





Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



Save all packaging until finished-


Assembly Steps



This Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Assembly Steps

Step 1



Open the carton and place all the parts onto a clean, non-marring surface.


Align the Right Leg (B)&Left Leg (C) onto Seat (A),

Attach Right Leg (B)&Left Leg (C) using Bolts(1) and Washers(2) with Allen Wrench (3). Tighten all the Bolts.

Note: Occationally some of the rope will cover the Bolt points, preventing easy assembly, the rope should not be cut but moved away from the mounting positions.


Step 2





Place the Chair on a LEVEL SURFACE to check for wobbles. Adjust the Leveler to ensure chair stability.

Step 3



Place the Seat Cushion(E) and Back Pillow (D) on the Chair.

Your Chair is ready for use.

This Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Care & Maintenance



- Prolonged exposure to rain may cause rusting which can stain floors.
- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- Ø ☐ Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- √ ♠ Keep away from sources of ignition.
