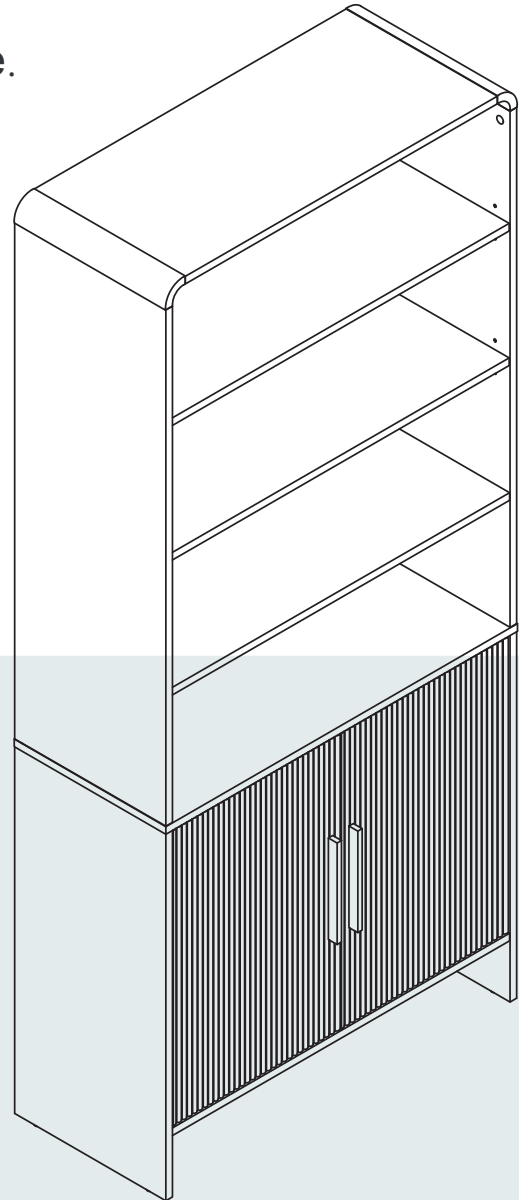

Safety and Care Advice



Important :

Please read these instructions fully before starting assembly.

- Check you have all the components and tools listed on the following pages.
- Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.
- Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.
- Make sure you have enough space to lay out the parts before starting.
- During assembly do not stand or put weight on the product, this could cause damage.
- Assemble the item as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.
- Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.
- Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.



- To reduce the likelihood of damaging your product please ensure that your power drill is set on a low torque setting.

Care and maintenance

- Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.
- From time to time check that there are no loose screws on this unit.
- This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal center.

Handy Hints

- Assemble all parts and bolts loosely during assembly, only once the product is complete should you fully tighten the bolts.
- Regularly check and ensure that all bolts and fittings are tightened properly.

Warning

In order to help prevent overturning, please follow these instructions.

- Use the anti-tip strap or wall fixing method provided (if applicable).
- Do not allow children to climb or hang on the furniture.
- Do not place heavy items in the top drawers.
- Do not place heavy items on top of the furniture, unless the furniture has been designed for this purpose.
- Please note that only the anti-tip strap is provided. You will need to provide wall plugs and screws applicable for your wall type.

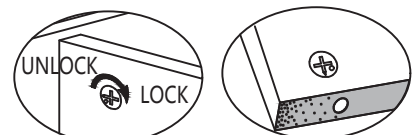


Insert hardware (C) into the corresponding holes of panel (8), then connect it to panels (2) and (3), and secure with hardware (A).



