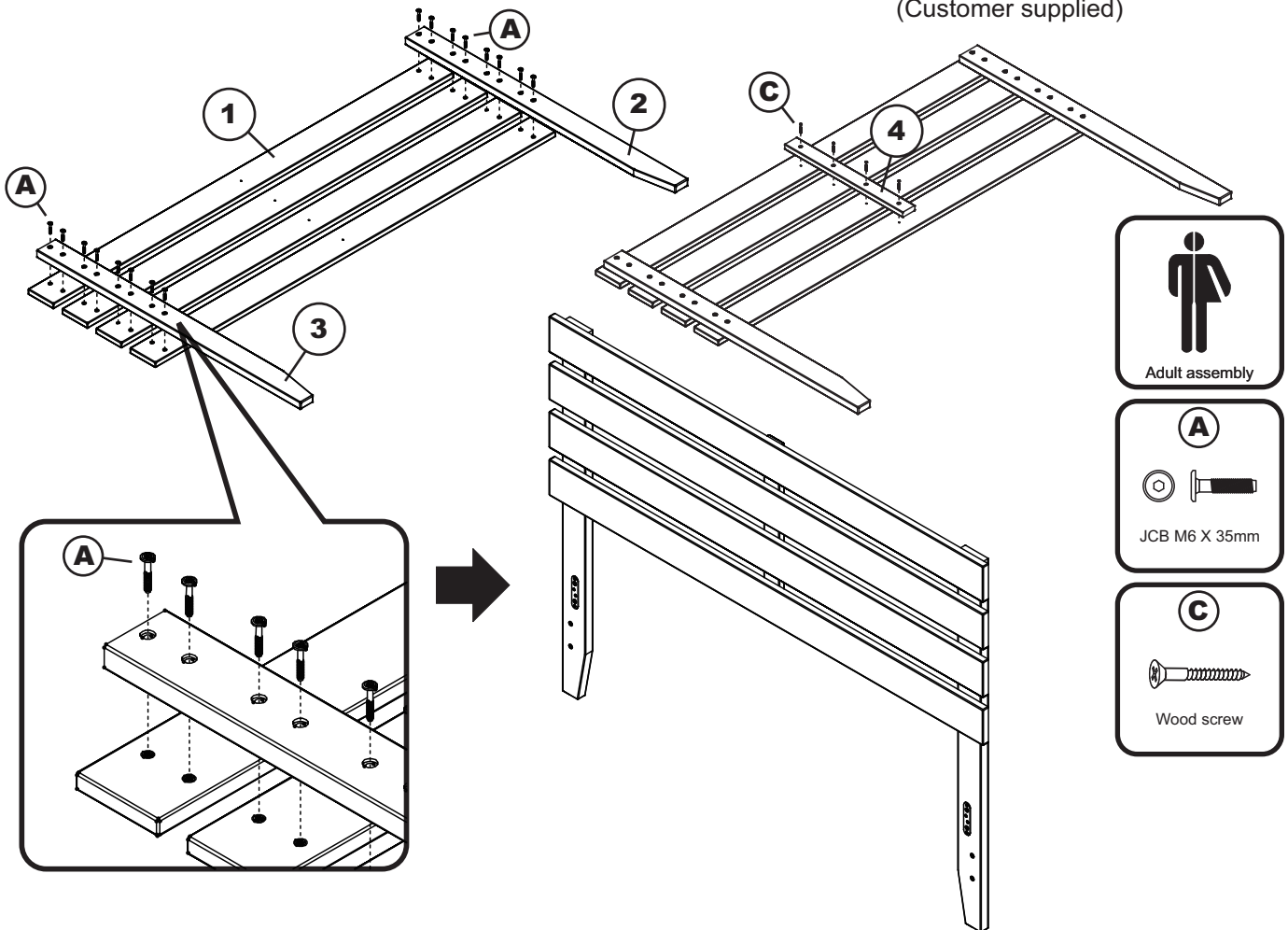
NOTE: WE INCLUDE SPARE HARDWARE IN CASE DAMAGE OCCURS DURING ASSEMBLY.

Step 1

Attach the legs (2) and (3) to headboard panel boards (1) using JCB M6 X 35mm (A). Tighten with the Allen wrench (G).

