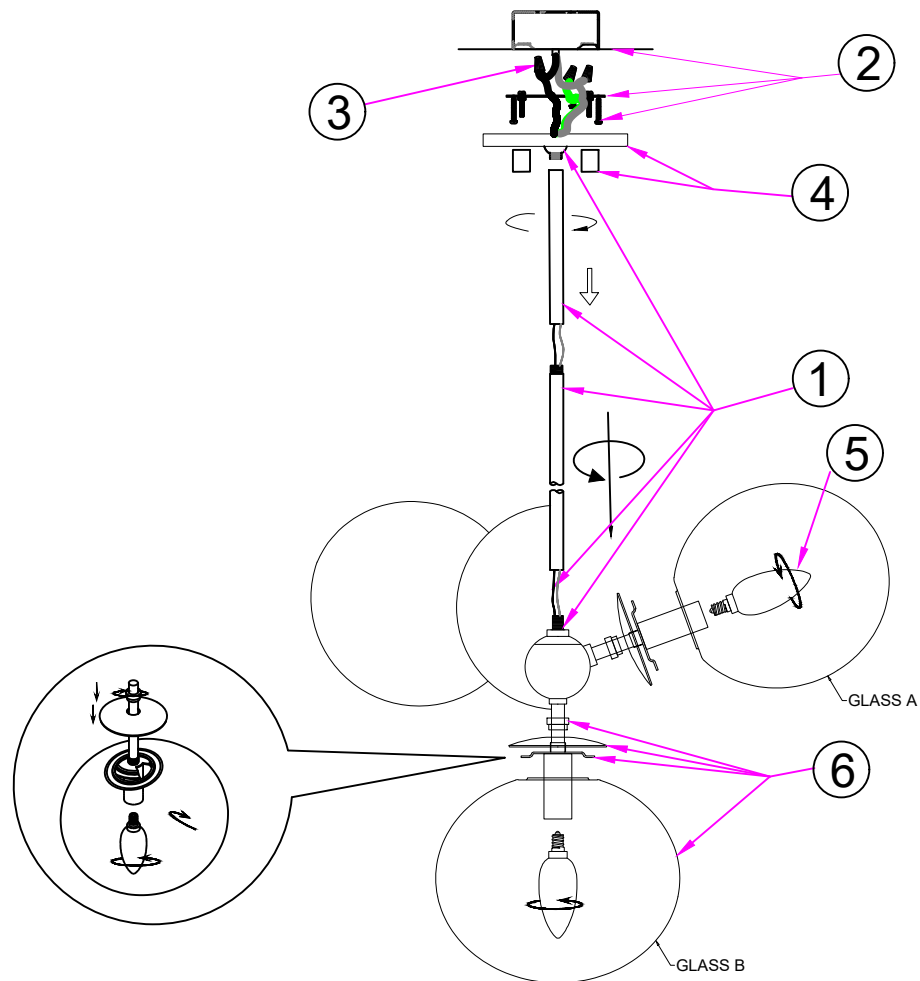


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Thread the Electrical Wires:

- Thread the wires through the suspension rods. Add extension rods as needed to achieve desired height, then securely tighten with the threaded coupling.
- Slide the ceiling canopy onto the top of the suspension rods, aligning it with the locking tabs.

2. Secure the Mounting Plate:

Pull the electrical wires from the junction box, and secure the mounting plate to the junction box using the screws.

3. Connect the Wires using connectors:

- Connect the fixture's live (black), neutral (white), and ground wires to the corresponding wires in the junction box.
- Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.

4. Place the electrical wire back into the junction box. Align the canopy with the mounting plate, and secure it with the decorative nuts.

5. Screw the bulbs into the lamp socket. (Bulbs Not Included)

6. Carefully lift the glass shades and attach them into place on the fixture. Secure them with the provided retaining rings.

7. Restore power and verify that the bulbs functions properly.

Installation Complete.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
