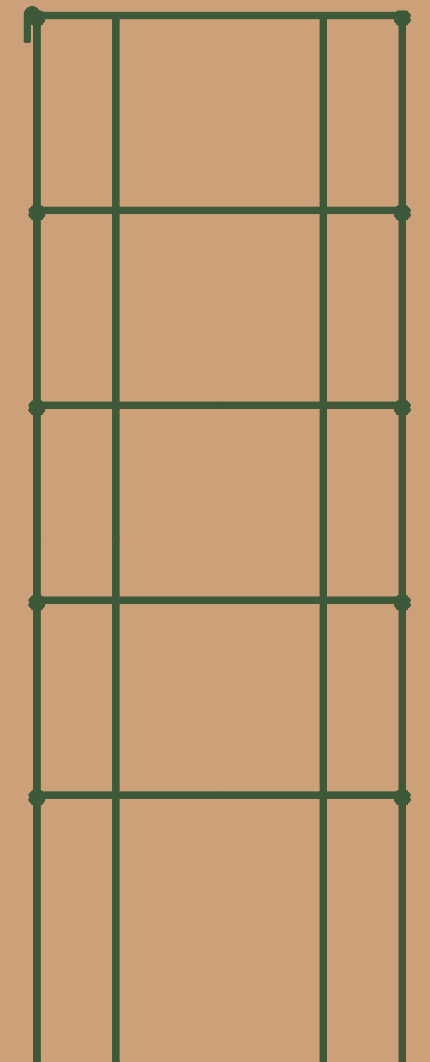
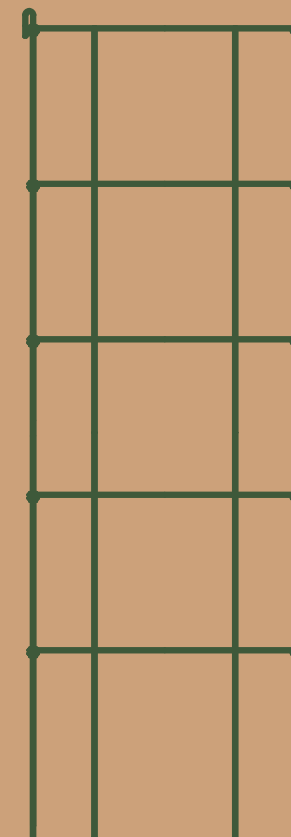
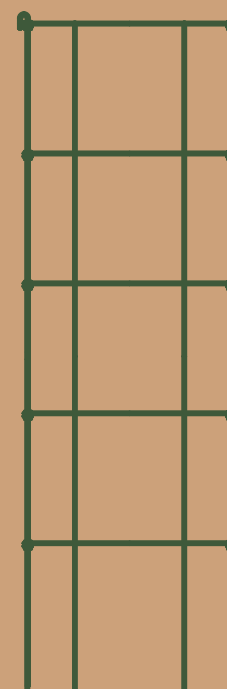


FlexGrow Tomato Cage User Manual

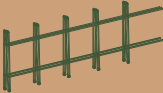
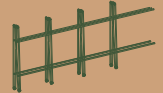

Installation Preparation

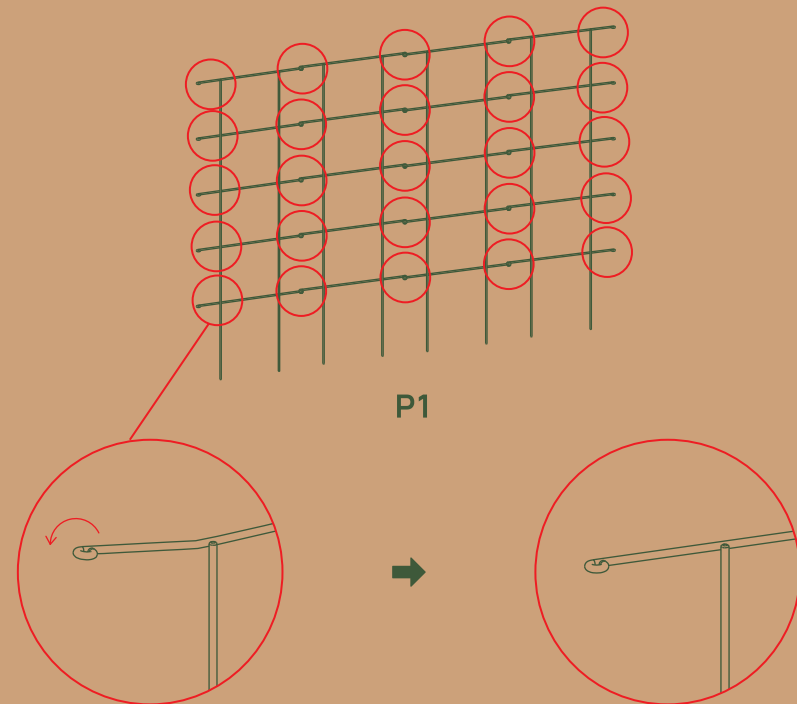
As part of our commitment to the environment, this package contains no plastic filler materials.

The product is designed with a “shape memory” structure, so during shipping it may arrive with slight bends or warping.

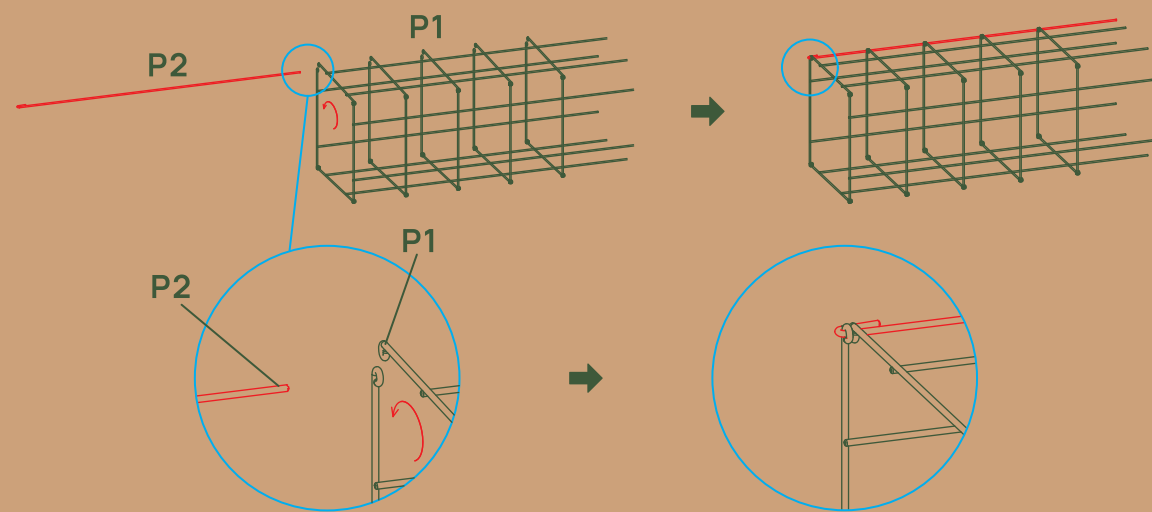
This is normal and can be easily corrected by hand—no tools are needed.

