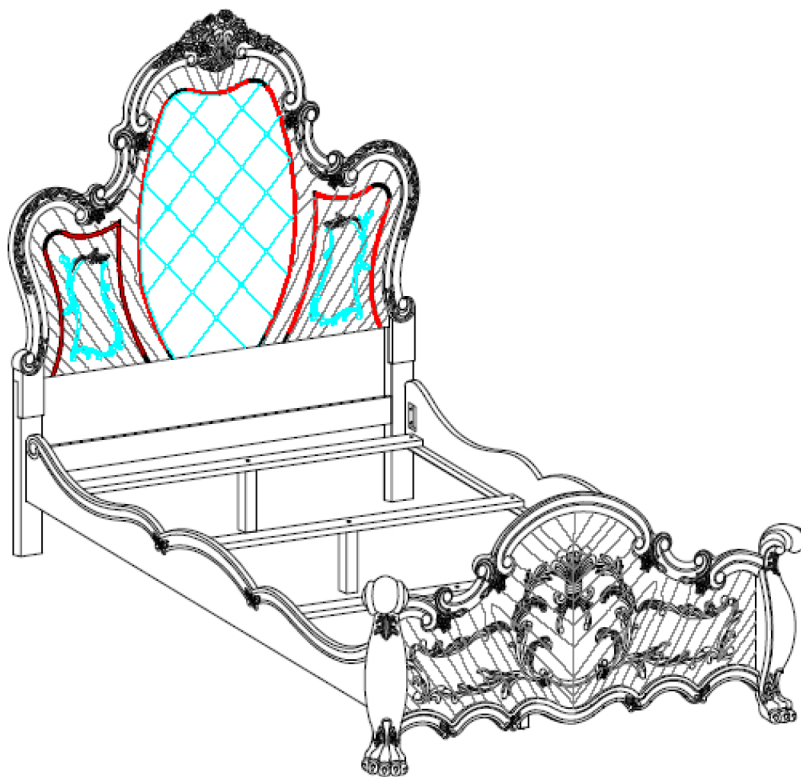


Assembly Instructions



ASSEMBLY RATING

The Assembly Rating is a 5-point system that shows the degree of effort needed in assembling a specific product (with 1 being easy and 5 being difficult). For some products, two persons are recommended.

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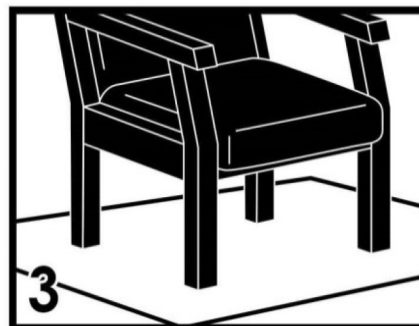
BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



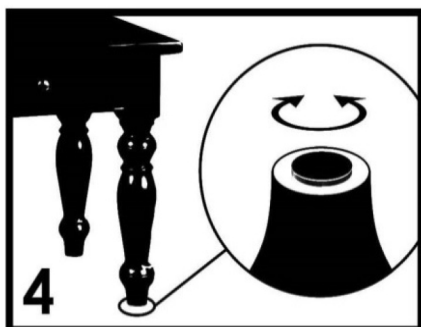
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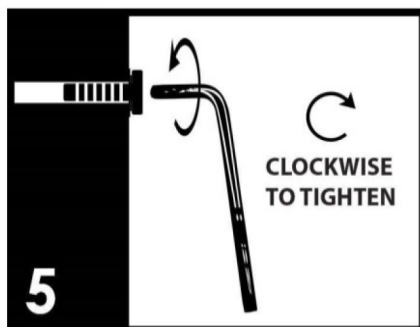
Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



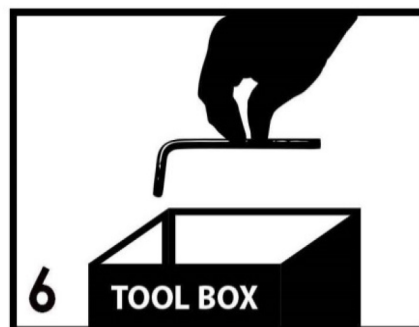
Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.



Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.



Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.

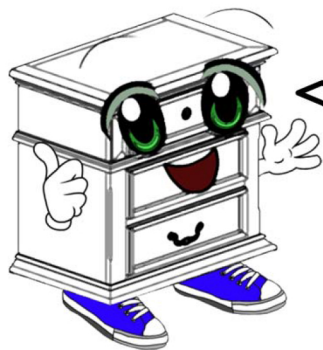


Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

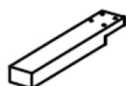

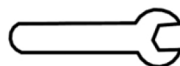

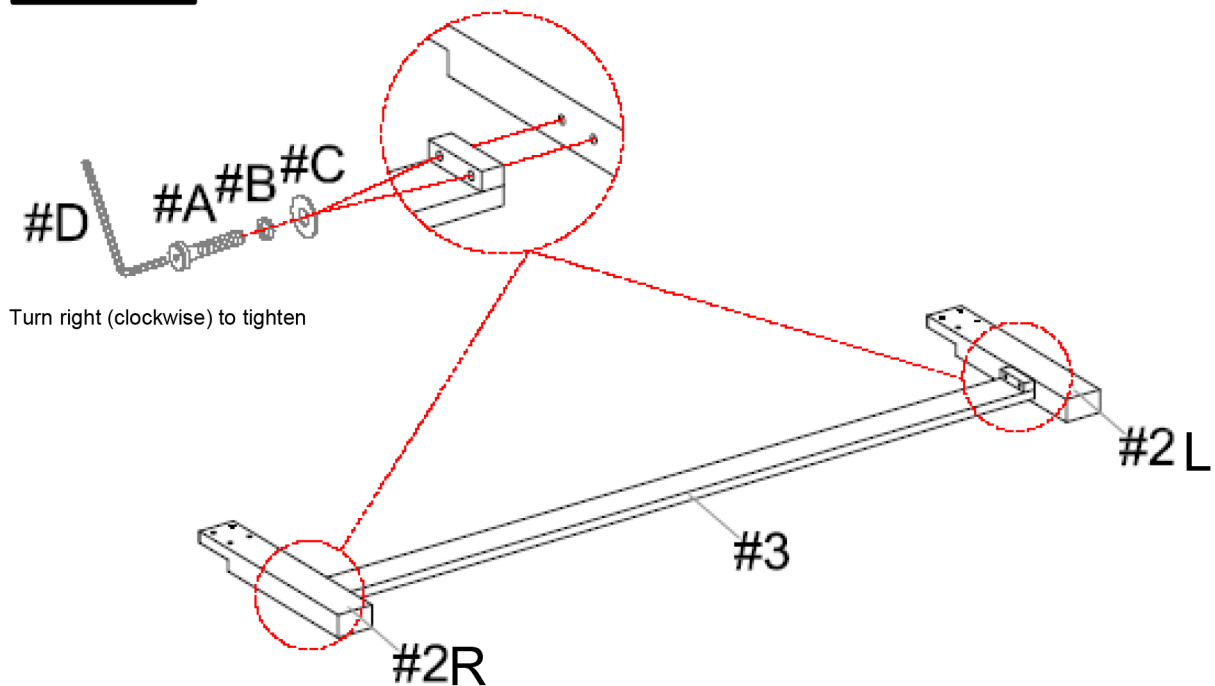


Due to the size and/or weight of this product, it is highly recommended that the assembly should be done near the area of its intended location. Make sure you have enough space to move around during the assembly. ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling of the product to avoid any potential injury and/or damage.



- I. Align the headboard leg rail (#3) with the pre-drilled holes of the right headboard leg (#2R) and the left headboard leg (#2L).
- II. Prepare 4 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#B) onto the bolt (#A) and then the flat washer (#C) onto the SAME bolt (#A), in that order.
- III. Insert the bolt assemblies through the holes of the headboard leg rail (#3) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#D) to lock them with the headboard legs.

