

# Assembly Instructions

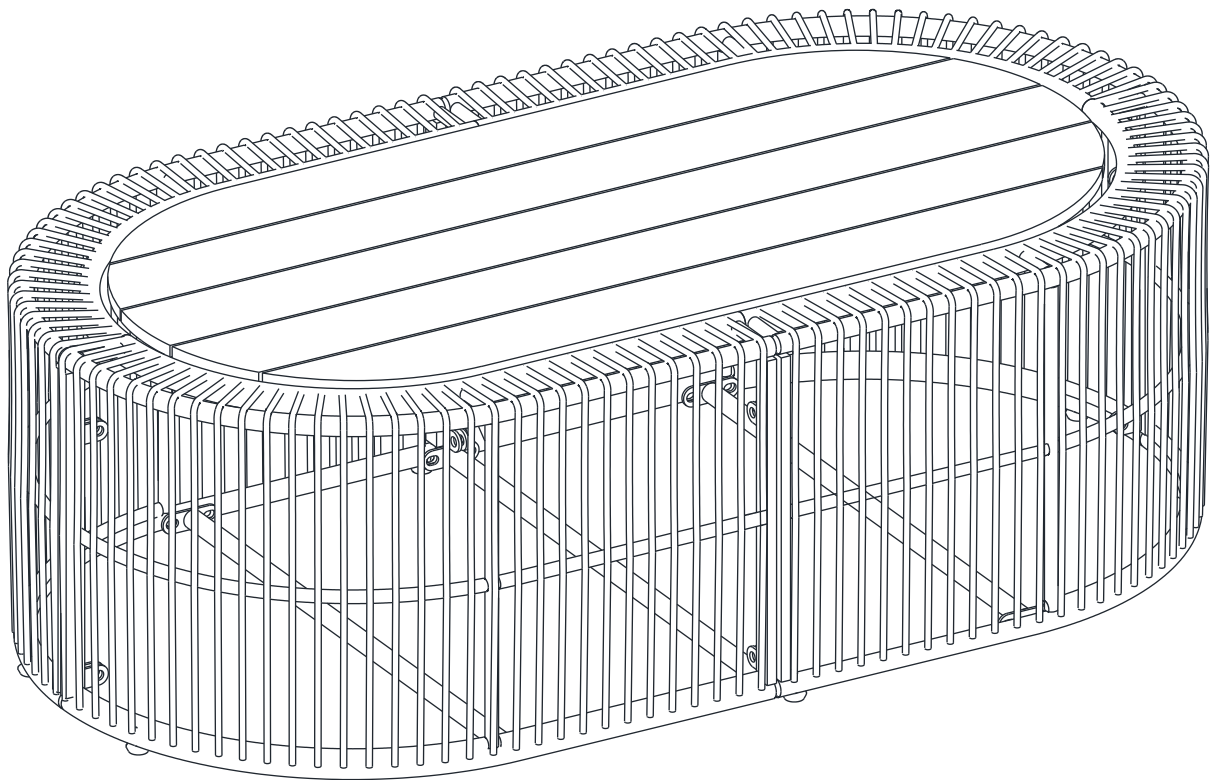
**Caution: You must read these Assembly Instructions before you proceed**

## Care & Maintenance

-   • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
-   • Prolonged exposure to rain may cause rusting which can stain floors.
-   • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
-   • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish
-   • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
-   • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
-   • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
-   • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
-   • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
-   • Keep away from sources of ignition.
-   • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.

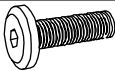
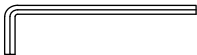
Keep your child/children at bay during the assembly process.

