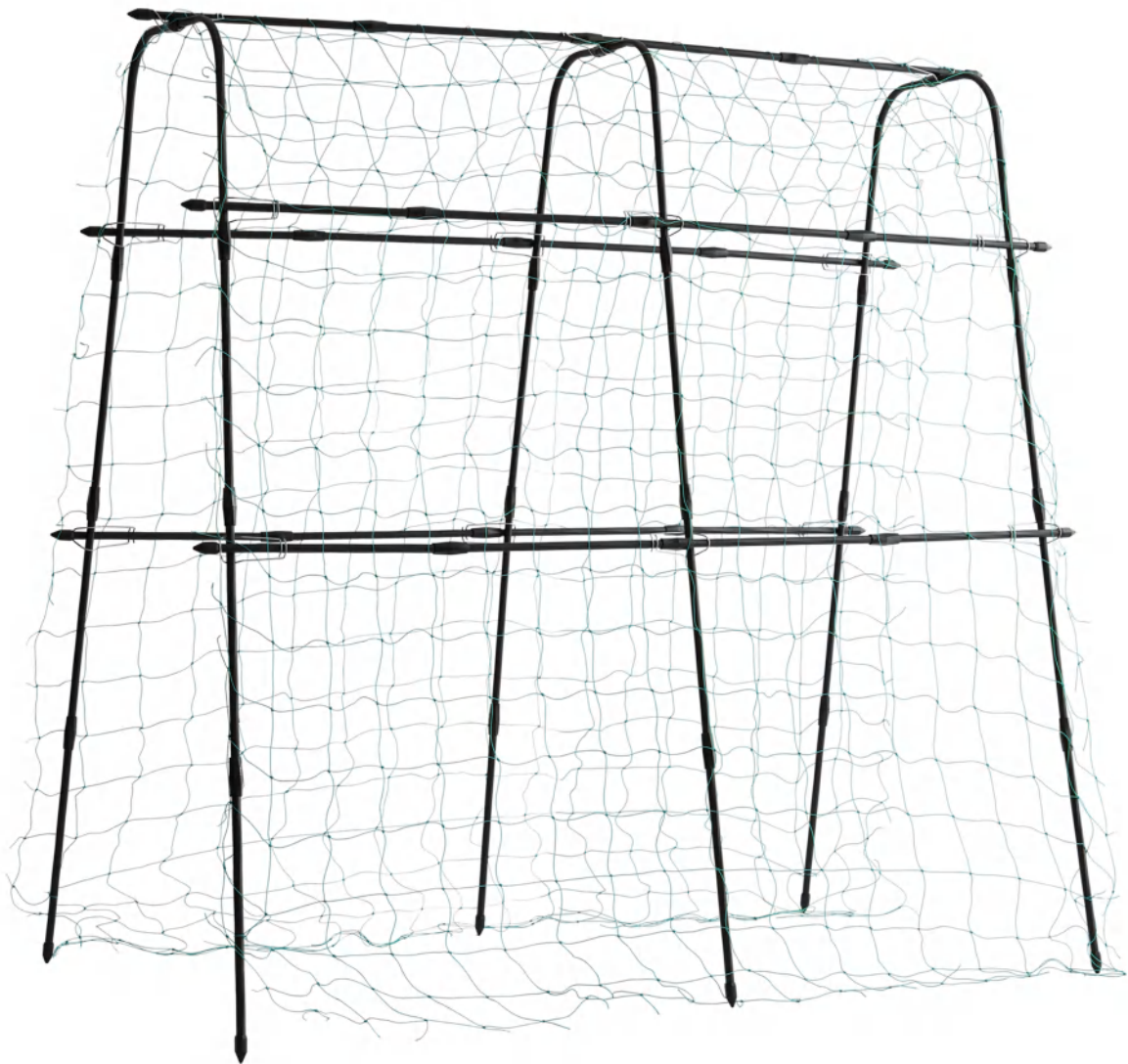


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

How to Install the Metal Sure-Clips?

(Please wear gloves when installing)

NOTE: This may require some extra finger strength, as Sure-Clips are made to be very tight.

