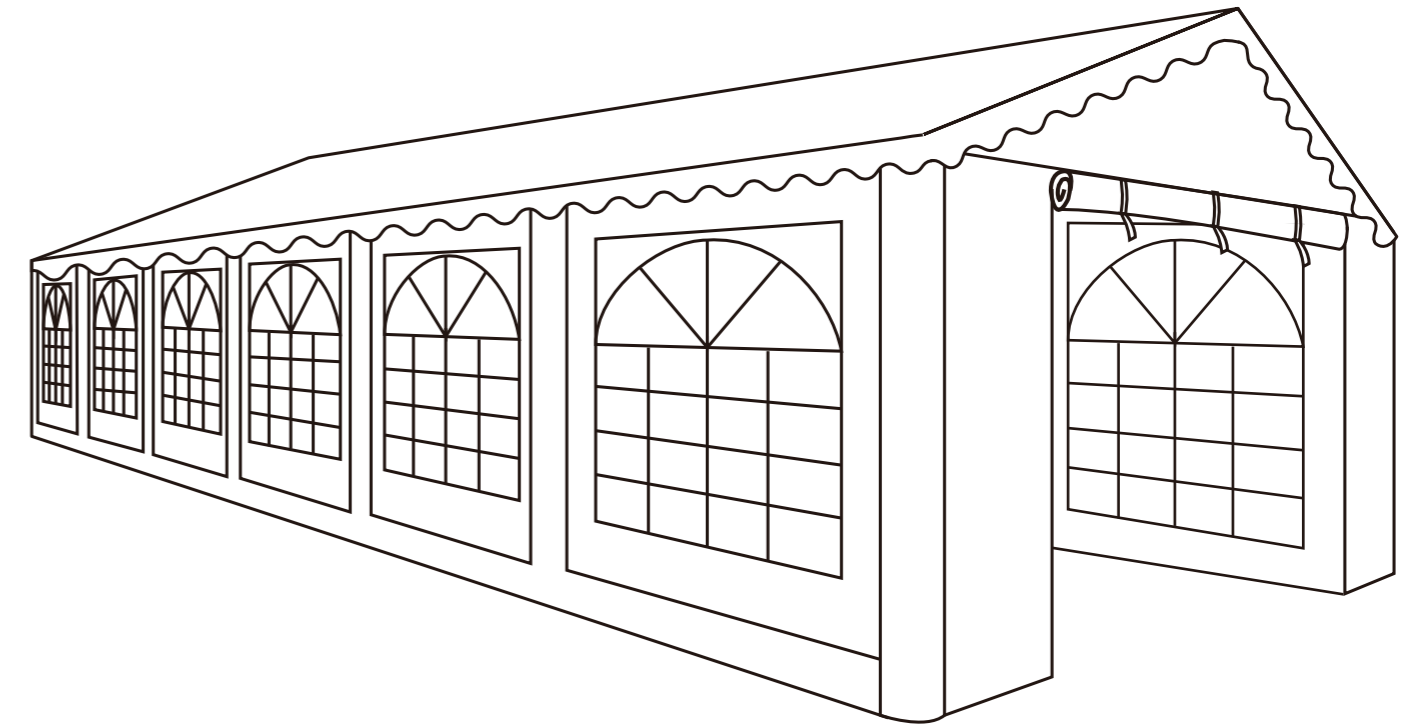

## Safety Information

- **Do not completely tighten screws until all screws are started.** Tighten each bolt firmly and properly.
- Some parts may contain sharp edges. Wear protective gloves as necessary.
- Children under the age of 16 should not be engaged in the assembly, removal or disassembly of the product. Children under the age of 10 should be supervised by a competent adult while using this furniture.
- Please keep children out of the assembly area during assembly.
- This set is heavy, and may require two adults for safe assembly.
- Never use this product as a support. Do not shake, lean, or climb on the product at any time.



**DANGER** : Do not allow children to play with plastic wraps or small parts to prevent potential choking hazard.



**CAUTION:** Read all the instructions before assembly. Failure to do so may result in faulty assembly and potential injury!

