









Examine all packaging material for small parts that may have come loose during shipment. Periodic checks are recommended to insure that all components are in proper position, tight and free from damage. Keep this assembly instruction for future reference. Adult assembly is required.




C	2	Adapter Plates 	STEP 1 - Figure 1 Begin assembly by connecting Leg Extensions (A) to Headboard (B) using 2 Allen Bolts (3) & 2 Flat Washers (4). Tighten all bolts with Allen Wrench (8) provided.

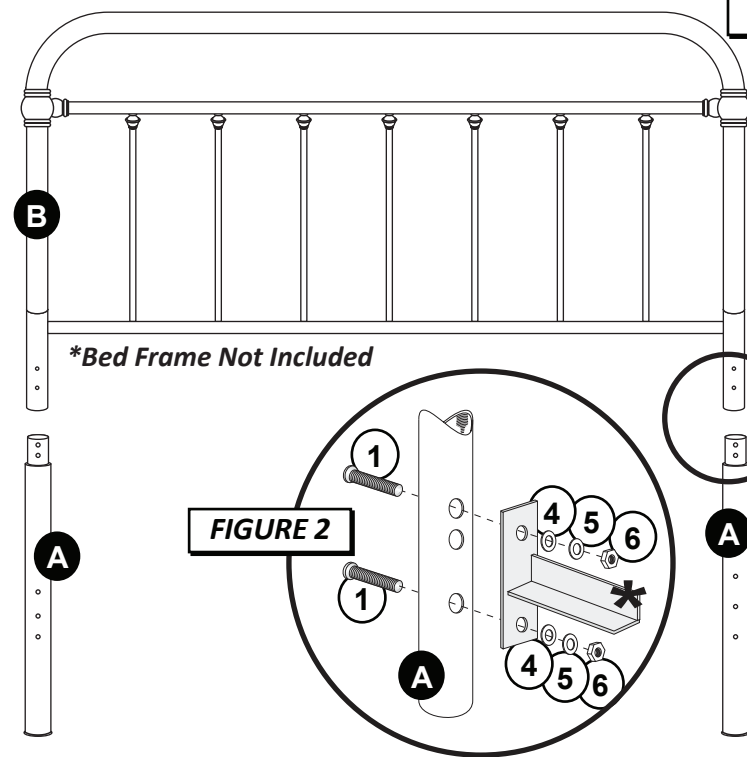

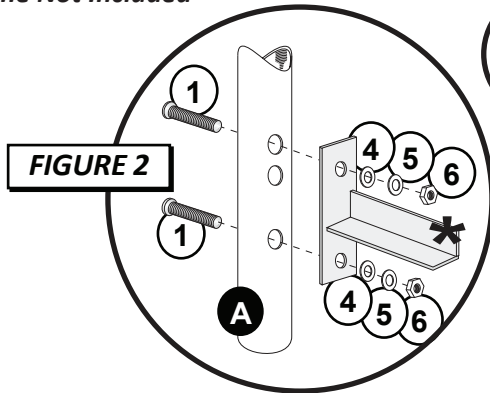

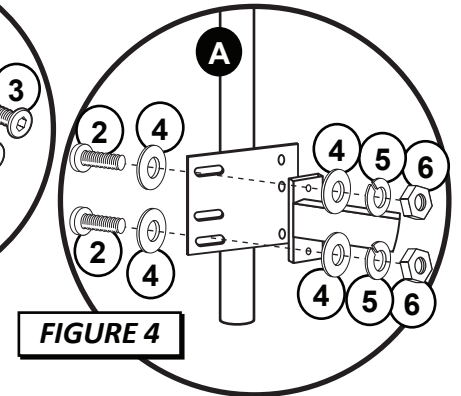
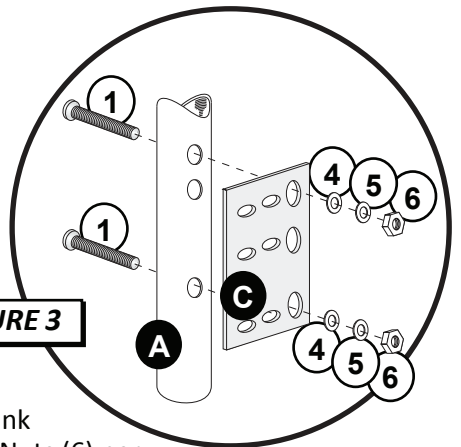

STEP 2 - Figure 2 - Queen Size Only

Next, attach the Bed Frame (*Not Included) to each Leg Extension (A) using 2 Countersunk Allen Bolts (1) from the outside, and 2 Spring Washers (5), 2 Flat Washers (4) and 2 Hex Nuts (6) per post. Tighten all nuts and bolts using the Allen & Hex Wrenches (7 & 8) that have been provided.

STEP 3 - Figure 3 - Full Size Only

Attach each Adapter Plate (C) to each Leg Extension (A) using 2 Countersunk Allen Bolts (1), 2 Flat Washers (5), 2 Spring Washers (5) & 2 Hex Nuts (6) per each side. Tighten all bolts and nuts using the Allen & Hex Wrenches (7 & 8) that have been provided.

STEP 4 - Figure 4 - Full Size Only

Once in place, secure the Bed Frame (Not Included) to each Adapter Plate (C) using 2 Allen Bolts (2) and 2 Flat Washers (4) from the backside, & 2 Flat Washers (4), 2 Spring Washers (5) & 2 Hex Nuts (6) per plate. Tighten all bolts and nuts using the Open Wrench (7) and Allen Wrench (8) provided. The assembly is now complete.

CARE & MAINTENANCE: The touch of a soft cloth is all the maintenance the finish will ever need. Please do not use harsh or abrasive cleaners for polishing, as they may cause damage to the finish. Periodic checks are recommended to make sure that all hardware is securely tightened.