Our tests confirm that minor shipping bends do not affect the product’s strength, stability, or performance.

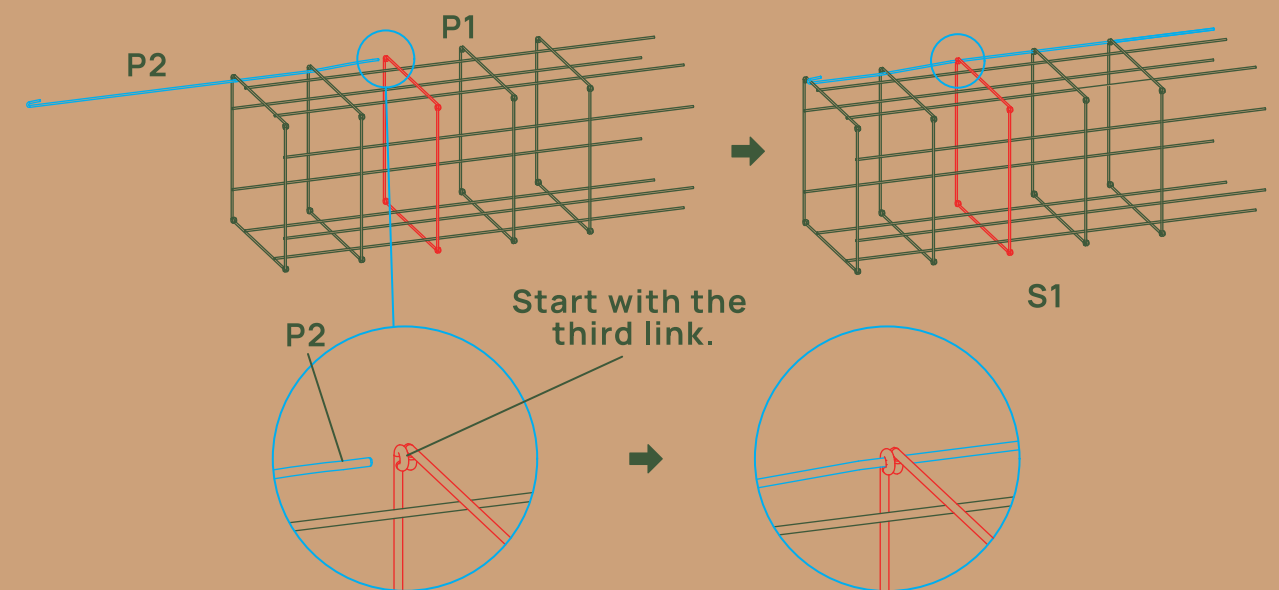
- 1** If P1 is deformed, you can straighten it by hand.



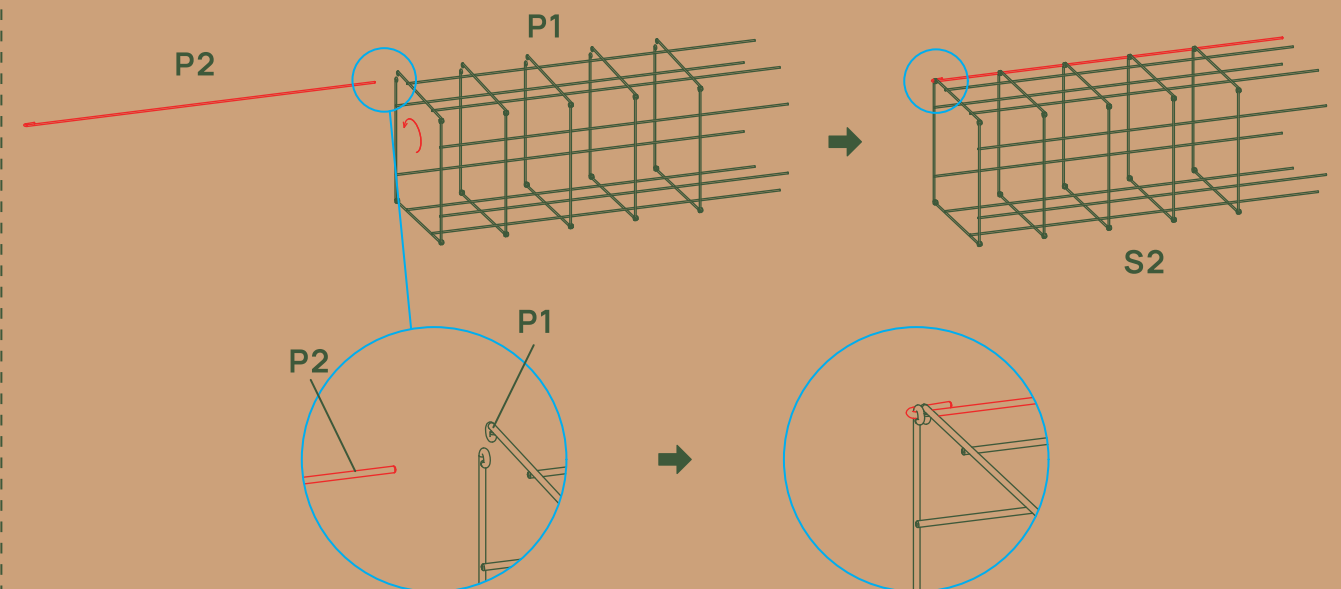
- 2a** For shorter plant needs:
Place P1 flat on the ground. Fold into a square shape, and slide P2 into the open corner holes of P1 as shown in the diagram. Repeat for each P1. You can now insert the legs into the soil and get to growing!



- 2b** For taller plant needs:
Place one P1 flat on the ground. Fold into a square shape. Slide P2 into the open corner holes of P1, skipping the top two links and starting with the third. This assembled cage will be referred to as S1. Please set it aside for later.