### LIMITED WARRANTY

This warranty is a limited warranty, and applies to the original purchase is required. This is a residential warranty and does not apply to commercial use. This collection carries a (1) year limited warranty and is valid from original date of purchase to the original owner (proof of purchase required).

We warrant the frame to be free of Manufacturing defects to the original purchaser for one year.

This warranty does not cover commercial use, hardware, acts of nature, fire, freezing and abusive. In addition, purchased parts are not covered under this warranty.

Assemble the item on a soft, non-abrasive surface, such as carpet or cardboard to avoid damaging the item. Seek assistance to assemble bulky or heavy items.


















NOTE: Identify all parts packed in the carton against the parts list. Remove all the protective material carefully and DO NOT use a knife to prevent scratching the furniture.













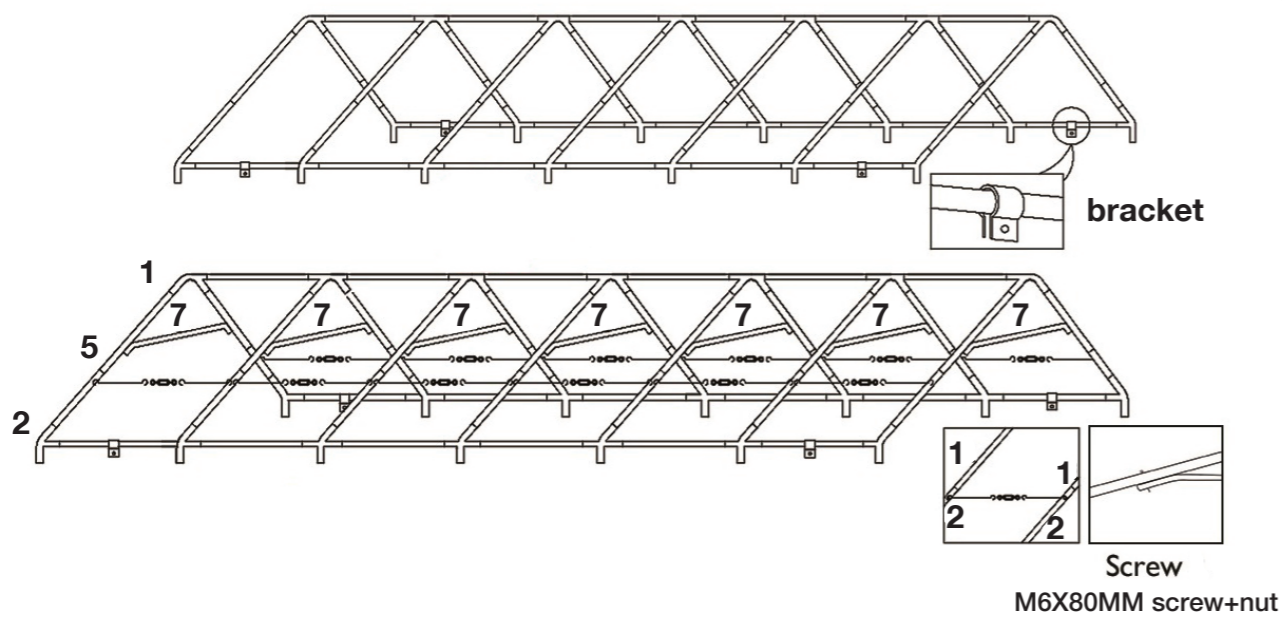
# Assembly

Assemble the upper frame and the roof frame using Pole (1,2) and the connector (5,8,9,10,11).

