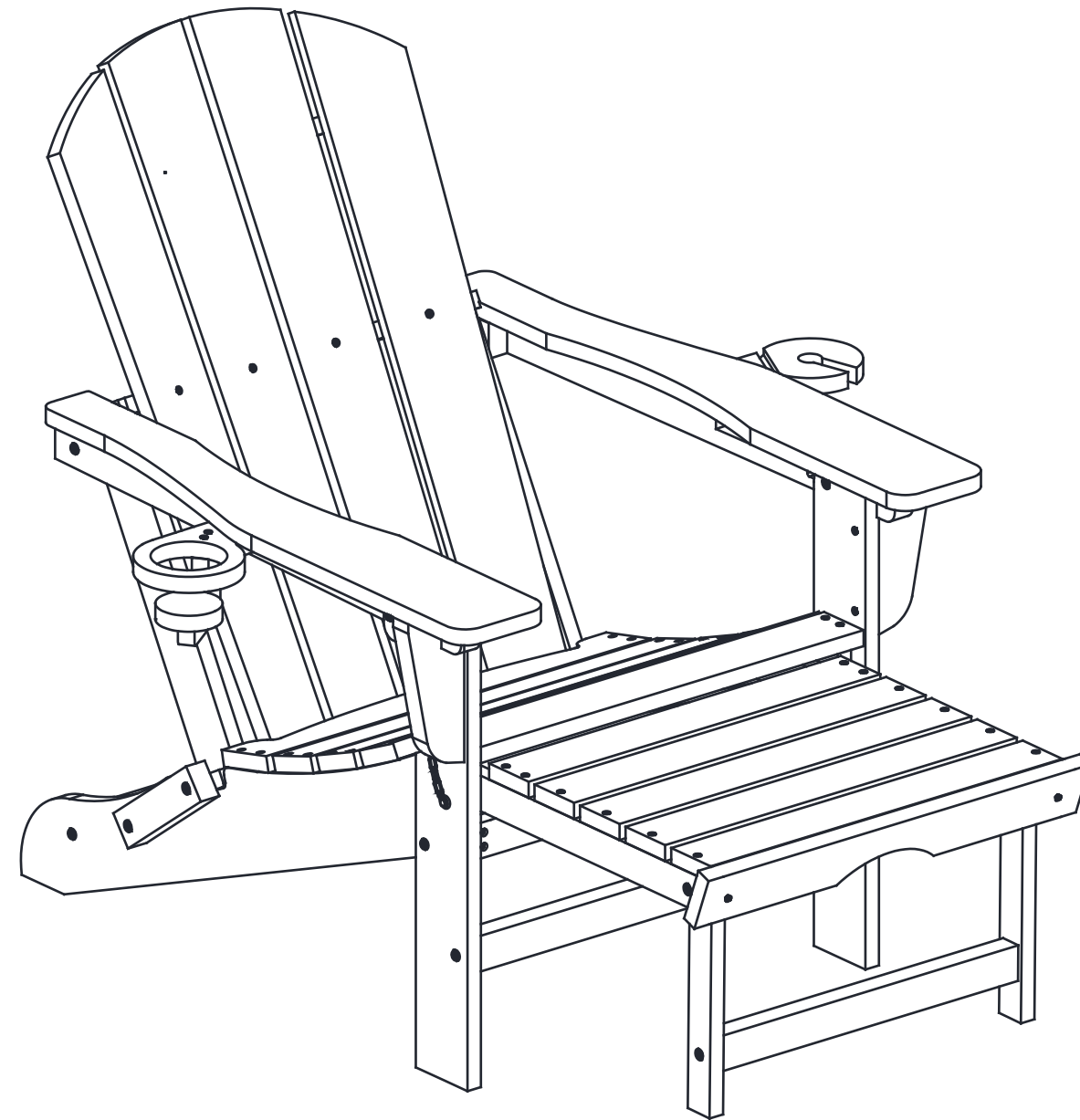

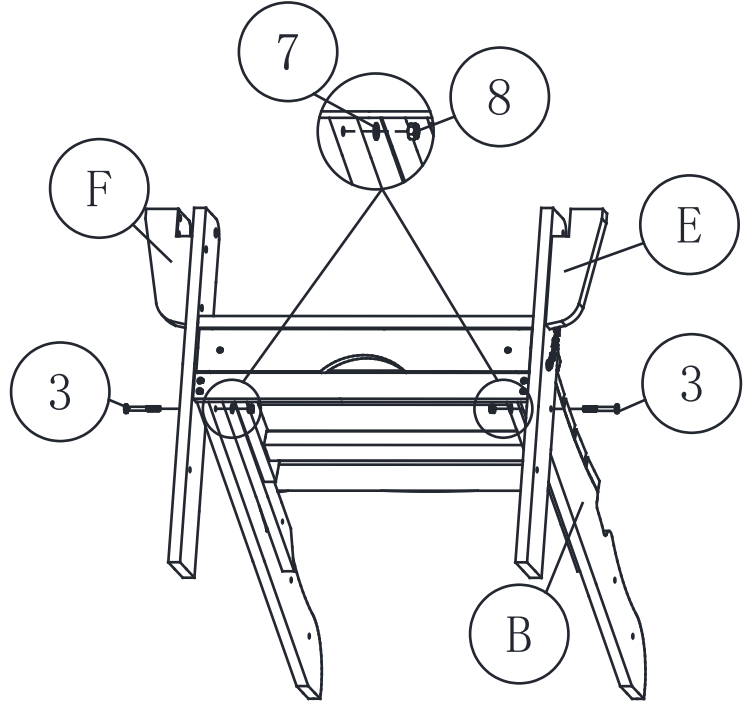

 6 × 2 M6 × 50MM Screws	 7 × 10 Washer	 8 × 8 Nut	 9 × 2 M6 × 30MM Screws	 Hex Key (Included) Wrench (Included)

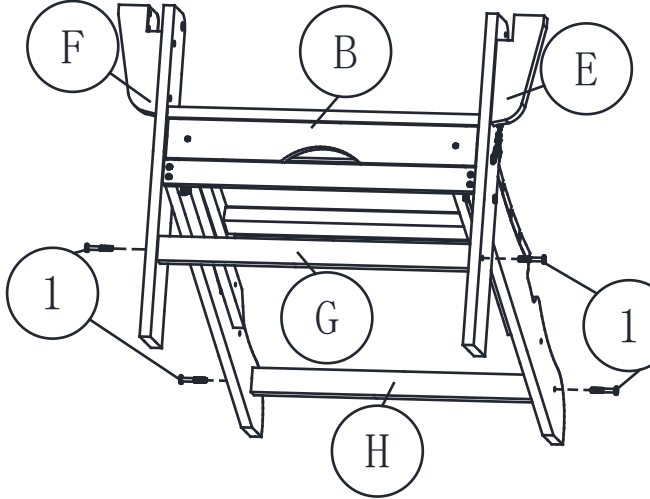

STEP 1
Attach "ChairLegs (F/E)" to "SeatFrame (B)" -Using "3 Bolts" with "7 Washer" and "8 Nut", tighten with hex key and wrench.

