Assembly Instructions



Step 1

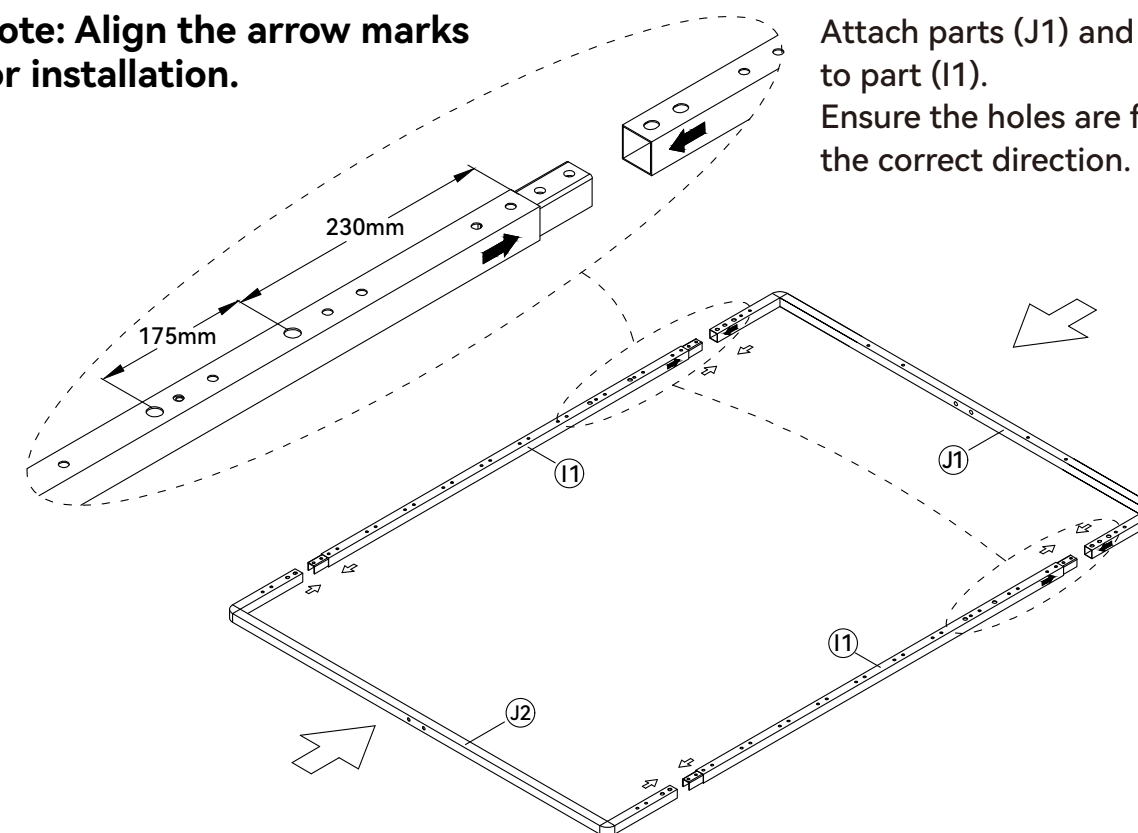
Connect parts (O1) and (O2).
Tighten with screw (X4).



Step 2

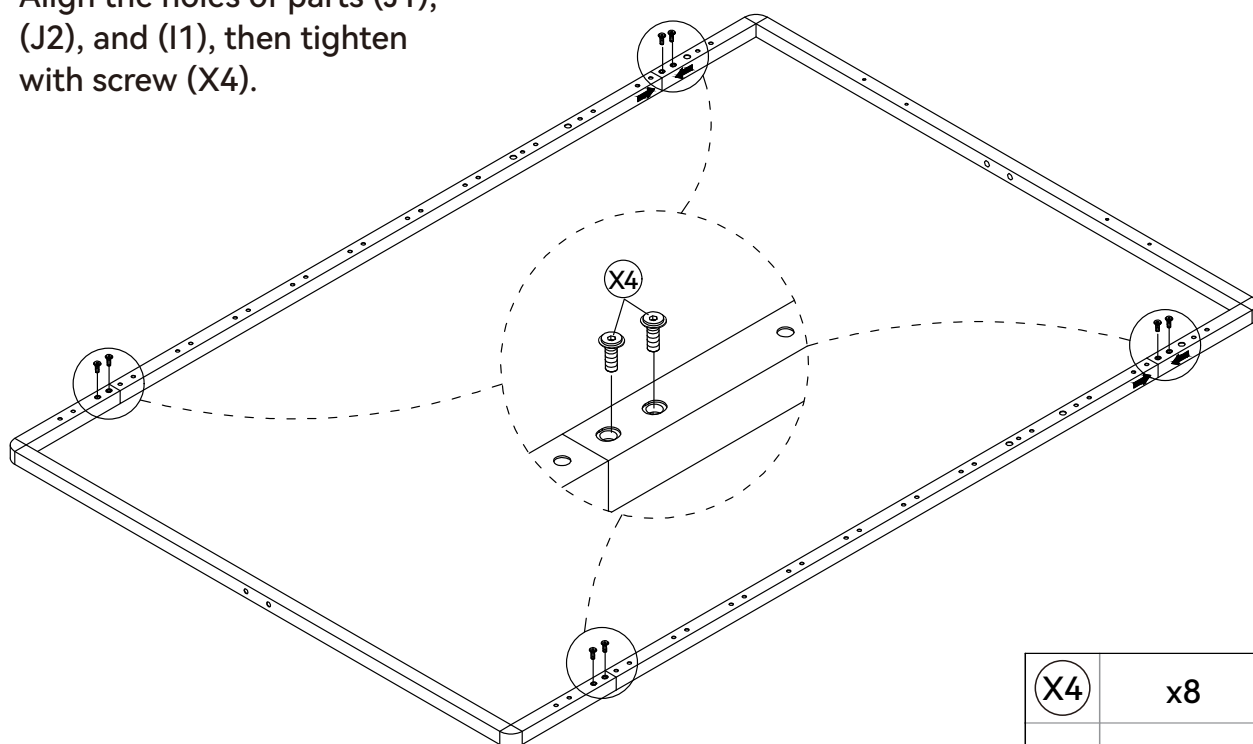
Note: Align the arrow marks for installation.