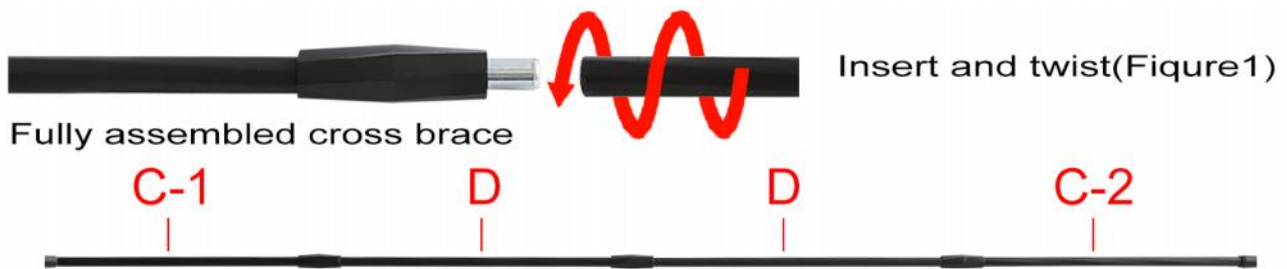


Assembling Cross Braces

Need Parts: Part C-1, 5 Pcs; Part C-2, 5 Pcs; Part D, 10 Pcs.

After splicing the two intermediate connecting stakes (Part D) together, connect the Cross braces (Part C-1,C-2) at each end.

Repeat these steps and then you will have 5 assembled cross braces. (Figure 1)

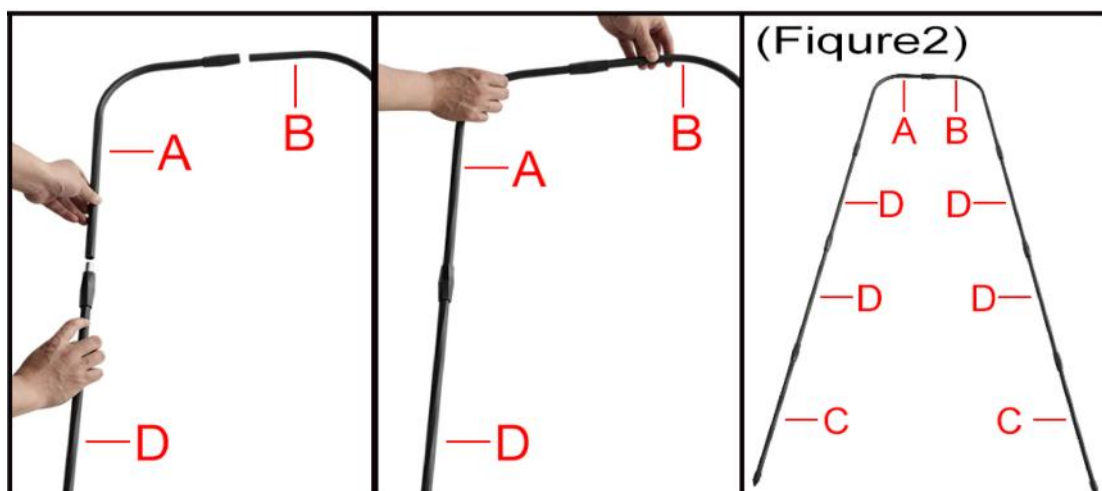

Assembling the Arch Support Frame

Need Parts: Part A, 3 Pcs; Part B, Connect Part A, B, C, and D in the same way, and tighten it. 3 Pcs; Part C, 6 Pcs; Part D, 12 Pcs.

Repeat the installation three times, and then you will get three arch support frames. (Figure 2)

