About Returns:

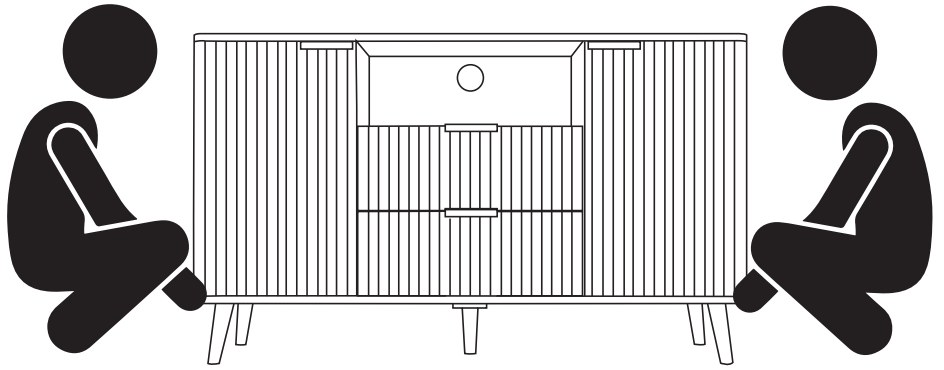
1. To initiate a return, email with your Order ID. For damaged items, please include a photo to expedite your replacement.

2. **Please Note: Returns made without a pre-authorized label may be subject to shipping fees at the customer's expense. Seller will not bear the fee of the customer's own purchase of the return label.**
3. If the product is damaged by the customer, we can refuse to provide a prepaid return label, and the customer needs to pay for the return shipping.
4. Boxes for return shipping will not be provided by the seller. Items must be returned in their original packaging. If original packaging is unavailable, the customer is responsible for providing suitable shipping cartons.
5. After all returned items arrive at the Return Center, please contact the After-sales team and we will fully refund back to the original payment method.

WARRANTY:

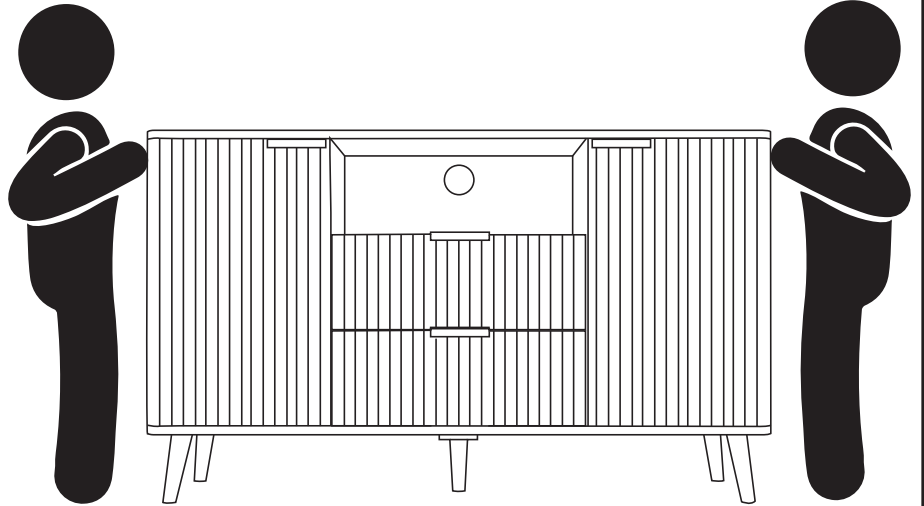

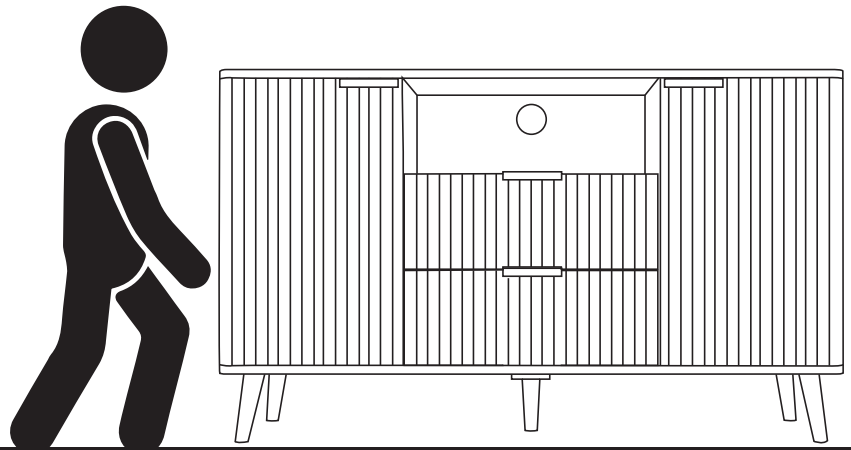
Please raise up the cabinet by holding the bottom when you move it