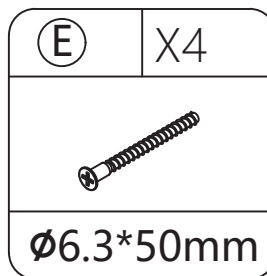
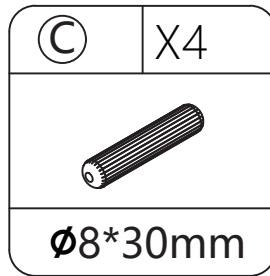
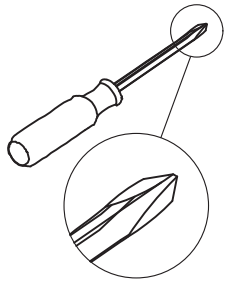

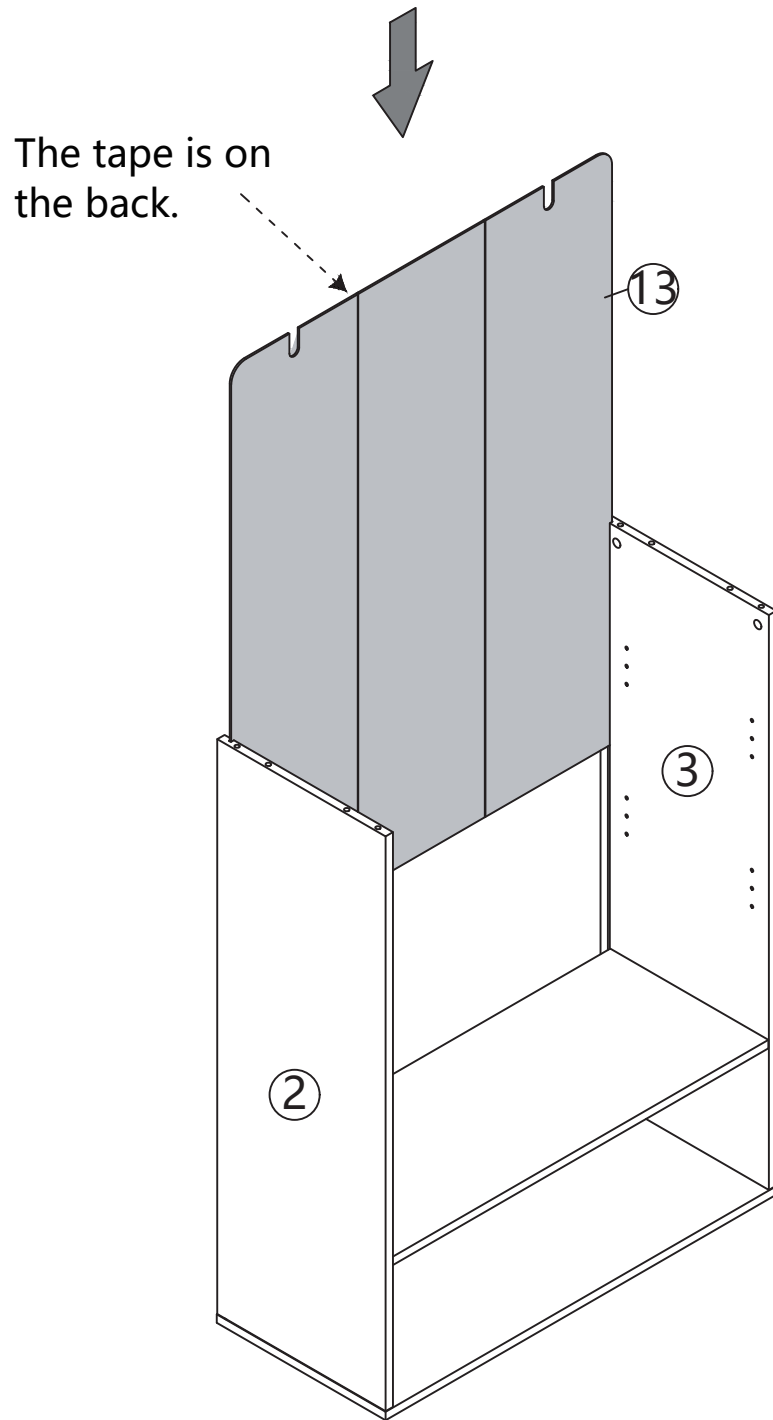


Insert hardware (C) into the corresponding holes of panels (2) and (3), then use screws (E) to pass through panel (16) and connect it to panels (2) and (3).