Attach parts (J1) and (J2) to part (I1).
Ensure the holes are facing the correct direction.



Step 3

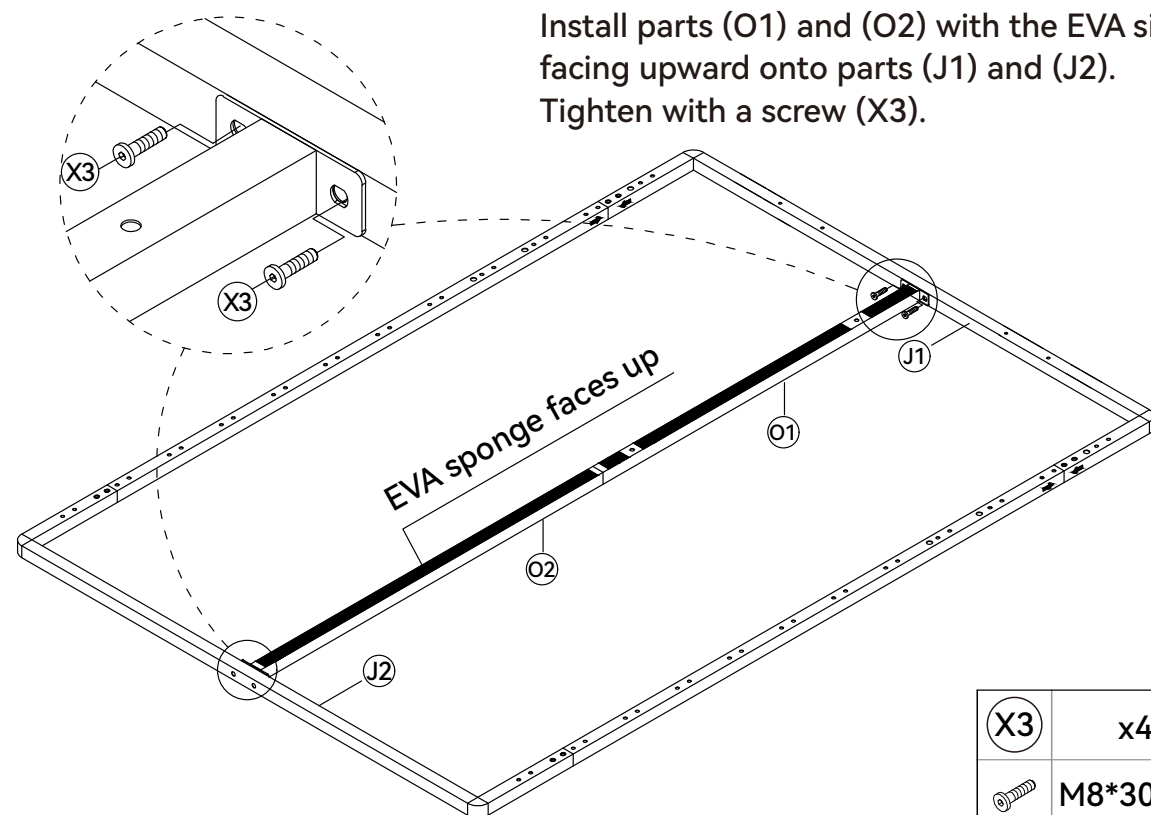
Align the holes of parts (J1), (J2), and (I1), then tighten with screw (X4).

Step 4

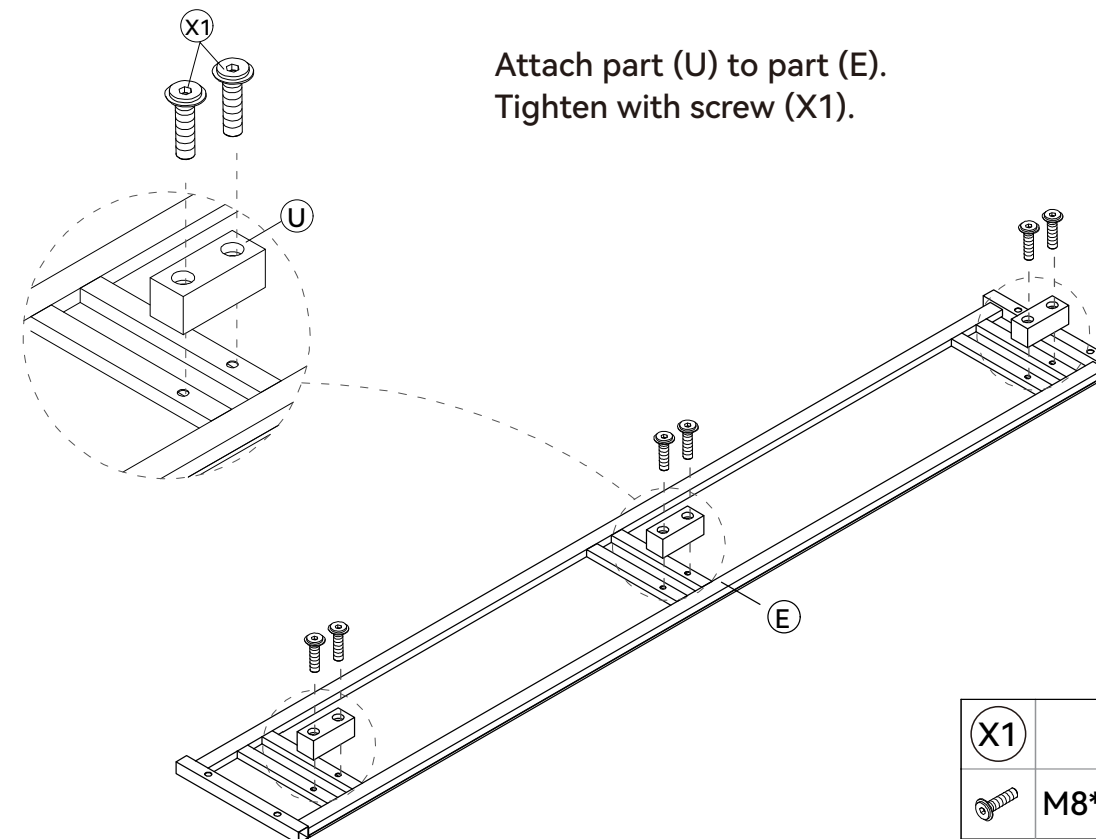
Install parts (O1) and (O2) with the EVA side facing upward onto parts (J1) and (J2). Tighten with a screw (X3).

