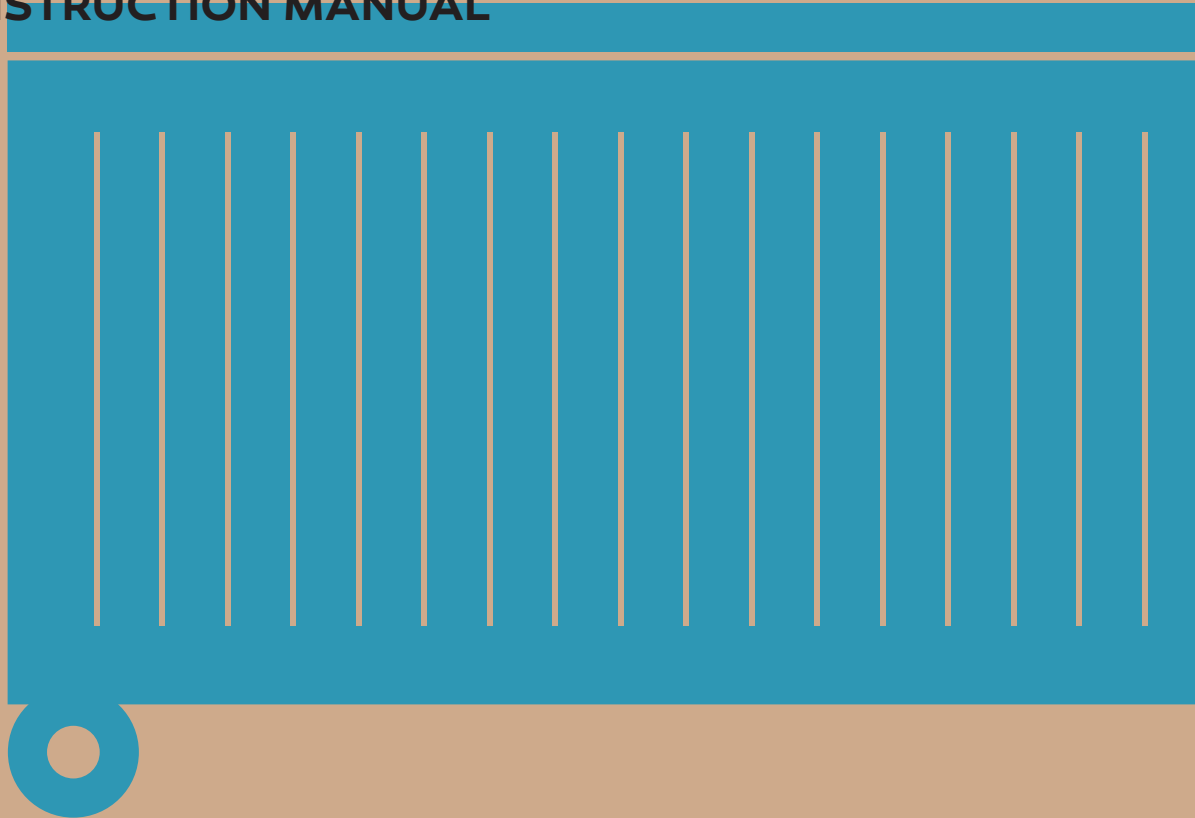

BEFORE ASSEMBLING YOUR DECK BOX

WARNING: Important safety instructions. Follow all instructions, since incorrect assembly can lead to severe injury.

Make sure you have all the tools required for assembling your deck box:

In order to assemble your deck box safely and correctly, please ensure you have access to the following tools and accessories, all of which are not provided.



2 Goggles



2 Protective Gloves



Scissors



Cordless
Screwdriver



Rubber Mallet



2 People Required

Notice: Adjust the torque range of the cordless screwdriver according to the bit used: T25: 5.4~7.2N.M.

Check to ensure there are no missing parts:

Before you begin assembly, please check that you have all the parts required to assemble your deck box. Please also carefully check that the quantity of parts matches with that of the model you have purchased. If any parts are missing, please refer to the **Warranty & Complaints Procedure** to contact customer service before beginning the assembly.

Prepare the parts you will need for each step:

In the **Assembly** section of the manual, each step indicates the necessary parts and quantities required to complete the step. We recommend that you prepare the parts you will need for each assembly step. Doing this will save you time and effort during assembly. If possible, place the parts on cardboard or other soft surface to protect from scratching the painted surfaces.




IMPORTANT SAFETY ADVICE

For the safety of all persons assembling and using the deck box, it is important to follow the safety guidelines below.

Preparation

Prepare, assemble, and use only on a flat, level surface.	Wear work shoes, gloves, and eye protection where appropriate.	Do not attempt to assemble the product in windy or wet conditions.	Recycle packaging and dispose of plastic bags safely, out of children's reach.	Keep children and pets away from the work area - small parts, tools, and packaging can pose choking or injury risks.
				

During Usage

Keep fingers and clothing away while closing the deck box.	Be cautious when moving a fully loaded product. It's intended for stationary storage and should not carry more than 100 kg / 220 lb.	Do not store flammable or corrosive chemicals in the product.
		

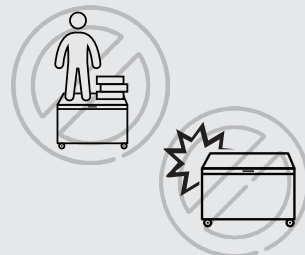
Keep children from playing inside the box to prevent suffocation. This product is not for use by children.



Do not place the deck box in extremely low (<math>< -22^{\circ}\text{F}</math> / -30°C) or high (>math>176^{\circ}\text{F}</math> / 80°C) temperatures, or near items like grills and fire pits.



Do not stand on, place items on, or hit the deck box, as impacts can cause permanent damage, component failure, and injury.

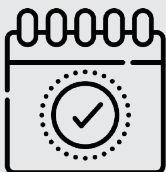






CARE & MAINTENANCE

Regularly check that all bolts and fittings are secure. Tighten if needed.



Use only manufacturer-approved replacement parts.

Use water/mild soap and air dry/wipe with a soft clean cloth to clean the deck box.



Do not use any bleach, ammonia, acidic, alkaline or other caustic cleaners.
