




























ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

Caution: Please read instructions thoroughly before unpacking assembly parts. Sharp, exposed staple tips can cause injury, therefore, for your protection, please remove any exposed staples used in packing.

1. We recommend that you should assemble this product with the assistance of another person; this will make assembly easier, and will help to eliminate damage to the product or injury to persons during assembly.
2. Be sure to check all packing materials carefully for small parts that may have come loose inside the carton during shipment.
3. Please do not over tighten screws or bolts.
4. Please put all parts on a non-abrasive floor before assembly, and follow the assembly steps to assemble your newly purchased product correctly and efficiently.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

STEP:1

over the mechanism. Check to assure both sides of the mechanism are positioned inside of the KD receiver on the back frame, pushing in a downward motion from the top of the back frame until a clicking sound is heard. see Fig. 1

STEP:2

POWER SKU'S ONLY: Attach the lead wire from the bottom of each inside back to the lead wire located at the rear of each seat. Care is to be taken to make sure that no wires are in the path of the reclining mechanism. Make sure to close the clip lock to prevent the connection from coming loose

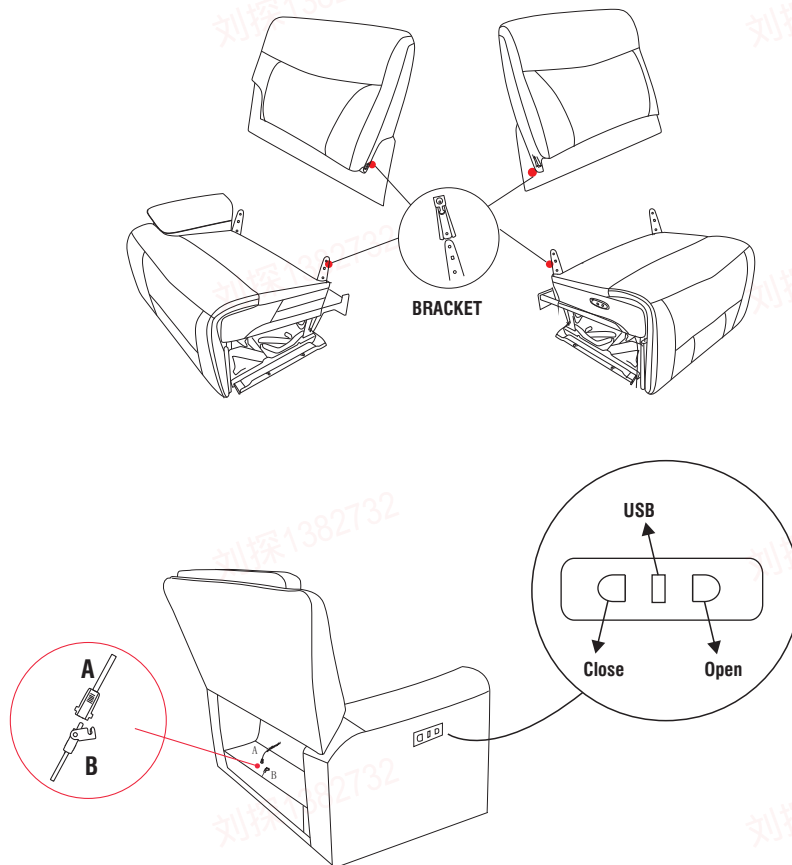
STEP:3

Close the Outside Backs: Using the preattached Velcro on the outside back flap align and press to the preattached velcro attached to the bottom rear of the seat frame.

Note: Follow the same process above on all sku's until all KD Backs are attached

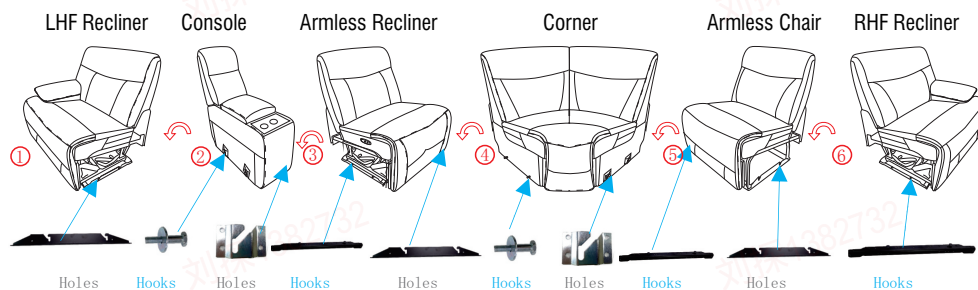
STEP:4

Wedge Only: Carefull to the wedge on its back. Attach the 5 legs (I) to the T nuts, location is pre marked



ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTION

STEP:5 Position your product in the area of its intended use and connect together using the sectional connectors



