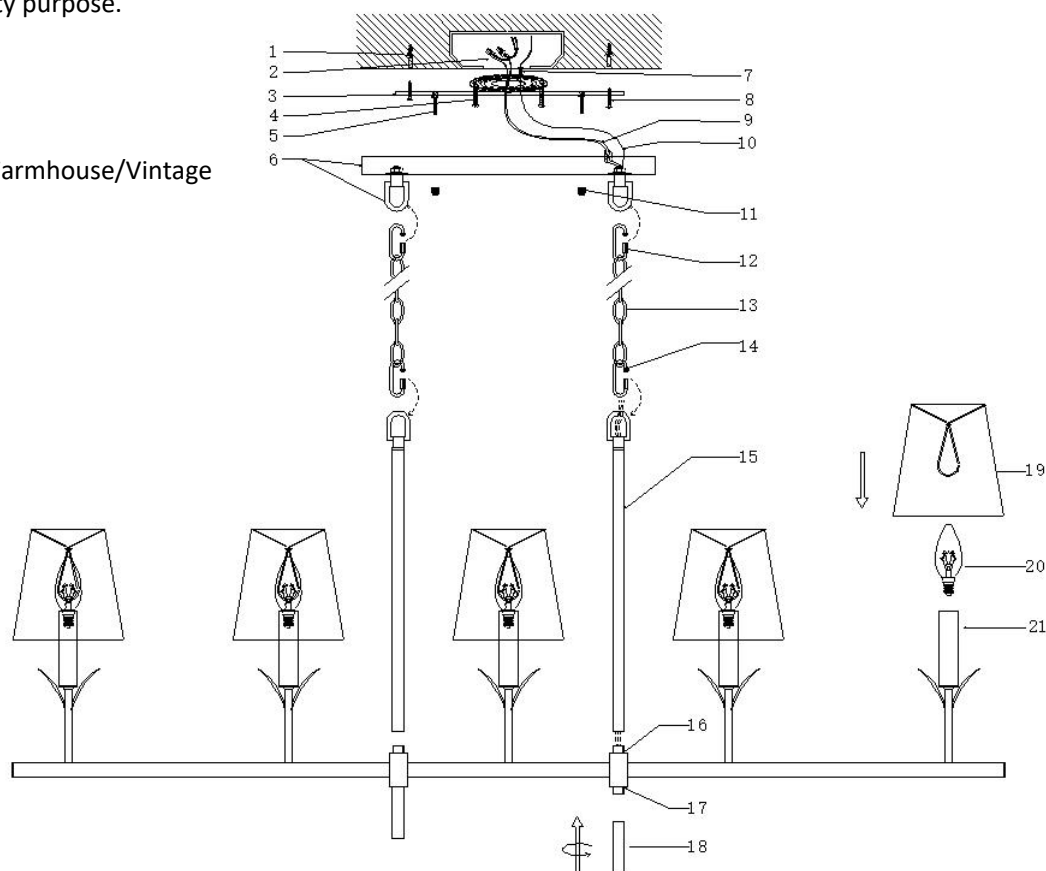

Installation Instructions

A: Screw the short rod (18) securely onto the threaded tube (17), and the long rod (15) onto the threaded tube (16).

B: Adjust the height of the hanging chain (13) to the desired length.

C: Thread the main power wire (9) and ground wire (10) through the hanging chain (13) and then through the canopy (6), in that order.

D: Use the quick link (14) to connect the hanging chain (13) to the long rod (15), and the quick link (12) to connect the hanging chain (13) to the canopy (6).

E: Insert the ribbed plastic anchors (1) into the ceiling. Then use the threaded bolts (4) to secure the round crossbar plate from the mounting plate (3) to the junction box. Attach the mounting plate (3) to the ceiling using the self-tapping screws (8).

F: Connect the labeled live wire from the fixture's main wire (9) to the external live wire using a wire cap (2). Connect the unlabeled neutral wire to the external neutral wire using another wire cap (2). Ensure no bare wires are exposed to avoid electrical hazards. Use the ground screw (7) to secure the fixture's ground wire (10) to the external ground wire at the mounting plate (3).

G: Align the canopy (6) with the threaded bolts (5) on the mounting plate, then secure it in place by tightening the cap nuts (11).

H: Screw the light bulbs (20) into the sockets (21).

I: Attach the shades (19) onto the bulbs (20) to complete the installation.
