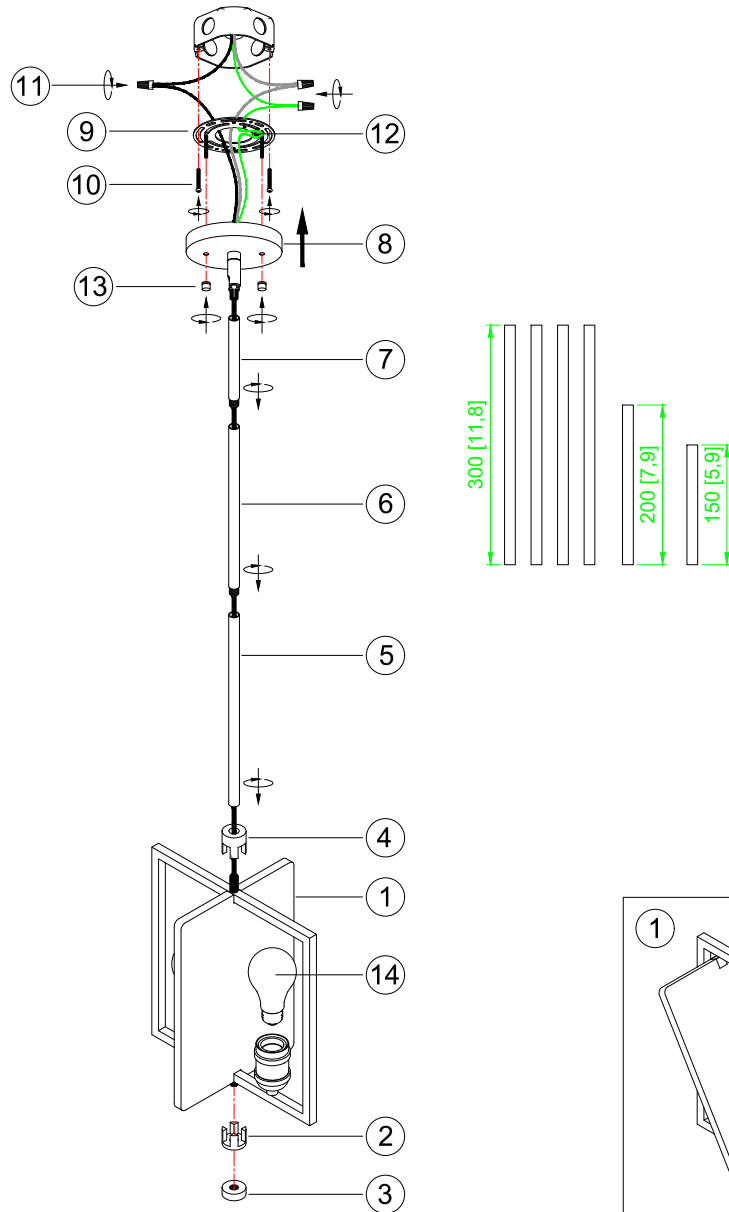


# ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

**WARNING:** TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



## Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

## Step-by-Step Installation:

1. Tilt the middle glass panels and align them vertically with the mounting slots on the fixture arms, ensuring they are perpendicular to the threaded rods.
- 2-3. Secure the bottom glass panel by sliding a four-claw bracket over the lower center threaded rod, then lock it in place with a decorative round finial.
- 4-5. Secure the top glass panel by sliding a four-claw bracket over the upper center threaded rod, then fasten it with a suspension downrod.
- 6-8. Assemble the provided rods and canopy to achieve the desired hanging height. Tighten all connections securely.
- 9-10. Mount the mounting plate to the junction box using the provided screws.
11. Pull power supply wires from the junction box. Use wire connectors to connect the black (hot) wire to the black wire, the white (neutral) wire to the white wire,
12. Secure fixture ground wire to the mounting plate using the green grounding screw. Connect supply ground wire using wire connector. Carefully tuck all wires into junction box.
13. Secure the fixture canopy (8) to the junction box using the provided decorative nuts (13).
14. Install light bulb (not included). Do not exceed the maximum wattage marked on the socket. Installation is complete.

## Safety Instructions:

**To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.**

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