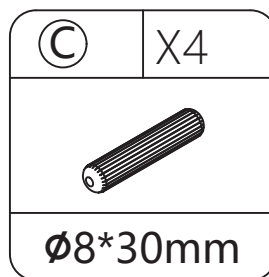
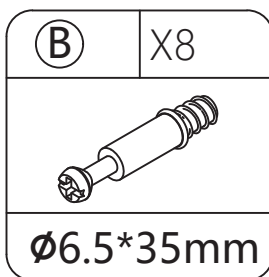
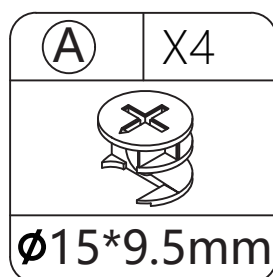
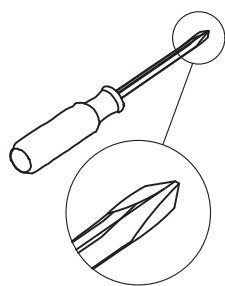

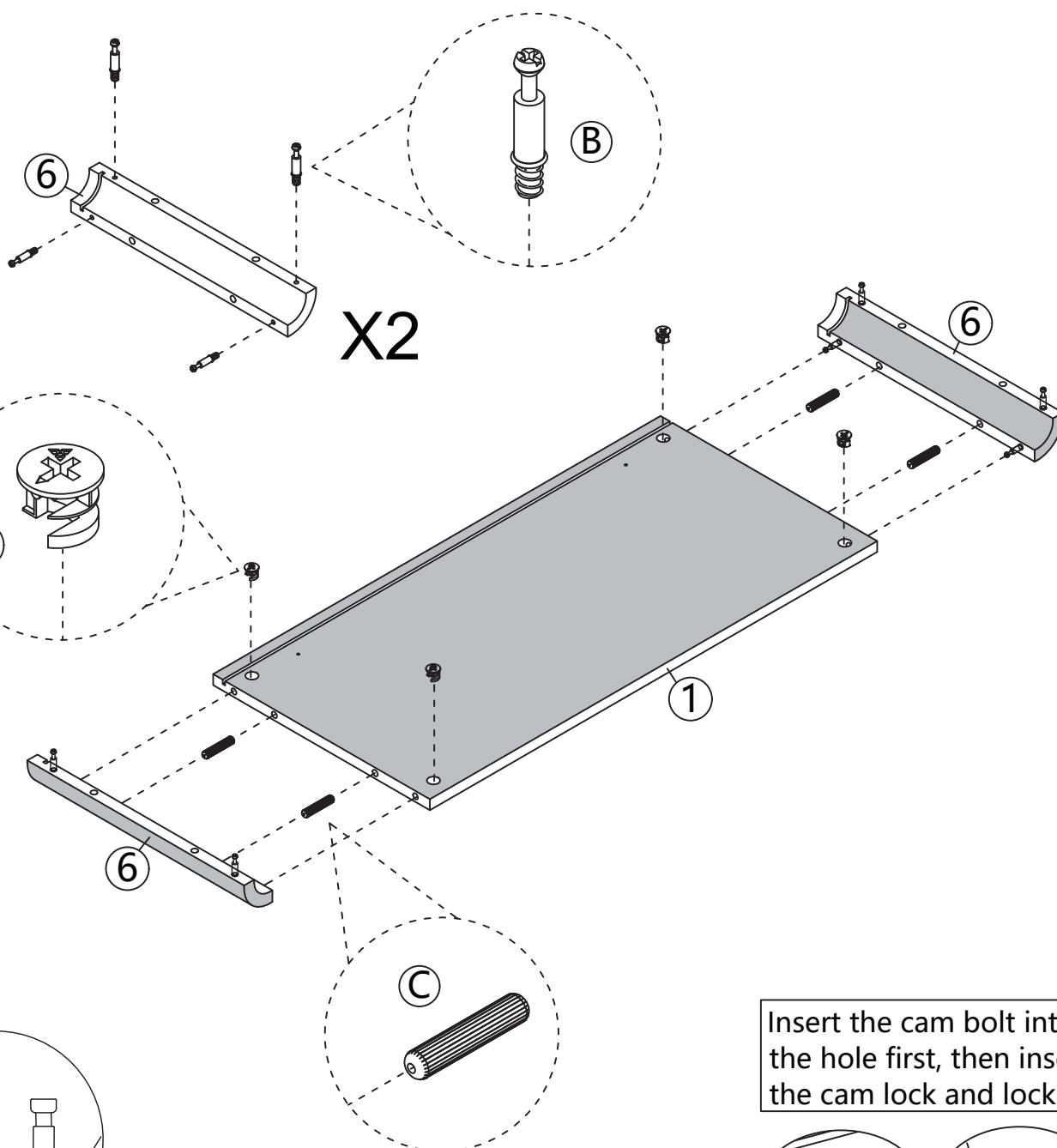
Align panel (13) with the grooves of panels (2) and (3) and insert it as shown. The side with tape should face the back.