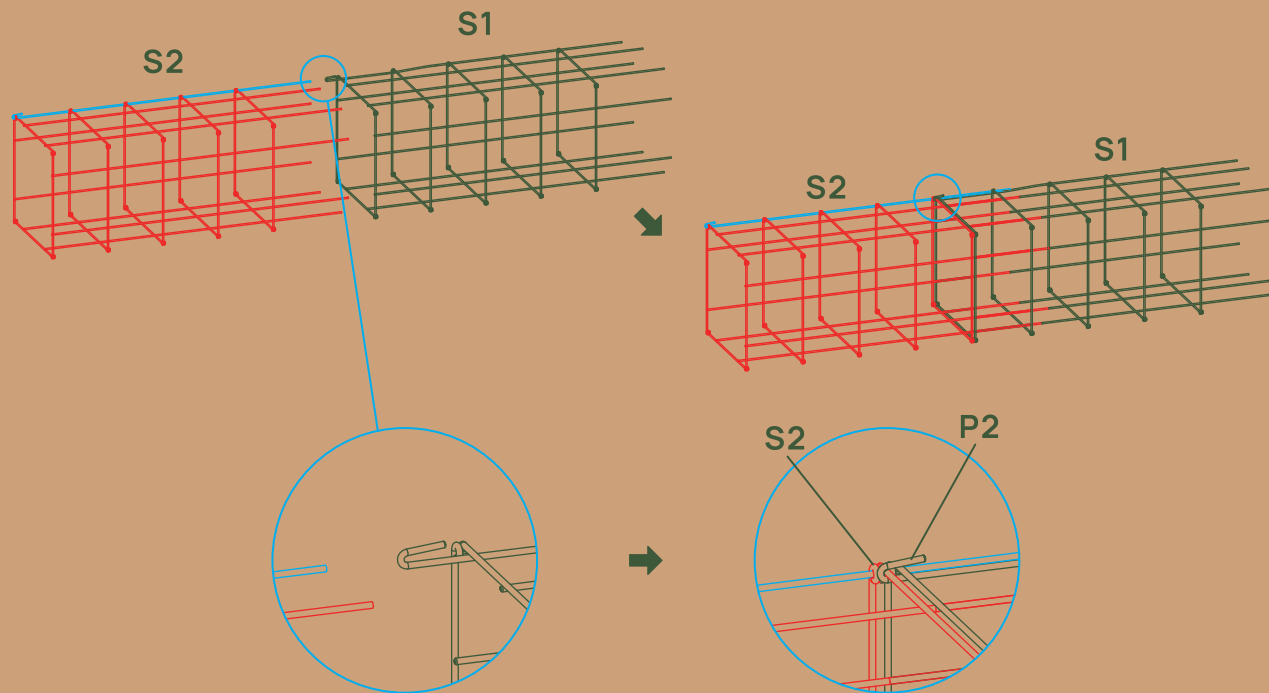


- 3** Place the other P1 flat on the ground. Fold into a square shape, and slide P2 into the open corner holes of P1 as shown in the diagram. This assembled cage will be referred to as S2.



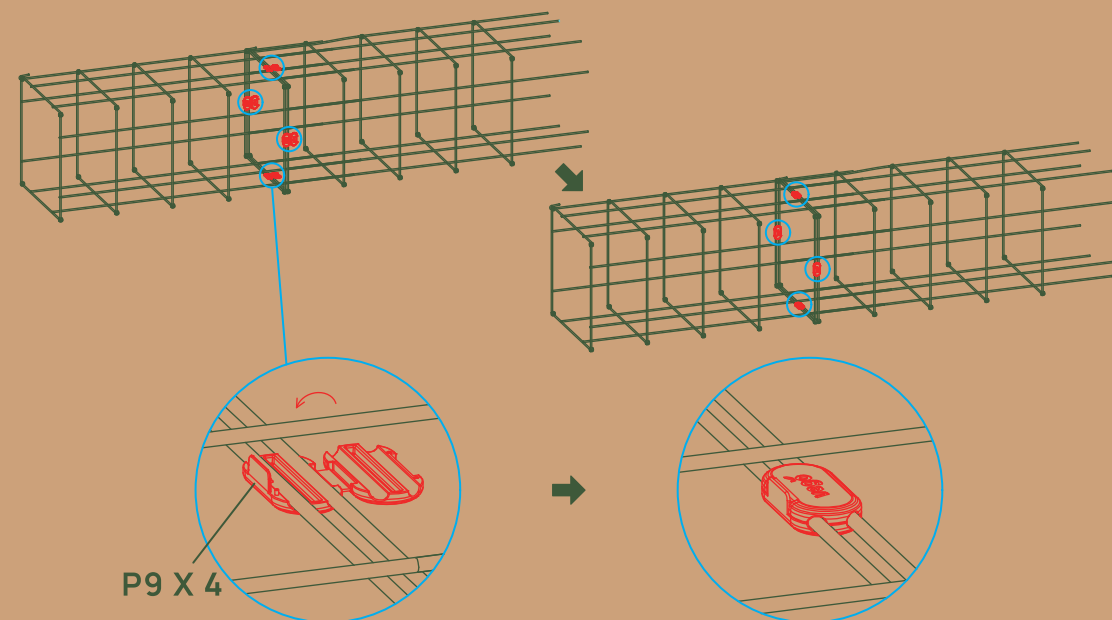
- 4** Insert the top cage (S2) into the bottom cage (S1). The P2 rod from S2 should slide into the top two unused links of S1.

Hook the top of the P2 rod from S1 to the bottom crossbar of S2.



- 5** Attach P9 clips to each side where the two cages meet to lock them together.