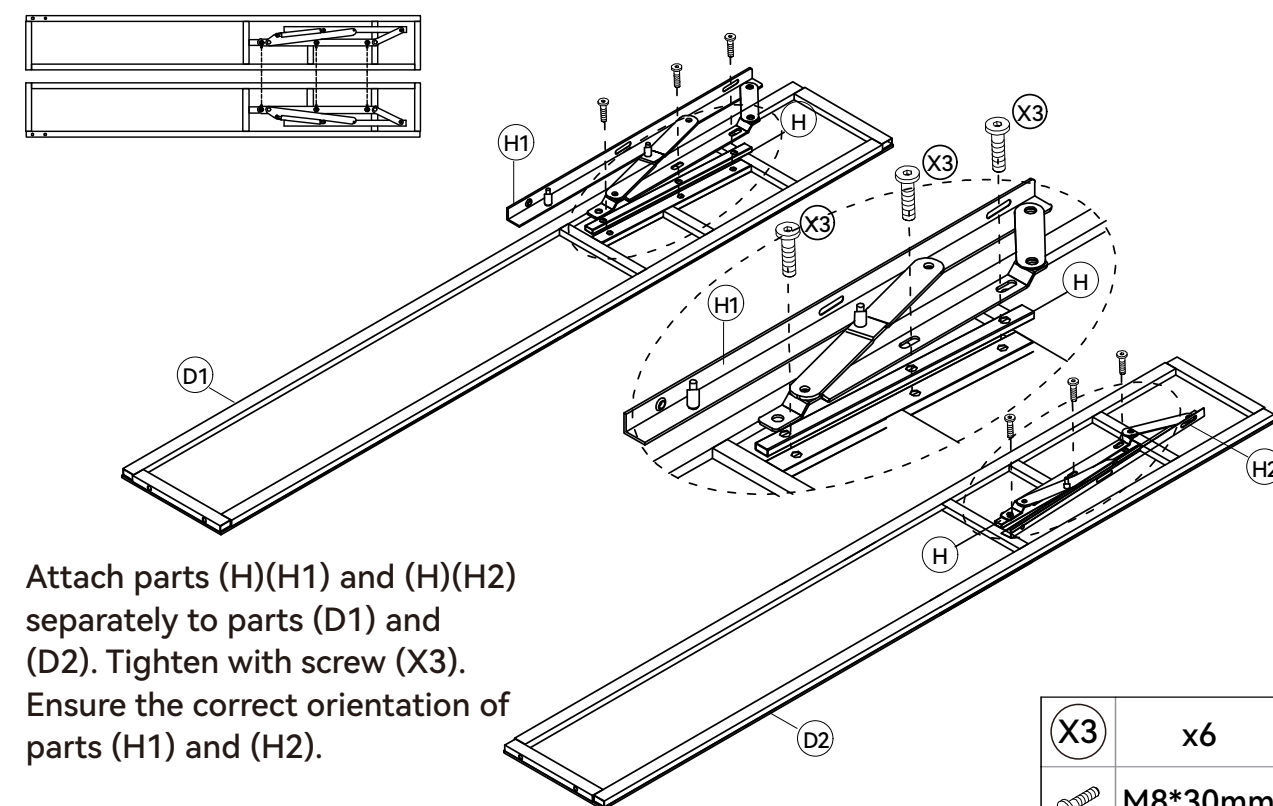
Step 5

Attach part (U) to part (E). Tighten with screw (X1).