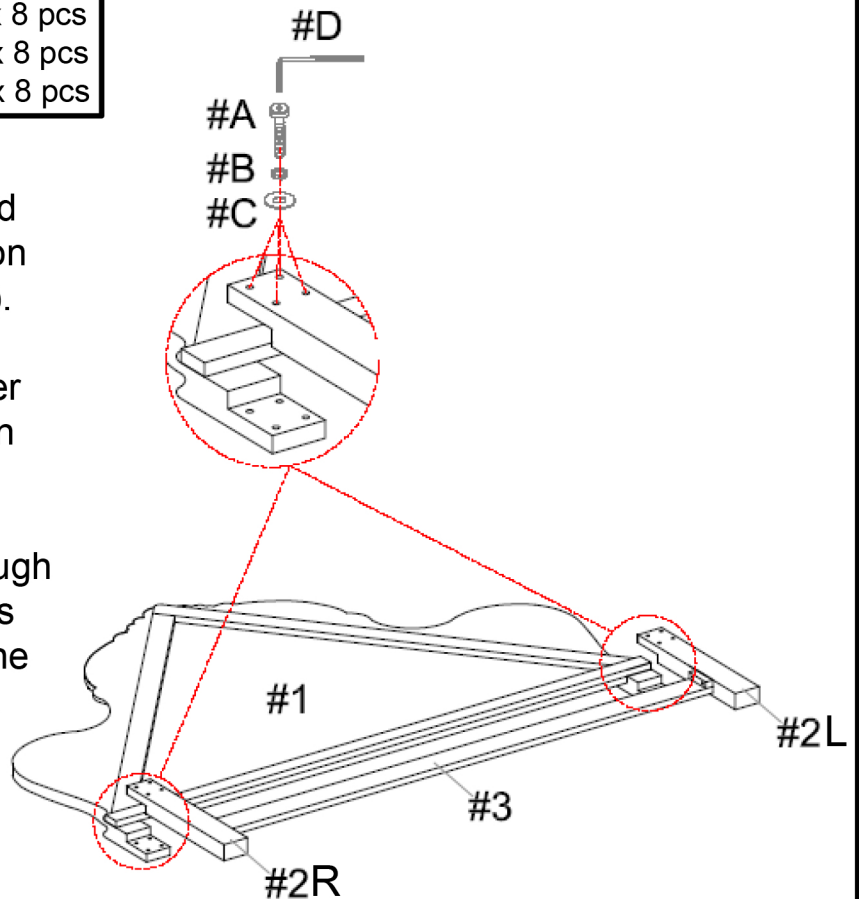
Note: Right and left are determined by facing the front of the bed in upright position.