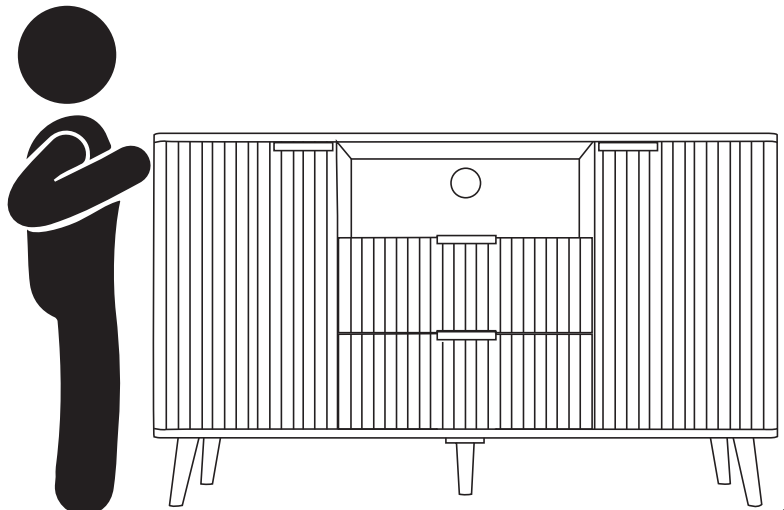
DON'T try to raise up the cabinet by holding the Top Plank



DON'T try to move the cabinet by holding the Side Plank

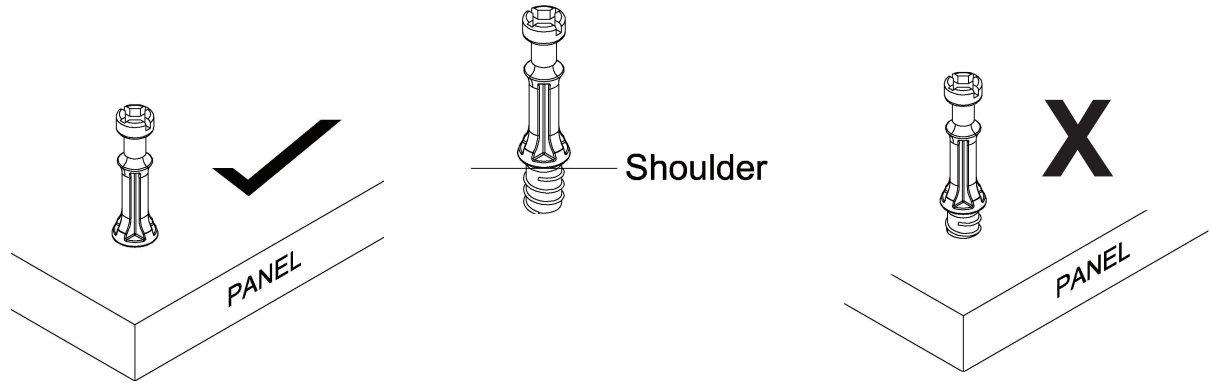

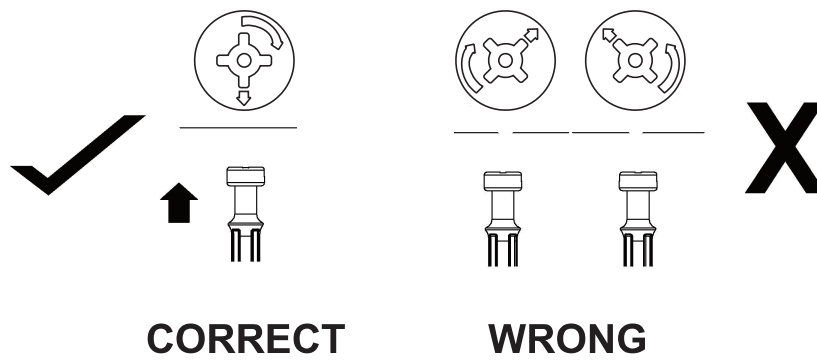
Tips before you start:

CAM BOLTS



Tighten Cam Bolts until shoulder is flush with panel. Do not overtighten or undertighten.

