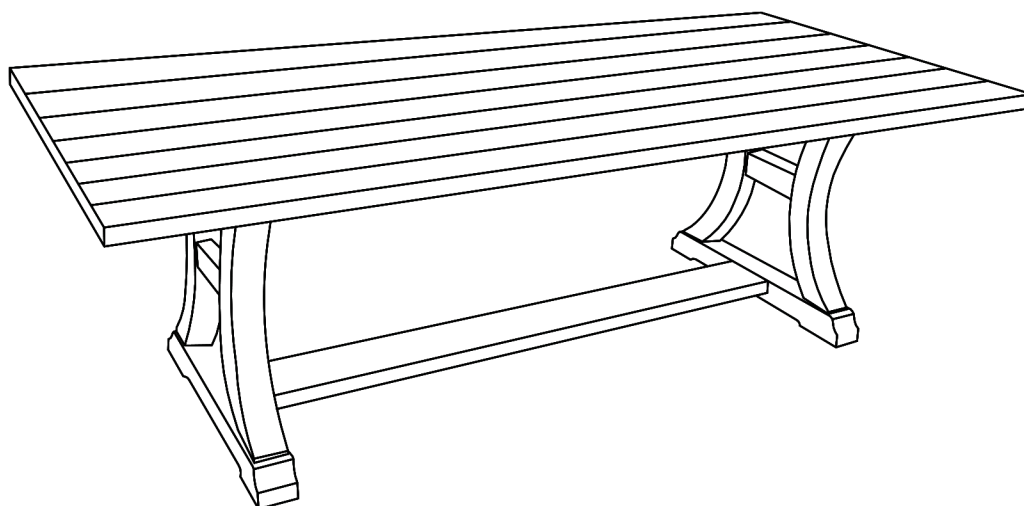


Assembly Instructions

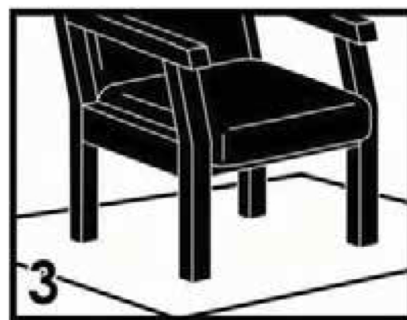
BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



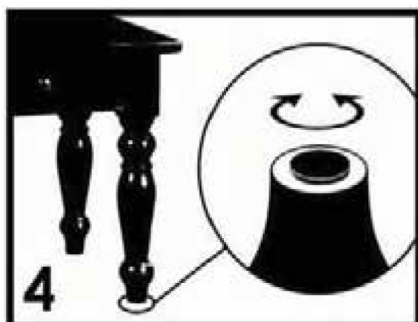
When lock or spring washer is used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or spring washer is placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.



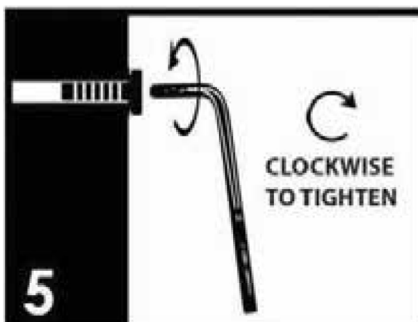
Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



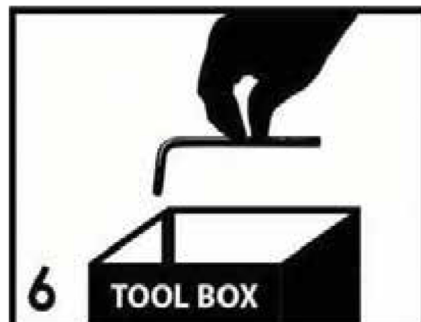
Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.



Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.



Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.



Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

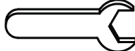

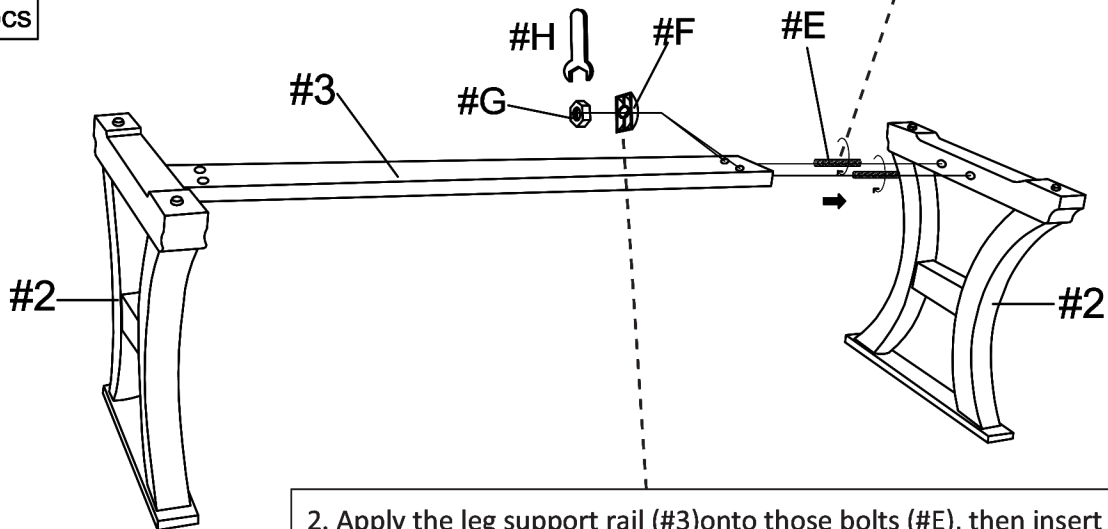

1. Insert 2 bolts (#E) into the holes along the top of the legs (#2), turn right to tighten.

2. Apply the leg support rail (#3) onto those bolts (#E), then insert a half moon nut (#F) and a hex nut (#G) in that order onto the end of the bolts from within the rail. Secure using the wrench (#H).

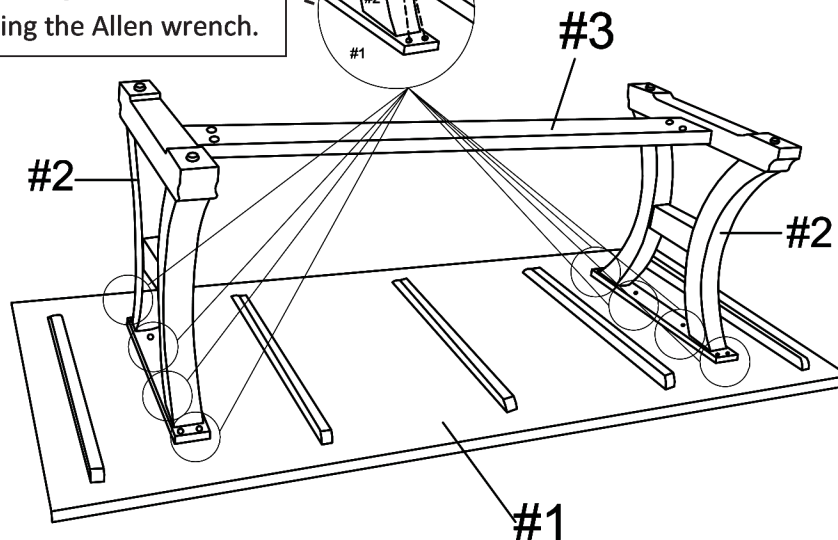
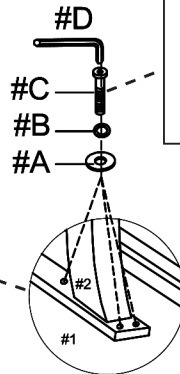