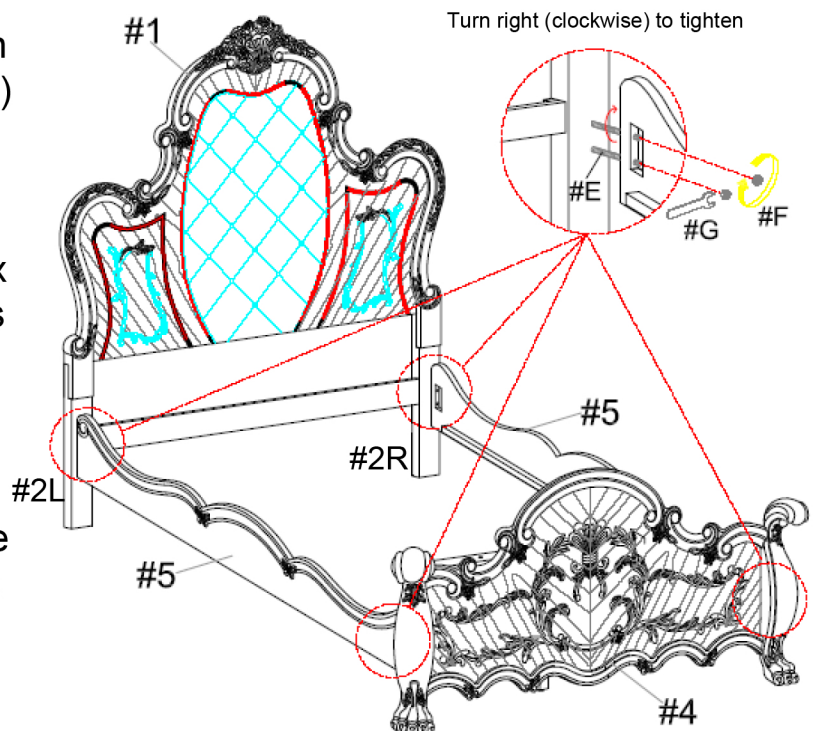
Turn right (clockwise) to tighten

- I. Align the assembled headboard legs with the pre-drilled holes on the back of the headboard (#1).
- II. Prepare 8 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#B) onto the bolt (#A) and then the flat washer (#C) onto the SAME bolt (#A), in that order.
- III. Insert the bolt assemblies through the holes of the headboard legs and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#D) to lock them with the headboard (#1).



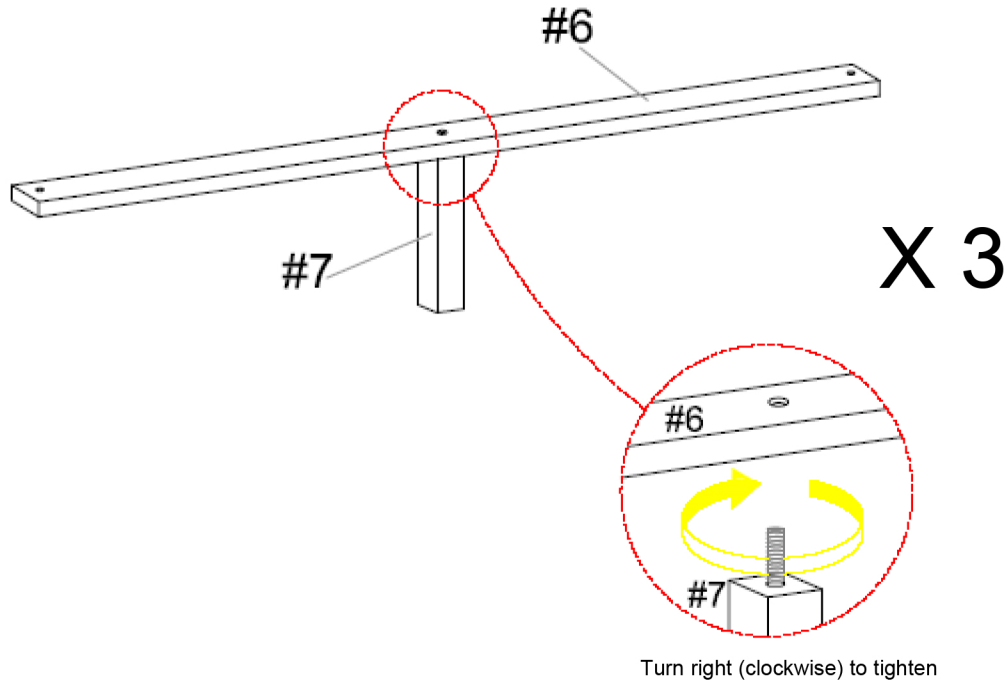

- I. Insert 4 threaded studs (#E) each into the right headboard leg (#2R) and the left headboard leg (#2L).
- II. Insert 2 side rails (#5) onto the threaded studs (#E) of the headboard legs and secure 4 hex nuts (#F) onto the threaded studs (#E) using the wrench (#G) to tighten.
- III. Insert 4 threaded studs (#E) into the footboard (#4).
- IV. Insert the other ends of the 2 side rails (#5) onto the threaded studs (#E) of the footboard (#4) and secure 4 hex nuts (#F) onto the threaded studs (#E) using the wrench (#G) to tighten.



