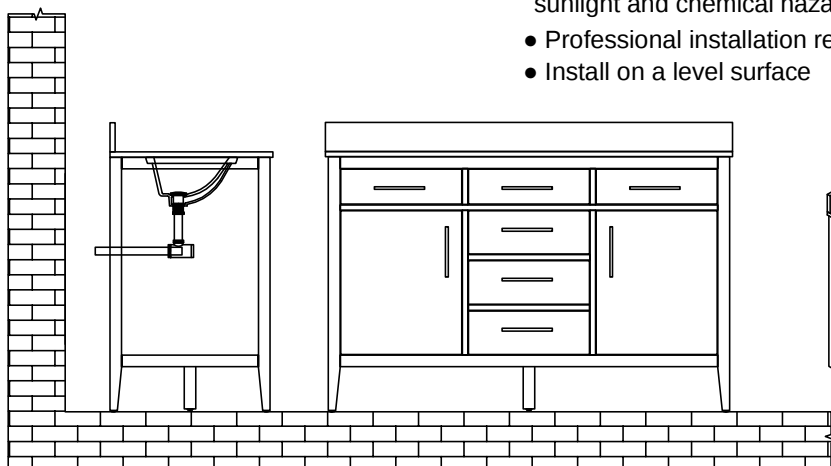
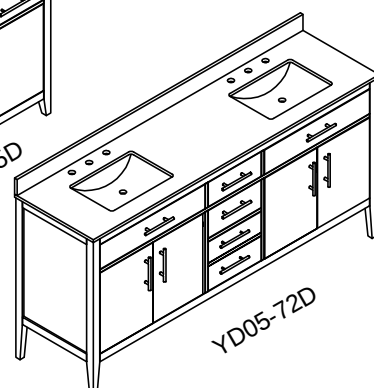
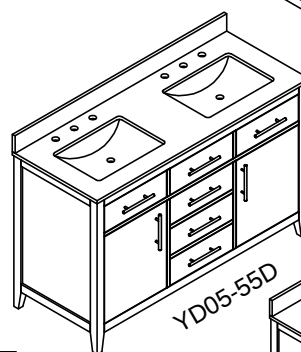
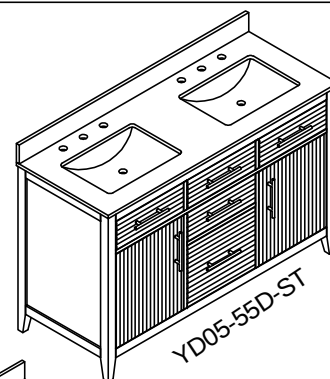


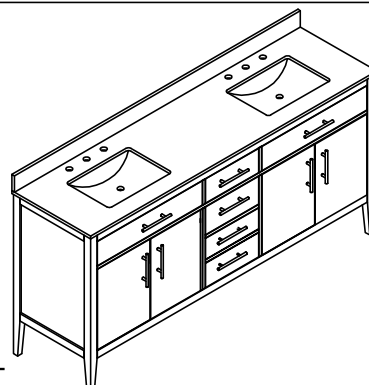
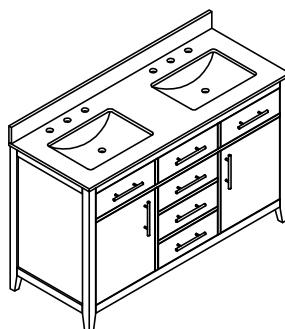
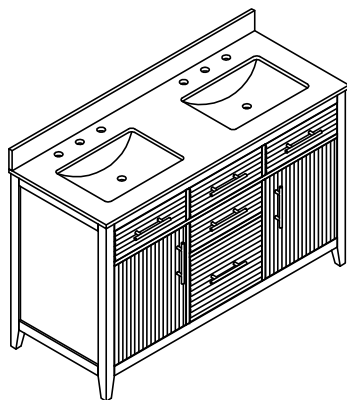
Bathroom Vanity

Bathroom Vanity

1. Please remove the top (B) from the vanity (A)
Place the top (B) and backsplash (C) face
down onto a scratch-free surface such
as a cardboard sheet that came in the packaging.

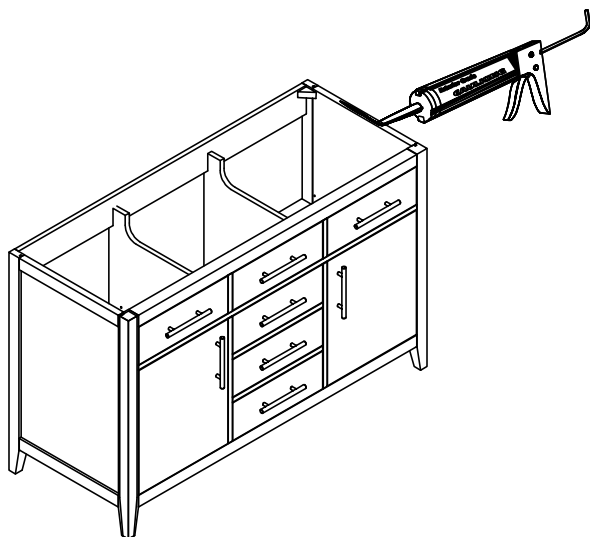


- 2- ATTACH BASE CABINET TO WALL
Place cabinet in desired location and determine where
the wall studs are. Adjust the feet if needed.