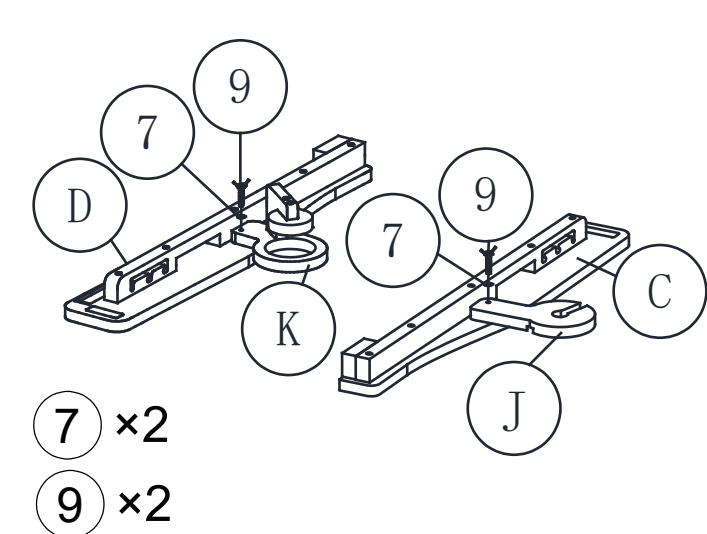


1 × 4
STEP 2
Attach "FrontStretcher (G)" to "ChairLegs (F/E)" -Using "1 Bolts", tighten with hex key.
Attach "FrontStretcher (H)" to "ChairLegs (B)" -Using "1 Bolts", tighten with hex key.

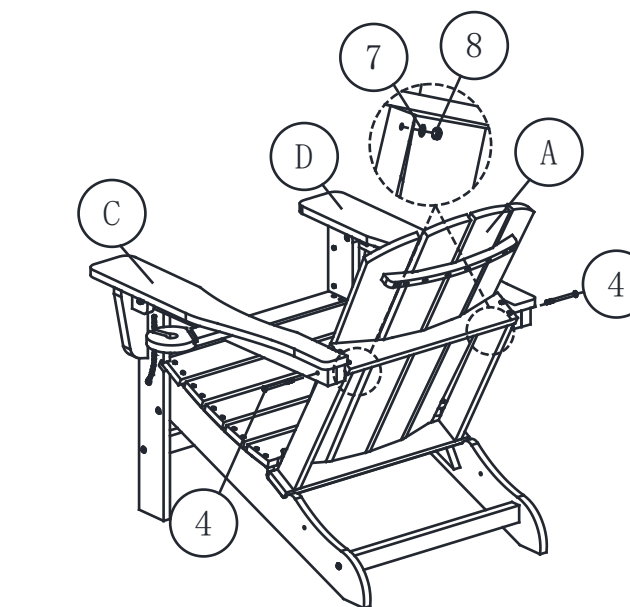

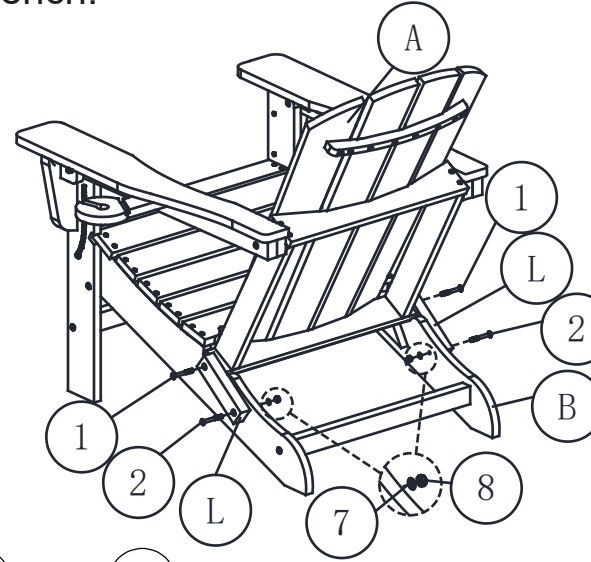

STEP 3
Attach "CupHolder (K/J)" to "ChairArm (D/C)" -Using "9 Bolts" and "7 Washer", tighten with hand.
5 × 2
7 × 2
8 × 2
STEP 4
Attach "ChairArms (D/C)" to "ChairLegs (F/E)" -Using "5 Bolts" with "7 Washer" and "8 Nut", tighten with hex key and wrench.



4 × 2
7 × 2
8 × 2
STEP 5
Attach "ChairArm (D/C)" to "Backrest (A)" -Using "4 Bolts" with "7 Washer" and "8 Nut", tighten with hex key.