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-



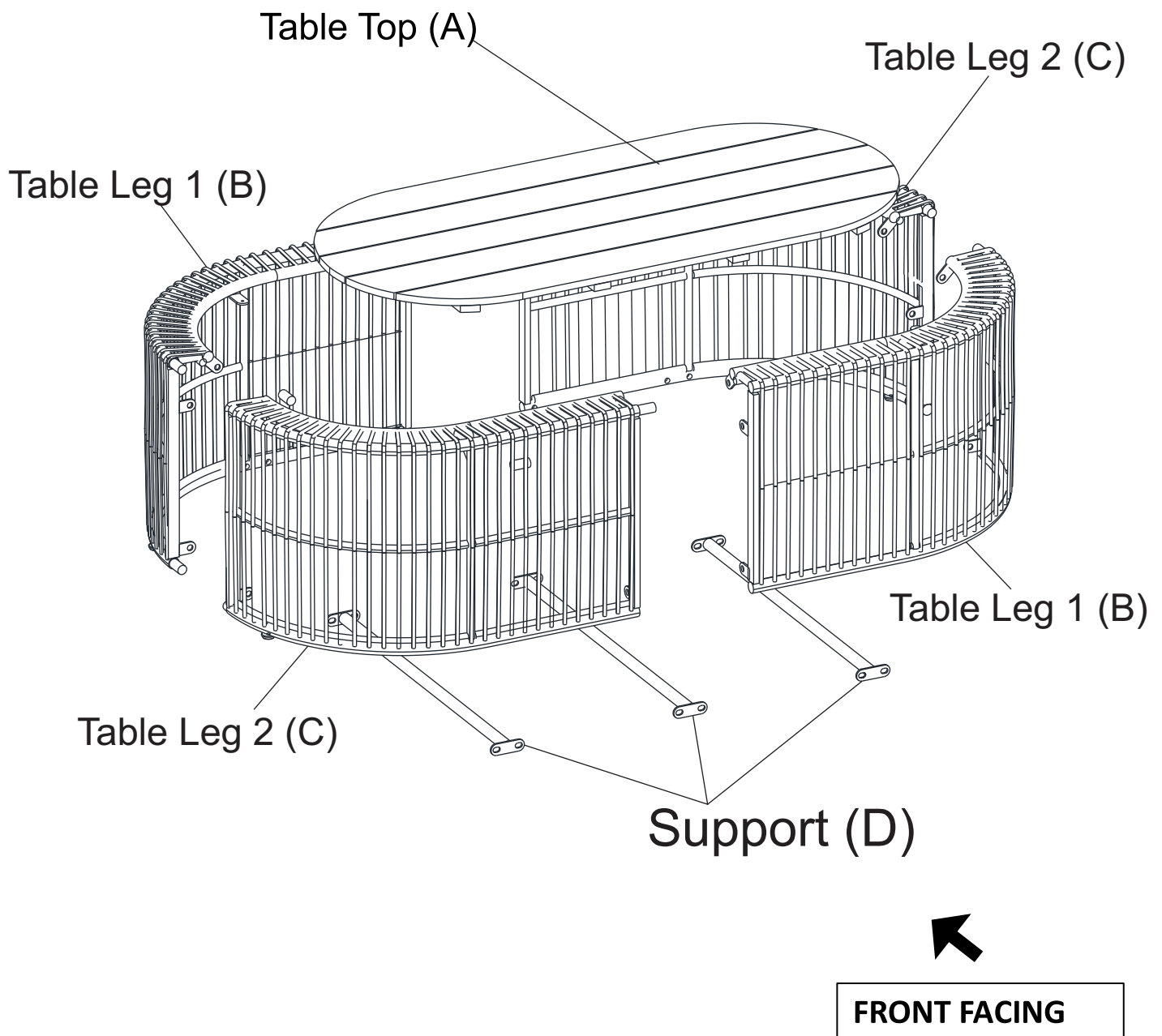
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-

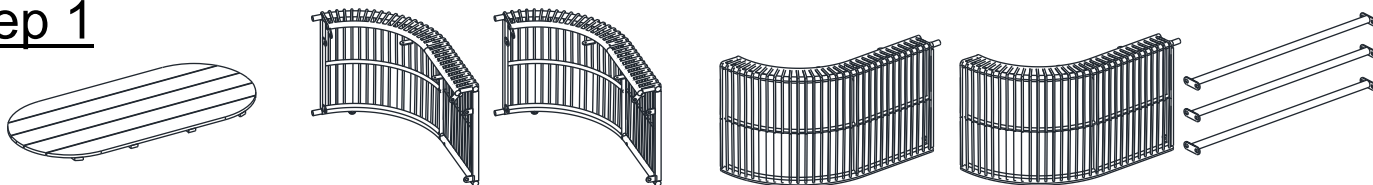
# Assembly Steps

## Overview



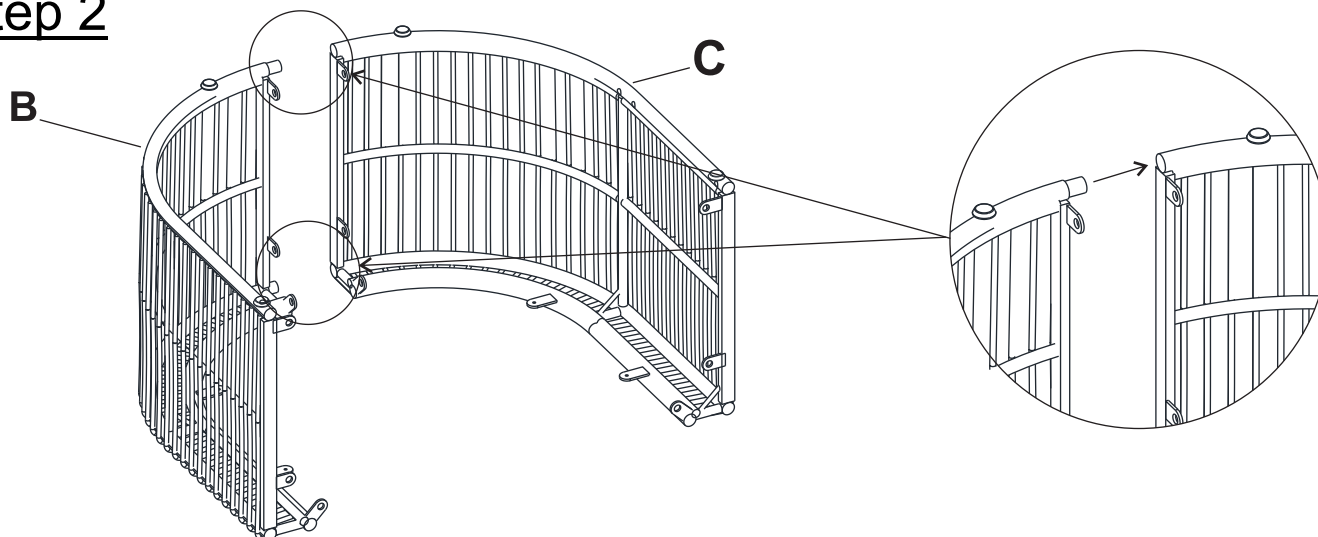
This Table has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