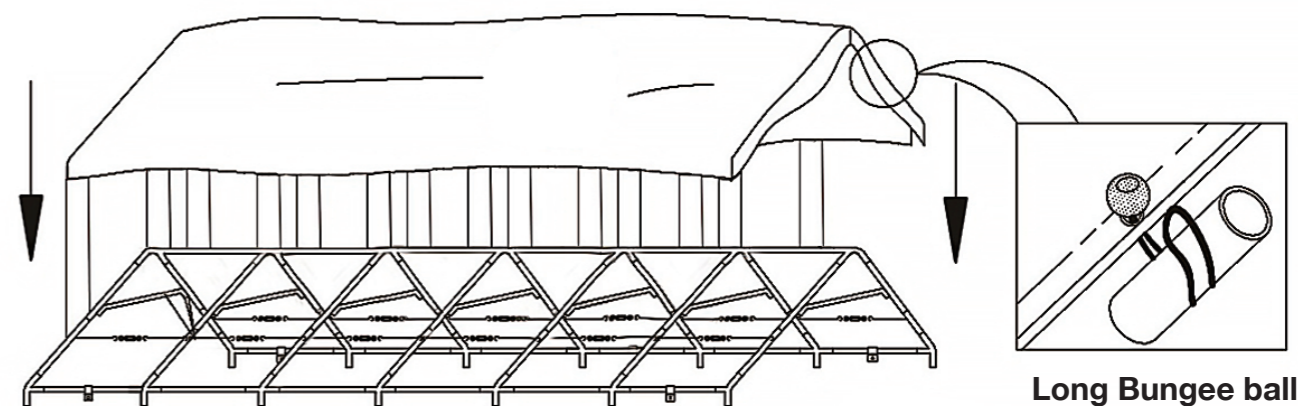

Attach the bracket at both ends of frame poles. Then reinforce the top frame by using Pole (7) and Steel Rope Set (Steel wires)

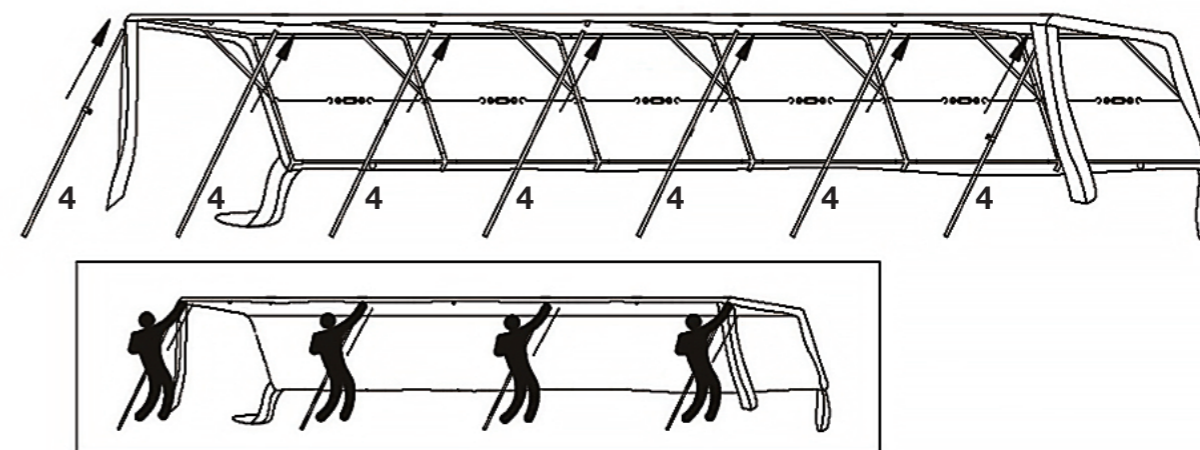

Place the cover tightly over the frame, then use the elastic balls (Long Bungee ball) to fix the cover and steel frame tightly.