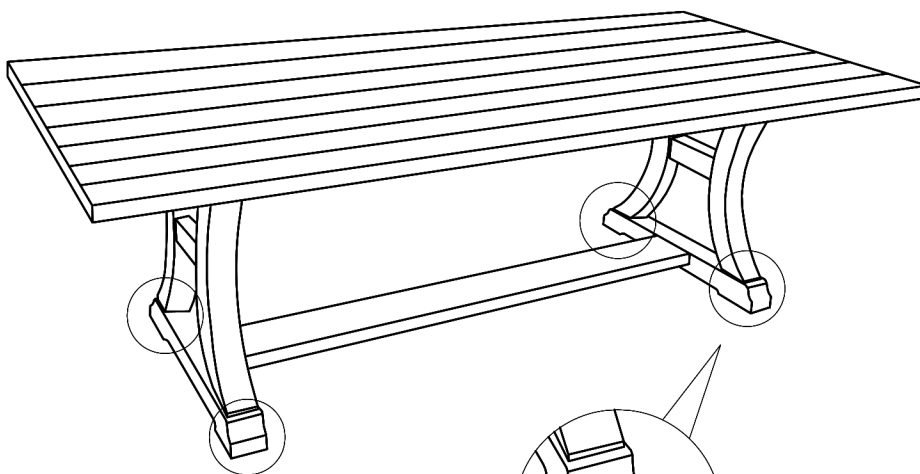

2. Place the table top (#1) face down onto a protected surface. Align the legs (#2) face down to the holes along the table top. Then insert 6 bolt assemblies into each leg and secure using the Allen wrench.

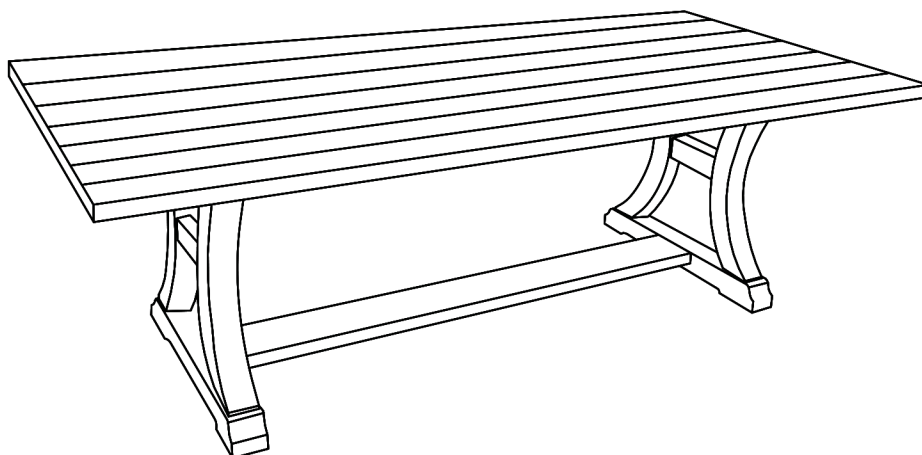
1. Prepare 12 bolt assemblies by first inserting a lock washer (#B) onto the bolt (#C) then a flat washer (#A) onto that same bolt (#C).



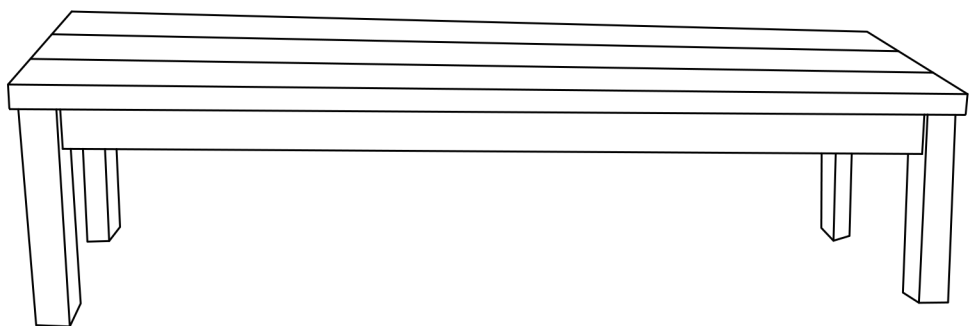


Adjust the leveler according to the ground level. To lower or to raise the legs, you need to turn the leveler clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.