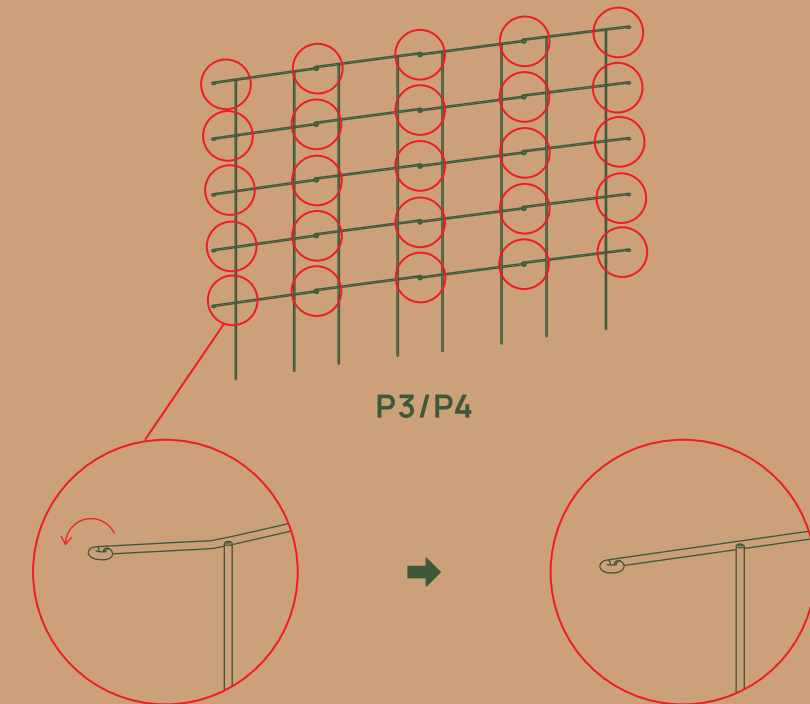
Note: Insert the two steel wires into the corresponding slots of the connector, then close the connector.

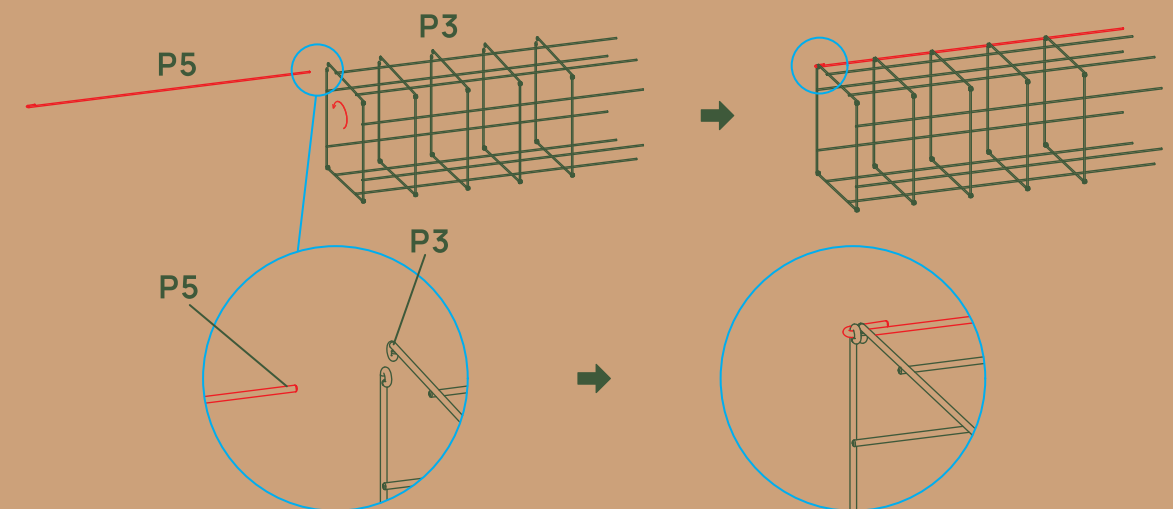

- 1** If P3 or P4 are deformed, you can straighten them by hand.



- 2a** For shorter plant needs:

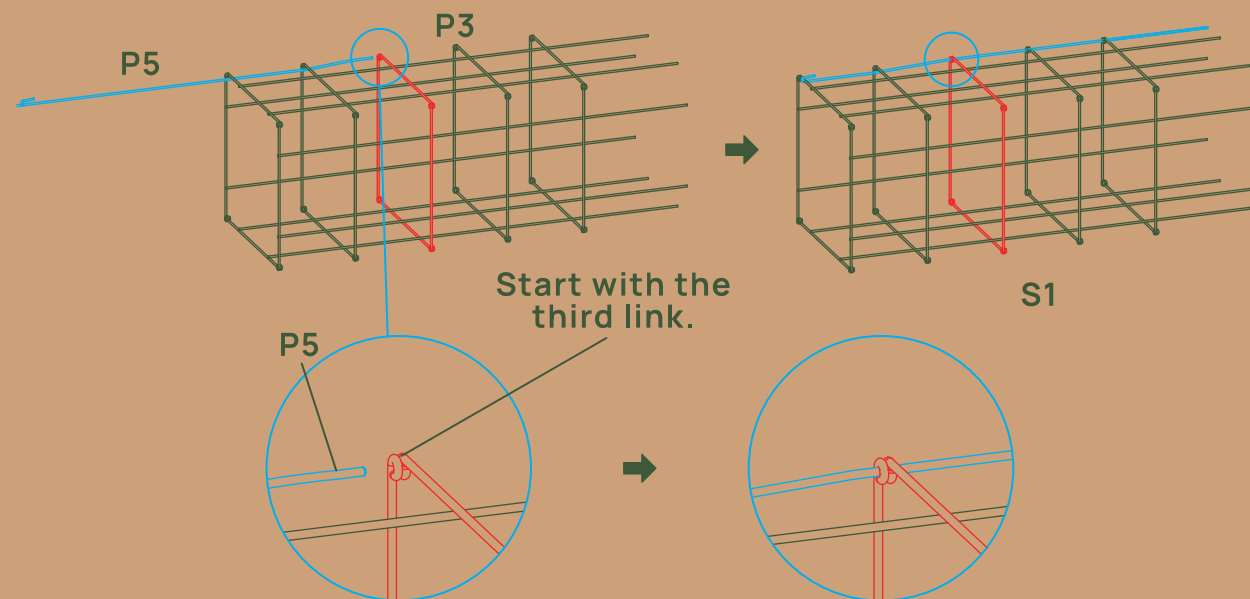
Place P3 flat on the ground. Fold into a square shape, and slide P5 into the open corner holes of P3 as shown in the diagram. If desired, repeat for P4, using the P6 rod. You can now insert the legs into the soil and get to growing!