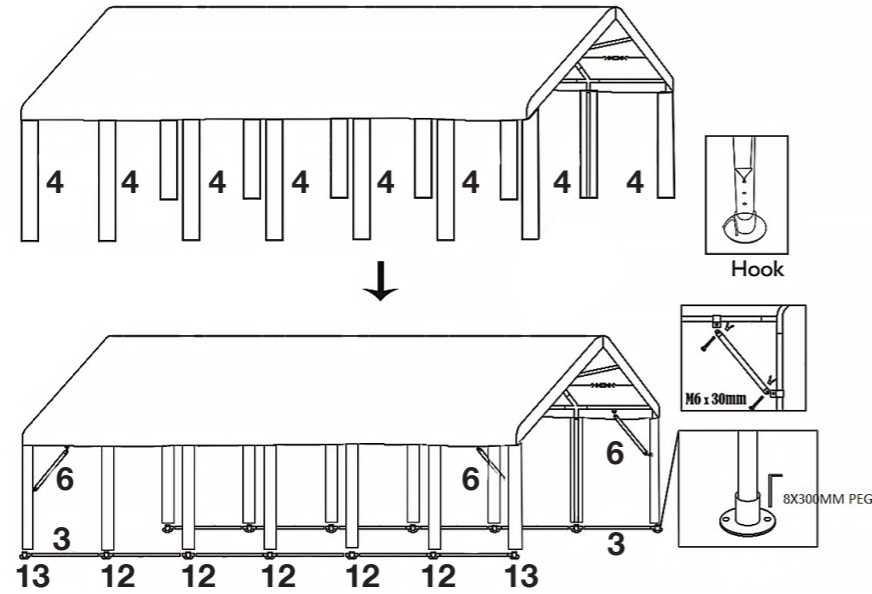

We Recommend several people lift up one side of the whole roof frame and slot Pole (4) to the matching the Connector (10,11).

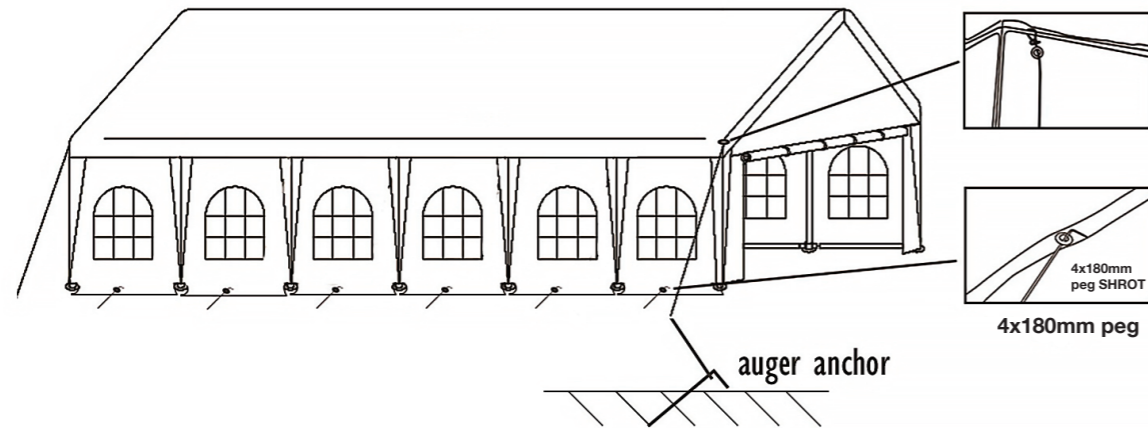

Hook the metal hooks into the tube holes near the feet to make the leg cover tightly, you can adjust the tightness of the leg cover by moving the hooks. Then connect all leg poles on the ground with Pole (3) and Base plates (12,13). Next reinforce the whole body frame using Pole (6), connect pole (6) and bracket with Screw M6x30mm. Finally push the Peg through the hole at the base plate and insert it into the ground to secure the pole.

Firstly, attach the Side panels & Zipper doors with Elastic balls, Velcros and Buckles. Secondly, Push the peg through the hole at the bottom of the cover and insert it into the ground to tight the cover. Finally, pass one end of the rope through the hole in the top cover and tie it to the pole inside, then tie the other end of the rope to the Auger Anchor and insert it into the ground to secure the tent.

**NOTE:** Securing the tent with ropes, pegs, auger anchors is very important, for the safety of the tent, please follow the installation instructions.

## Warning

- Take note that the tent needs to be handled carefully to avoid damage.
- Do not force the frame, as there may be damage in the process.
- Tents are meant as temporary shelter and must be evacuated under extreme weather conditions.
- Please select a suitable site for the tent to avoid damage to underground sprinkler systems, water, gas or electrical lines.
- Keep away from naked flame and other heat sources.
- Take preventative measures to avoid wind when wind speed reaches 25 mph or higher.
