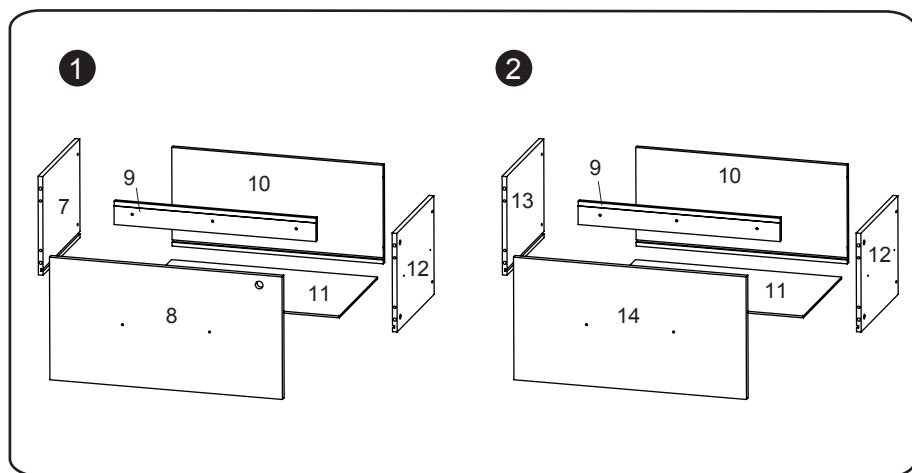
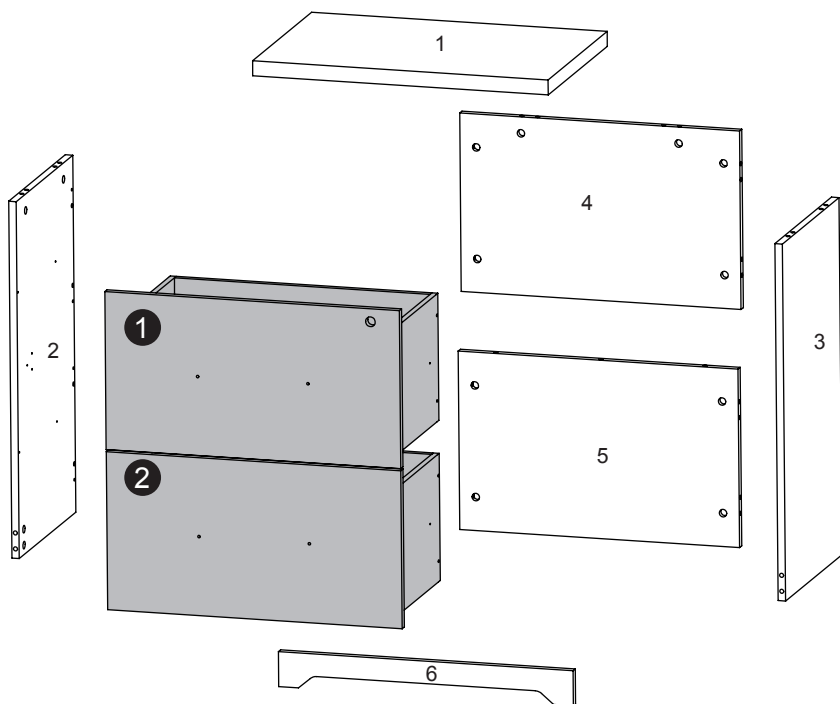
ANTI-TIP WARNING

- Since different wall materials require different types of fixing device, for advice on suitable fixing systems, contact your local specialized dealer.



















