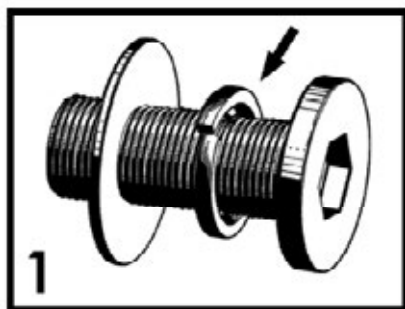

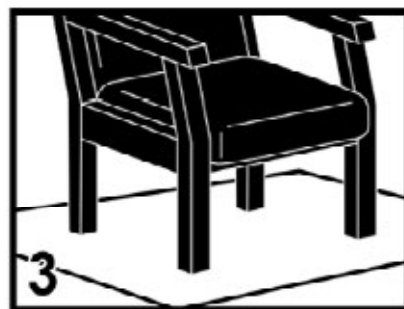
BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



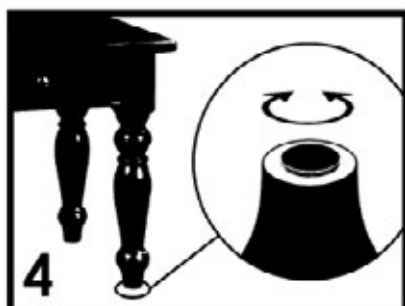
1 Before attaching each of the screws, make sure that the **smaller lock washer is between** the larger washer and the head of the screw.



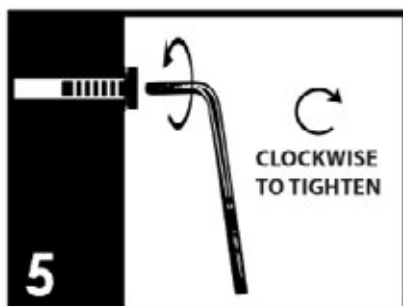
2 Position each part correctly and insert all screws into their respective holes. Then, **hand-tight and leave room for later adjustment. Do not use tool.**



3 Make sure the furniture rests on a **flat and level surface** with each leg evenly touching the ground.



4 Some furniture come with optional **height adjustment knobs** underneath each leg. Turn counter-clockwise or clockwise to raise and lower each leg.



5 Finally, make sure all parts are properly aligned then use the included **hex key** to completely tighten the screws. Your furniture is now ready for use.



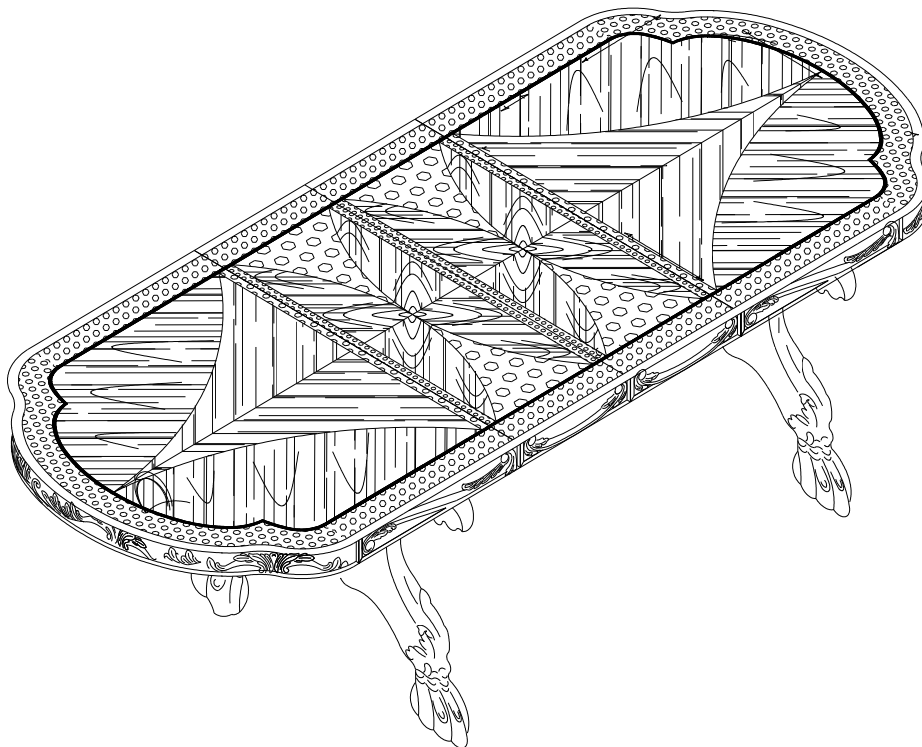
6 Store the hex key for later maintenance. Tighten the screws again **after two (2) weeks**, and then at least **once every six (6) months** after that.

