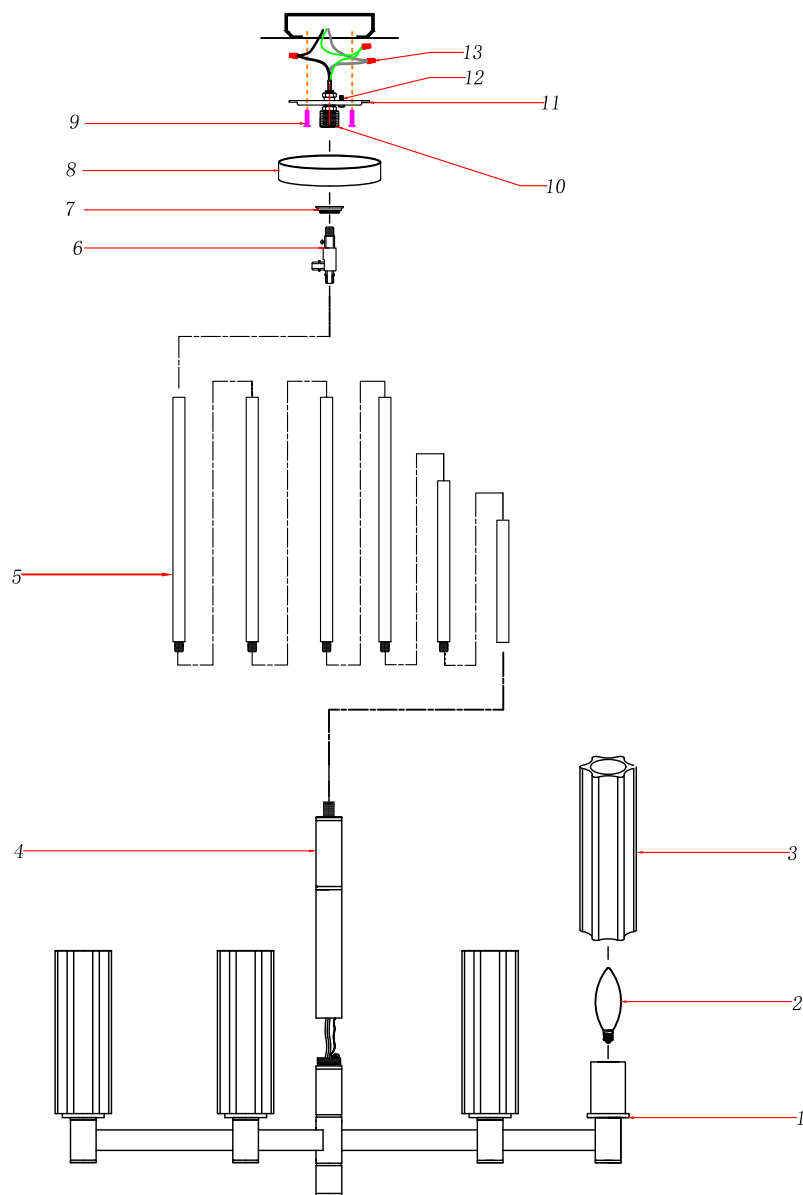


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

- 1.Thread the fixture wires and ground wire through the connecting tube (4). Screw the connecting tube clockwise into the fixture body.
 - 2.Select a downrod (5) of suitable length. Feed the wires through the downrod, then screw the downrod clockwise into the connecting tube (4).
 - 3.Feed the wires in sequence through the swivel (6), retaining ring (7), ceiling canopy (8), threaded connector (10), and mounting plate assembly (11). Then, secure the swivel joint (6) to the downrod (5).
 - 4.Reassemble the retaining ring (7) and ceiling canopy (8) onto the downrod. Secure the threaded connector (10) and mounting plate assembly (11) to the swivel joint (6).
 - 5.With two persons assisting, lift the assembled fixture. Secure the mounting plate (11) to the junction box using the screws (9).
 - 6.Wiring Connections
 - Use wire connectors (13) to connect the fixture's positive wire, negative wire to the corresponding wires from the junction box. Secure the fixture's ground wire to the mounting plate (11) using the provided green grounding screw (12).
 - Ensure no exposed conductors remain outside wire connectors or outside the junction box.
 - 7.Neatly tuck all wires into the junction box. Then, secure the canopy (8) to the threaded connector (10) using the retaining ring (7).
 - 8.Install the bulb (2) into the socket. (Bulb Not Included) The maximum wattage is marked on the warning label located on or near the socket.
 - 9.Install the crystal shade (3) by threading it through the bulb and socket, so it hangs vertically above the lamp head (1).
- Restore power and test the fixture for proper operation.

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock, be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