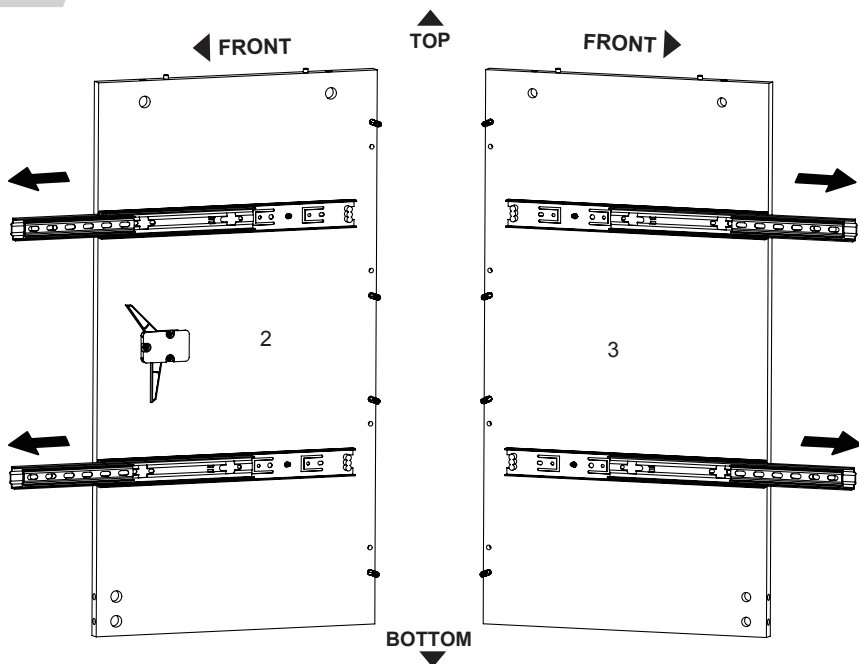
When installing, please make sure the screws are flattened, not crooked; Otherwise the drawers will not be installed perfectly.

3. Please install hole #1 first, then hole #10.

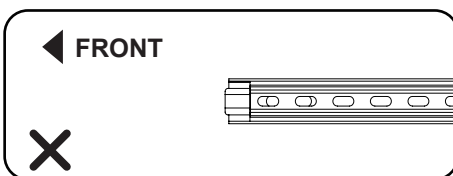
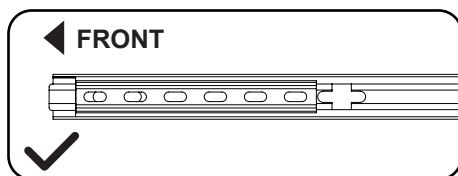

1. Please full extend the slide runners.



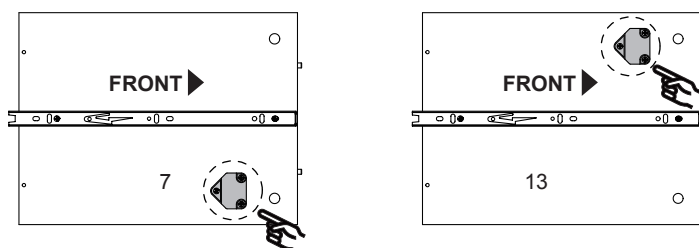
2. Simply push the ball bearing cart all the way to the end of the slide(in both sides).





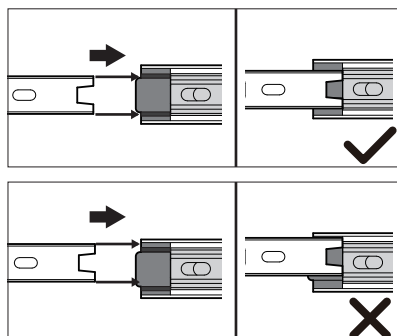
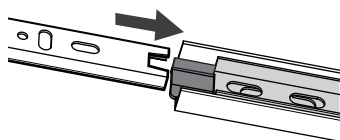