IT IS THE USER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO MAINTAIN THE FURNITURE. THE SCREWS MAY LOOSEN OVER TIME AND CAUSE THE FURNITURE TO BE WOBBLY AND UNABLE TO SUPPORT ITS INTENDED WEIGHT CAPACITY. THIS CAN LEAD TO COLLAPSE AND CAN CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY.




The Assembly Rating is a 5-point system the degree of effort needed in assembling a specific product (with 1 being easy and 5 being relatively difficult).

For some products, two persons are recommended.











Do not tighten screws until completely assembled.

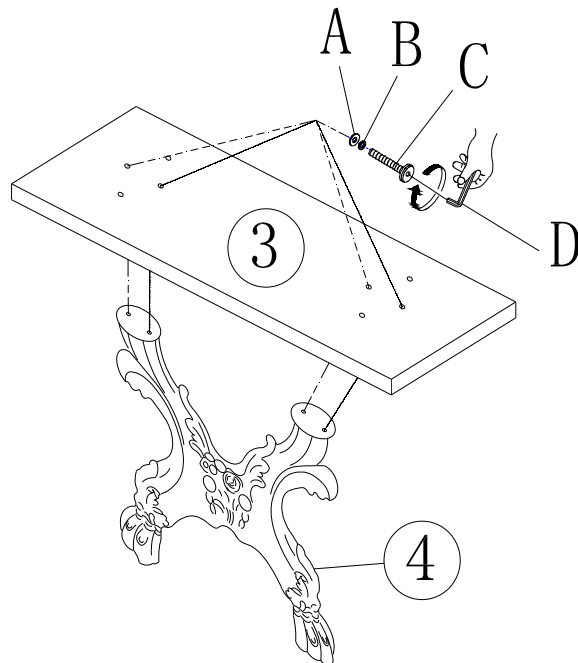

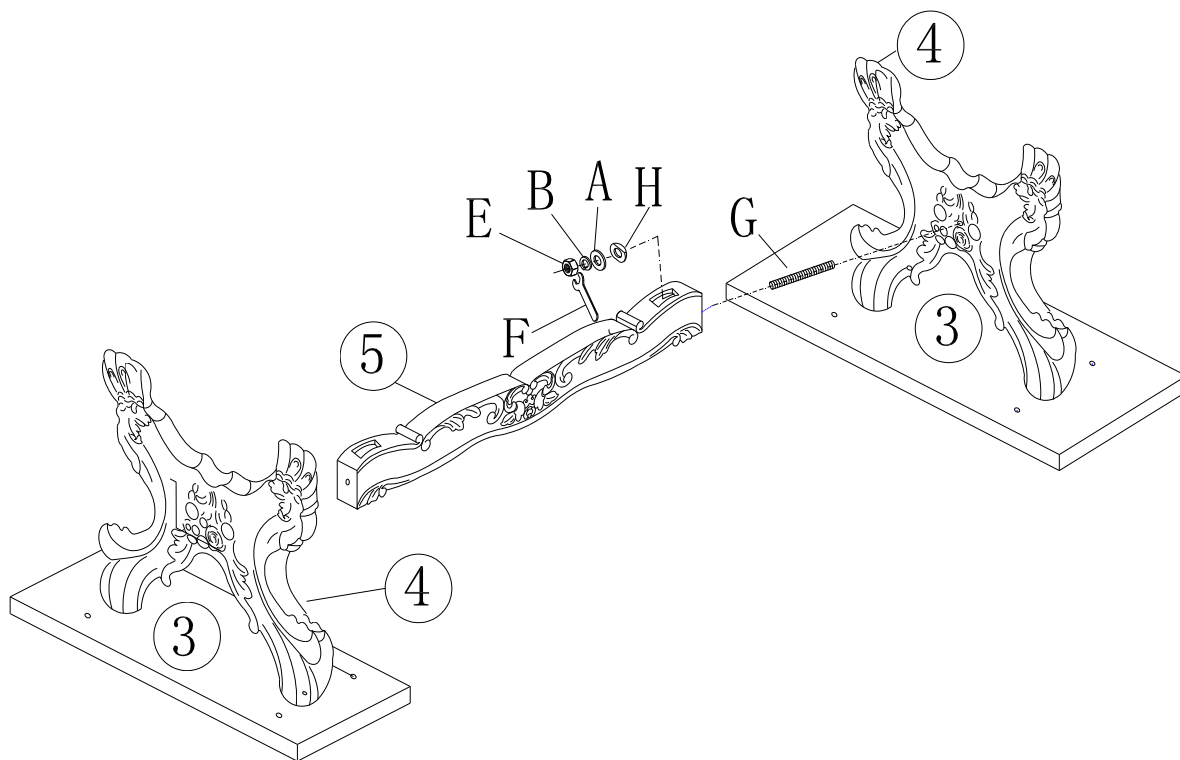

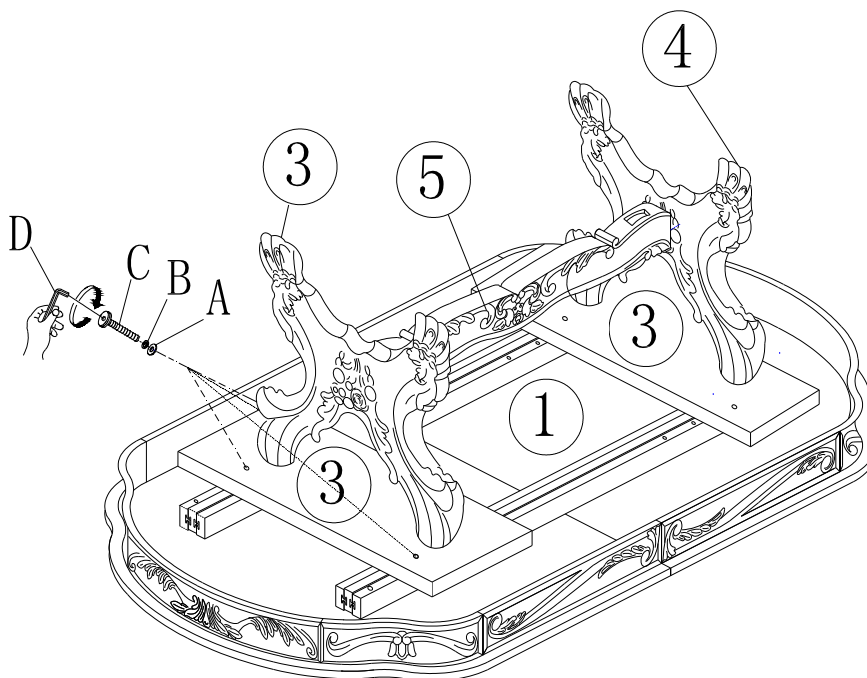


Step 2: Stand bases up on legs and set mounting palte over the base aligning the holes. Use bolts with lock washer and flat washer, tighten with screw. Secure the mounting plate with all three bolts. Follow same procedure for the second base.



