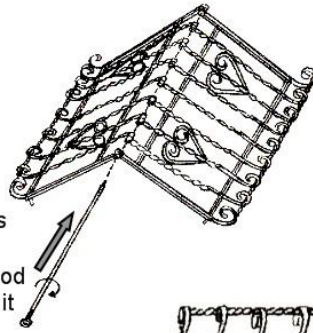
Parts List

| | 22 Sm. Screws |
| | 2 Lg. Axle Screws |

Follow Steps 1-9 in order.

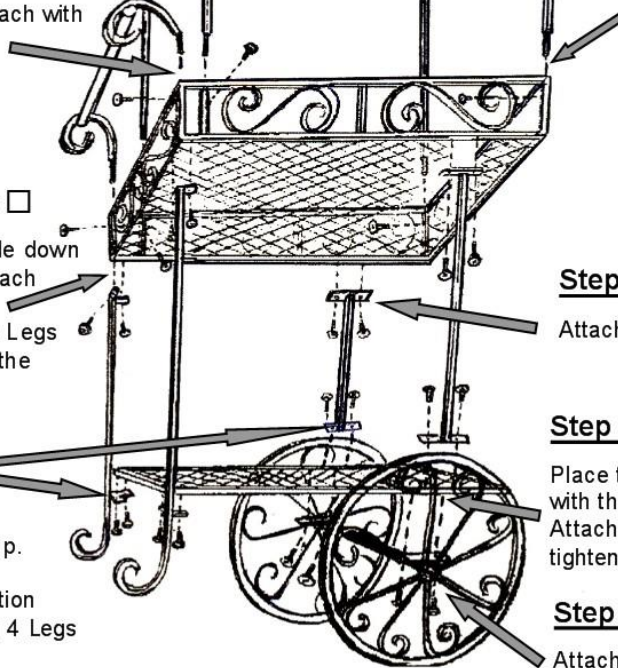
Step 8 Canopy

Lay the 2 Canopy Sections on a flat surface with the tubes aligned in the center as shown.
Slide the Long Connecting Rod through the tubes and screw it into the threaded hole at the end.



Step 6 Handle

Insert the Handle into the holes in the Top Tray and attach with 2 Screws



Step 9

Install the assembled Canopy onto the Canopy Supports as shown.

Step 3 Curved Legs

Turn the Top Tray upside down on a flat surface and attach the Curved Legs. Be sure the curls on the Legs point toward the end of the Top Tray as shown.

Step 7 Canopy Supports

Insert the 2 Canopy Supports into the holes in the Top Tray and secure with Screws.
NOTE: Check hole placement in corners before inserting.

Step 4 Straight Legs

Attach the Straight Legs as shown.

Step 5

Turn the Bottom Shelf and Wheels right side up. Bring the Top Tray and Leg Assembly into position as shown and attach all 4 Legs to the Bottom Tray.

Step 1 Axle

Place the Bottom Shelf on a flat surface with the side having 8 holes facing up. Attach the Axle with 4 Screws and tighten.

Step 2 Wheels

Attach the 2 Wheels with Large Axle Screws and tighten with Hex Tool.
