



Wooden Toy Chest ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS





THANK YOU!

Thank you for choosing the Melissa & Doug Wooden Toy Chest! This sturdy and roomy chest is perfect for storing toys and games, and allows kids to open up a world of wonder every day!

NOW IT'S TIME TO PUT IT TOGETHER!

Don't worry, assembling your new toy chest is simple, and we're here to help. Here are a few tips before you begin:

- · Read through all the instructions first.
- Clear a flat, covered space (carpeted is best) to lay out all the materials so everything is close at hand.
- You will need a Phillips head screwdriver (not included) to assemble the toy chest. A power screwdriver
 is not recommended. We've included everything else you will need. All parts are labeled with a sticker
 (A-G; 1-5).
- The instructions include lots of helpful pictures—we show you, step-by-step, how to align pieces and parts
 for speedy and accurate assembly. Note that the hardware needed for each step is shown in the upper
 right corner of the page, each piece being added in a given step is highlighted in gray, and the "assembled
 view" (what it looks like in the completed product when the step is completed) is included in the lower
 right corner of every page.
- In the instructions, the name of a part is followed by a letter or number in parentheses. This letter or number corresponds to the sticker on the part, as well as the picture of the part shown on page 2.
- · Helpful hints are highlighted with a large exclamation point.

⚠ WARNINGS!

Warning-Prevent Sudden Lid Closure!

- Failure to properly install lid supports may cause pinching fingers and hands or possible entrapment and strangulation hazard associated with sudden lid closing.
- The lid support is designed to not drop more than 1/2" from its own weight (except for the final 2" before it closes).
- Do not use this product unless the lid supports are installed correctly and the lid functions properly.

Warning—Prevent Tip Overs!

- The toy chest must be placed on a hard, flat, level surface.
- Never place computers, televisions, or other heavy objects on top of the toy chest.
- The toy chest must be assembled as instructed.
- Do not allow children to climb on or in the toy chest.

Retain these instructions for future reference.


MAINTENANCE:

PARTS - Be Smart—Sort Your Parts

Before you begin assembly, make sure you have all the parts listed below.

screws (8)


bolts (8)

STEP 1 - Every Journey Begins with the First Step

Using two long bolts (part 1), attach the back panel (part A) to the right side panel (part B). Do not fully tighten the long bolts at this time.






STEP 2 - Put Up a Good Front

Using two long bolts (part 1), attach the front panel (part C) with notched edge on top, to the right side panel (part B). Do not fully tighten the long bolts at this time.



STEP 3 - All About the Base

Slide the base panel (part D) into the grooves along the inside bottom of the front and back panels.







STEP 4 - What's Left

Stand the toy chest on its side. Using four long bolts (part 1), attach the left side panel (part E) to the toy chest. Do not fully tighten the long bolts at this time.








Assembled View

STEP 5 - Put a Lid on It


- First, rotate chest box onto its back.
- Second, slide the lid panel (part F) so the hinges on the toy chest and hinge holes on the lid line up. Using six small flat head screws (part 2), attach the hinges to the lid panel.







STEP 6 - The Springs Are the Things

Using eight small pan head screws (part 3), attach the lid supports (part 4) to the back panel of the toy chest. Then, angle the lid to align the holes on the underside of the lid with those on the lid supports and attach. The "UP" arrow on the lid supports should point toward the lid panel.









STEP 7 - Brace Yourself

- First, rotate toy chest so it's upright.
- Second, completely tighten all long bolts on the toy chest.


Assembled View