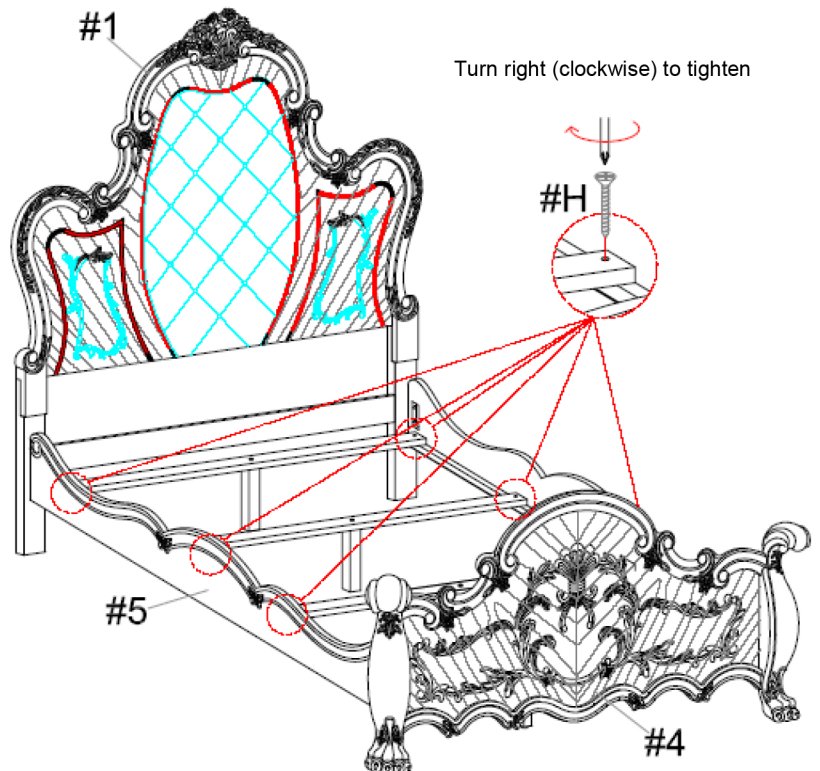


Align the threaded end of the slat support leg (#7) with the pre-drilled hole of the slat (#6) and tighten by hand until secured. Repeat the process to assemble the remaining 2 slat support legs (#7) onto the remaining 2 slats (#2).



