




## WARRANTY INFORMATION



### Saddle Chairs

 warrants to the original purchaser that its products are free from defect in material and workmanship under normal use for the lifetime of the chair. Normal use is described as wear and tear which occurs during a normal eight hour workday. Weight limitation is 280lbs (127 kgs).

#### **Five Year Warranty Covers:**

- Seat and back structures
- Star base
- Chair control (steel structures)
- Structural parts
- Castors
- All moving parts

#### **Two Year Warranty:**

- Fabric and PU

This warranty does not apply to products that are subjected to abuse, alteration, misuse or negligence. Should customers fail to perform regular maintenance (ie cleaning, adjustments, lubrication) the warranty shall become void.

This warranty is limited to the replacement or repair, at Jobri's discretion, of defective products that have been reported to and inspected by the selling dealer. Jobri may require that the product be returned to its facility for inspection, repair or replacement. Jobri does not assume any responsibility for any labour charges.

There are no other warranties except as expressly set forth above, either expressed or implied.

#### **Continuous Shift Operations**

Jobri warrants to the original purchaser that its products are free from defect in material and workmanship for a period of 2 years from the date of purchase. Weight limitation is 280lbs (127 kgs). Lifetime warranty does not apply. Fabric is not covered by this warranty. Warranty shall become void if chair is subjected to abuse, misuse, alternation or negligence.

#### **Operating and Assembly Instructions**

Jobri kneeling/saddle chairs are designed for static sitting. The user should remain static in the chair, and avoid lateral movement while in use. Please refer to the detailed assembly instructions on the reverse of this sheet



#### **Care Instructions**

**Fabric:** Use a mild detergent and water, or a foam upholstery cleaner.

**Plastic parts:** Do not use abrasives or excessive amounts of cleaner. Recommend a mild detergent with water.

**Frame:** Clean powder coated frames by gently wiping with a damp cloth and any mild detergent.

**Mechanism:** Use only a light machine oil very sparingly once a year. Do not use WD40.