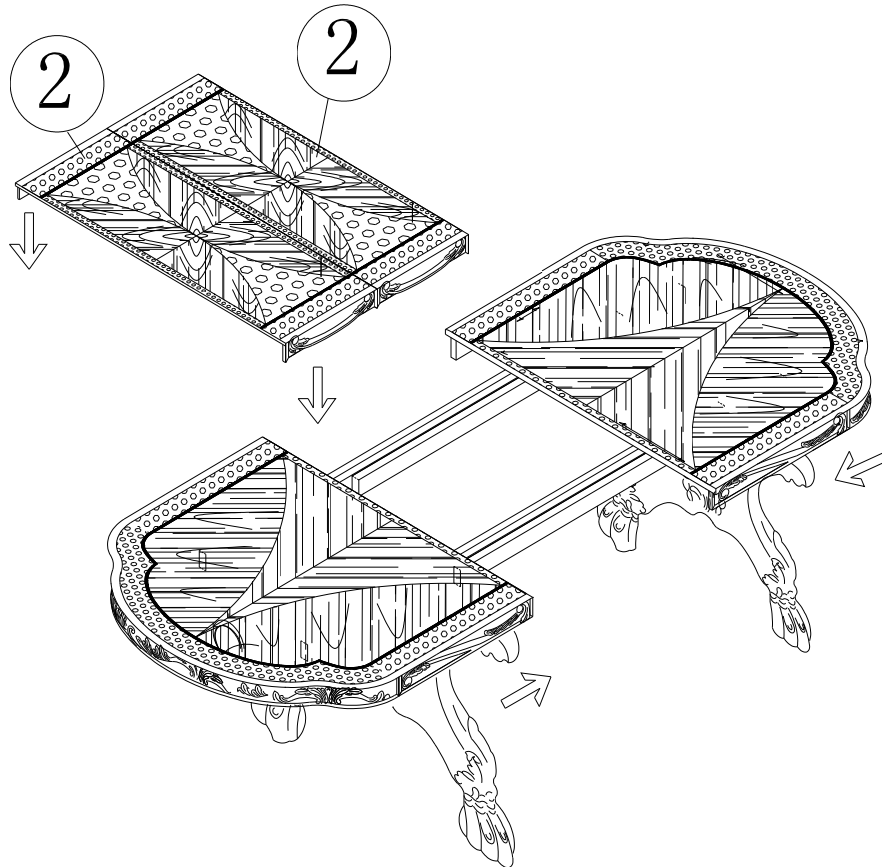
Step 2: Put base upside down on soft non adrasive surface. Assembly stretcher, using #G bolts insert base. Inset #H bolts, #A flat washer, #B lock washer into center hole of seat frame - only hand tighten.

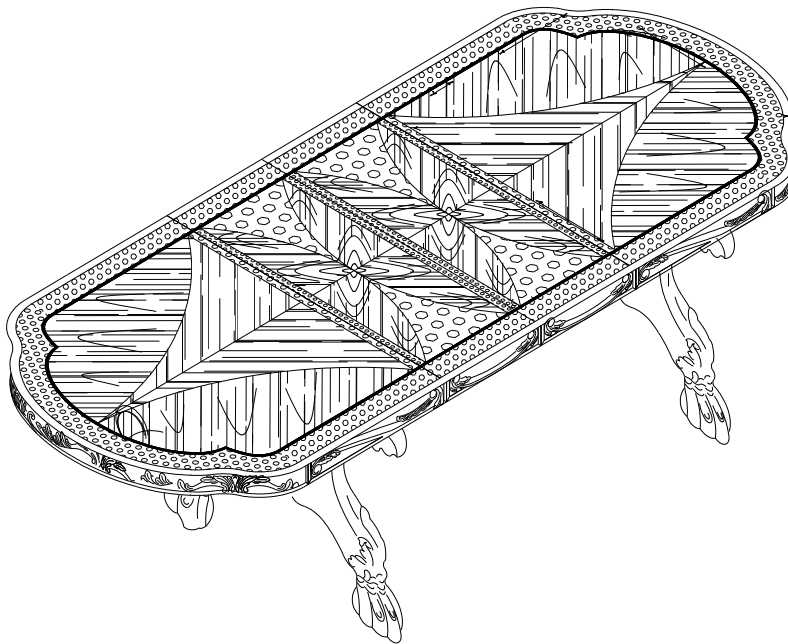


Stpe 3: Put table top spside down on soft non abrasive surface(using 2 people). Turn over bases with mounting plates and place on table runners as shown. Fasten with bolts, lock washer and flat washer.Be sure bolts are tighten with wrench.

Step 4&5: Flip table right side up (use 2 people)-open table top-you may need to unlock the latches under the top. Place leafs into place lining up and insertin pins into the top, then push close.