2b For taller plant needs:

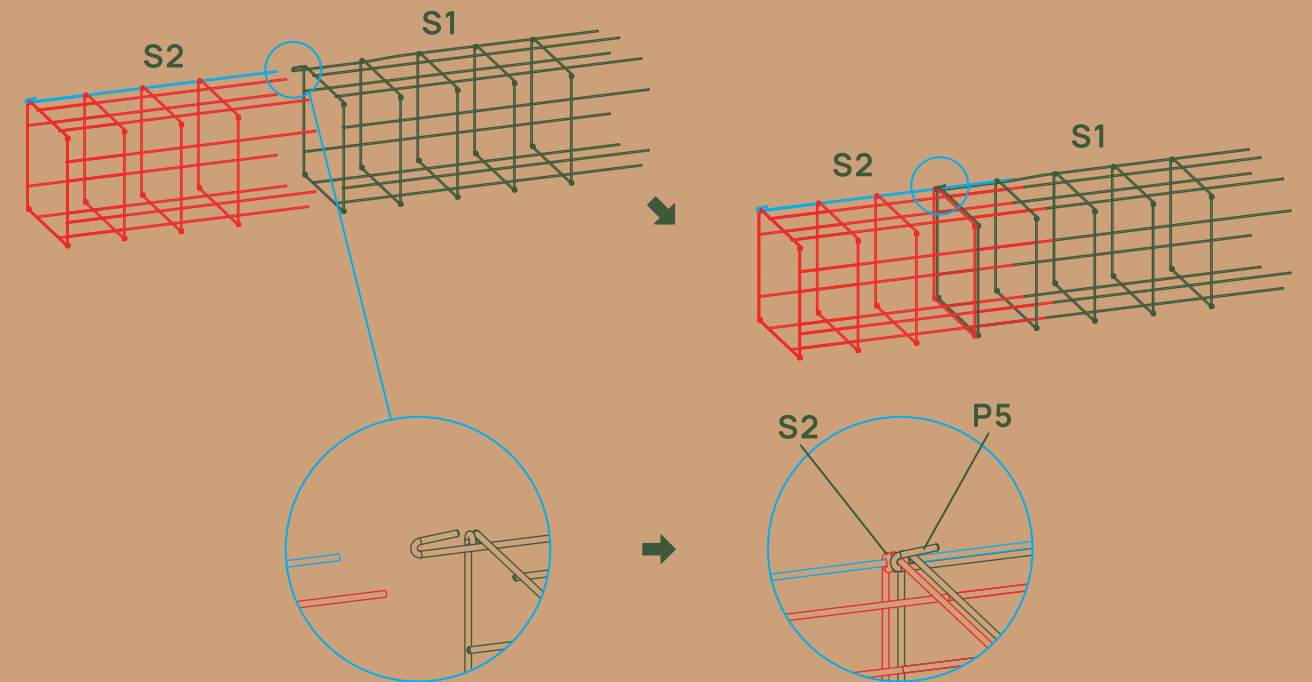
Place one P3 flat on the ground. Fold into a square shape. Slide P5 into the open corner holes of P3, skipping the top two links and starting with the third.

This assembled cage will be referred to as S1. Please set it aside for later.



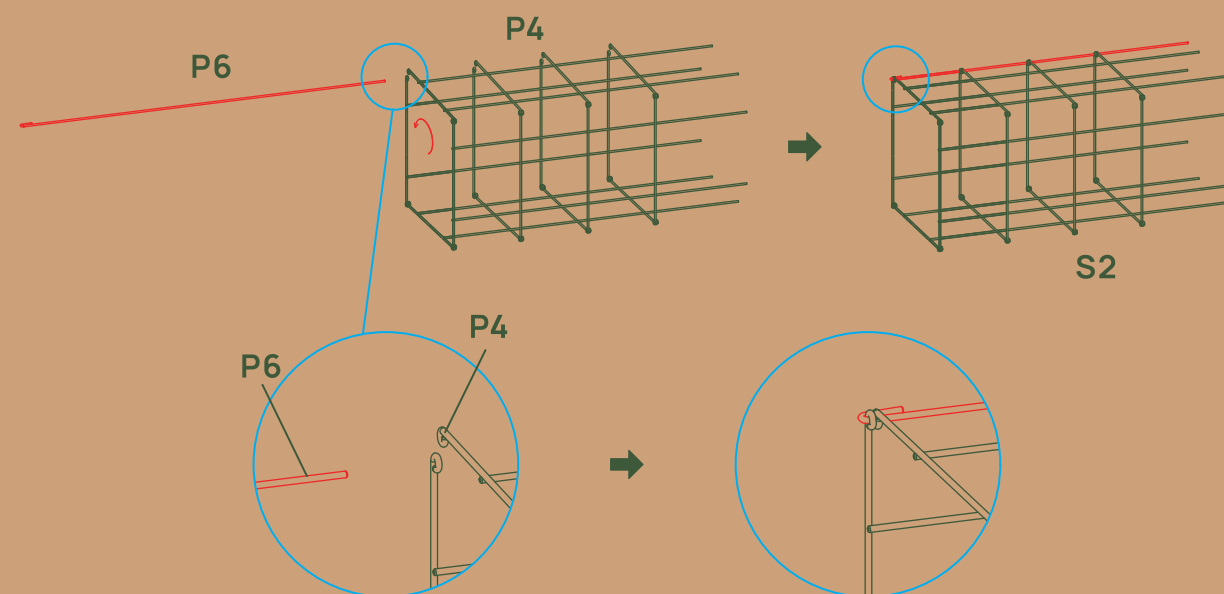
4 Insert the top cage (S2) into the bottom cage (S1). The P6 rod from S2 should slide into the top two unused links of S1.

Hook the top of the P5 rod from S1 to the bottom crossbar of S2.