CAMLOCK

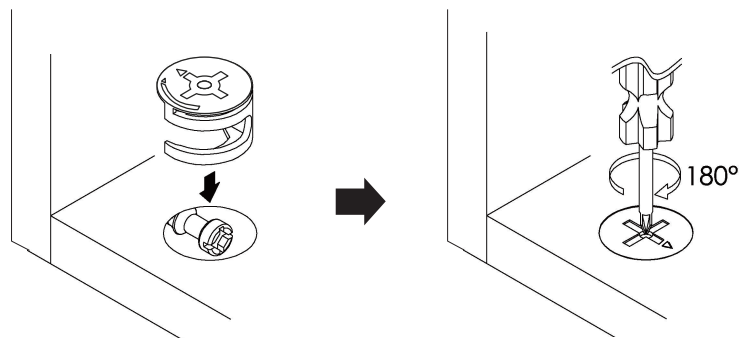


When fitting cam lock, ensure starting position is correct before you insert connecting Cam Bolts.

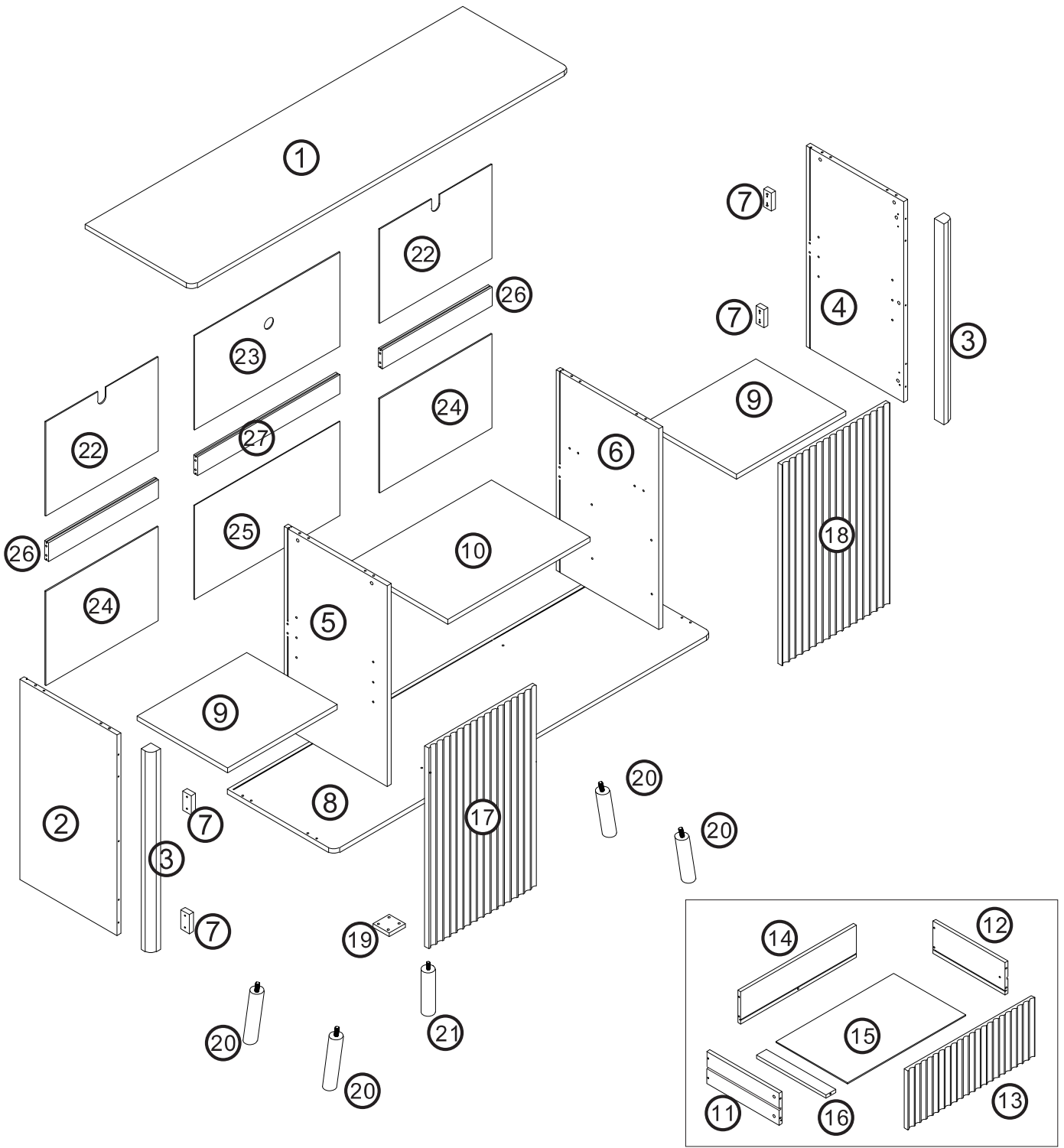
LOCKING-IN

Cam Bolts head should be in the centre of the cam lock when the two panels are joined.