Step 2

Attach headboard support (4) to headboard panel boards using wood screw 1 1/4" (C) Tighten with the Phillips head screw driver. (Customer supplied)

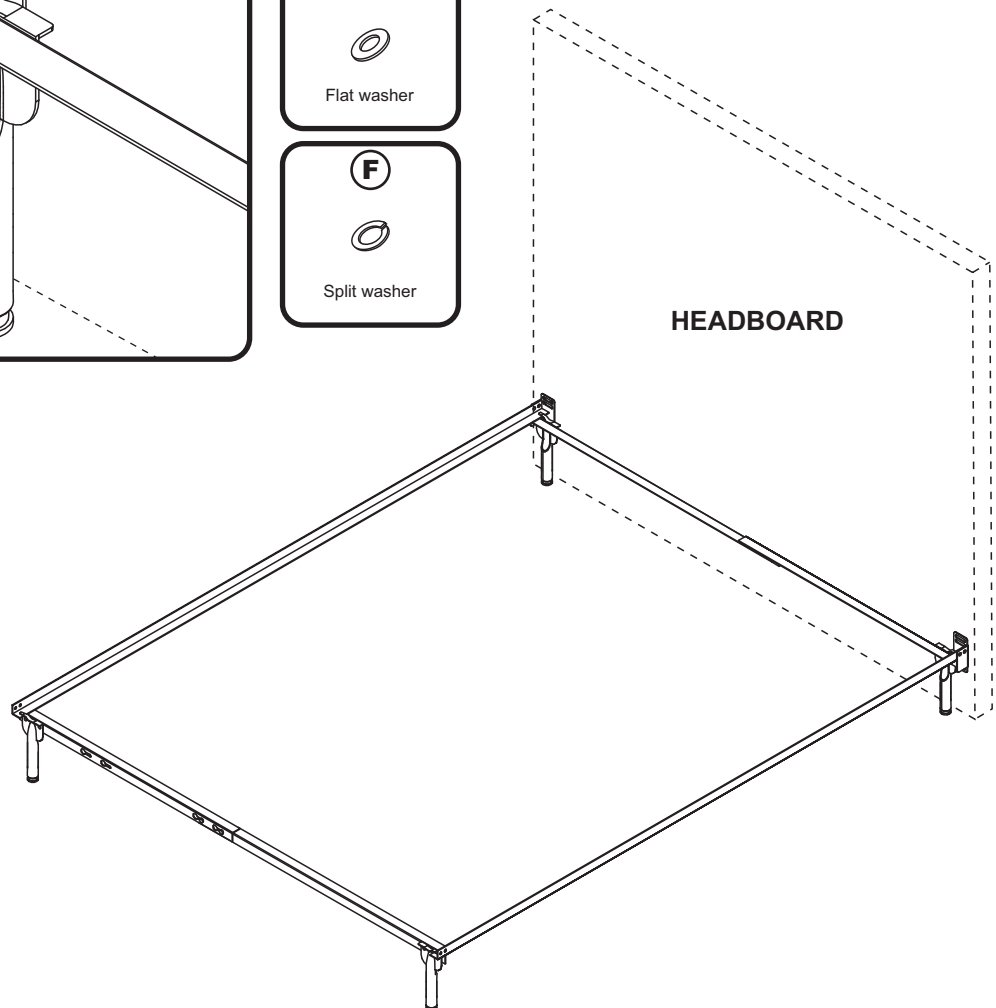
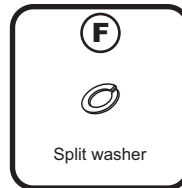
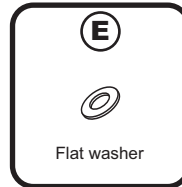
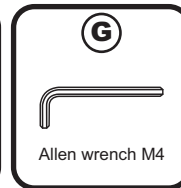
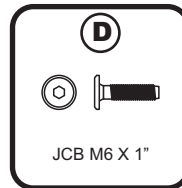
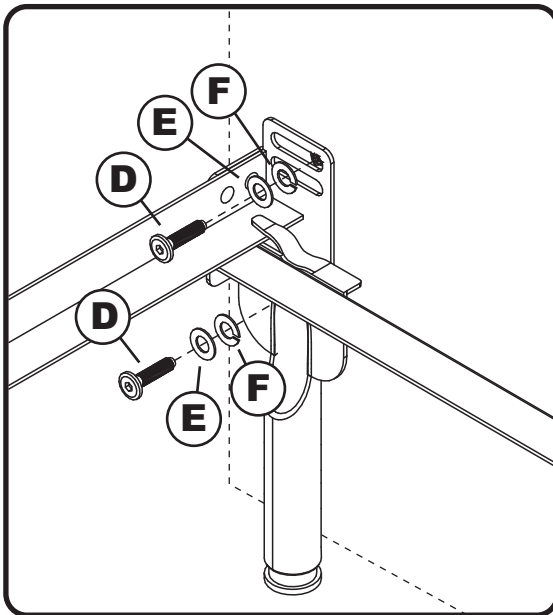


Adult assembly

Metal bed frames are sold separately from wood headboards. The hardware shown on this page is supplied with your wood headboard for attaching the bed frame to the headboard. The metal bed frame is supplied with its own assembly instructions and hardware.

Step 1

Attach the headboard assembly to the metal bed frame using JCB M6 X 1" (D), flat washer (E), and split washer (F) then tighten with Allen wrench (G) as shown below.



Congratulations!

Your bed is now ready for use.

To ensure lasting safety, we recommend that you periodically check that all screws are tight and all parts are secure.