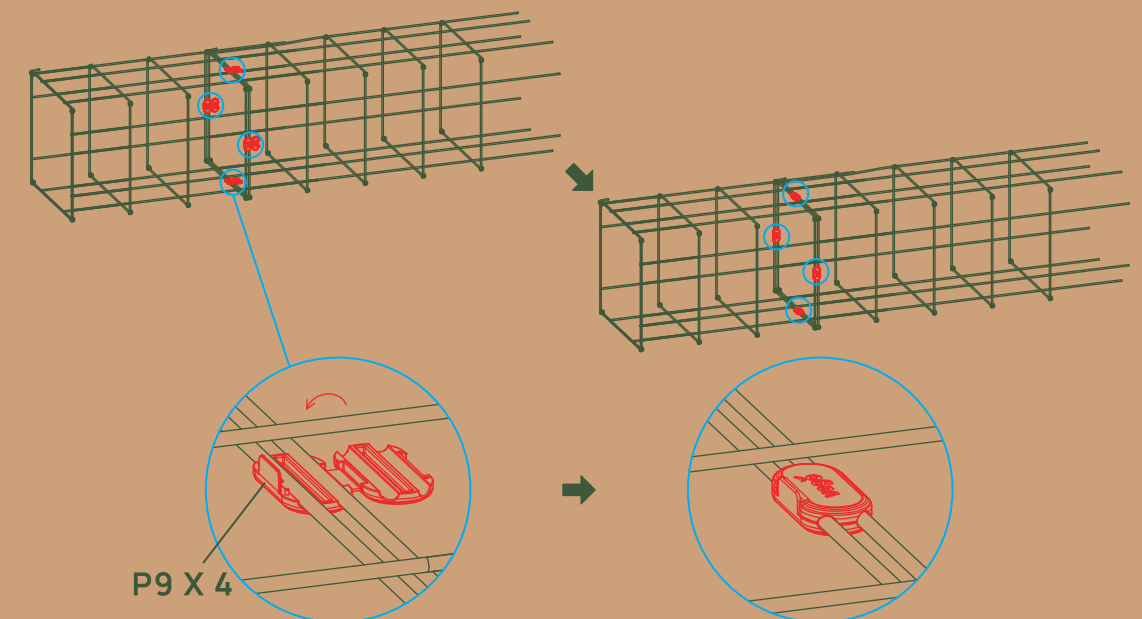
3 Place P4 flat on the ground. Fold into a square shape, and slide P6 into the open corner holes of P4 as shown in the diagram.

This assembled cage will be referred to as S2.

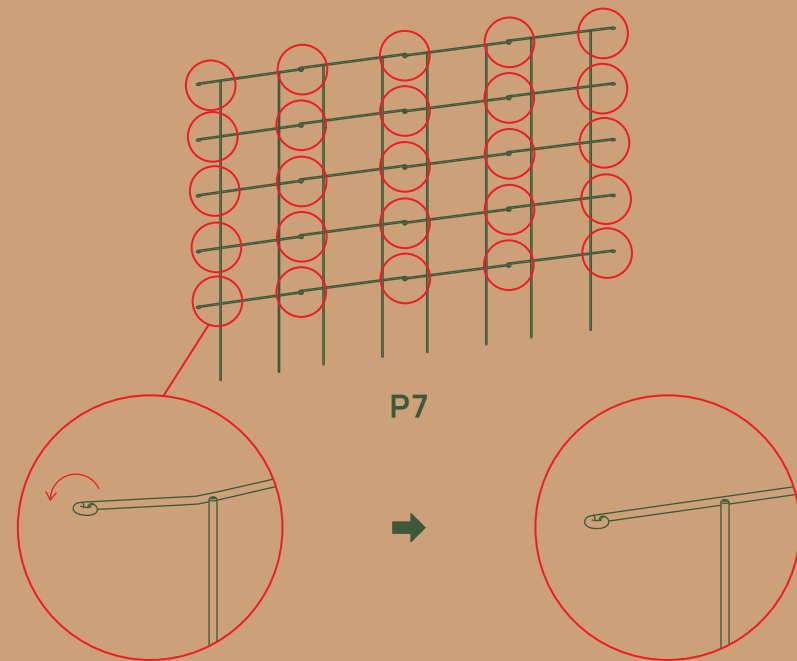


5 Attach P9 clips to each side where the two cages meet to lock them together.

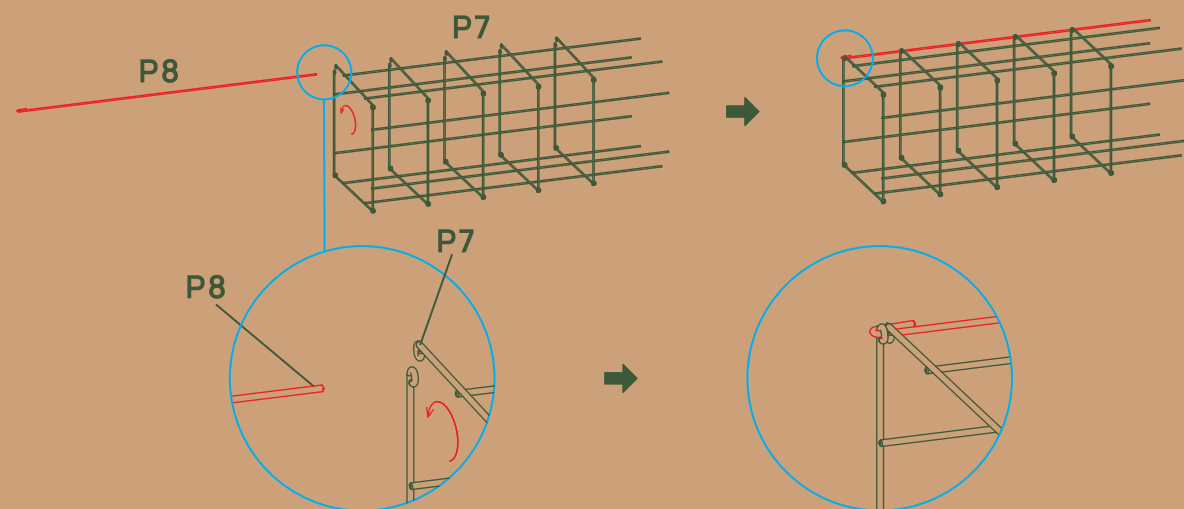
Note: Insert the two steel wires into the corresponding slots of the connector, then close the connector.



- 1 If P7 is deformed, you can straighten it by hand.



- 2 For shorter plant needs:
Place P7 flat on the ground. Fold into a square shape, and slide P8 into the open corner holes of P7 as shown in the diagram. Repeat for each P7. You can now insert the legs into the soil and get to growing!