Cam lock should be inserted before Cam Bolts.






















Turn camlock clockwise to tighten.

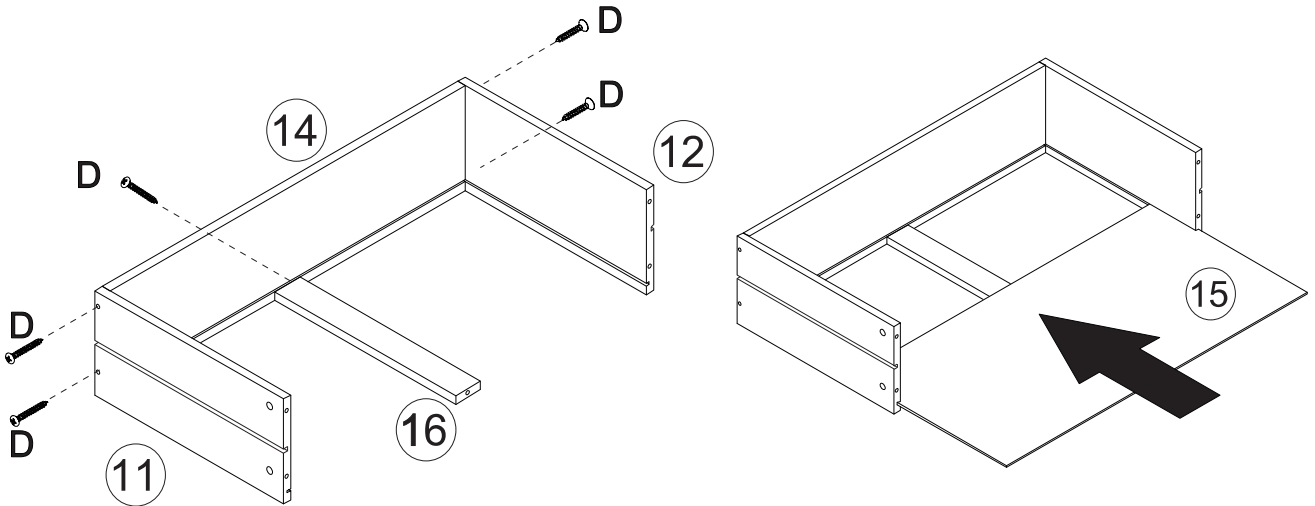
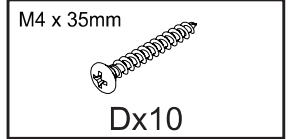

When installing part 19 onto part 8, ensure that part 19 is facing you as indicated by the ✓ symbol in the diagram. This confirms correct orientation.

