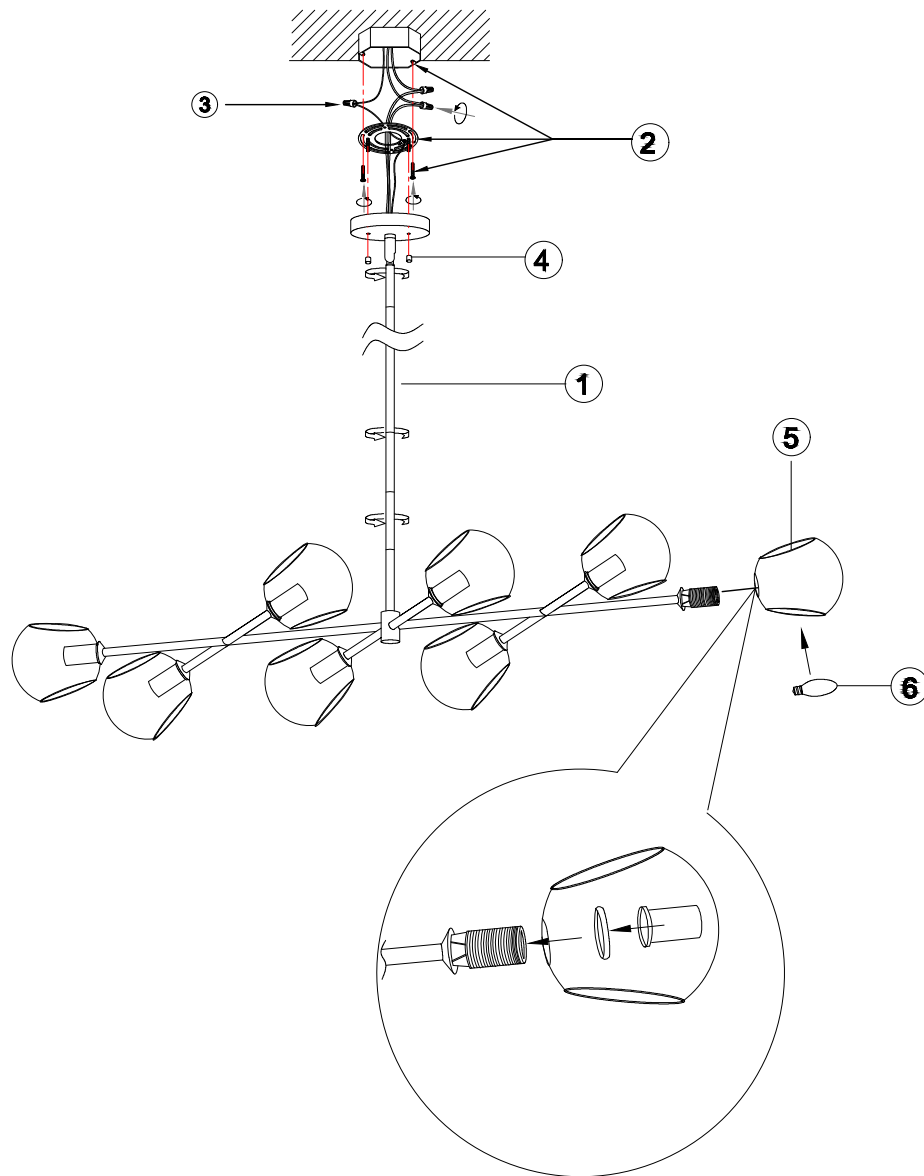


# ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

**WARNING:** TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



## Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

## Step-by-Step Installation:

### Step 1: Assemble Suspension Rod & Route Wiring:

Adjust the suspension rods to the desired hanging height by connecting the segments. Feed the main power cord completely through the assembled suspension rod.

### Step 2: Secure the mounting bracket to the junction box using the mounting screw.

### Step 3: Wiring the Fixture:

- Connect the neutral wire (white) from the fixture to the neutral wire (-) from the power source using a wire nut.
- Connect the live wire (black) from the fixture to the live wire (+) from the power source using a wire nut.

*\*Ensure no exposed wires are visible to prevent electrical hazards.*

Secure the fixture ground wire to the mounting bracket using the green ground screw and connect it to the external ground wire.

### Step 4: Attach the canopy: Align the canopy with the mounting bracket and secure it using the decorative screws.

### Step 5: Attach the Glass Shade

Place the rubber gasket onto the fixture socket. Align the glass shade and secure it with the retaining ring.

*\*Caution: Glass is fragile! Avoid overtightening—stop when resistance is felt.*

### Step 6: Install the light bulbs. (Bulb Not Included)

## Safety Instructions:

**To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.**

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