## Step 1



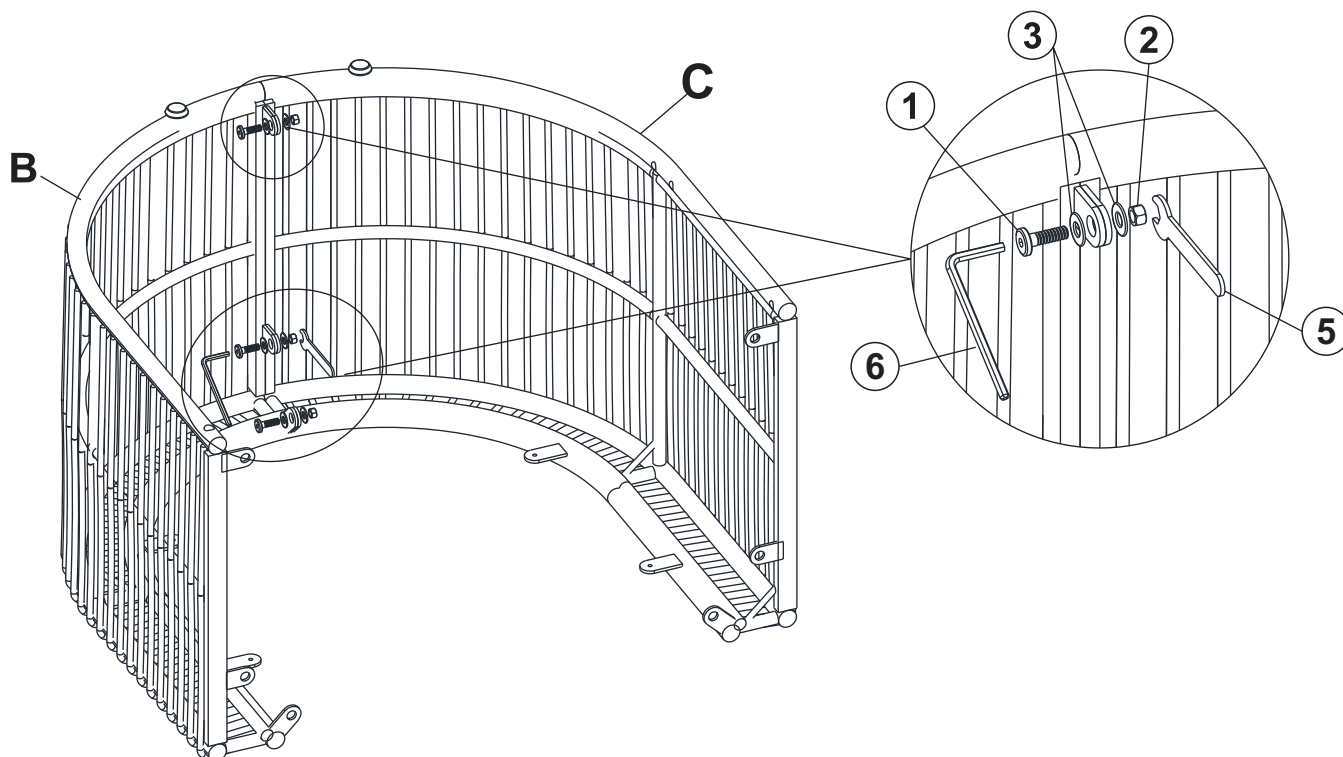
Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

## Step 2



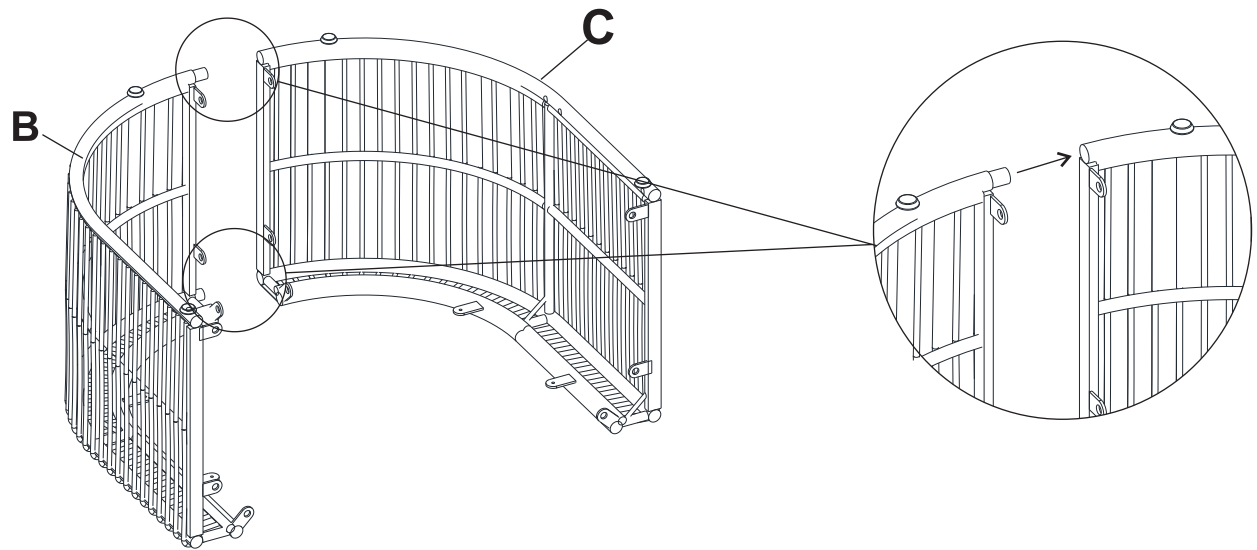
2. Connect Table leg 1 (B) and Table leg 2 (C).