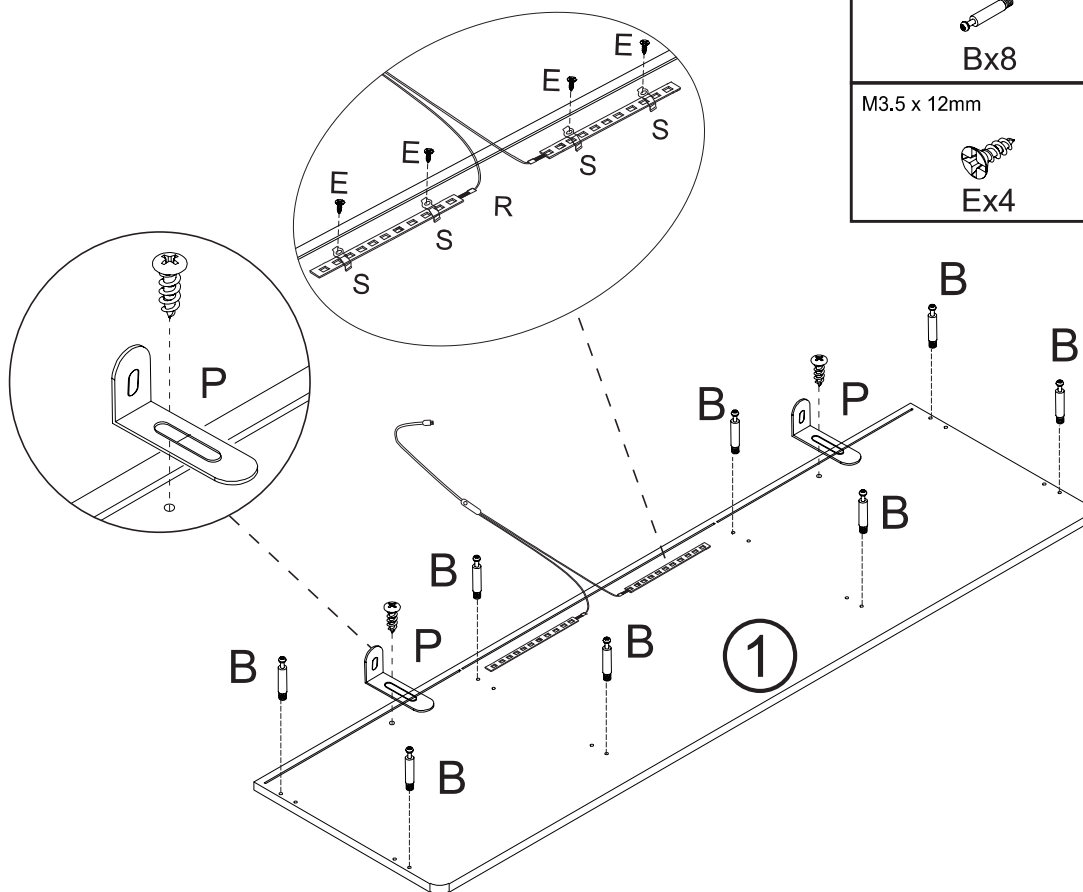

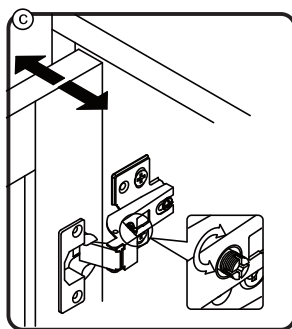
1. Vertical Adjustment

Loosen the screw as shown and move the door up or down to the desired height.



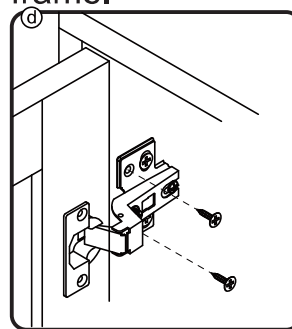
2. Depth Adjustment

Turn the screw clockwise or counter clockwise for proper alignment with the cabinet frame.



3. Lateral Adjustment

Turn the screw as shown to move the door left or right, adjusting the gap between the door and the cabinet frame.



4. Final Fixing

Tighten all screws securely to ensure door stability.

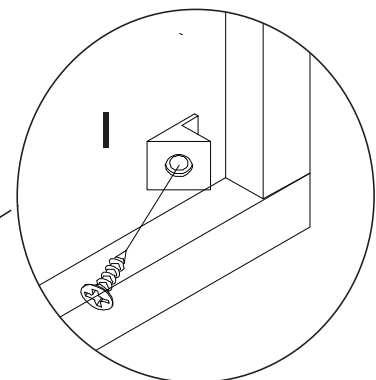
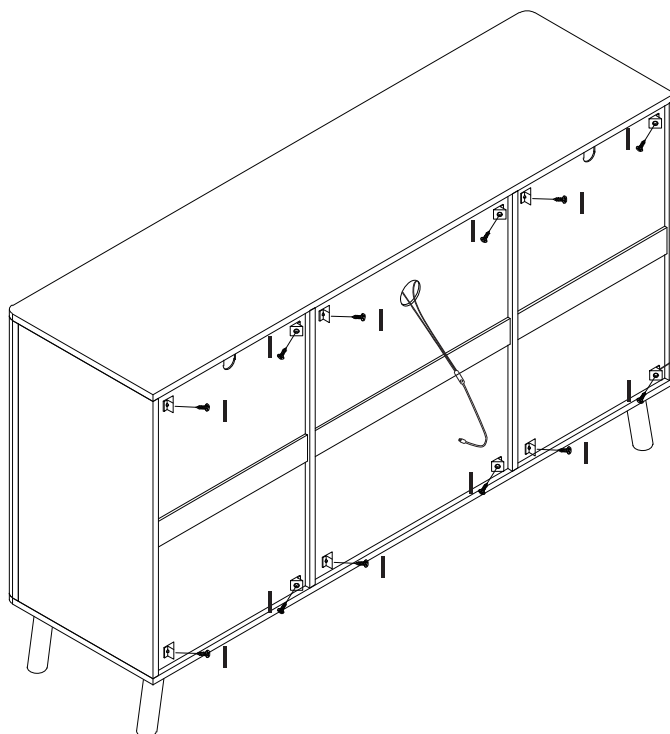
- 1. Align the grooves in the drawer sides with the drawer glides on the side panels, then slide the drawer into place.
- 2. Open the drawer and push each drawer glide forward until it is flush with the front panel of the drawer.
- 3. From inside the drawer, locate the hole on the drawer side and secure the glide with a screw.

