BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



When lock or apring washer in used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or apring washer in placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.



Position each part correctly and insert ecrews or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



Use cardboard or carpet area when assambling furniture to prevent scratches . Make sure the furniture reate on a flat and level surfece with each leg evenly touching the floor.



Some furtiture comes with height adjustment knobs undernasth each leg. To lower or to relise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise respectively.



Make sure all parts are properly sligned, then use the approprishe hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or externs. Do not use power tools and do not <u>overtighten</u>.



Save the instructions and store the Alien whench or any supplied tool for later maintanance. After two weeks, chack and tighten any loose hardware and repeat agein every six months thereafter.
