HANGING A 5-PIECE CANVAS ART SET

OUR SIMPLE GUIDE BELOW OFFERS STEP-BY-STEP INSTALLATION TIPS FOR HANGING OUR 5-PIECE CANVAS SET. WHEN IT COMES TO HANGING A SET, THERE ISN'T NECESSARILY A WRONG WAY, BUT WE'RE HERE TO LEND A HELPFUL HAND IN SIMPLIFYING THE PROCESS!



SUPPLIES NEEDED: - HAMMED - MEASURING TARE - NAILS OF COKS





Measure the width of the wall and mark the center,

FIND HOOK SPOT DISTANCE:



Each piece measures 12" wide. Add desired panel distance apart. We chose 2". (Ex. 12" + 2" = 14")

HANG 5-PIECE SET:



Align the sawtooth hanger (located on back) with the hook on the wall and hang. Then repeat with the other 4 panels.

FIND THE HEIGHT:



Suggested hanging height is 60° from the floor + half of your piece. Each piece measures 30° H. Add half of the piece height to the suggested hanging height. (EX.15° + 60° = 75°)

MARK THE HOOK SPOTS



Starting from the center mark, measure and mark a hook spot at 14" and 28" to the right side. Then repeat on the left side of the center mark

MARK THE HEIGHT:



Mark the height of 75° from Step 2. Make sure it corresponds with our center measurement from step 1. This is you nail marker.

INSTALL:



Hammer or screw your hooks into all 5 marked spots.
