#### **SAFETY WARNINGS**

- Follow the information on the warnings appearing on table and on the carton. Do not remove warning label from cabinet.
- Do not allow children under 3 years of age to use the cabinet.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.

### **FURNITURE TIP-OVER HAZARD**

### Children have died from furniture tip-over

To reduce the risk of furniture tip-over:

- ALWAYS install tip-over restraint especially if used by a wall or in the open.
- NEVER put a TV on this product
- NEVER allow children to stand, climb or hang on drawers, doors, or shelves.
- NEVER open more than one drawer at a time.
- ALWAYS place heaviest items in lowest cabinet.

### PARENTAL SUPERVISION IS REQUIRED

- Parents or Guardians should supervise use under the intended age specifically regarding children that may have access to it and climb on the unit.
- Do not allow horseplay on, under, or behind the unit and prohibit jumping on the cabinet.
- If used improperly, your table may be pulled over or fall, creating risk of injury or damage. Children should not be permitted to climb or pull on the cabinet.


### **USE. MAINTENANCE & ASSEMBLY**

- Periodically check and ensure that the components are in their proper position, free from
- damage, and that all connectors are tight.
- Use on level surfaces only. Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damage to unit or floor.
- Do not use this item if any components are missing or damaged.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer or dealer for replacement parts.
- Only clean using damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- · Check you have all components and tools listed on page 4
- Do not stand or put weight on this product during assembly, this could cause damage.
- Remove all hardware from the plastic bags and separate them into groups.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Certain assembly steps may be easier with 2 people.
- Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.
- We do not recommend power screwdrivers. Only use hand screwdrivers to prevent damage to unit.
- Keep these instructions for future reference.





- 7. Right Side Table Panel ×3




### **ASSEMBLY HARDWARE**





Select 1 ( $\times$ 1) and A( $\times$ 4). Insert A( $\times$ 4) into 1.





Select  $6(\times 1)$ ,  $7(\times 1)$  and  $8(\times 4)$ . Insert  $8(\times 2)$  into two holes of 6 and intall 6 into 1 with  $8(\times 2)$ . Repeat for 7 and  $8(\times 2)$ .





Select  $C(\times 3)$  and  $E(\times 4)$ . Insert 2 into 6 and 7 with  $C(\times 3)$ . Insert  $E(\times 4)$  into 2.






Select A( $\times$ 4). Insert A( $\times$ 4) into 2.



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

Select  $6(\times 1)$ ,  $7(\times 1)$  and  $B(\times 4)$ . Insert 6 and 7 into 2 with  $A(\times 4)$ . Insert  $B(\times 2)$  into 6. Repeat for 7 and  $B(\times 2)$ .


Select  $C(\times 3)$  and  $E(\times 4)$ . Insert 2 into 6 and 7 with  $C(\times 3)$ . Insert  $E(\times 4)$  into 2.



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


Select A( $\times$ 4). Insert A( $\times$ 4) into 2.






Select  $6(\times 1)$ ,  $7(\times 1)$  and  $B(\times 4)$ . Insert 6 and 7 into 2 with  $A(\times 4)$ . Insert  $B(\times 2)$  into 6. Repeat for 7 and  $B(\times 2)$ .






Select  $3(\times 1)$ ,  $C(\times 3)$  and  $E(\times 4)$ . Insert 3 into 6 and 7 with  $C(\times 3)$ . Insert  $E(\times 4)$  into 3.


Select  $5(\times 1)$ ,  $C(\times 8)$  and  $E(\times 8)$ . Insert 5 into Cabinet with  $C(\times 8)$  and  $E(\times 8)$ .



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

Select 4( $\times$ 1), C( $\times$ 10) and E( $\times$ 10). Insert 4 into Cabinet with C( $\times$ 10) and E( $\times$ 10).


Select D( $\times$ 2) and F( $\times$ 1). Insert F into the hole of 1 with D( $\times$ 2).
