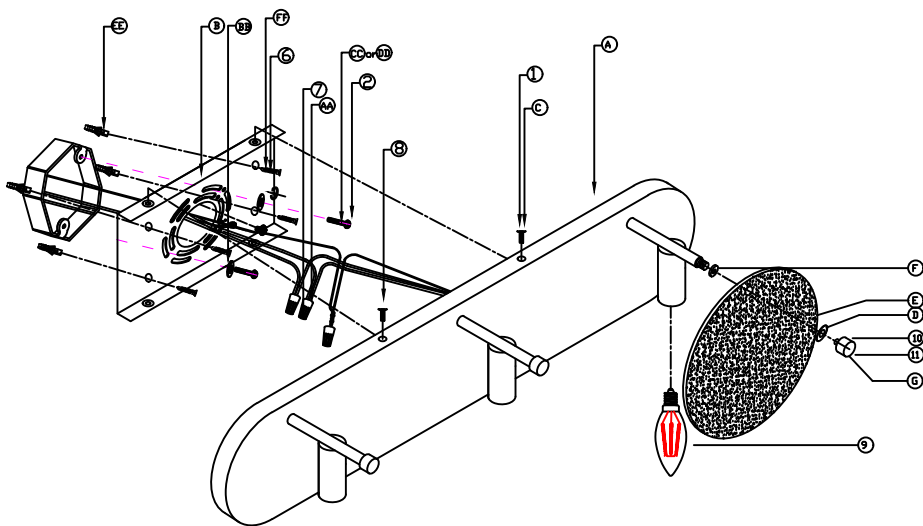


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

AA 3X
BB 2X
CC 2X
DD 2X
EE 4X
FF 4X



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Unscrew the mounting plate (B) from the lamp by rotating the mounting screw (C).
2. Secure the mounting plate (B) to the junction box using the provided screws (CC or DD, chosen based on junction box depth) and washers (BB).
3. Mark the four hole positions on the mounting plate (B) with a pen.
4. Remove the mounting plate (B) from the junction box and drill holes in the wall at the marked positions.
5. Fix the expansion plugs (EE) into the drilled holes using a hammer.
6. Secure the mounting plate (B) to the junction box with the provided screws (CC or DD) and washers (BB). Reinforce the plate with additional screws (FF).
7. Connect incoming and outgoing wires using the wire connectors (AA). (Note: Connect positive to positive (live), negative to negative (neutral), and ground to the grounding terminal. Ensure no wires are exposed during connection.)
8. Secure the lamp body (A) to the mounting plate (B) using the mounting screws (C).
9. Install the light sources (fixtures only, bulbs not included).
10. Unscrew the iron sheet (D) and rubber pad (F) from the lamp body by rotating the iron piece (G).
11. Thread the rubber pad (F), glass (E), and iron sheet (D) onto the lamp rod in sequence, then secure them with the iron piece (G).

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