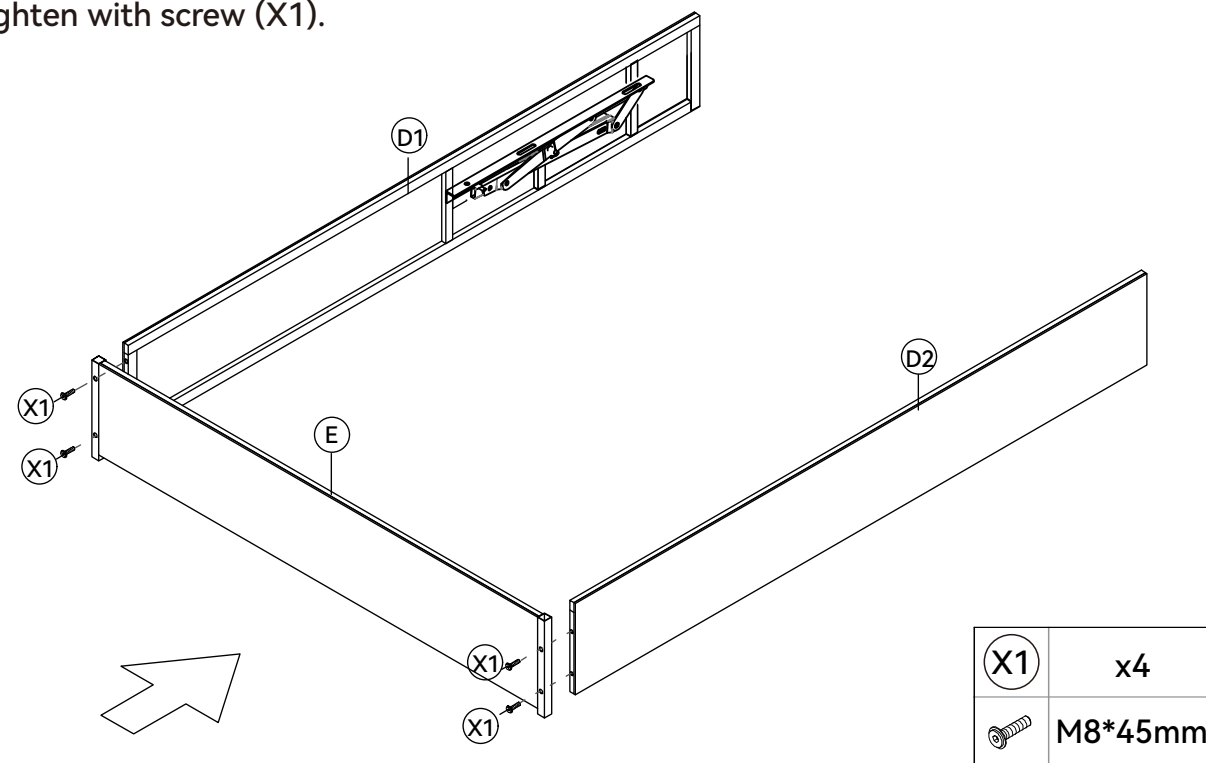


Attach parts (H)(H1) and (H)(H2) separately to parts (D1) and (D2). Tighten with screw (X3). Ensure the correct orientation of parts (H1) and (H2).

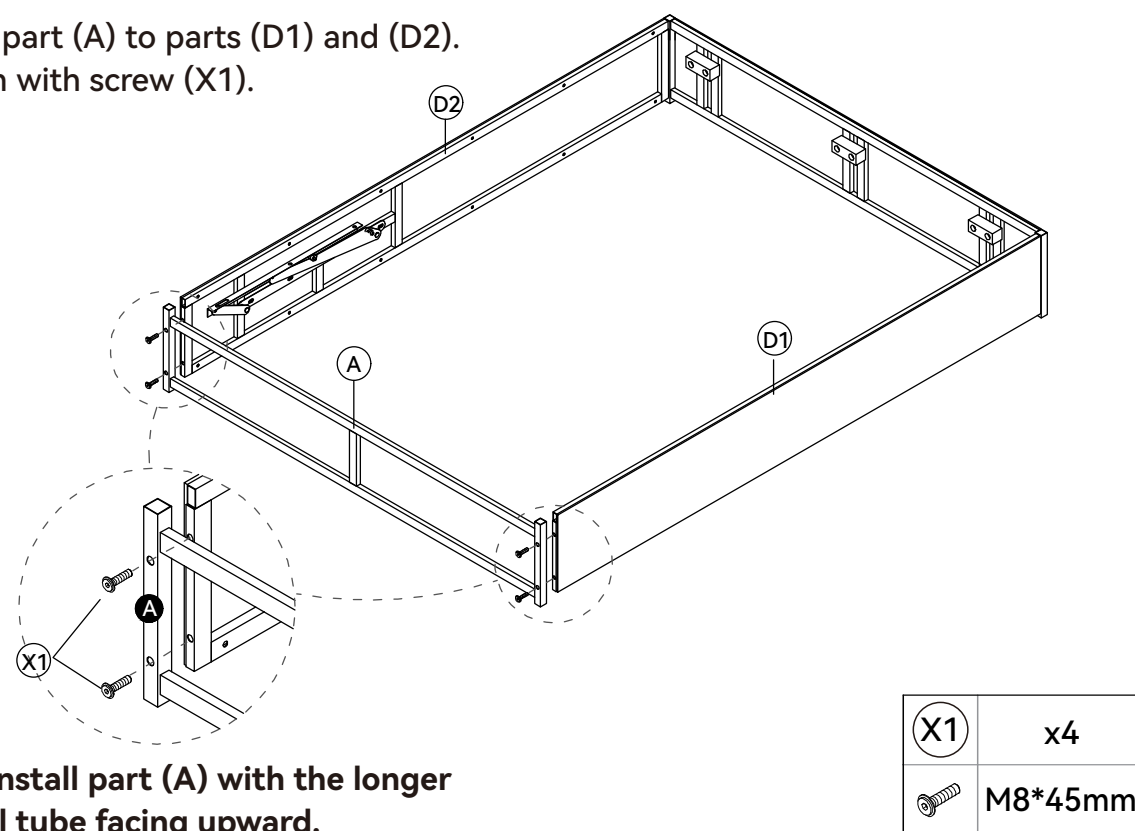
Step 7

Connect parts (D1) and (D2) to part (E).
Tighten with screw (X1).