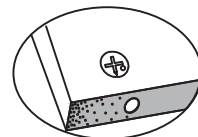
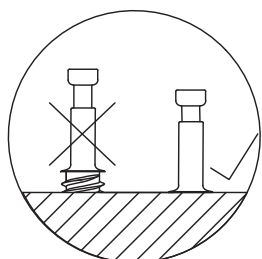
STEP 5

Insert hardware (G) into the holes of panels (2), (3), (4), and (5), then place panels (7) and (10) into the cabinet.



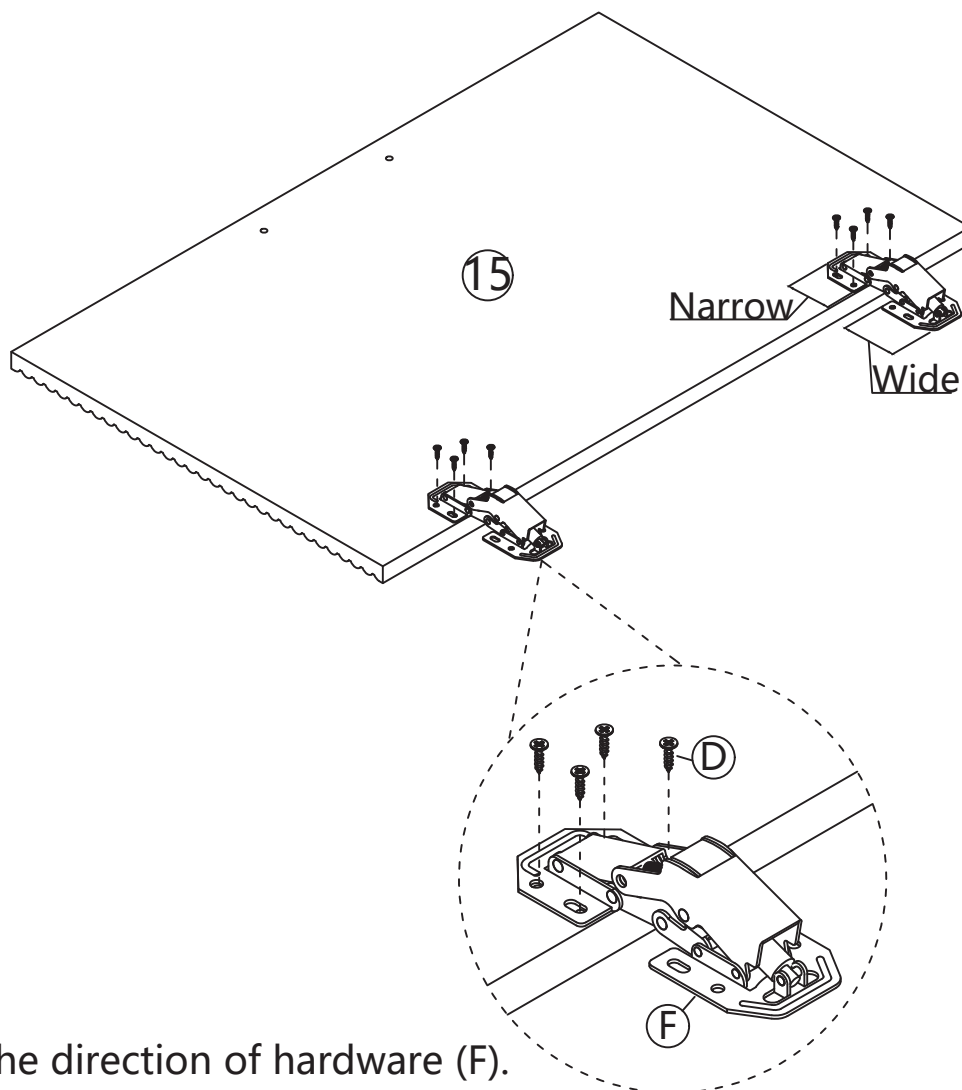

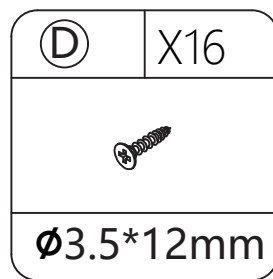
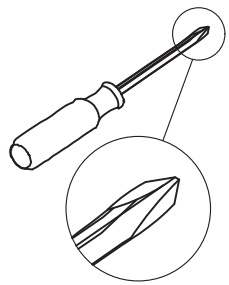
Use screws (D) to secure hardware (F) onto panel (15).
Pay attention to the direction. Repeat this step twice.