## Step 3



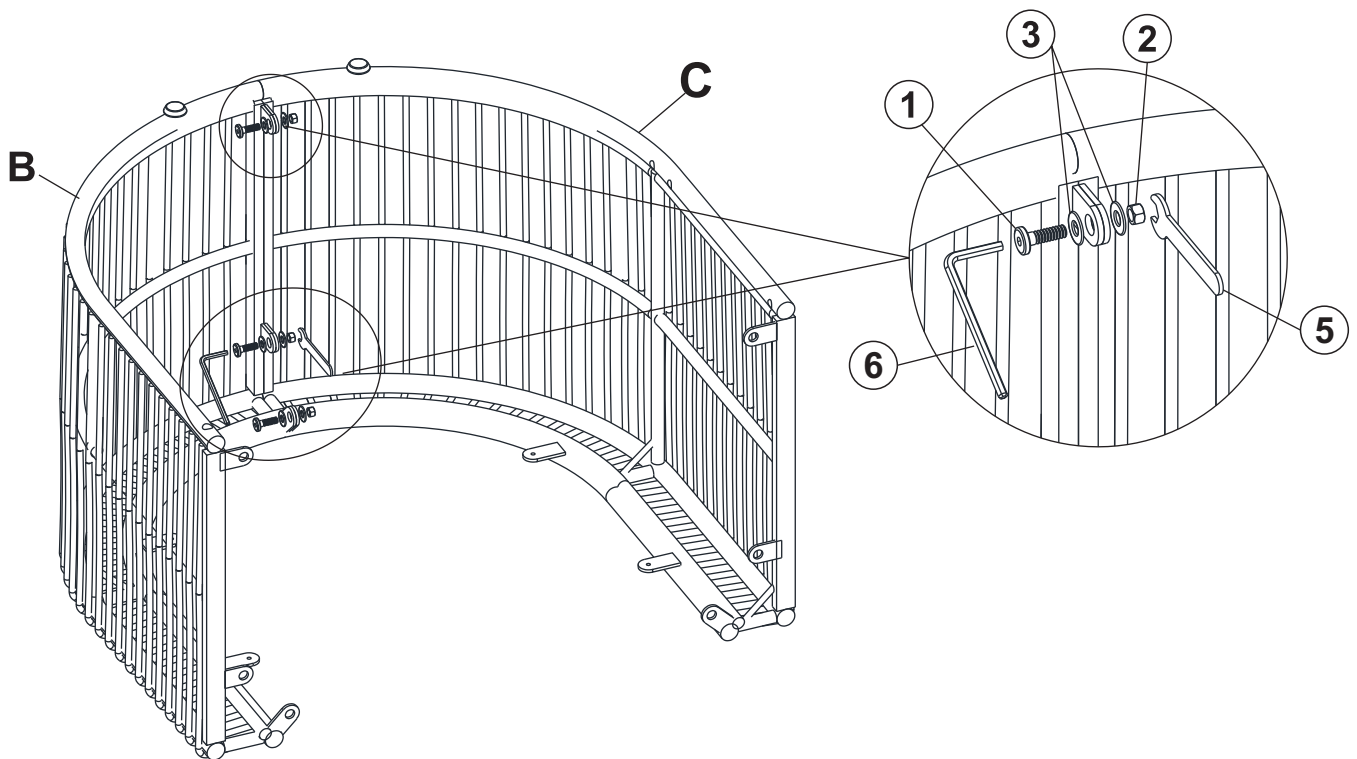
3. Then using Bolts (①), Nut (②), Washer (③) with Allen Wrench (⑥) and Spanner (⑤) to connect.  
**Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**