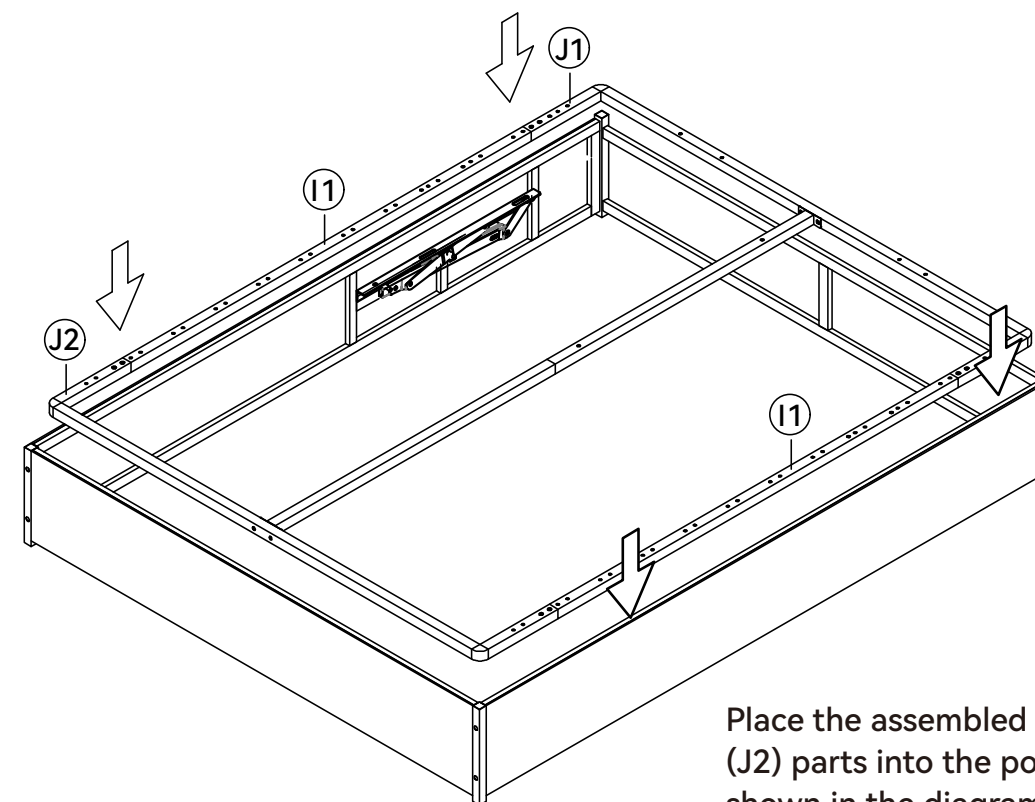

Attach part (A) to parts (D1) and (D2).
Tighten with screw (X1).



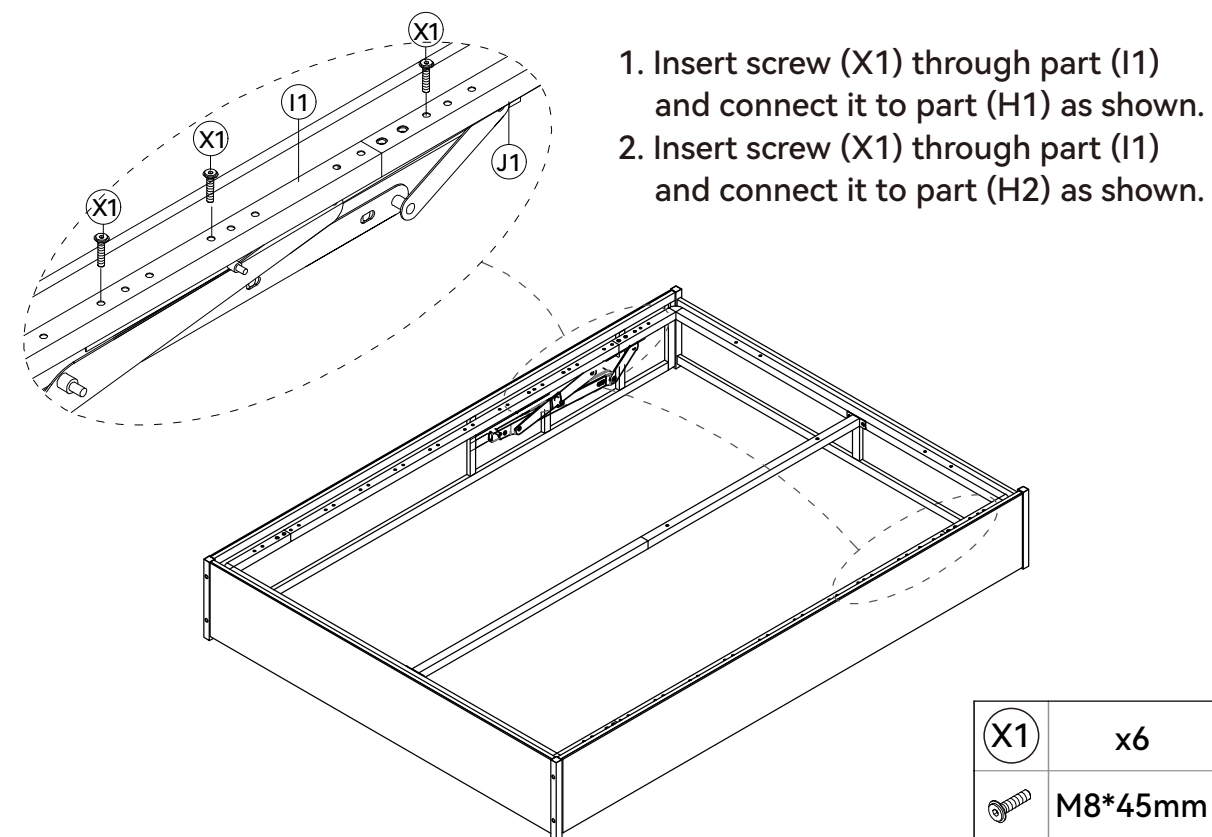
Note: Install part (A) with the longer vertical tube facing upward.

