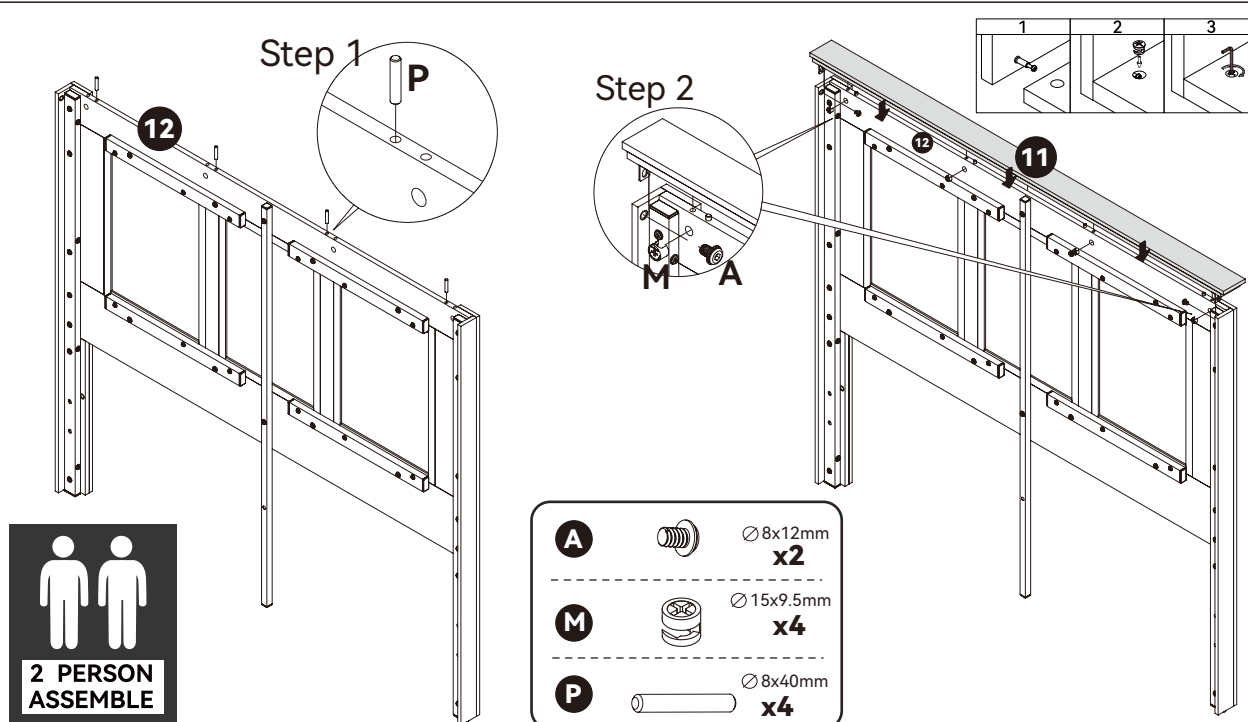


As shown, use screw (A) to secure part (41) to part (11) at both ends, and then assemble screw rod (K).