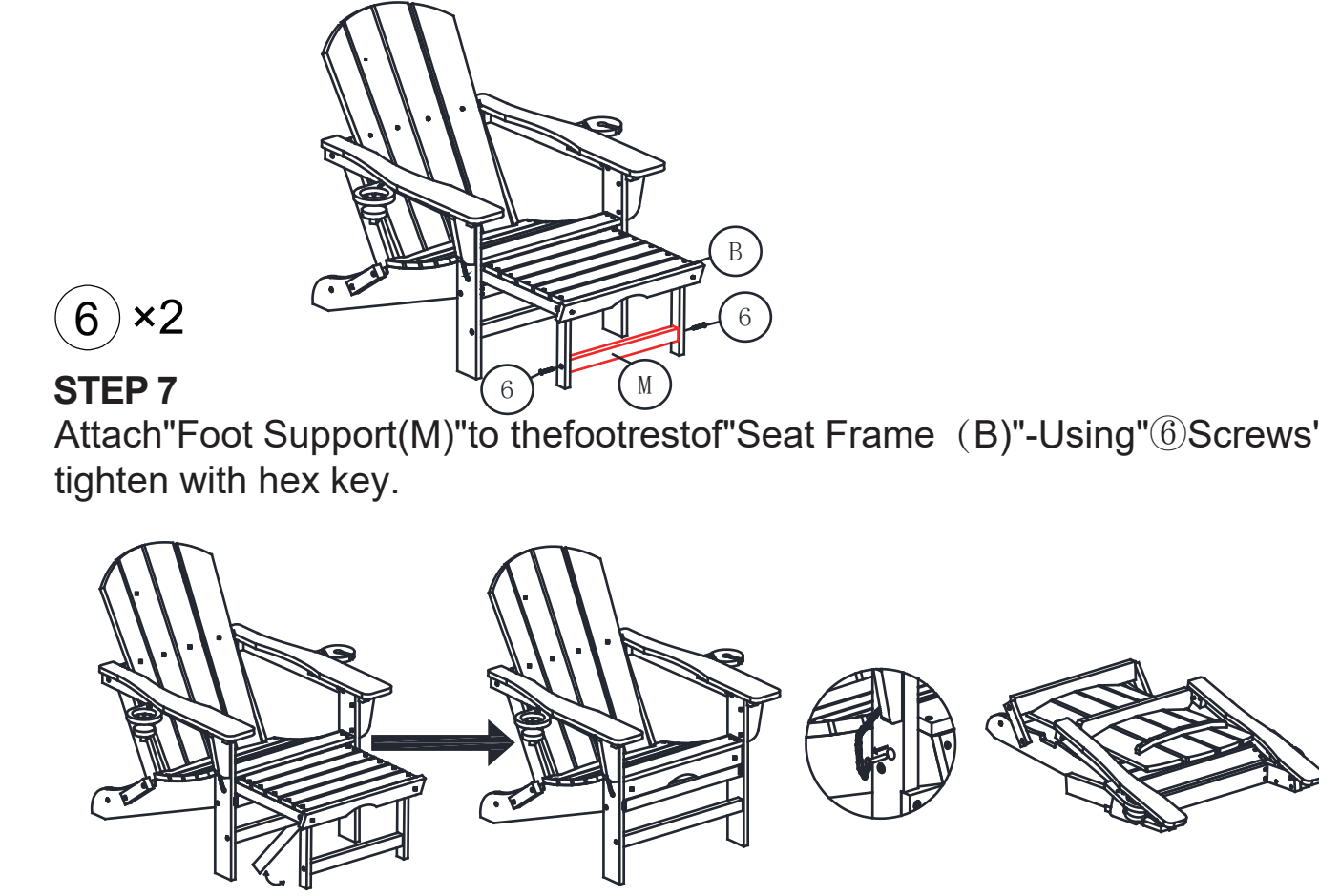

STEP 6
Attach "Backrest (A)" to "SeatFrame (B)" with "Brace (L)" -Using "2 Bolts" with "7 Washer" and "8 Nut" in the backlegs, and using "1 Bolts" on the backrest frame, tighten with hex key and wrench.