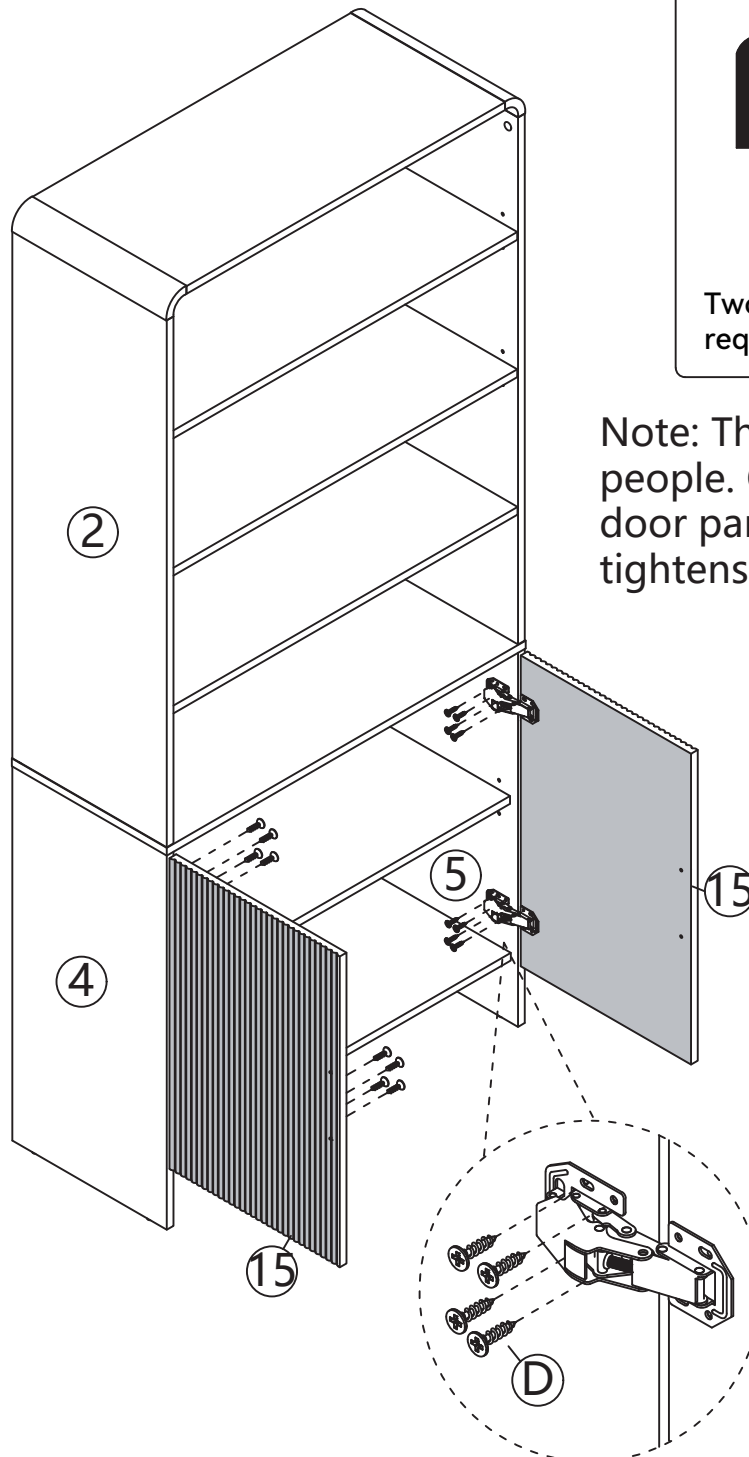

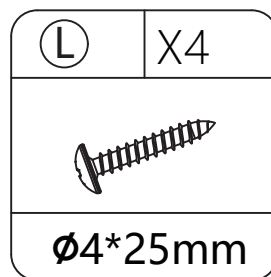
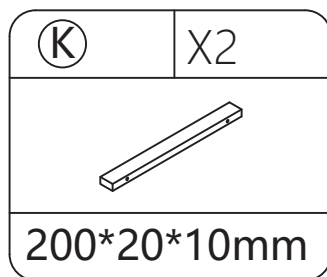
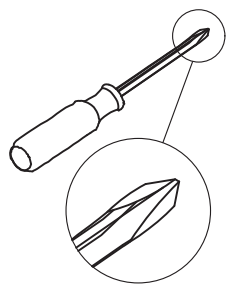


Use screws (D) to secure panel (15) to panels (4) and (5) as shown.