## Step 4



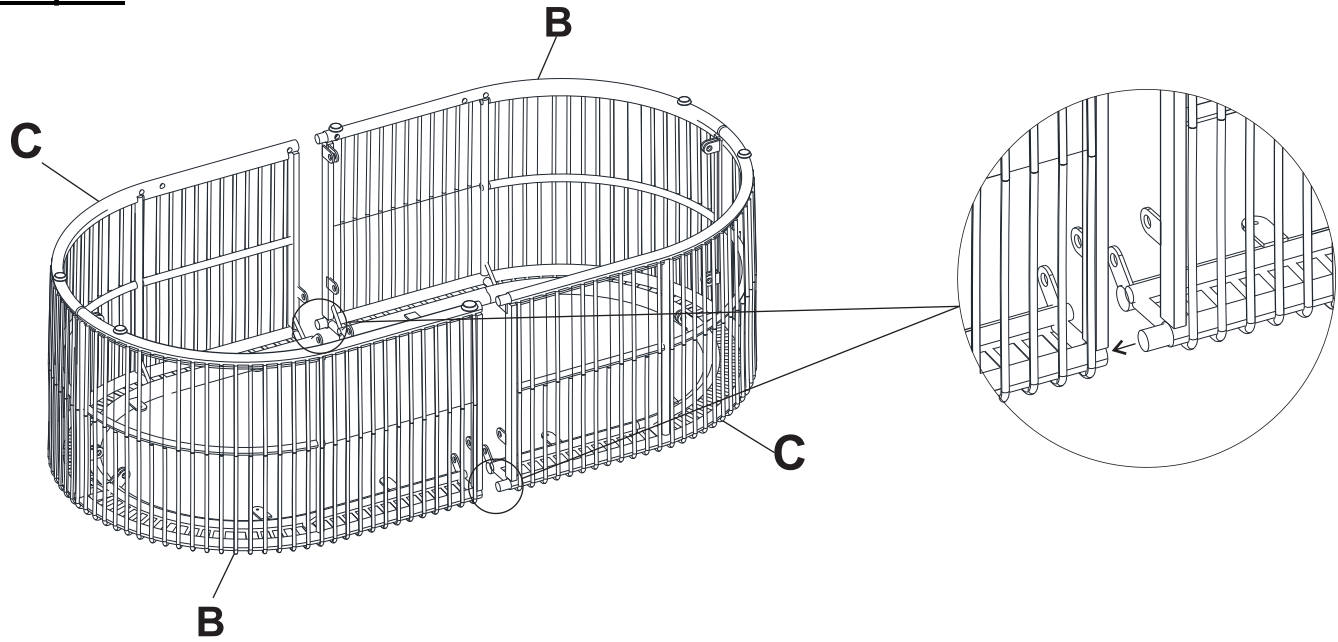
4. After that, Connect Table leg 1 (B) and Table leg 2 (C).

## Step 5



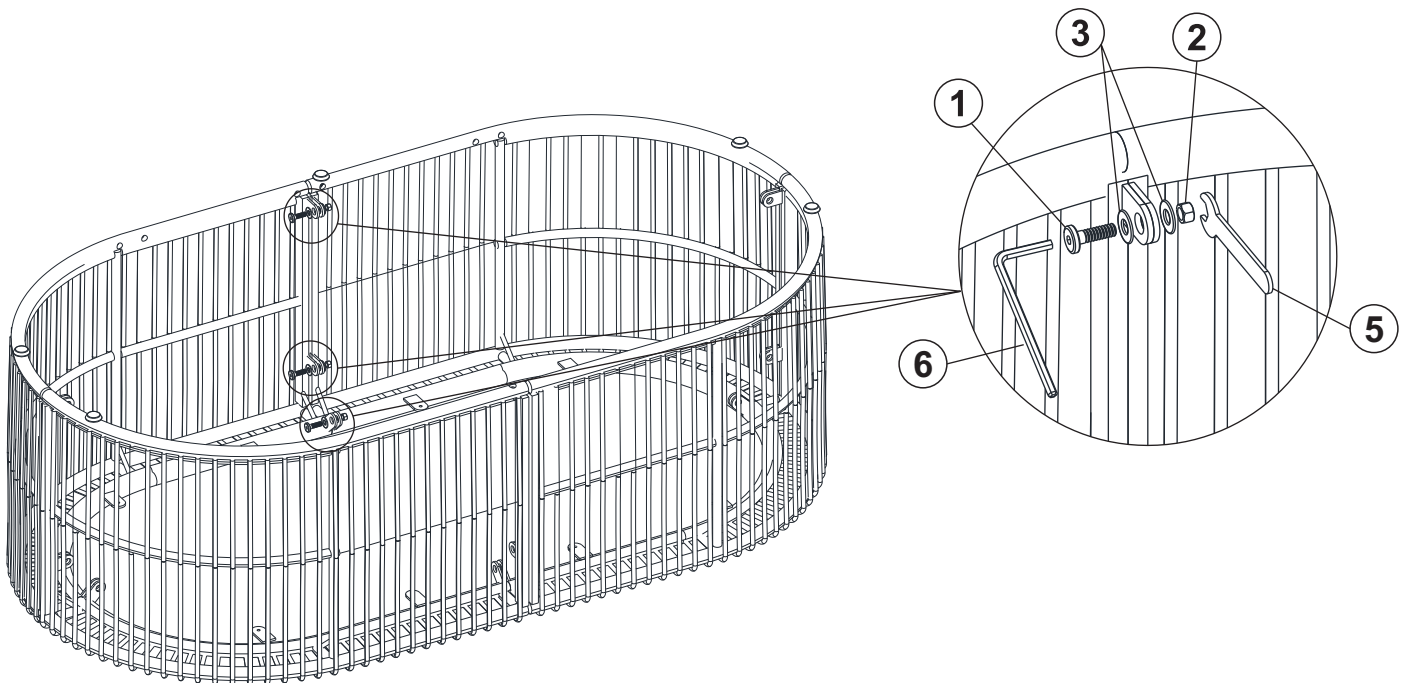
5. Then using Bolts (①), Nut (②), Washer (③) with Allen Wrench (⑥) and Spanner (⑤) to connect.  
**Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**