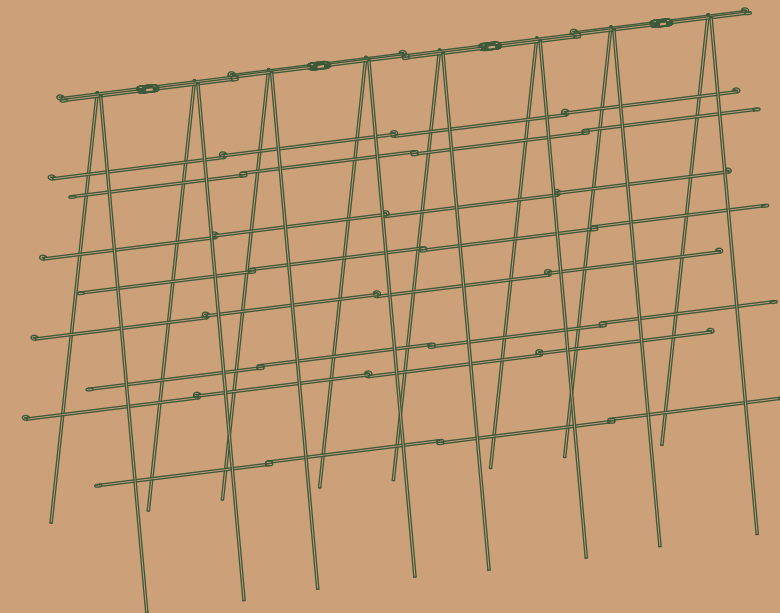
- ! For taller plant needs: Installation method is the same as VPSSGTDG.

Versatile Design

You can assemble the product in different configurations to suit your needs. Below are a few simple examples.

- 1 "A" Frame Trellis

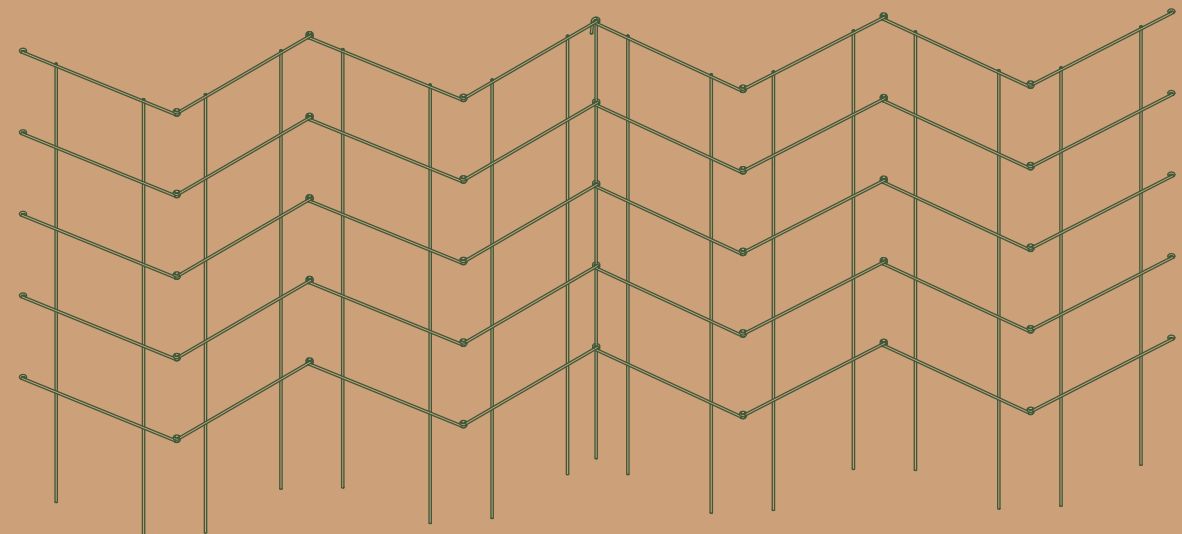
Note: Use 2 cages.



- 2 "Z" Shape Wall Trellis

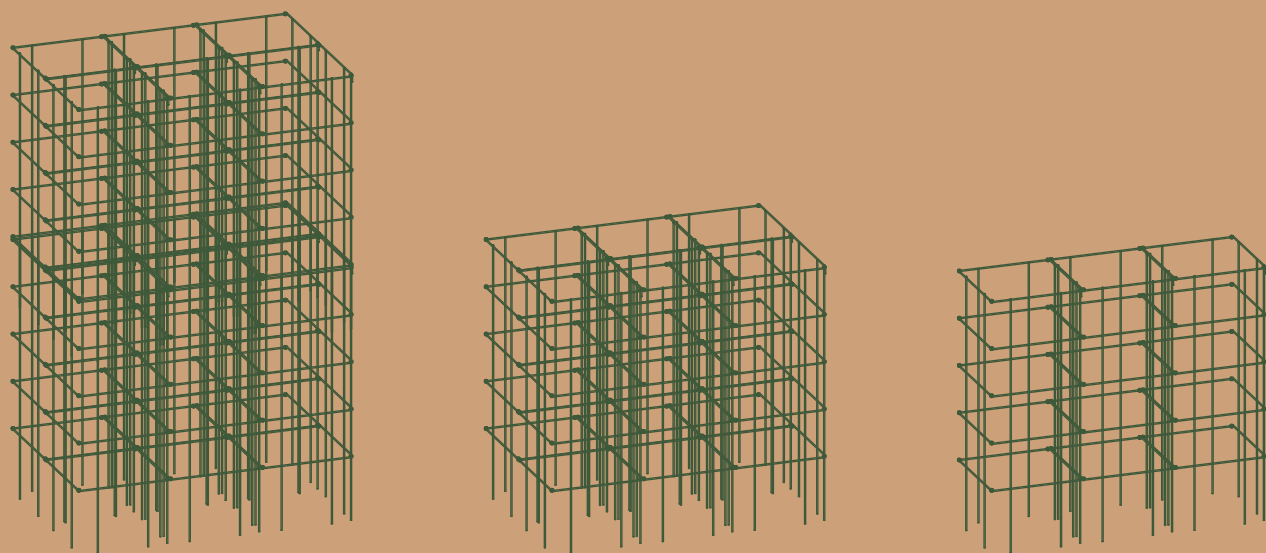
Note: Use 2 cages.

For safety, the two surfaces should be at a 45-degree angle.



