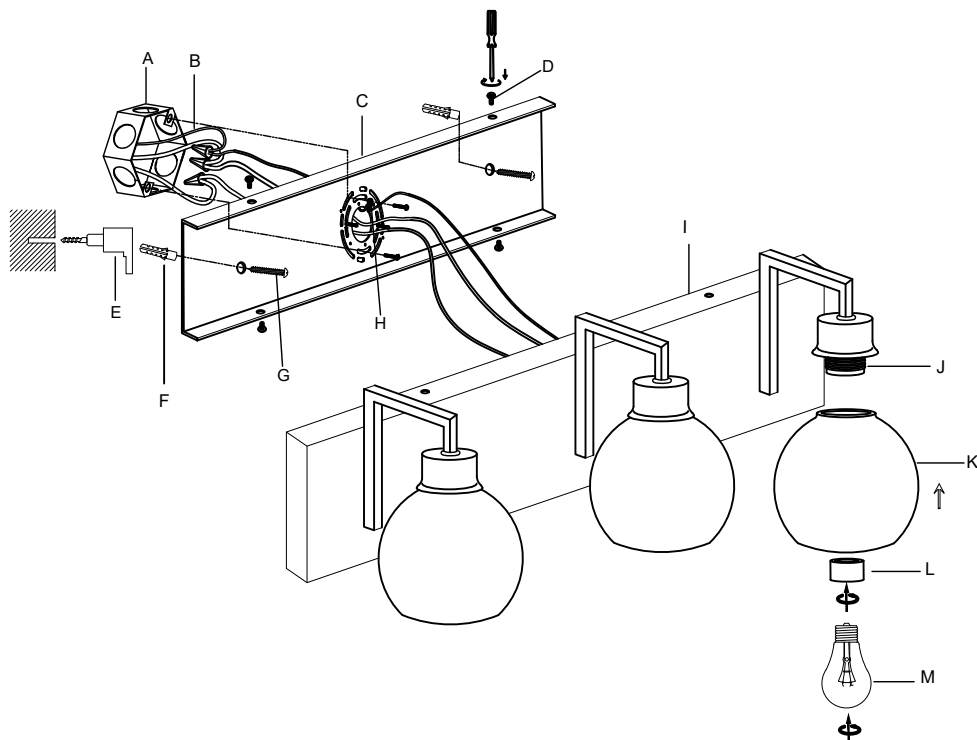


ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.



Before You Begin:

- Ensure power is turned off at the circuit breaker before installation.
- Read all instructions carefully.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are unfamiliar with wiring.

Step-by-Step Installation:

Step A:

- Place the back plate (C) on the junction box (A), ensuring both mounting holes engage properly and mark drill points.
- Drill holes in the wall using a power drill (E).
- Insert the expansion plug (F) into the drilled holes with a hammer.
- Screw the machine screws (G) into the expansion plug (F), and secure Phillips truss-head machine screws (G) onto the junction box using a screwdriver.

Step B:

- Connect the positive main wire (marked with text) to the positive power supply wire (+) with wire connector.
- Similarly, connect the negative main wire (unmarked) to the negative power supply wire (-) with a wire connector.

Notice: Ensure no bare wires are exposed to prevent electrical leakage.

- Secure the fixture ground wire and external ground wire to the mounting plate with the green screw (H).

Step C: Secure the fixture to the back plate with a screw (D) using a screwdriver.

Step D: Align the holes in the glass shade (K) with the socket (J), and then tighten the retaining ring (L).

Step E: Install bulb (M) (not included) firmly into the socket (J).

Safety Instructions:

To avoid fire, shock, and serious personal injury, follow all instructions carefully.

1. Do not install or use the light fixture if any part is missing or damaged.
2. To avoid possible electrical shock be sure electricity is turned off at the main fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring.
3. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside the wire connectors.
4. All wiring must conform to national and local electrical codes.
5. Follow the recommended instructions for the proper method of wiring your new light fixture. If you feel you do not have enough electrical wiring knowledge or experience, have your light fixture installed by a licensed electrician. Any electrical work not described in this manual should be performed by a licensed electrician.