## Step 6



6. After that, Connect two part together.

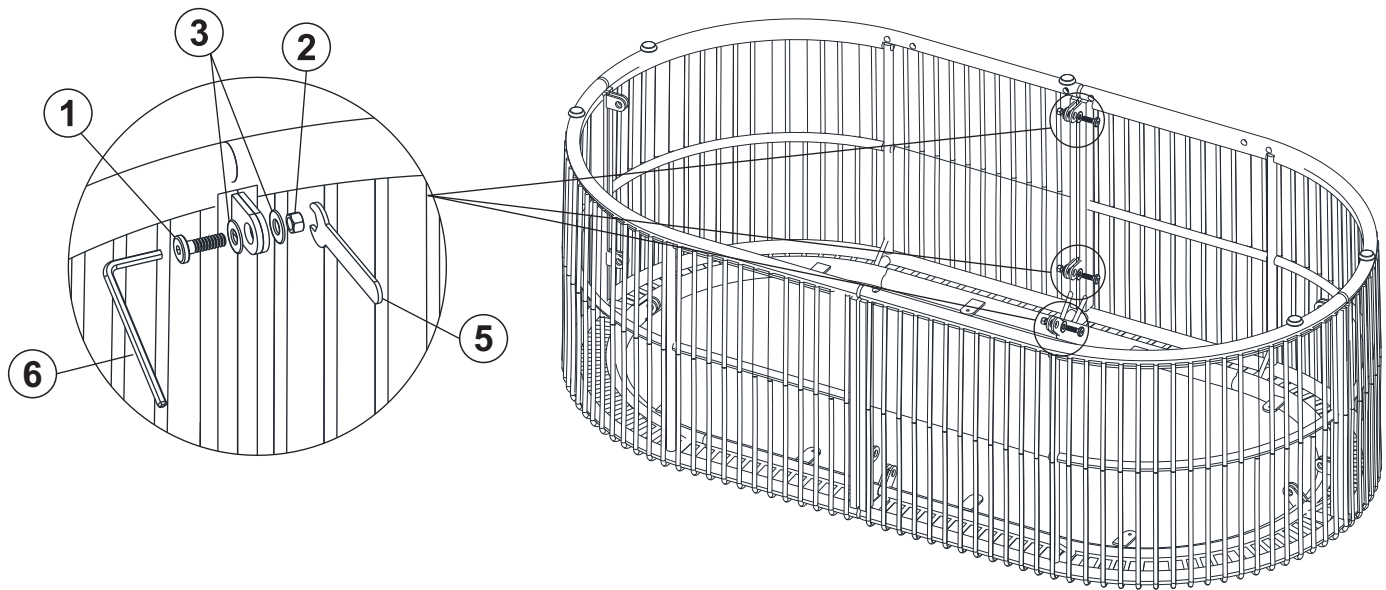
## Step 7



7. Then using Bolts (①), Nut (②), Washer (③) with Allen Wrench (⑥) and Spanner (⑤) to connect to part together.

**Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**

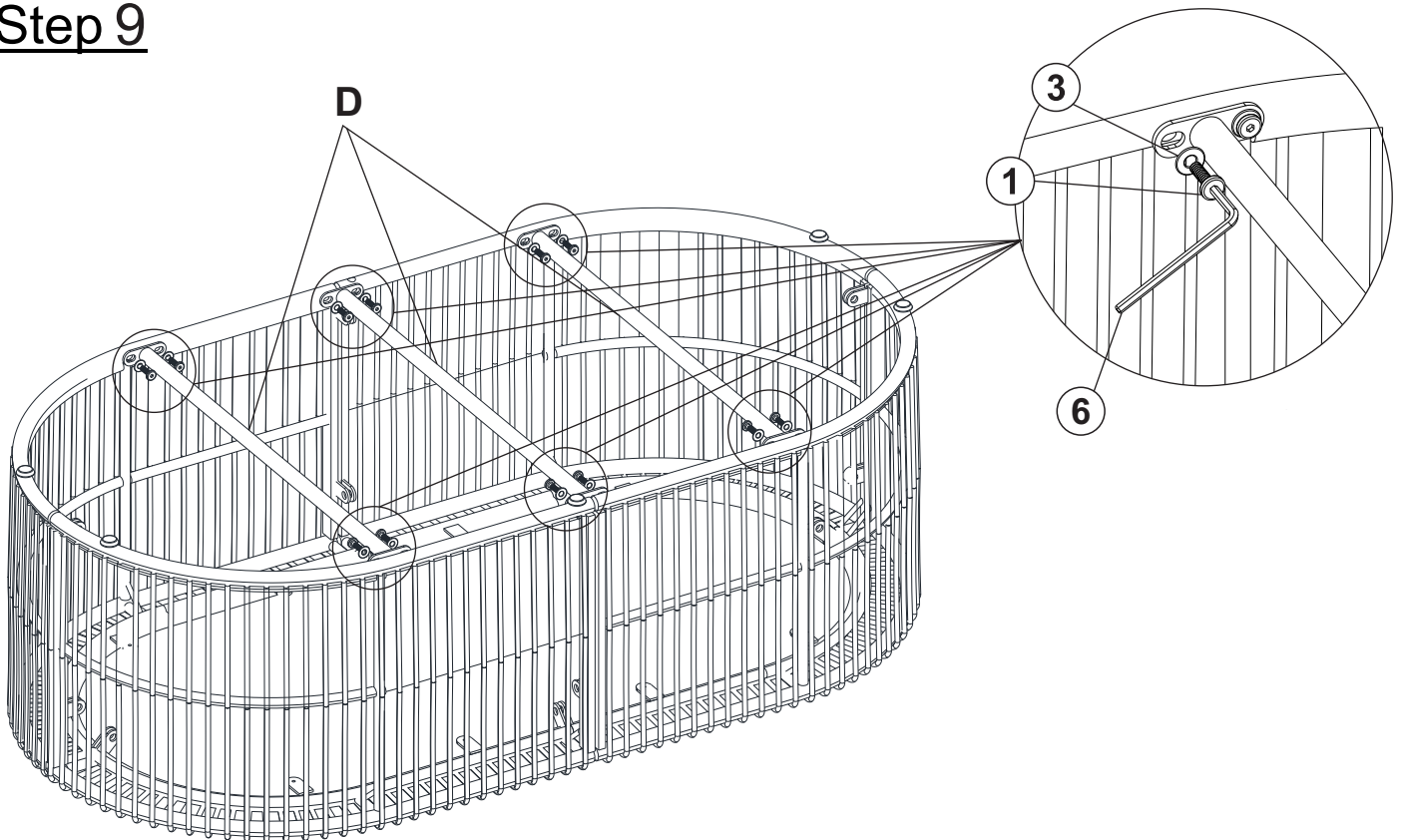