Note: Before securing the anti-tip bracket, make sure all cables are properly routed.



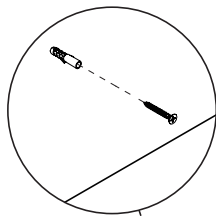

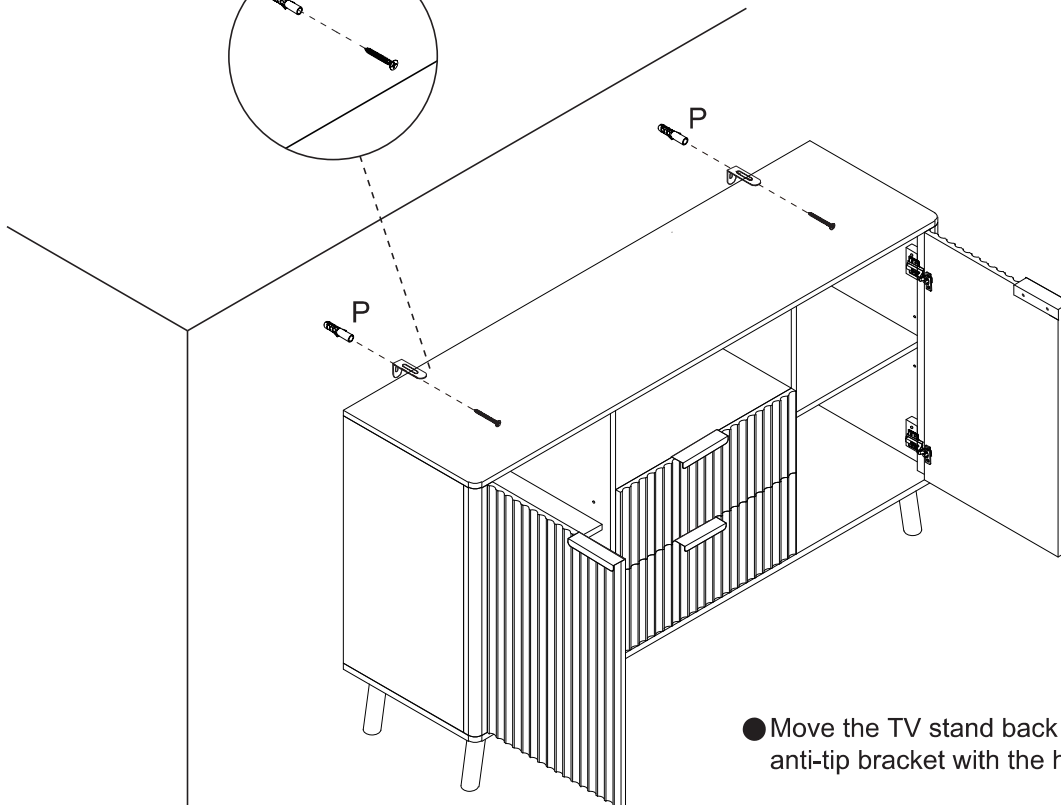
Anti-tip Installation Instructions

- Move the TV stand to its final position against the wall.
- Mark two drilling points on the wall through the holes of the anti-tip bracket.
- Move the TV stand away and drill two holes at the marked points.
- Insert the wall plugs into the holes.

- Move the TV stand back into position and align the anti-tip bracket with the holes.
- Secure the anti-tip brackets to the wall with the screws.
