Introduction

Our solar charged lights are brighter and last all night with a typical solar charge. Unique design, superior light output and numerous installation options confirm the outstanding value of our product.

Please read the instruction manual carefully to obtain the best results from your purchase.

Tools that are needed but not supplied with the solar post lamps are: a screw driver and a power drill.

WARNING: These Light bulbs are built and designed for our products only. They are not designed to be used in other electrical sockets.

For the same reason, regular AC and/or Low Voltage bulbs cannot be used in our products.

NEW MORPH TECHNOLOGY

Our NEW Morph Solar Panel Technology is a groundbreaking process in the way we capture more power from the sun. Our Morph technology still uses monocrystalline solar panels. However, instead of the standard limited sized solar panels, our new technology allows the solar panels to MORPH into the light fixture.



1. Solar Light Location:

For optimum light duration throughout the night, it is very important to place the solar panel in a spot where it will receive the maximum amount of direct sunlight throughout the day.

NOTE: For best results, the solar lamp post must be charged for two sunny days in the "ON" position.

2. Assembly Instructions:

a. Bulb Assembly

1. Remove the lens by turning it counterclockwise (**Fig. 2**)
2. Make sure the Low/OFF/High switch is in the OFF (O) position. (**Fig.1**)
3. Remove (if needed) the existing bulb by turning it counterclockwise (**Fig.3**)
4. Install the new Solar LED Bulb by turning into the bulb socket clockwise (**Fig.3**)
5. Reassemble the unit by reversing the above procedure (**Fig.4**)

b. Solar Light Fixture Assembly

1. Slide the decorative cap over threaded shaft (**Fig.5**)
2. Install the wall bracket to the threaded shaft by turning it clockwise (**Fig.6**).
3. Your item will be fully assembled as shown in **Fig.7**

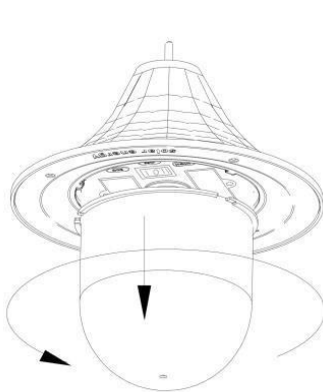

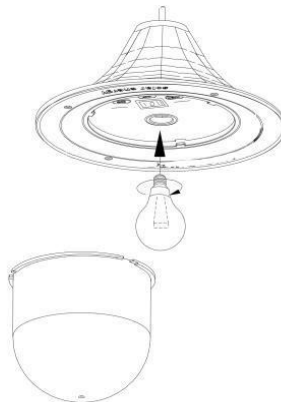

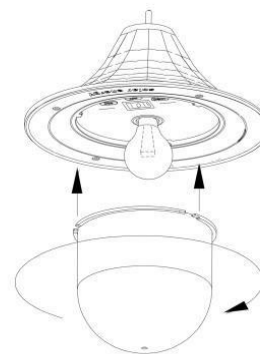

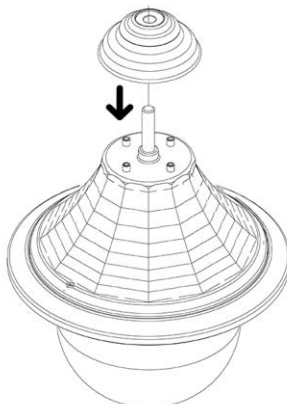

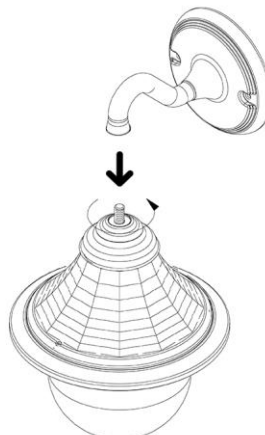

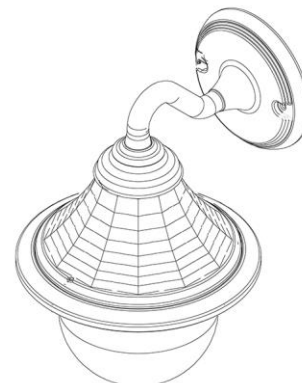

3. Installation Instructions (Fig. 8)

Refer to the “solar light location” paragraph before choosing the installation location.