Step 9



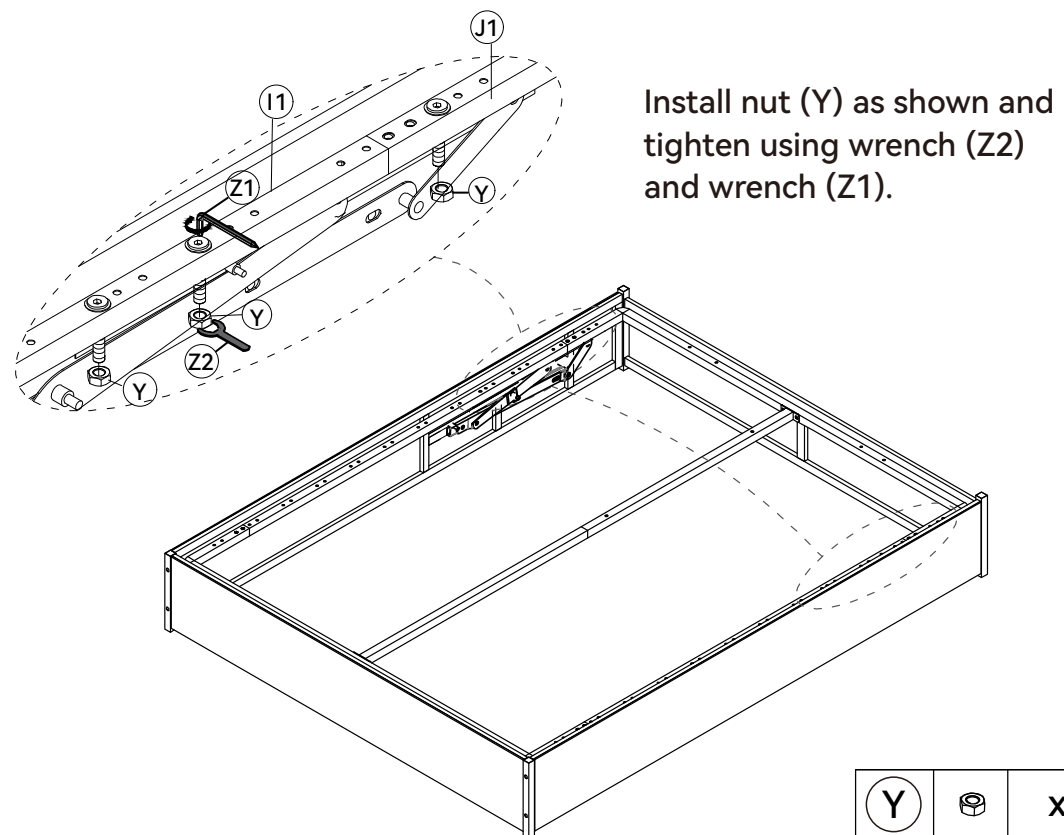
Place the assembled (J1) and (J2) parts into the position shown in the diagram.

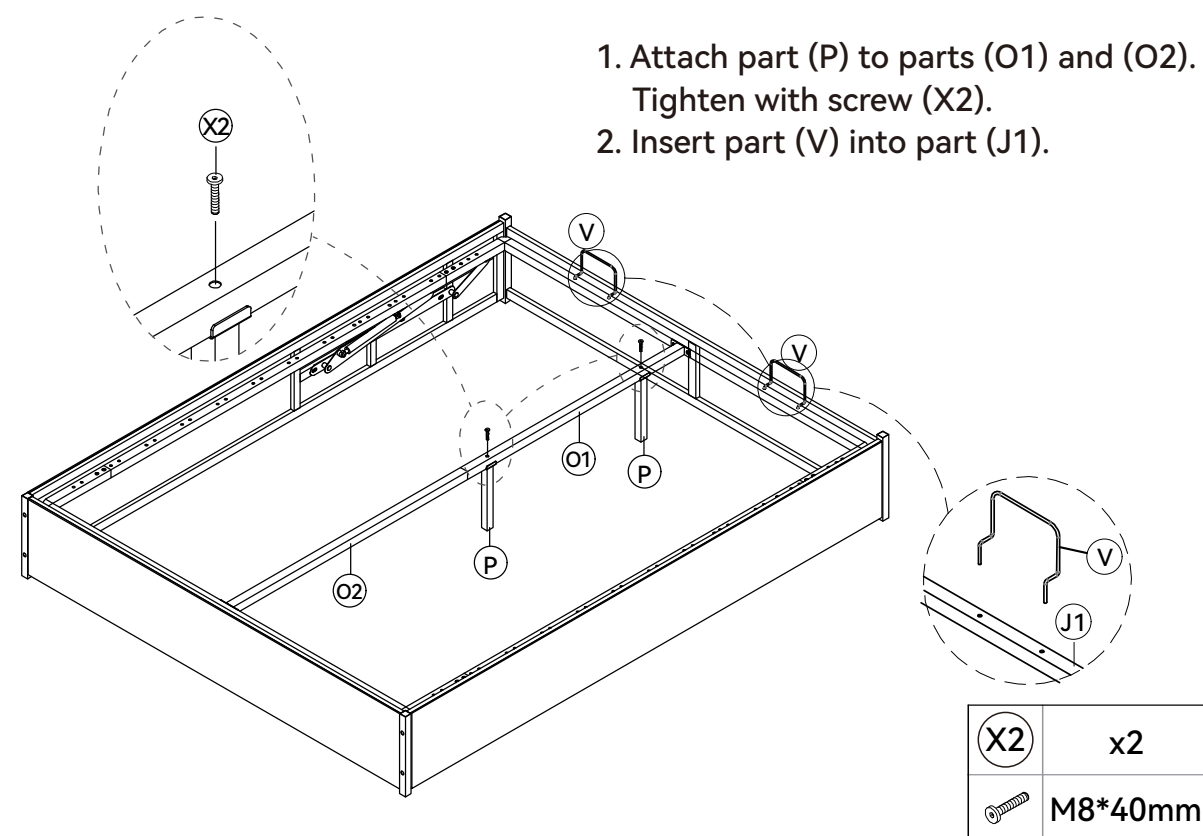


1. Insert screw (X1) through part (I1) and connect it to part (H1) as shown.
2. Insert screw (X1) through part (I1) and connect it to part (H2) as shown.