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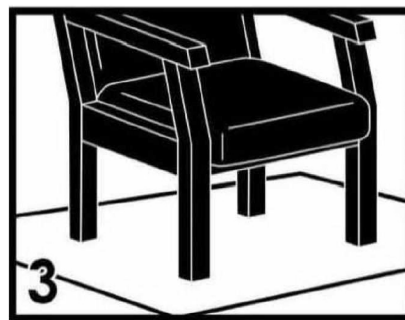
BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



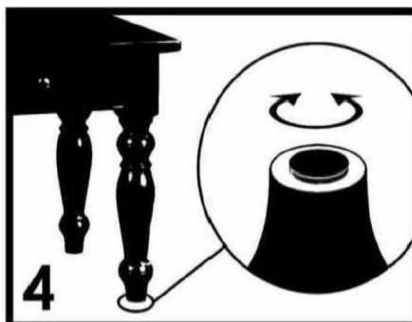
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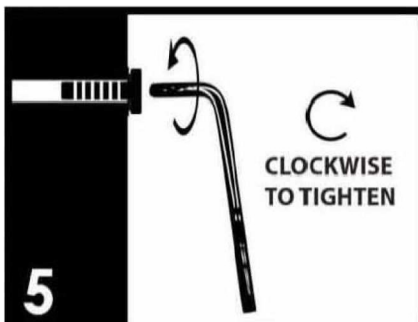

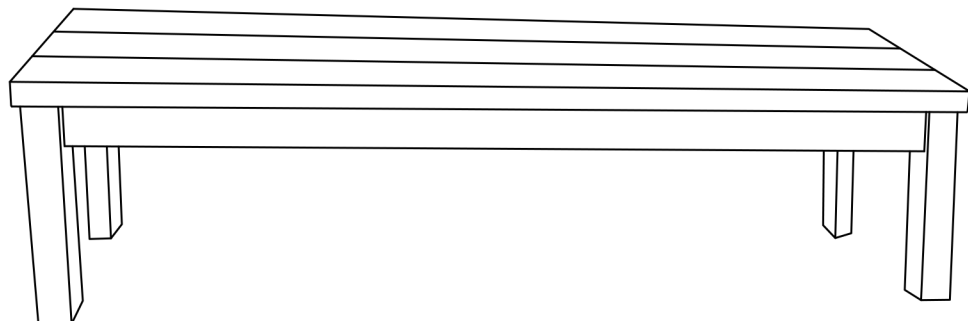


Prepare 8 bolts assembly by inserting lock washer (#B), then flat washer (#A) onto bolts (#C).
Align legs (#2) to the holes of the bench top (#1), then secure with bolts (#C).

