




STEP 1


Align bolt holes on leg bracket of Left Leg (C) to bolt holes at the bottom near the left edge of Footboard (A), and fasten (C) with Bolt (L). Use Allen Key (P) to tighten (L). Do not tighten (L) completely until both bolts are in place. Use the above procedures to

install Right Leg (D) on the right side of Footboard

Note: To illustrate parts assembly, the frames are shown standing vertically. It is easier to perform the procedures with the frames and panels place flat down.




STEP 2



- a) Lay Side Rail (B) flat down with the inside-face (with bolt holes) facing up on a material that does not scratch or damage its surface.
- b) Align bolt holes on L-Metal Plate (G) to bolt holes on (B) on both end. Use Bolt (M) fitted with Spring Washer (K) and Flat Washer (J) to fasten (G) to (B). Use Allen Key (Q) to tighten (M). Do not tighten (M) completely until both bolts are in place. Use the same procedure to fit (G) to the second Side Rail.
- c) Locate the bolt holes on Footboard and Leg Post. Align the bolt holes on (G) -from Step b) to the bolt holes on Leg Post and Footboard. Use Bolt (M) fitted with Spring Washer (K) and Flat Washer (J) to fasten (G) to Footboard and Leg Post. Do not tighten (M) completely until both bolts are in place.

STEP 3



- a) Fasten Support Leg (O) to Wooden Slats (E) with Bolt (N) fitted with Spring Washer (I) and Flat Washer (H). Use Allen Key (P) to drive and tighten (N) completely.
- b) Locate pilot holes on Side Rail (B). Use Screw (F) to fasten Slat (E) to Side Rail as shown.

The assembly of the bed frame is complete.

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


PARTS AND HARDWARE



- a) Lay Headboard (A) with back-side facing up on a material that does not scratch its front surface.
- b) Place Slat (E) to align the top 3 bolt holes on (E) to the 3 holes on the bottom left corner of (A) and fasten with Bolt (F) fitted with Spring Washer (H) and Flat Washer (G).Use Allen Key (I) to drive (F). Do not tighten (F) until all 3 bolts are in place.
- c) Place Left Wooden Leg Post (B) below left bottom corner of A. Align the 2 bolt holes on (B) to bolt holes on Slat (J) and fasten with Bolt (F) fitted with Spring Washer (H) and Flat Washer (G).Use Allen Key (I) to drive (F). Do not tighten (F) until all 3 bolts are in place.
- d) Use the above steps b) & c) to install Right Wooden Leg Post (C) to right bottom corner of (A).

- a) Fit Wooden Foot (D) to Left Wooden Leg Post (B) by screwing the bolt on the edge of (D) into the bolt hole on the bottom of (B). Tighten (D) completely.
- b) Use the same procedure to fit (D) to Right Wooden Leg Post.

Cleaning & Care

Treat surface with care. Surface is resistant to scratches but is not scratch resistant. Clean surfaces with a dry or damp soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners. Hardware may loosen over time. Periodically check that all connections are tight.
