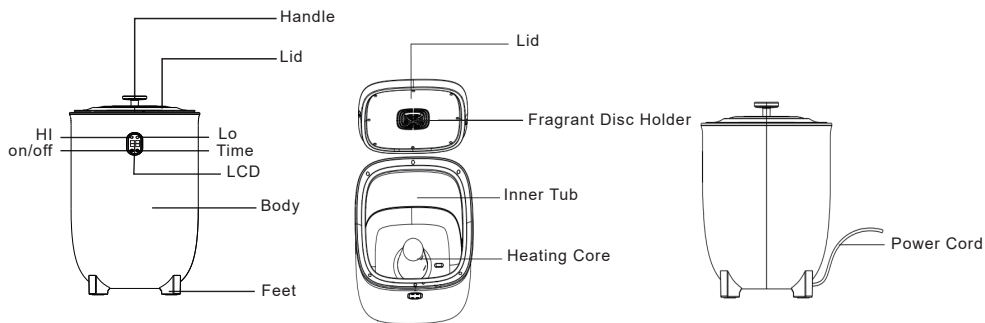

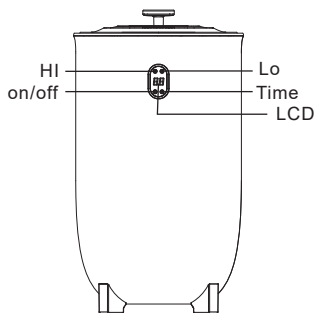
- Set low/ high heating temperature .

Instructions for indicators



Using instruction

1.

Take out the machine from the packaging box.



2.

Remove the plastic bags on the product and the lid.



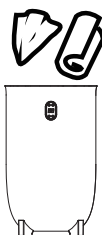
3.

Take out all the accessories inside and check if they're complete



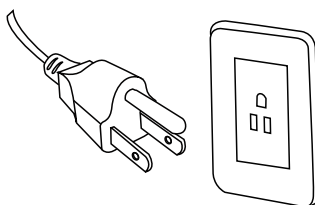
4.

Throw your towel into the machine. (please make sure the towel is dry and try to arrange it in a fluffy way)



5.

Insert the 3 - prong grounding plug into a AC120V electrical outlet.



6.

Press the “”, the machine starts to work.



7.

Press the “” to adjust the expected working minutes(20/40/60/90). And the default time is 60 minutes. The time shown here is a countdown of the remaining working time



Using instruction

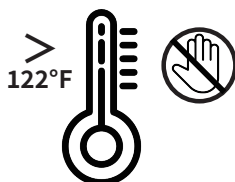
8.

Press "HI" or "LO" to adjust the mode of heating power. The button will be lit after you press the corresponding buttons. The default gear is "HI"



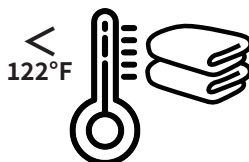

When the temperature inside the machine is higher than 122 °F, the "HI" or "LO" buttons will turn red. Please do not touch the internal surface with your hands.



10.

When the scheduled working time is completed, the machine will stop working. Now you can open the lid and use the towel. However, if you need to touch the internal surface to move the machine, do so after the indicator light has turned white (the inner wall temperature is below 122°F)



Using tips

1.

It would only take 6 minutes to reach a high temperature.



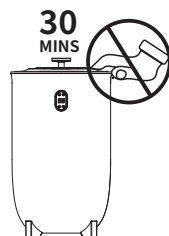

You can stop the heating program at any time by pressing the “” for once when the machine is working.



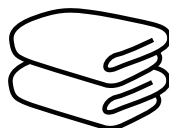

After the heating cycle is complete, the interior surface of the towel warmer will be too hot to touch until at least 30 minutes.

4 towels (55*27.5 inches) can be accommodated

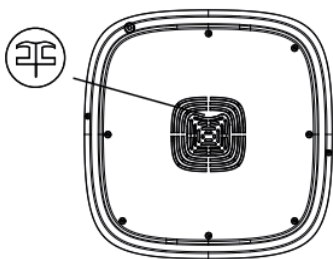
The internal diameter: 12 inches

Instruction of fragrance disc

This fragrance disc holder additionally design is for some users who like to use aromatic tablets or essential oils when warming towels. It would be an innovative air refresher for your home, which also effectively eliminates odors

1. Before insert the fragrance disc into the fragrance disc holder, please remove its sealed plastic bag.
2. A carrier(like a wood chip) would be needed if you want to use essential oils.
3. The fragrance disc holder is located on the underside of the lid. It can accommodate the size of objects with a thickness of less than 4mm and a diameter of less than 47mm.



The fragrance disc is an innovative air fresher for your home, which also effectively eliminates odors.

Tips for best results

1. Use cotton or cotton blend towels or fabrics only.
2. For fast and even heating, loosely pile one towel into the Towel & Blanket Warmer. Tightly rolled or folded towels will take longer to heat thoroughly. Two towels will take longer to heat than one.
3. Use only with DRY fabrics.

NOTE: Do NOT use with damp or wet articles.

4. Avoid using delicate fabrics that cannot withstand high heat. Any fabric indicating that a cool iron must be used may not be able to withstand the heat of the Towel & Blanket Warmer, resulting in damage to the fabric and the product.
5. Once the heating cycle has begun, keep the lid closed. This will prevent heat from escaping. Opening the lid mid-cycle may result in slower heating times.

NOTE: Condensation on the lid and interior of the product is normal.

6. When used with the Towel & Blanket Warmer, the Fragrance Disc may warp over time.

Safety Instructions

Please read the following instructions carefully before putting your device into use. Please retain these instructions for further reference!



WARNING

To reduce risk of fire, electric shock or serious injury to persons when using the appliance, adhere to the following basic precautions:

FOR HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY

Always unplug the product from the electrical outlet immediately after use. Do not use the device for anything other than its intended use.