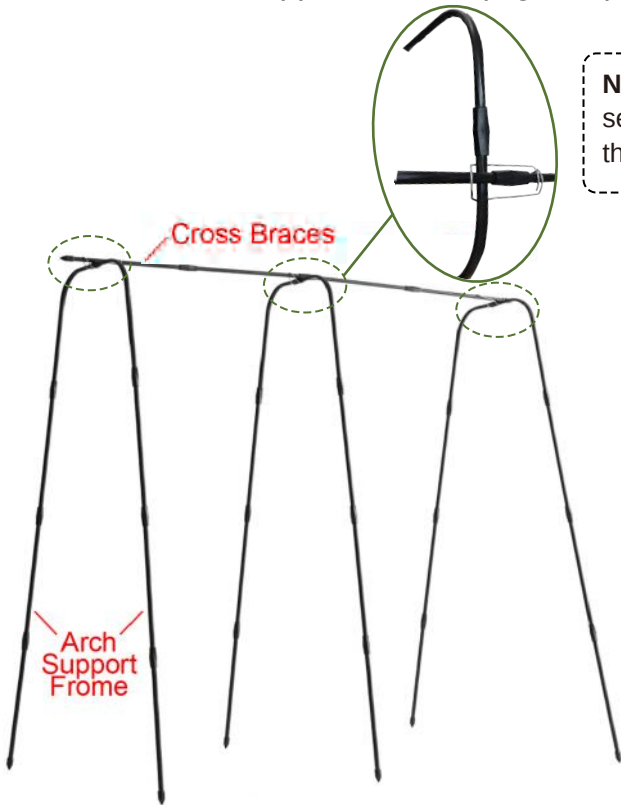

Fix Arch Support Frame with Cross Braces

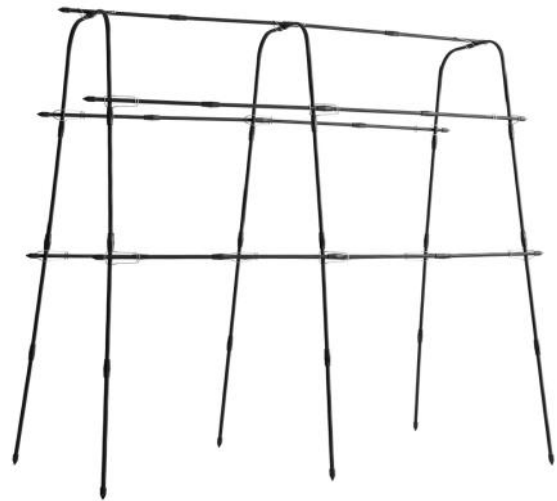
Need Parts: Part E, 15pcs; 3 arch support frames (the second step has been installed completed);

5 support cross-braces (the first step has been installed completed). Stand the 3 arch support frame upright and fix one assembled cross brace on the top of 3 arch by 3 Sure-clips (Part E). (Figure 3) Repeat the installation three times, and then you will get the whole Trellis support frames. (Figure 4)

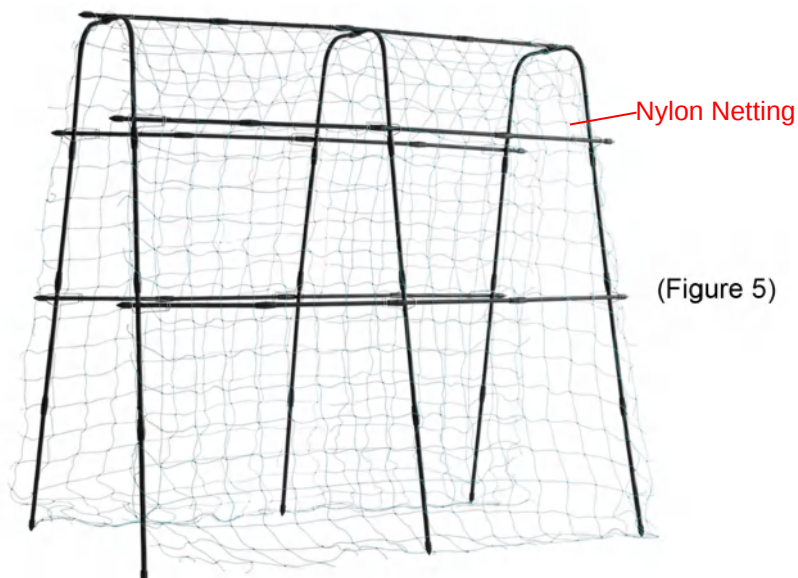
NOTE: To make it easier to install from the top, it can be secured to the side. The Sure-clips (Part E) are tight, so there's no need to worry about slipping.

Cover and fix the Nylon netting on the whole frame of the trellis.

Need Parts: Part F. Install the climbing Netting (Part F), and fix the netting with twist ties (See Figure 5)
