

Be sure to check all packing material carefully for small parts, which may have come loose inside the carton during shipment.

Step 1: Place the Table Top (G) upside down on a soft, non-abrasive surface such as a blanket or carpet, or its own packaging materials.

Step 2: Attach the Legs (H) to the four corners of the Table Top with the 1-1/2 "long Allen-Head Bolts (A), Spring Washers (B) and Flat Washers (C). Do not fully tighten bolts until Step 5.

Step 3: Attach the "L" Brackets to the Shelf (I), through the slotted holes, using the 3/4" long Allen-Head Bolts (D) and the same washers as used in previous step. Do not fully tighten until Step 4.

Step 4: Position the Shelf into the notches of the Legs and attach the Shelf to the Legs with the "L" Brackets and the 3/4" long Allen-Head Bolts and the same washers as previous steps. Using the Allen Wrench (E), tighten the Bolts into the Legs first, then pull the Shelf snug into the notches of the Leg at each corner and tighten the Bolts attaching the "L" brackets to the Shelf.

Step 5: Using the Allen Wrench, tighten the Bolts at the top of each Leg and then attach the Cover Panels (K) over the Bolts.

Step 6: Carefully turn the assembled Table upright and install the Top Glass (I) into the Table Top.