## Step 8



8. Then using Bolts ((1)), Nut ((2)), Washer ((3)) with Allen Wrench ((6)) and Spanner ((5)) to connect.

**Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**

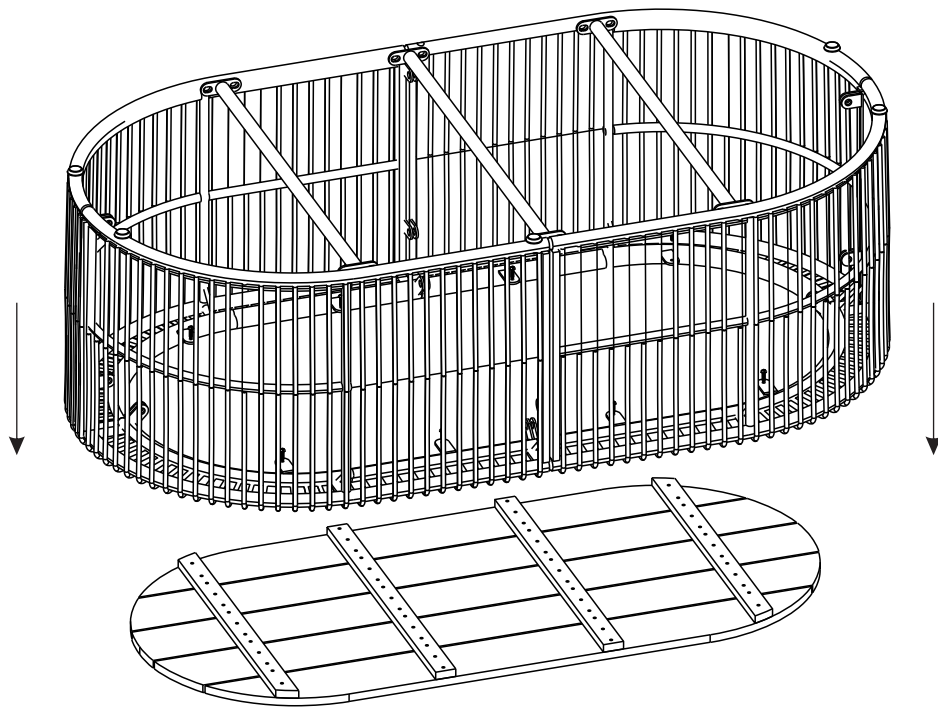
## Step 9



9. Then using Bolts ((1)), Washer ((3)) with Allen Wrench ((6)) to connect Support (D).

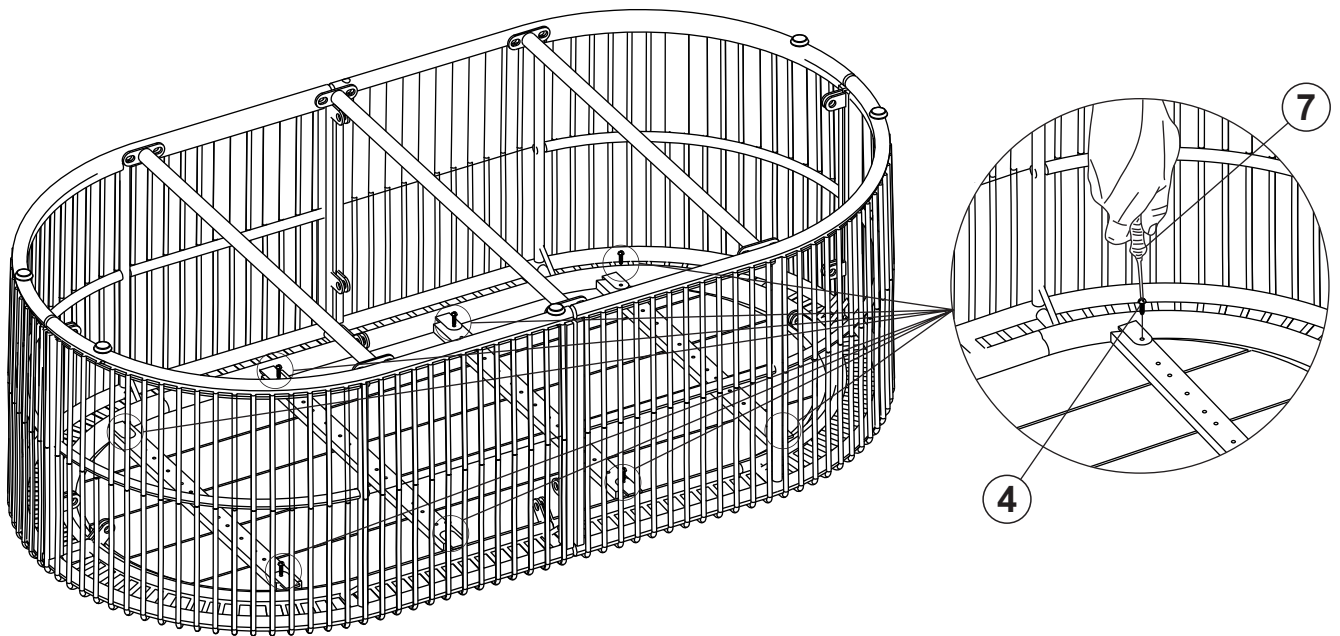
**Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**