1. Note the difference between the part 7 and the part 13 .



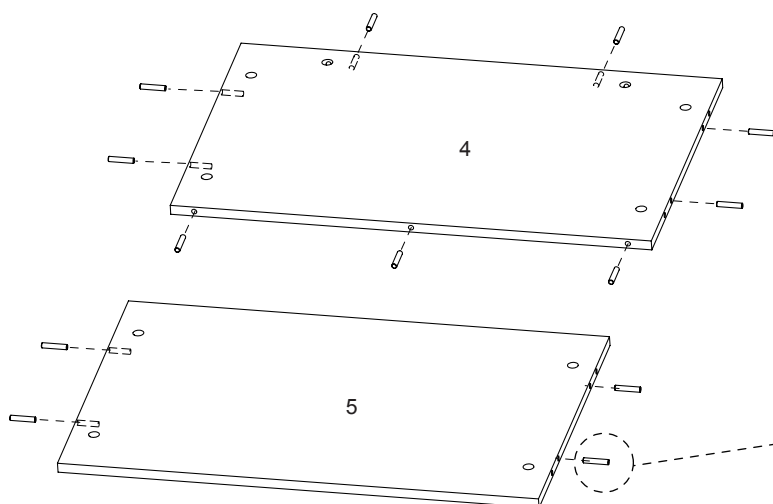
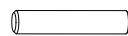
2. Align the slide runners on the drawer with the unit and push it carefully inside until it stops.

3. If the drawer does not go in smoothly please take it out and repeat the step.

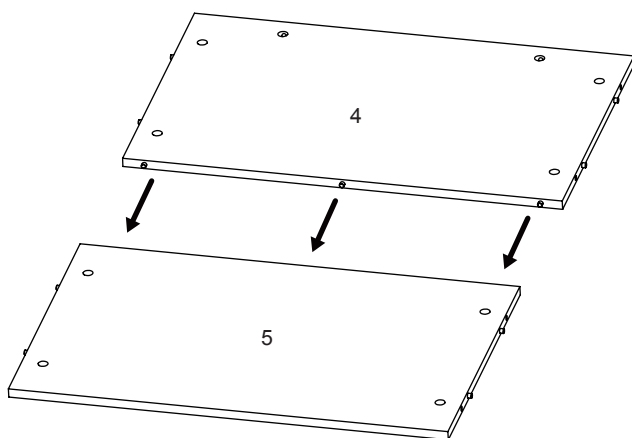

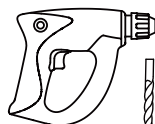
WALL ANCHORING GUIDE

The hardware you should use to secure your furniture to the wall depends on both the type of furniture you have and your wall material.

Attaching your furniture to cavity wall with anti-tipping device

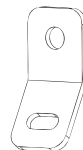

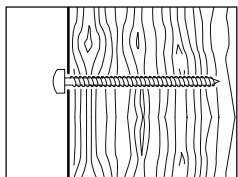

Type of Wall Material

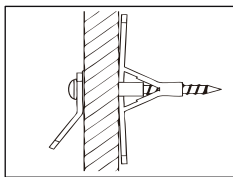
Using the guide below, identify your wall material and choose the corresponding steps.

Mark the attachment point(s) with a pencil at the appropriate height.



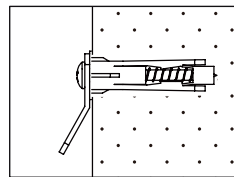
Drywall or plaster with available wood stud

- Drill 1/8-inch (3mm) diameter pilot hole(s) into the wood stud(s), at the height you marked with pencil.



Drywall without available wood stud

- Drill 5/16-inch (8mm) diameter hole(s) through the wall at the height you marked with pencil.
- Drive the plastic plug(s) into the hole(s), using a hammer if needed.



Masonry

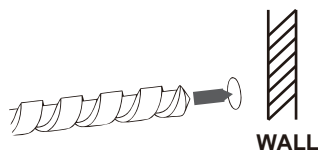
- Drill 5/16-inch (8mm) diameter hole(s) 2-inches (50mm) deep into the wall at the height you marked with pencil.
- Drive the plastic plug(s) into the hole(s), using a hammer if needed.

Follow the appropriate pictogram instructions on the following pages, drive the screw(s) with washer(s) through the brackets and tighten screw(s) firmly into the plastic plug(s) in the wall. Do not over-tighten.
