

Thank you for purchasing the HEADBOARD!Before you start, here are some helpful

- 2. Owing to the size and weight of the headboard, we recommend that it is assembled by two adults, on a carpeted or padded area, in the room that it is intended for. Approximate assembly time: 30 minutes.
- 3. Please do not use any tools other than those provided or recommended in these instructions.
- 4. Please do not throw away any of the packaging or the instruction until you have checked all the components and hardware and the furniture is fully assembled. Please ensure that the packaging is disposed of in a safe and environmentally friendly way.
- 5. Assemble all components loosely until advised to tighten. Depending on use, it may be necessary to tighten the components from time to time, so please save the tools that have been provided.
- 6. Please keep all the fitting out of reach of children.







STEP 1:

Note: Extra hardware were provided for attaching the headboard to your Bed Frame (use is optional).


Note: there are seven heights for your choice, please assemble at your desired height.

- 1. Insert Low Post (2) into the Headboard (1) as shown.
- 2. Attach by using Arc Washer (B) and Bolt (A) from the holes on the back of Low Post (2) and Headboard (1).
- 3. Use Allen Wrench (C) to tighten all Bolts (A) clockwise until secure at this step.




STEP 2:


Carefully turn up the assembled **Headboard (1)** by two adults.



Assembly is completed. The headboard is ready to use now! **NOTE:** Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are tight.




STEP 1:

- 1. Line up the **Bed Frame (2)** board's pre-drilled holes to match those of the **Headboard (1)**.
- 2. Secure the **Headboard (1)** to the **Bed Frame (2)** by using 2 pieces of **Bolts (B)** for the thicker **Bed Frame (2)**, and 2 pieces of **Bolts (A)** for the thinner **Bed Frame (2)**.
- 3. Before inserting each bolt, place 1 piece of **Spring Washer (D)** and **Flat Washer (C)** on each bolt. Then fit 1 piece of **Flat Washer (C)** and **Nut (E)** on the bolt as it protrudes through the **Bed Frame (2)** and the **Headboard (1)** as shown.
- 4. Repeat the same procedure for each bolt and each side of the Bed Frame (2).
- 5. Use Allen Wrench (F) and Spanner Wrench (G) to tighten all Bolts (A or B) and Nut (E) clockwise as shown.



STEP 2:

Carefully position the assembled bed to the desired location by four adults.




Assembly is completed. The bed is ready to use now!




Components:



1. Headboard x1 2. Bed frame x1

STEP 1:

- 1. Line up the Headboard (1) board's pre-drilled holes to match those of the Bed Frame (2).
- 2. Secure the **Headboard (1)** to the **Bed Frame (2)** by using 2 pieces of **Bolts (B)** for the thicker **Bed Frame (2)**, and 2 pieces of **Bolts (A)** for the thinner **Bed Frame (2)**.
- 3. Attach the **Headboard (1)** to the **Bed Frame (2)** by using 2 pieces of **Bolts (B)** with 2 pieces of **Spring Washers (D)** and 2 pieces of **Flat Washers (C)** for the thicker **Bed Frame (2)** as shown.
- 4. Repeat the same procedure for each bolt and each side of the Bed Frame (2).
- 5. Use Allen Wrench (E) to tighten all Bolts (A or B) clockwise as shown.



STEP 2:

Carefully position the assembled bed to the desired location by four adults.



Assembly is completed. The bed is ready to use now!