## Step 10



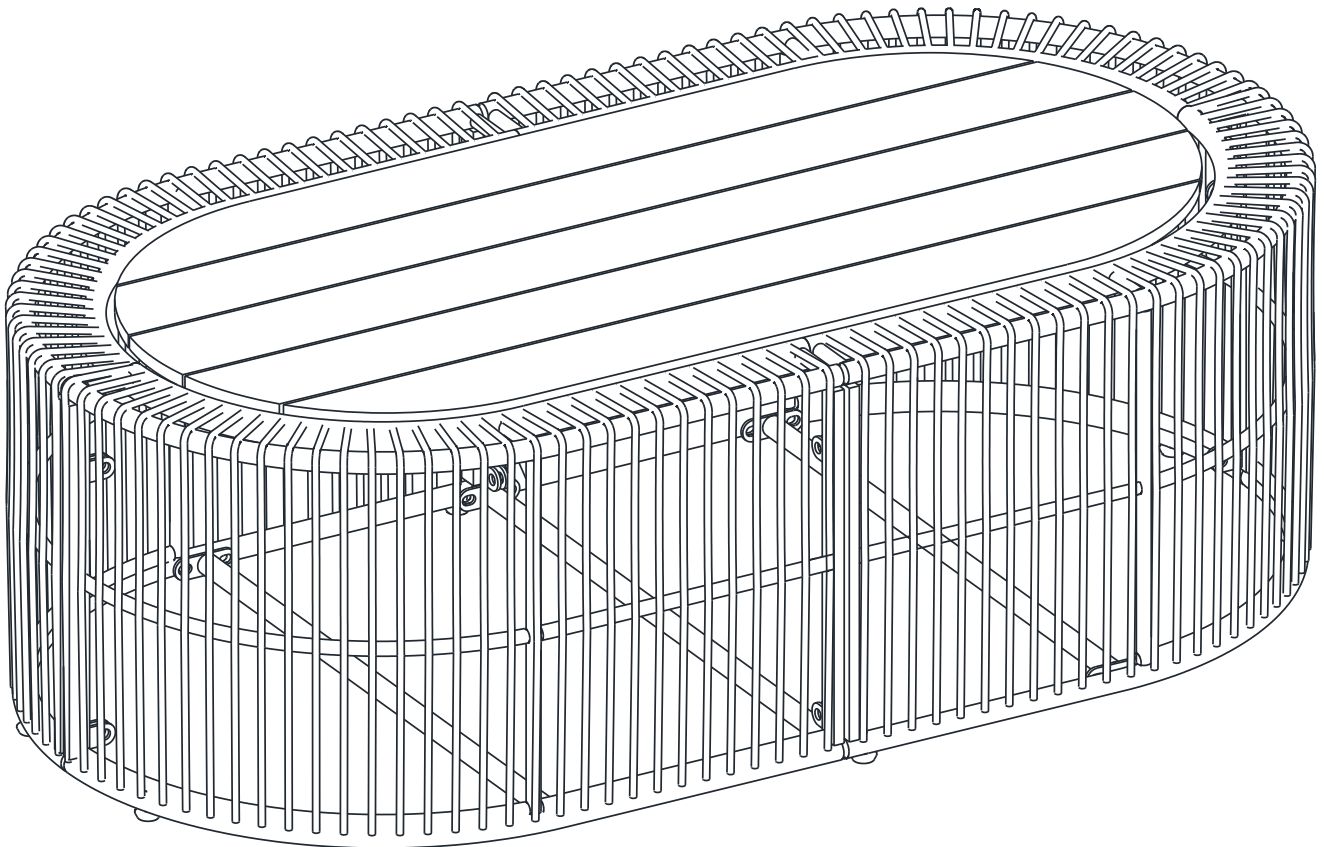
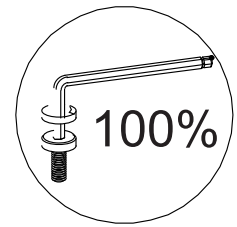
10. Then put the part on Table Top (A).

## Step 11



11. Then using Screw (④) with Screwdriver (⑦) to connect.

## Step 12



inspect the table and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Then EXERT pressure, floorwards onto the table with both hand

This pressure will help align all parts at all joint.

In a sequential manner, tighten all bolts at all joint.

**Adjust the Levellers until the table is level with the ground.**

**To adjust the Levellers, get assistance from an adult partner to lift/lean and hold the table while you are working**