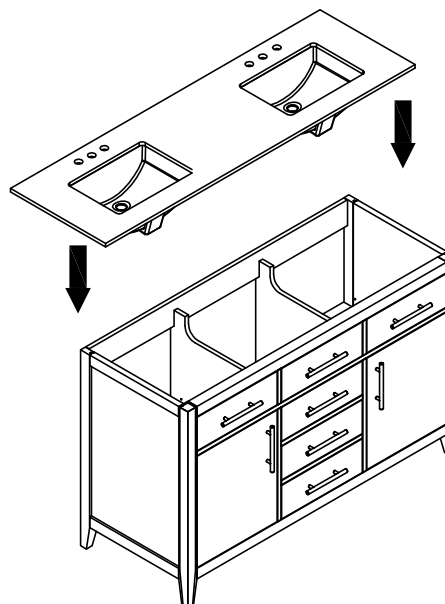
3- PREPARE BASE CABINET

Using a caulking gun, apply silicone around the top
of the base cabinet.



4 - SET COUNTERTOP IN PLACE

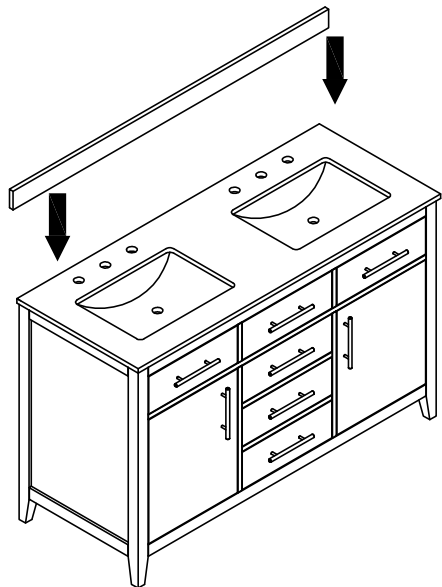
Carefully place the countertop, with the sink attached, onto the
cabinet and press down firmly.
Wipe away any excess silicone immediately.

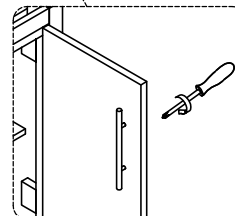
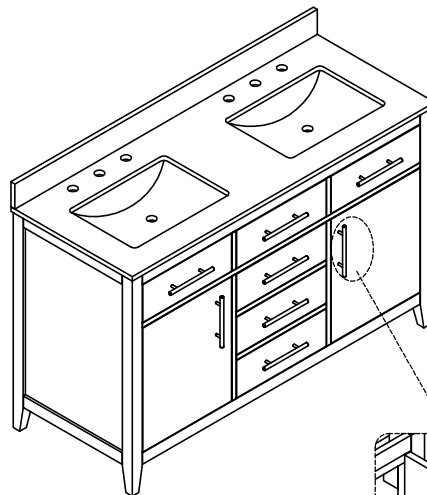
5 - SET BACKSPLASH

After the vanity is in place, use a caulking gun to apply silicone to the back and bottom unfinished sides of the backsplash. Press firmly down and back to set in place. Remove any excess silicone.



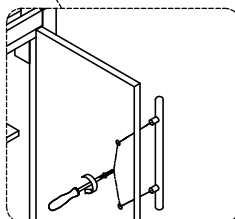
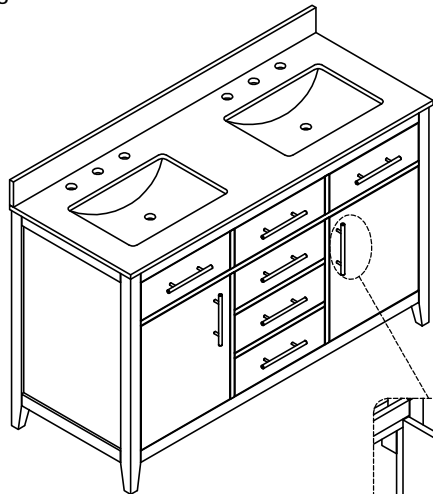
6 - SET HANDLES

The pull handle is installed inside the door and drawer. Need to dismantle it first.



7 - SET HANDLES

Unpack the handles and install them on the vanity. Do not over tighten when attaching. Short screws are for the door handles and long screws are for the drawer handles.
