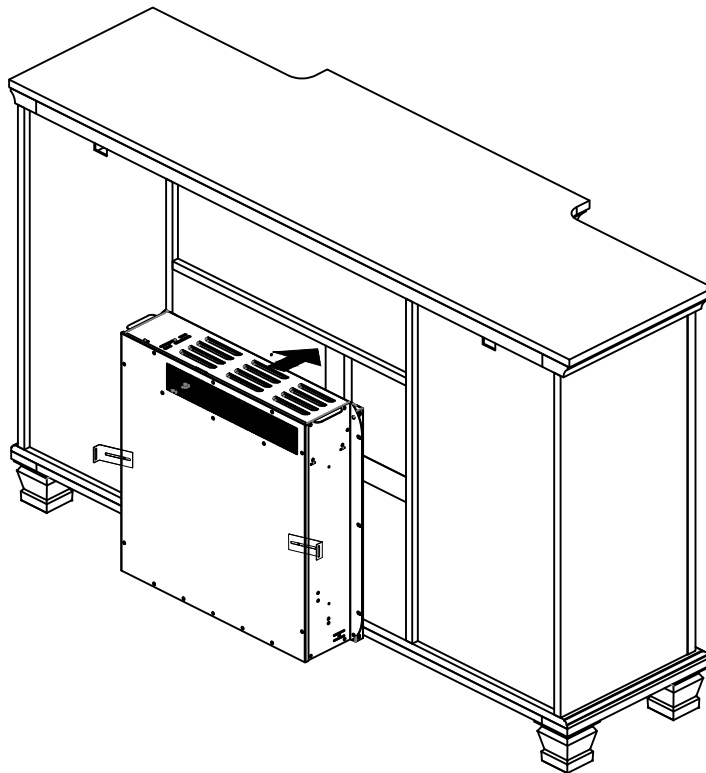

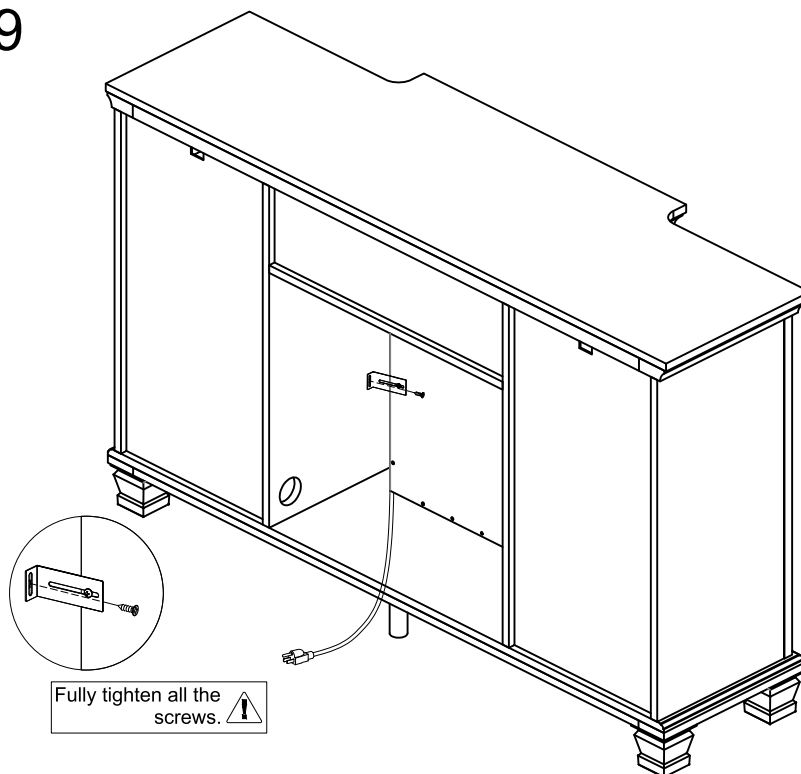
Please do not tighten the screw to ensure that component **AA** can move left and right.

First unscrew this screw on the fireplace, and then secure component **AA** with it.

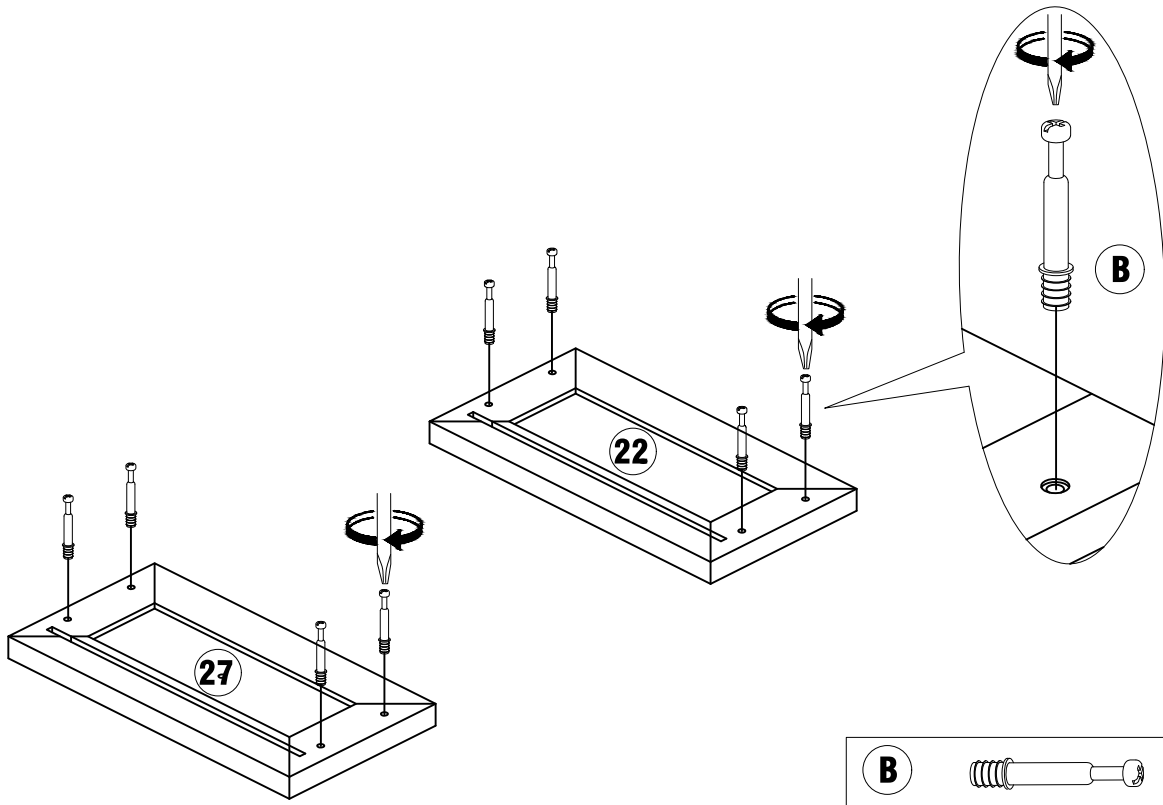