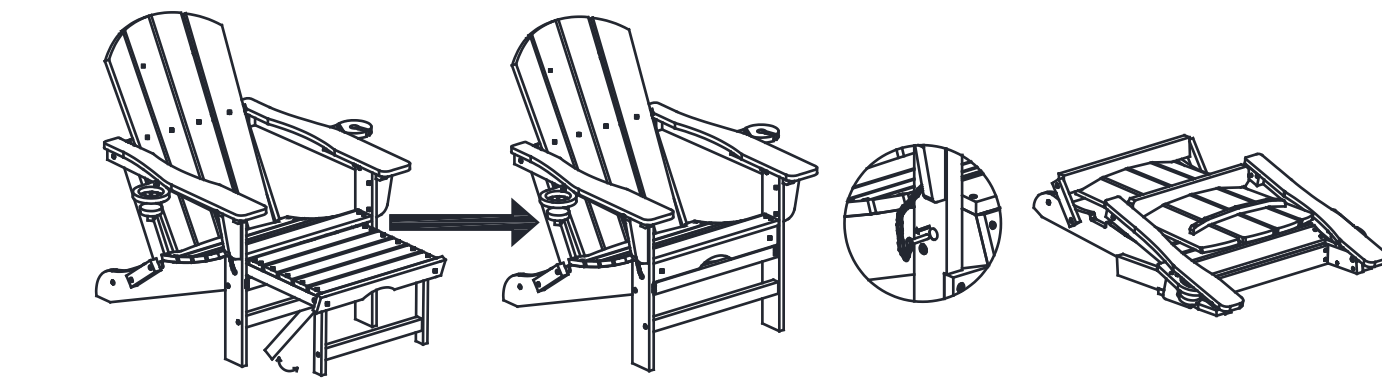

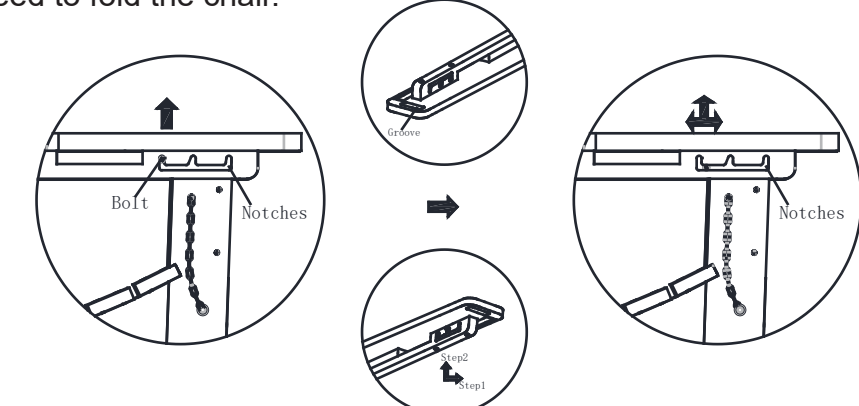
⚠ Caution: Please do not over-tighten bolts and screws during assembly.



6 × 2
STEP 7
Attach "Foot Support (M)" to the footrest of "Seat Frame (B)" -Using "6 Screws", tighten with hex key.



This Adirondack chair can be easily folded flat by pulling out the "Plugs" inserted in the chair legs.
Warning: To avoid damage, please keep the plugs inserted when the chair is in use. Pull out the plugs when you need to fold the chair.



You must lift the armrests and pull them backward or forward to adjust the backrest angle. There is a small groove at the bottom of the armrest where your fingers should go when you lift the armrests.
1. When adjusting the backrest, push the armrest forward before lifting it up.
2. Pull forward or backward to adjust the backrest to a particular position;
3. Then put the armrests down to let bolts rest on the notches simultaneously.
(Please do not lay on the backrest when you are adjusting)

Warnings

Important -Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly

Check you have all the components and tools listed on the page 2.

Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts may cause choking if swallowed.

Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before starting.

Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

The assembly will be easier with 2 people while 1 person could also do the job.

Cleaning & Maintenance

• Clean the product with a solution of mild soap and water. Dip a soft cloth or sponge into the solution and wipe down the entire surface.

• After cleaning, thoroughly rinse the furniture with water to remove any remaining soap residue.

• When not in use, cover the product with a protective cover to keep it clean and prolong its lifespan.