STEP:6 Attach the power cord found at the bottom rear of the armless dual power recliner to the matching plug found at the bottom rear of the LAF/RAF dual power recliner as seen above . Make sure to close the clip lock to prevent the connection from coming loose

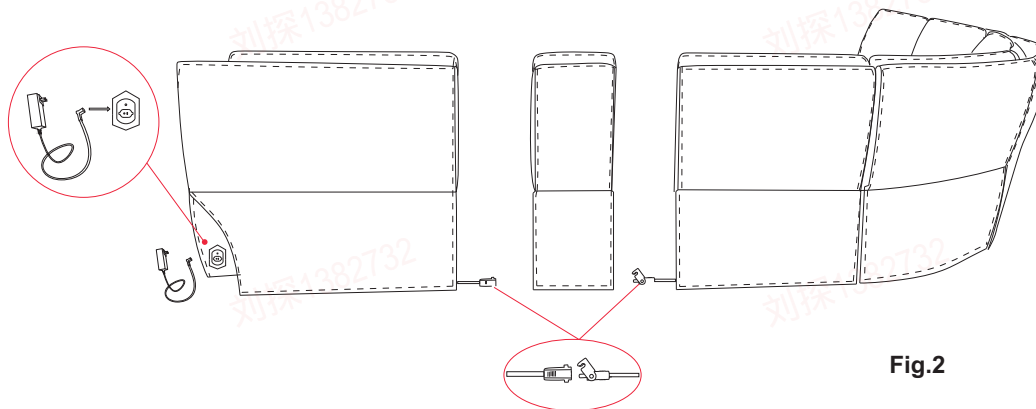

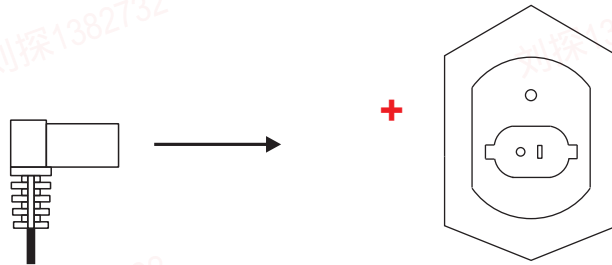
To avoid any risk of suffocation to animals or children dispose of the plastic bags immediately

Cleaning

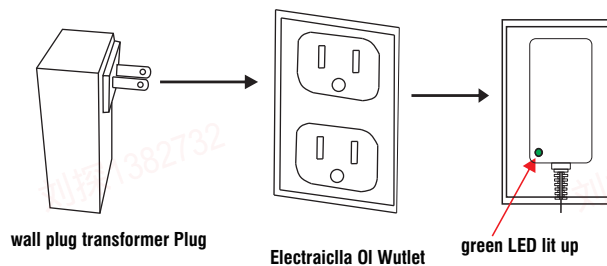
As with all surfaces clean with a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive products.

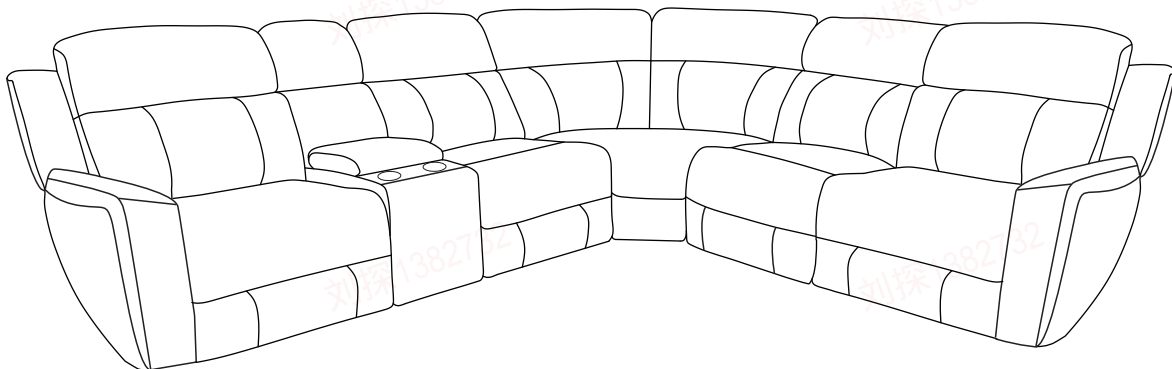
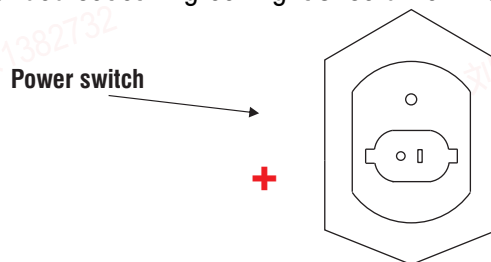
- STEP:7** Connect the matching end of the power supply to the power switch located at the bottom rear of the arm
