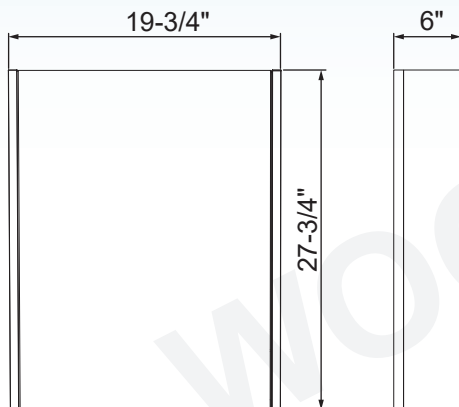

It is important to identify the type of wall where the medicine cabinet will be installed and prepare the installation location accordingly.

- * Install an anchoring brace in the wall before installing the drywall, this can be a 2" x 6" piece of wood that will fit between the two studs, then install drywall and finish as usual. Due to the excessive weight of this medicine cabinet, It should not be mounted to drywall unless it is properly secured to the anchoring brace.

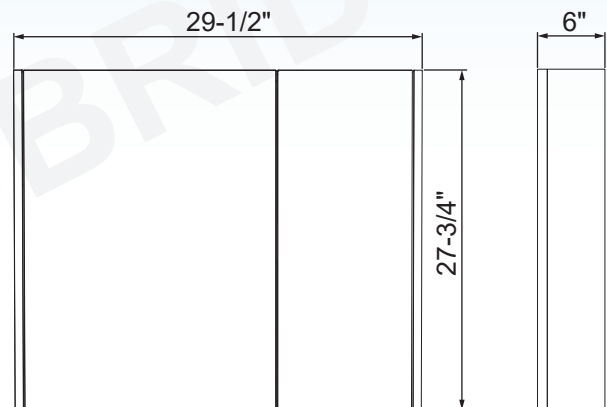

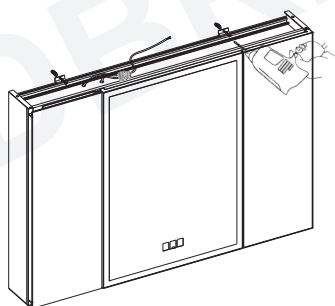

Installation Procedure

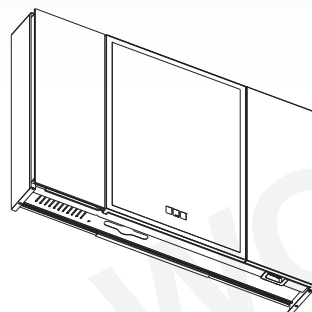
- 1 Install the lower mounting bracket after calibrating the product: Once you've leveled the product using a leveling device, remove the lower mounting bracket and mark the hole positions on the wall. Drill holes at these marks, insert the expansion anchors, and then secure the lower mounting bracket by tightening the M4 screws.



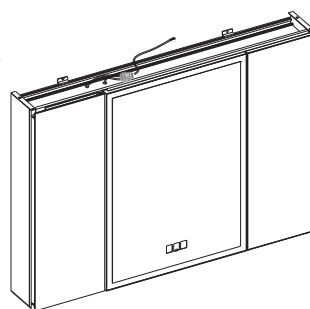
- 3 Secure the mirror cabinet: Position the wall-mounted piece at the desired location, aligning it with the wall holes. Drill into the marked spots, insert the expansion anchors, and tighten the M4 screws to secure the mirror cabinet in place.



- 2 Install the mirror cabinet on the wall: Insert the mirror cabinet into the lower mounting bracket, ensuring it fits securely from top to bottom.

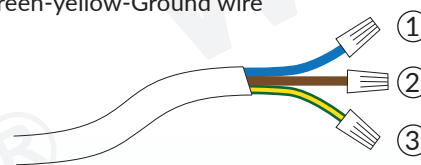


- 4 Connect the power cord: Plug the three-core power cord into the appropriate power source.



Three core wire

1. Blue-neutral wire
2. Brownish grey-Fire wire
3. Green-yellow-Ground wire



Points for Attention

1 Operation instructions

1. Touch Switch: Light in blue, power off. When the light is white, power on.
2. Switch light color: Three-color switching, white, yellow, and white with yellow.
3. Defog Switch: Light in blue, function close. Light in blue, function on.

2 Socket/USB

The socket/USB is located inside the cabinet.

3 Cleaning the device

Please shut down the device before cleaning. Do not use any kind of chemical detergent to wipe the device. It is recommended to use a soft, fine, non-corrosive cloth.

Woodbridge warrants its products as listed in below to be free of material and workmanship defect, subjected to the limitations set forth in this limited warranty.

- Bathtub, Whirlpool/Air Bubble Massage Tub, Wooden Cold Plunge: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
- Toilet and Bidet: 1 Year limited to be free of defects in material and workmanship.