Use an electric drill to make two holes in the wall, place provided anchors into holes, place the wall bracket in line with the holes and secure the light fixture with the provided screws.

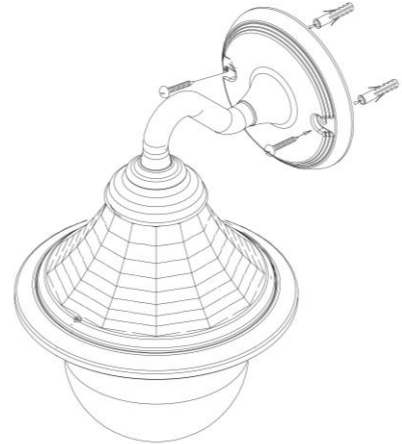

Operation Instructions

1. Remove the lens by turning it counterclockwise (**Fig. 2**)
2. Turn the operation switch (**Fig. 9**) to the ON position at the desired settings.
 - a. (I) For softer light and longer duration.
 - b. (II) For brighter light output.The Solar Lamp will automatically operate from dusk to dawn.
3. Reattach the lens by turning it clockwise (**Fig. 4**).

4. Replacing the Batteries (Fig.16)

(After several years of use, the batteries may need replacing).

1. Remove the lens by turning it counterclockwise (**Fig.2**). Make sure the ON/OFF switch is in the OFF (O) position.
2. Unscrew each of the battery compartment's screws on the back of the metal cover. (**Fig.10**)
3. Unclip the connector and remove the old battery. Make sure the new battery is a high quality [3.2V/1500mAh Li-Ion rechargeable battery](#) with connector.
4. Clip on new battery and install into the battery compartment. Re-install the battery compartment cover.
5. Reassemble the unit by reversing the above procedure.

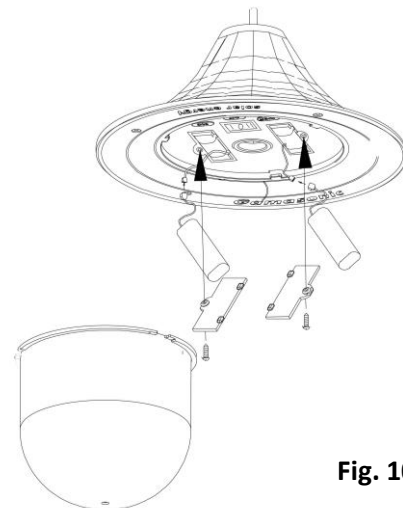

WARNING: Do not dispose of Li-Ion battery in the regular trash, municipal waste stream or by fire as batteries may leak or explode. Do not open, short circuit, or mutilate batteries as injury may occur. Preserve our environment by recycling Li-Ion batteries or disposing of them in accordance with local, State and federal regulations. Do not mix old and new batteries.

Maintenance

Clean the solar panel regularly with a damp towel to guarantee optimum performance. Do not use any type of solvent for cleaning and be careful not to put too much pressure on the solar panels while cleaning.

Trouble Shooting

If your solar charged light does not come on at dusk despite observance of all the instructions, please try the following steps:

1. Make sure that the solar panel is not being affected by any other light source.
2. Ensure the solar light is not positioned in the shade during the day.
3. Make sure the switch in the lamp head is the On (|) position.
4. Check that the batteries are installed correctly.

NOTE: The performance of the solar lamp will vary with the time of year. It will deliver more light when it has had a full day in the sun rather than a day in overcast weather.

WINTERTIME TIPS: For optimal performance, be sure to remove any snow or debris accumulation from solar panel. A solar panel free of debris will charge the batteries much more efficiently.

WARNING: Please keep out of reach of children.