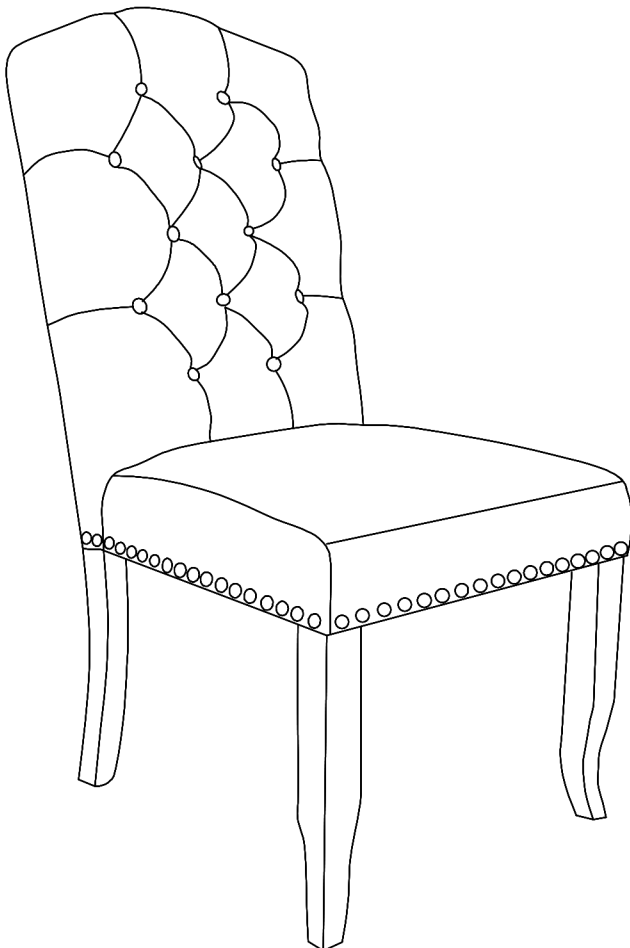

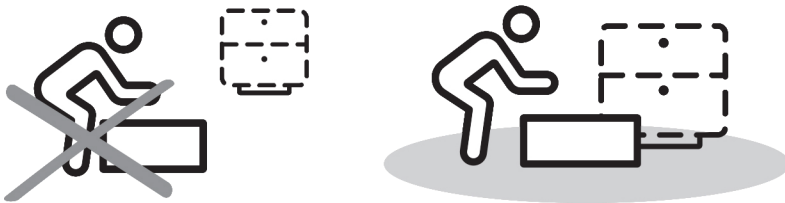
PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

We understand building ready-to-assemble furniture can be a challenging experience for some. To help avoid confusion, we have provided some helpful tips that may speed up the process.



Teamwork

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



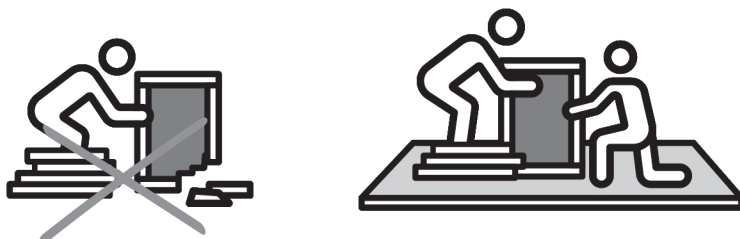
Suitable Location

Assembling near the area of the intended location is highly recommended.



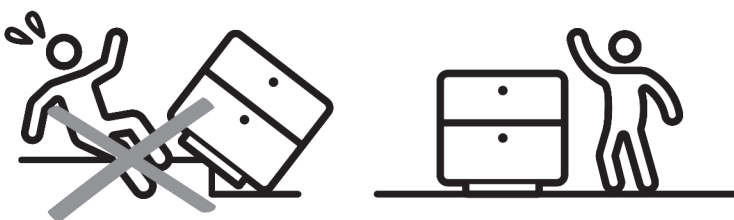
Sufficient Space

Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly.



Avoid Scratches

Use cardboard, blankets or a carpeted area while assembling furniture to prevent scratches.



Flat Surface

Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.

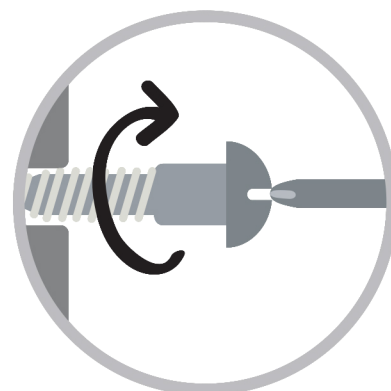

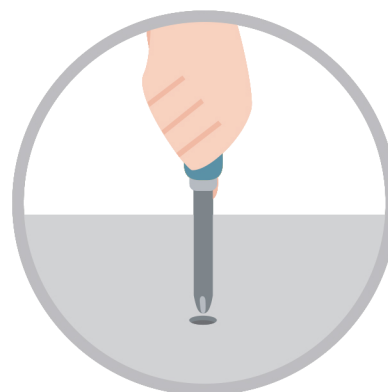

damage during assembly.



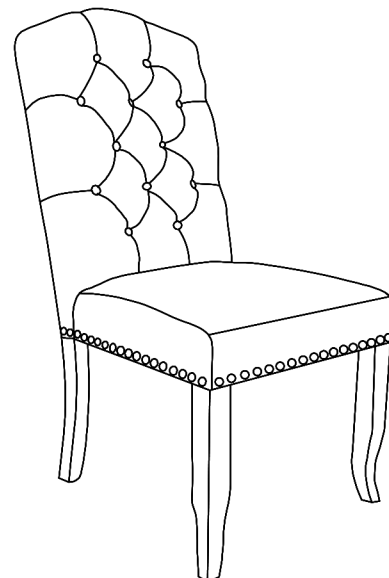