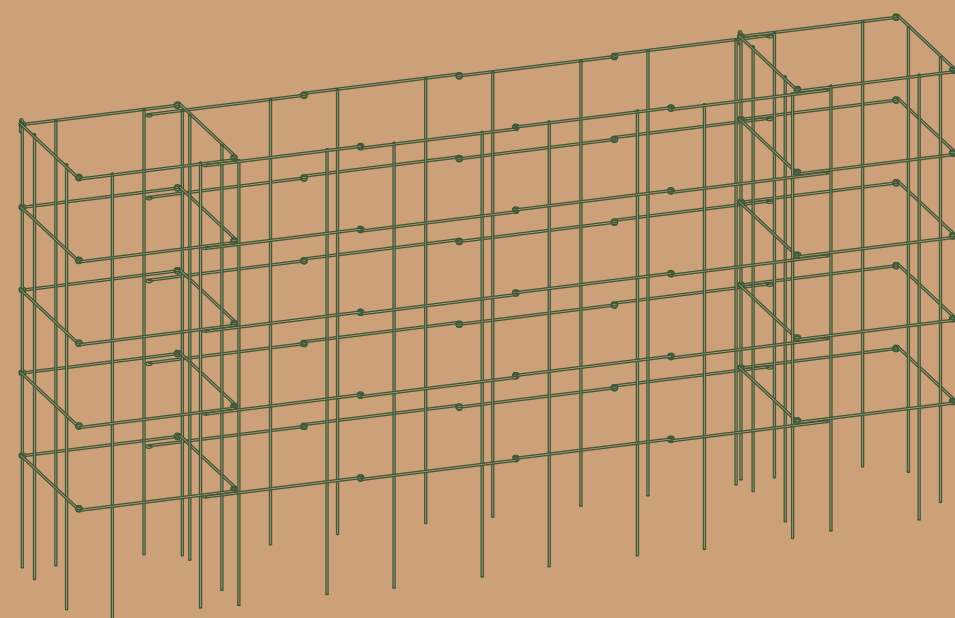
3 Grid

Note: Use at least 2 cages.



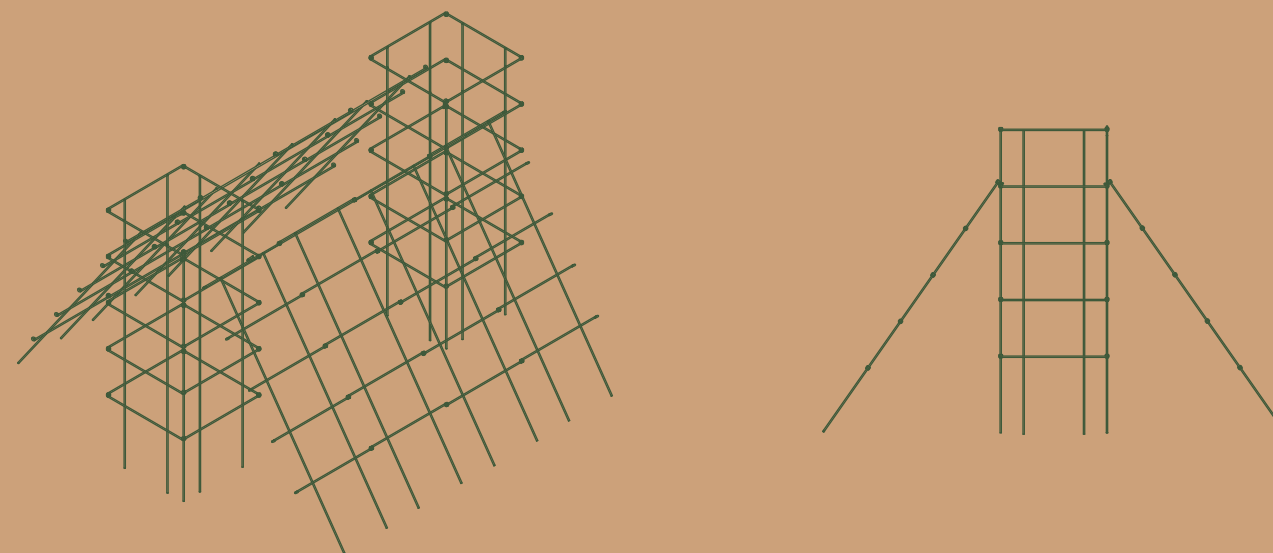
4 Cage with Tunnel

Note: Use at least 4 cages.



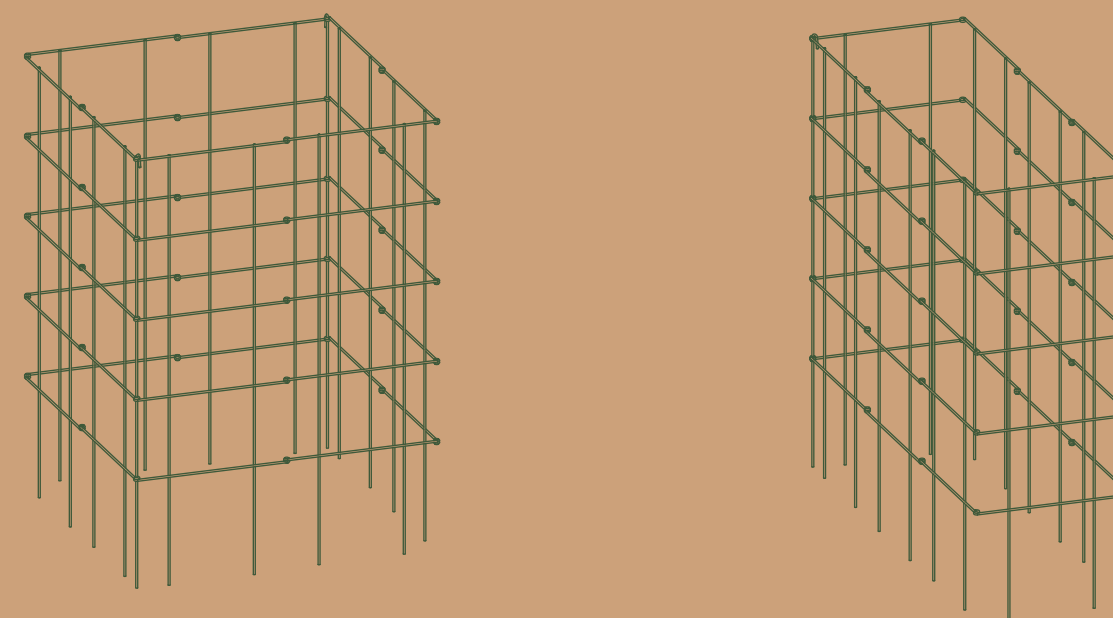
5 Cage with Cucumber Trellis

Note: Use at least 4 cages.



6 Fence

Note: Use at least 2 cages.



Important

For your safety, please ensure the structure is securely fastened using connectors and ties. In windy areas, be sure to anchor your trellis firmly to the ground or attach it to a fence post. This will keep strong winds from tipping it over and harming your plants.

Maintenance

To extend the life of your trellis, we recommend storing it in a dry, covered place at the end of the season. The trellis is finished with a protective powder coating. If the coating gets scratched, simply touch it up with exterior paint or polyurethane to help prevent rust.
