

General Instructions:

We strongly recommend that this product be installed by a professional.

Materials Recommended:

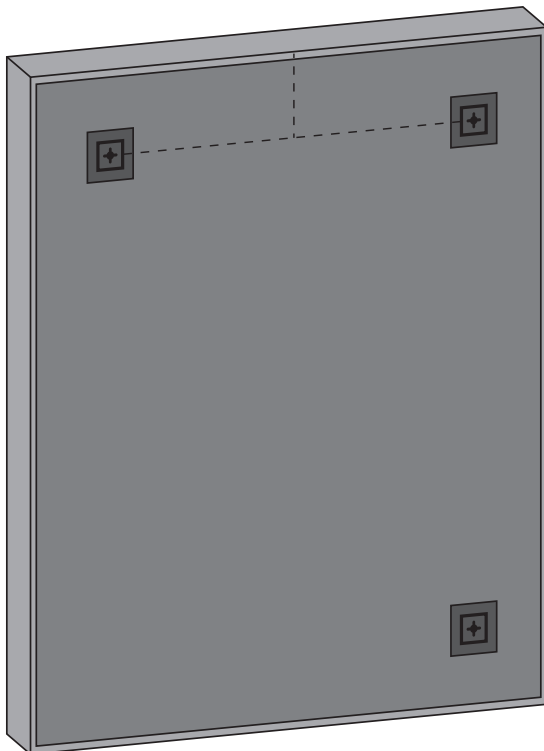
Appropriate hanging hardware for your chosen mounting surface *(Rated for at least 30lbs)*

Tools Needed:

Measuring Tape Pencil Level

1. Decide the hanging orientation for the mirror: portrait or landscape.
2. Select the mounting location that will accommodate the weight and size of the mirror.
3. On the back of the mirror, measure and record the distance between the top of the mirror and the center of the mounting bracket as well as between the centers of the two mounting brackets. *(Figure 1)*

4. Hold the mirror to the selected mounting location and lightly mark the wall at the top center of the frame, then using the previously recorded measurement mark the wall down where the mounting brackets center will sit. *(Figure 2)*
5. Install the hanging hardware at the markings on the wall according to the manufacturer's instructions and then attach the mirror. Check with a level and adjust if necessary.