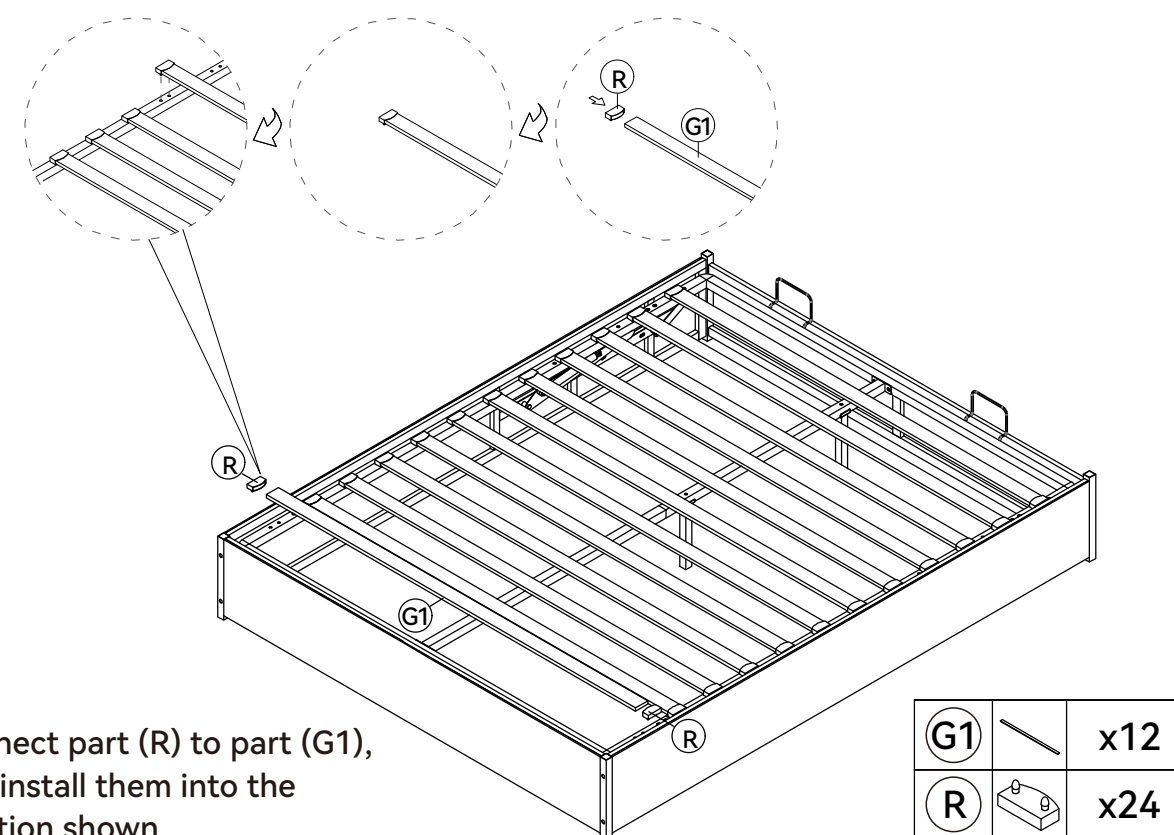

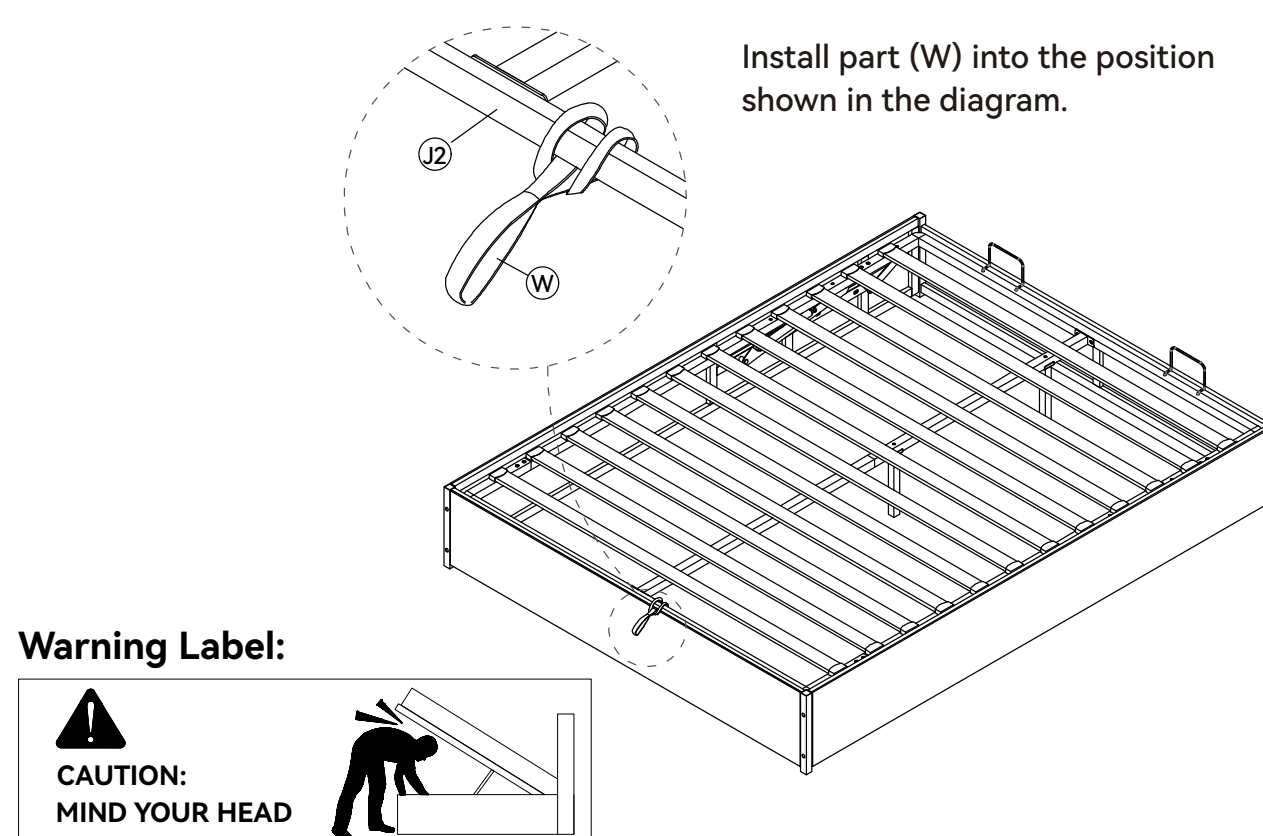

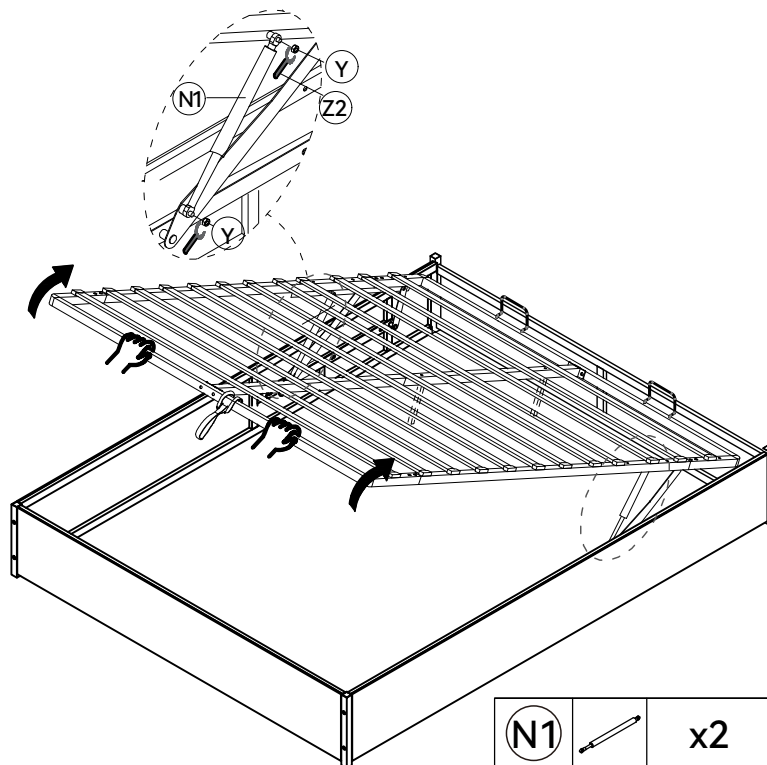

Tips: If only one person installs the Hydraulic rod, one hand to hold the I1 up and the another put the N1 on the right position as shown in the figure. After installing the N1, tighten the screws.

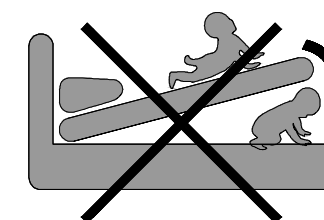
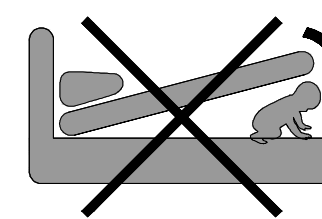
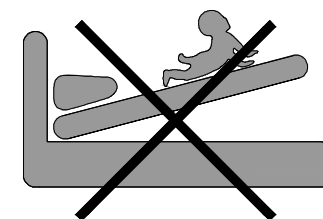
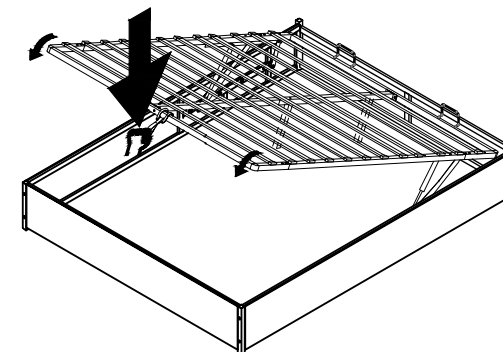
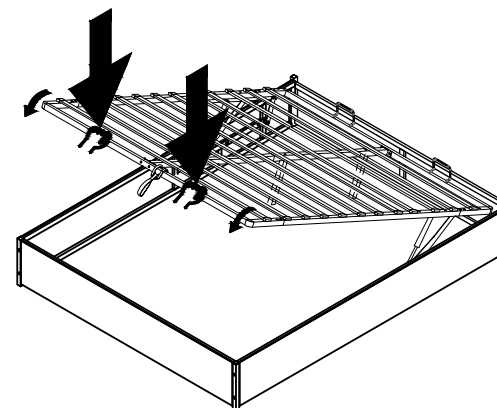
