Flexsteel is aware that chemicals categorically referred to as PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances) have been used to develop stain, water, oil, and wrinkle resistance properties in textiles. PFAS are stable chemicals and known as “persistent in the environment” as they do not readily break down. Flexsteel is also aware that the U.S. EPA and a growing number of U.S. States have enacted legislation to prohibit PFAS-based chemicals from use in certain products, including residential textiles/covers. Flexsteel continues to work to ensure that PFAS are not intentionally added to its products.

Flexsteel’s goal is to eliminate intentionally added PFAS-based chemicals from its supply chain. Accordingly, Flexsteel audits all fabric and leather suppliers to ensure that they have either phased out PFAS chemicals or have a plan in place to eliminate them. Per audits completed dating back to the year 2022, suppliers being used in Flexsteel residential furniture do not contain any intentionally added PFAS.
