



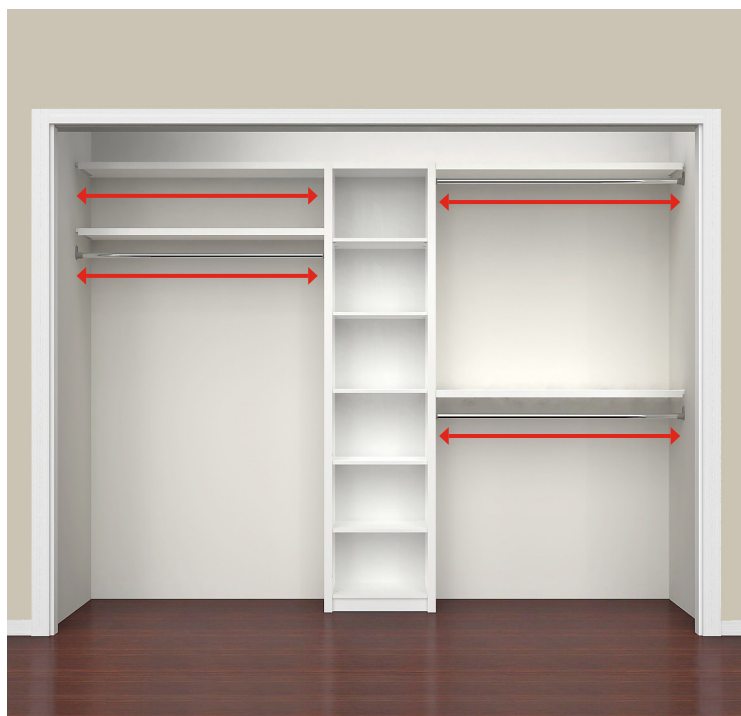
■ *Why would you cut a top shelf?*

After purchase, if you find that our top shelves won't fit inside your space, you can cut them down to the exact length you need.

■ *What materials are used?*

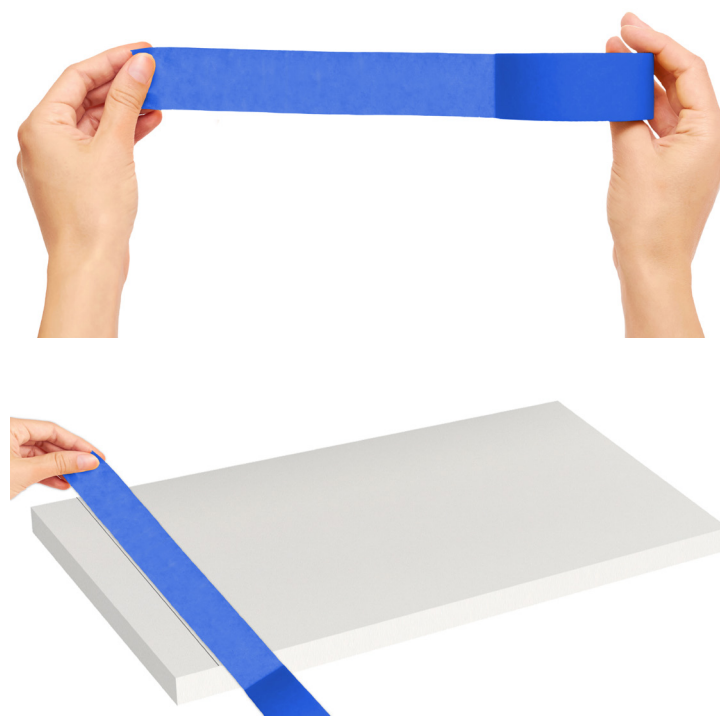
- Tape Measure
- Painter's Tape (or other thick tape)
- Hand Saw or Circular Saw*

STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS:



MEASURING

Measure the width of your space to determine the necessary length of your top shelves. Remember to account for the width of the tower. For the ClosetMaid SpaceCreations closet systems, you can cut the shelf and trim at the same time.



PREPPING

Prepare the shelf by marking the length and placing a strip of thick tape where you will make the cut. This will help prevent chipping or cracking.



CUTTING

Use a hand saw or a circular saw* to cut top shelves. Always use a narrow, fine-toothed blade that is suitable for cutting wood.

* Always take safety precautions, such as wearing eye protection, when using power tools.