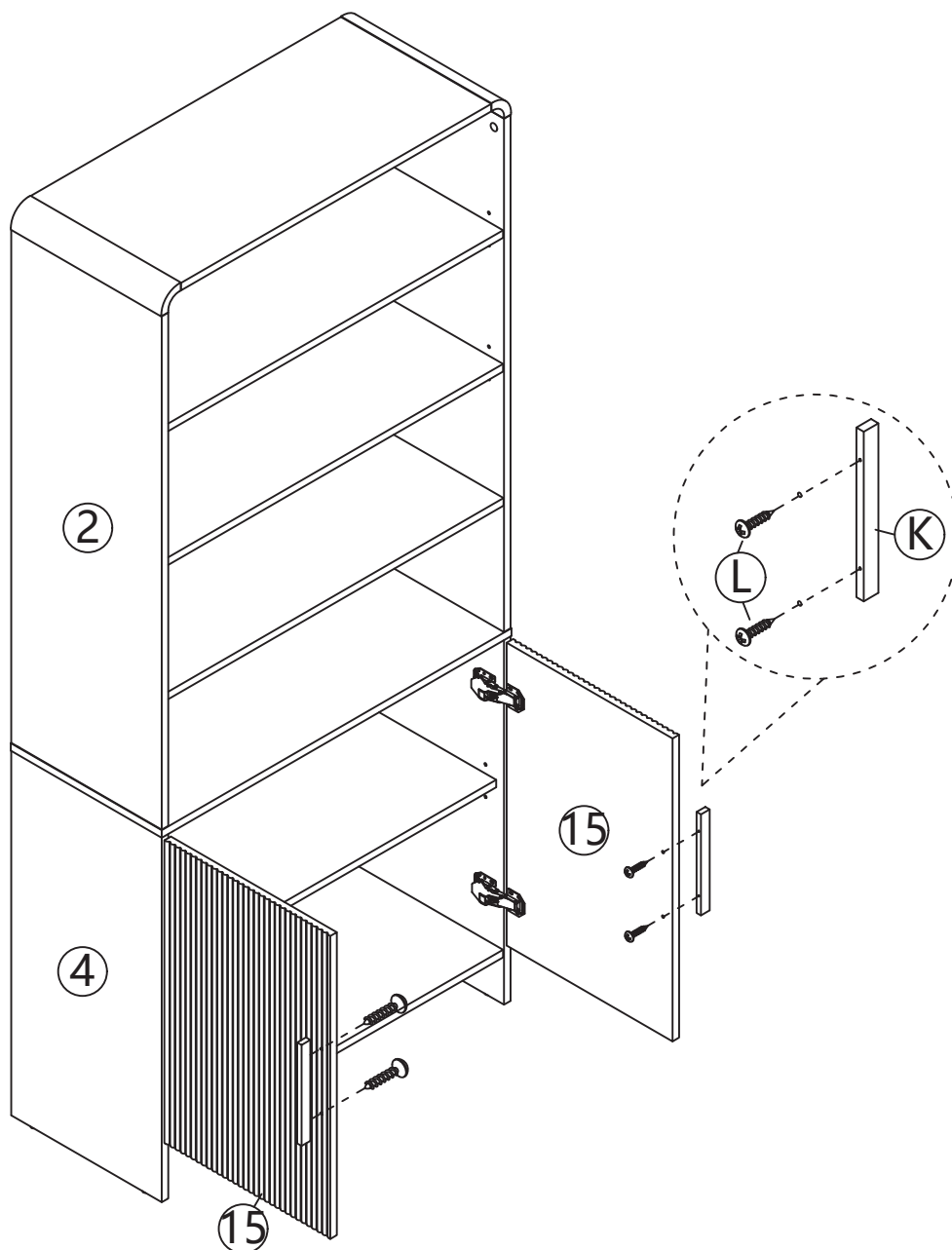


Note: This step requires two people. One person holds the door panel while the other tightens the screws.

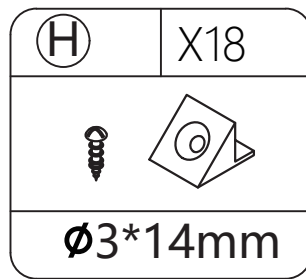
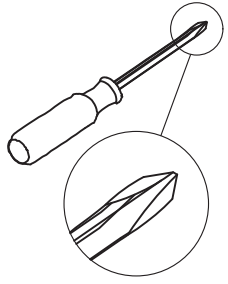

