# **A** IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

#### WARNING: RISK OF ELECTRICALSHOCK

- Turn off electrical power at fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring fixture to the power supply.
- Turn off the power when you perform any maintenance.
- Verify that supply voltage is correct by comparing it with the luminaire label information.
- Make all electrical and grounded connections in accordancewith the National Electrical Code and any applicable local code requrirements.
- All wiring connections should be capped with UL approved wire connectors.

#### **CAUTION: RISK OF INJURY**

- Wear gloves and safety glasses at all times when removing luminaire from carton, installing, servicing or performing maintenance.
- Avoid direct eye exposure to the light source while it is on.
- Account for small parts and destroy packing material, as these may be hazardous to children.

#### WARNING: RISK OF BURN

- Allow fixture to cool before handling. Do not touch enclosure or light source.
- Do not exceed maximum wattage marked on luminaire label.
- Follow all lamp manufacturer's warnings, recommendations and restrictions for: driver type, burning position, mounting locations/methods, replacement, and recycling.

#### **CAUTION: RISK OF FIRE**

• Keep combustible and other materials that can burn away from luminaire and lamp/lens.

BEFORE STARTING THE INSTALLATION, SHUT THE LINE FEED POWER OFF USING THE CIRCUIT BREAKER. CONSULT A LOCAL LICENSED ELECTRICIAN OR ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR IF YOU ARE NOT SURE ABOUT THE INSTALLATION.





#### **TURN OFF ELECTRICITY**

At main fuse box (or circuit breaker box)
Before removing the old fixture



#### REQUIRES 2 PEOPLE

Assistance will be required to support the fixture during installation

- Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts on a clear area. Take care not to lose any small parts necessary for installation.
- Attach the THREADED NIPPLE to the MOUNTING BRACKET, then secure it with a WASHER and HEX NUT. Secure the SCREW COLLAR LOOP to the THREADED NIPPLE.
- **3** Attach the MOUNTING BRACKET to the JUNCTION BOX by using two JUNCTION BOX MOUNTING SCREWS.
- 4 Pass CANOPY over the SCREW COLLAR LOOP. Screw the SCREW COLLAR RING onto the SCREW COLLAR LOOP to secure CANOPY.
- Determine the length of the CHAIN you need. To open chain links: Locate the split in the chain link you're removing. Put one pair of pliers (not included) on each side of the split and rotate the pliers in opposite directions to open the link's split. The open link should be shaped like the letter "C".
- Using the OPEN CHAIN LINKS on chain, attach one end to SCREW COLLAR LOOP and the other end to FIXTURE LOOP. Weave the fixture electrical and ground wires through every other chain link and pass through THREADED NIPPLE into junction box. Then lower the SCREW COLLAR RING and CANOPY over the CHAIN.
- 7 Pull out the source wires from the junction box. Make wire connections using wire nuts as follows:
  - a. Connect the black wire from the fixture to the black wire from the junction box.
  - b. Connect the white wire from the fixture to the white wire from the junction box.
  - c. Attach the fixture grounding wire to the MOUNTING BRACKET with the green grounding screw, and then connect it to the house grounding wire with a wire nut. Carefully put the wires back into the junction box.
- Pass CANOPY over the SCREW COLLAR LOOP. Screw the SCREW COLLAR RING on the SCREW COLLAR LOOP to secure CANOPY.
- 9 Insert 60-watt max. medium-base BULB or CFL/LED equivalent (none included) into SOCKET.
- 10 Turn on power at circuit breaker or fuse box. Turn the light switch on to activate the fixture.