Two people are required. Lift the structure into the indicated position, install part (N1), and tighten nut (Y) using wrench (Z2).

Lock all the screws.

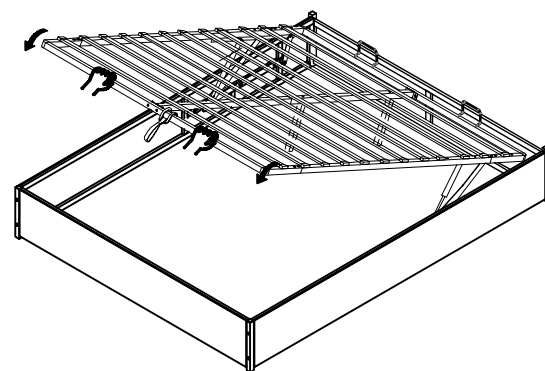

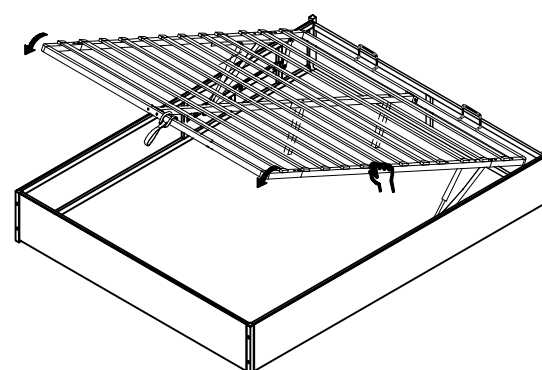

Note:

1. It requires extra force to push down when there is no mattress placed on it.
2. The hydraulic struts only function when mounted on the bed frame and cannot be actuated independently.



Operate from the foot of the bed



To avoid deformation of the metal frame, do not operate from the sides of the bed.