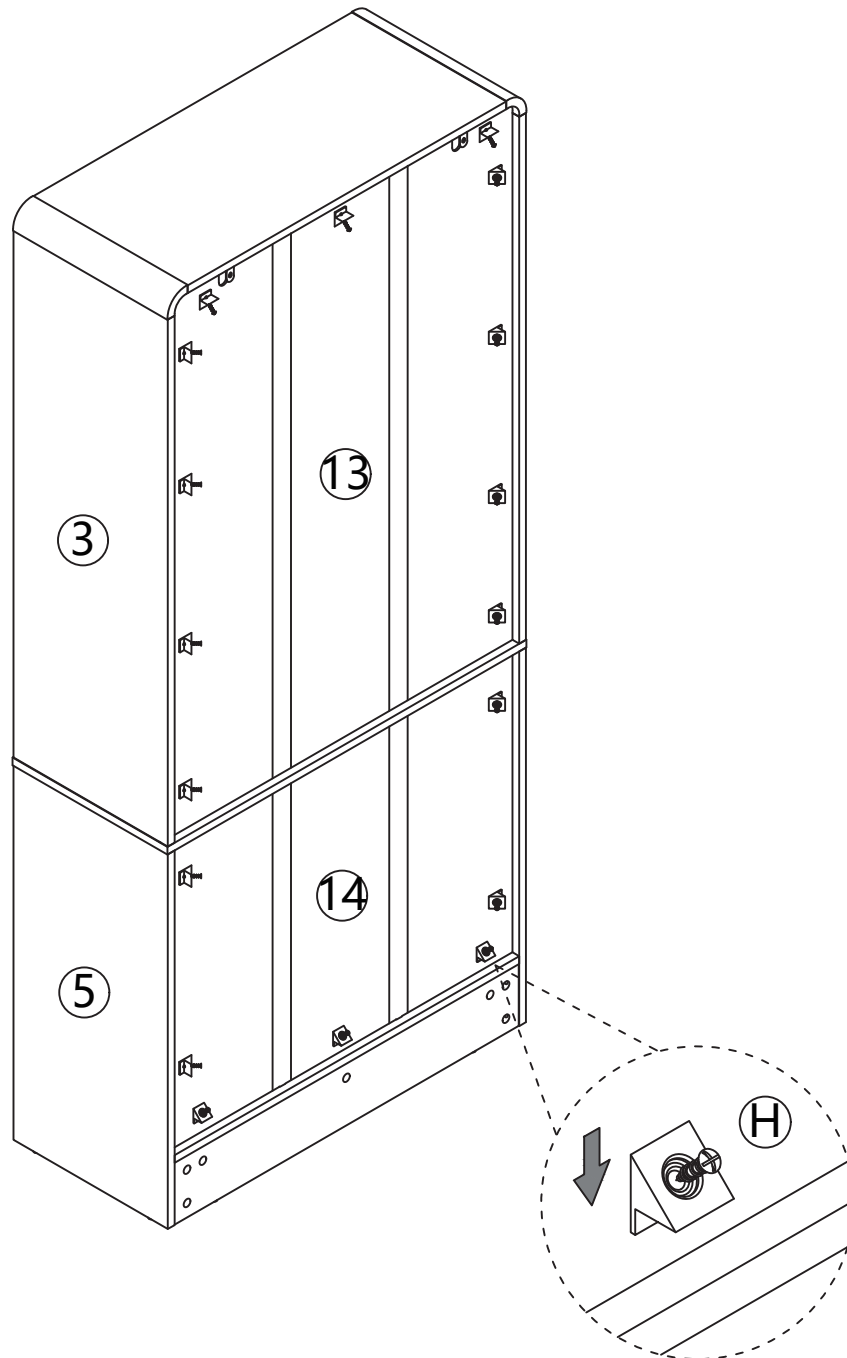
Insert screws (L) through panel (15) to connect with hardware (K).



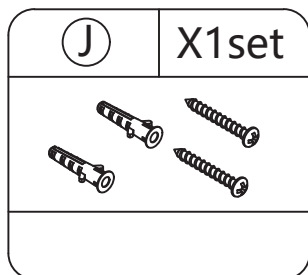
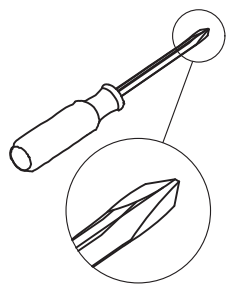
STEP 19



Insert the plastic clips from hardware (H) into the back panel grooves, then insert screws through the holes in the clips and secure them in place.

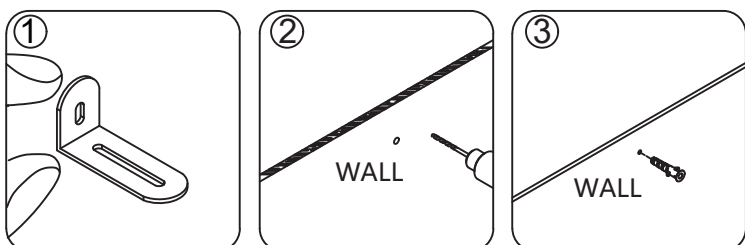

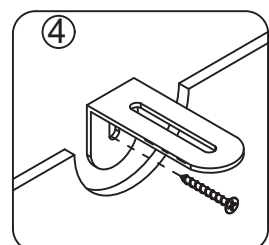
Install the anti-tip device:



1. Mark the position on the wall.

2. Drill two holes with a diameter of 6 mm in the wall.

3. Insert two expansion bolts into the holes.



4. Use long screws to secure the device to the wall.