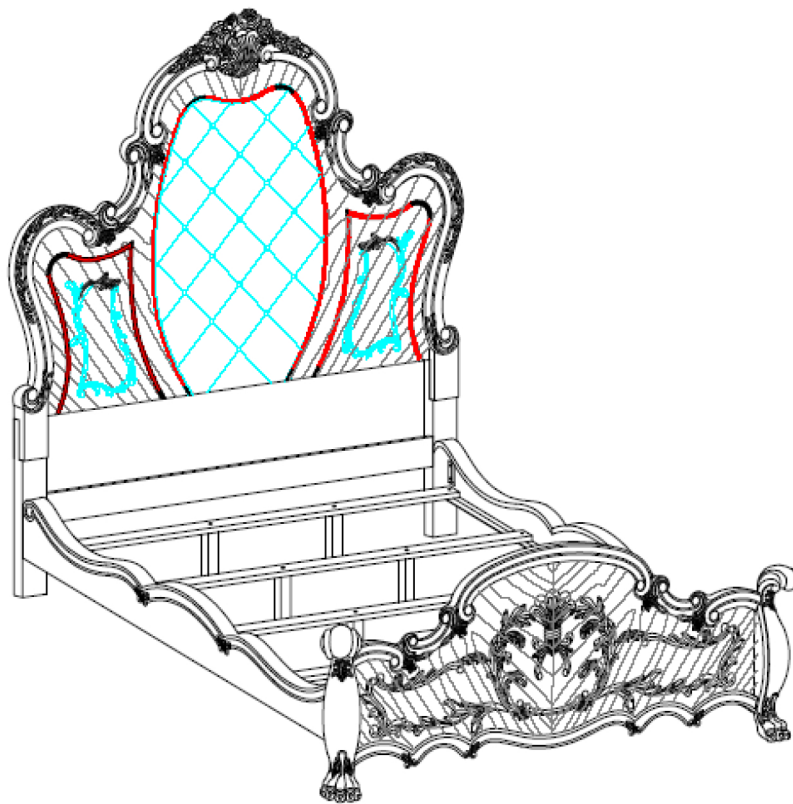
#H x 6 pcs

- I. Align the ends of the assembled slat (#6) with the pre-drilled holes on each side of the side rails (#5).
- II. Secure 2 screws (#H) onto each end of the slat (#6) by using a Phillips screwdriver to tighten them down to the side rails (#5). Repeat the process to assemble the remaining slats (#6).
- III. Make sure the bed is rested on a flat surface and does not feel loose or wobbly. If it does, double check that the bolts/screws are secured and properly tightened.

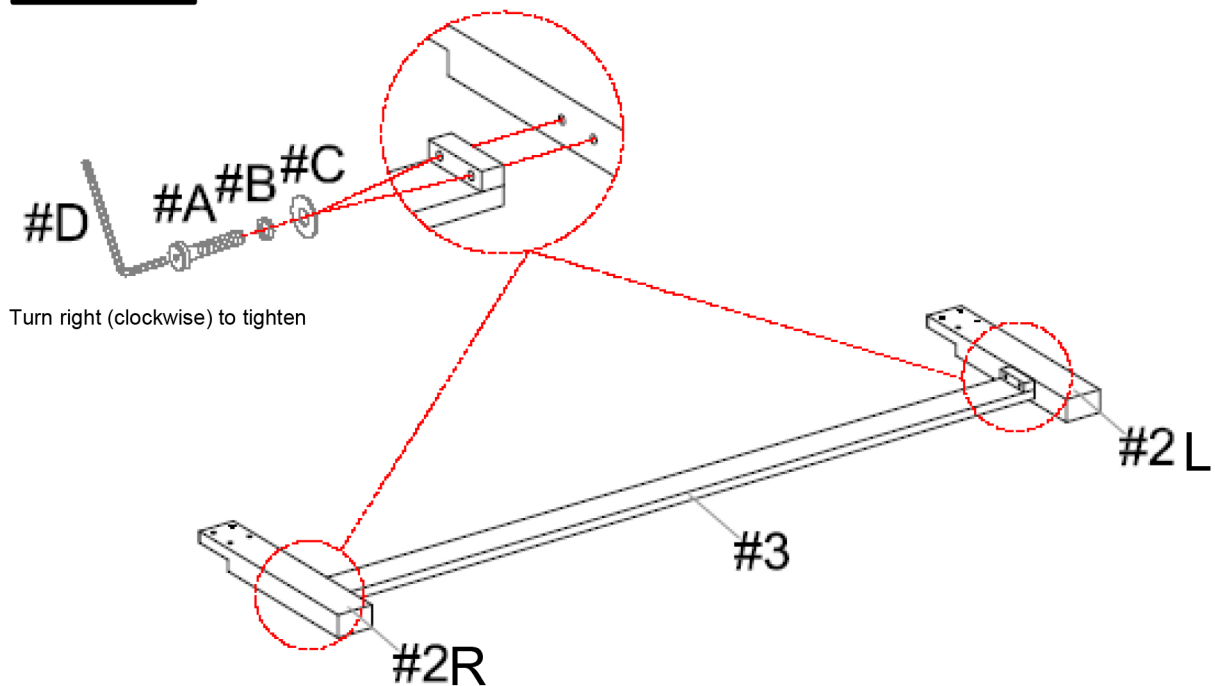


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- II. Prepare 4 bolt assemblies by inserting FIRST the lock washer (#B) onto the bolt (#A) and then the flat washer (#C) onto the SAME bolt (#A), in that order.
- III. Insert the bolt assemblies through the holes of the headboard leg rail (#3) and secure those bolts using the Allen wrench (#D) to lock them with the headboard legs.

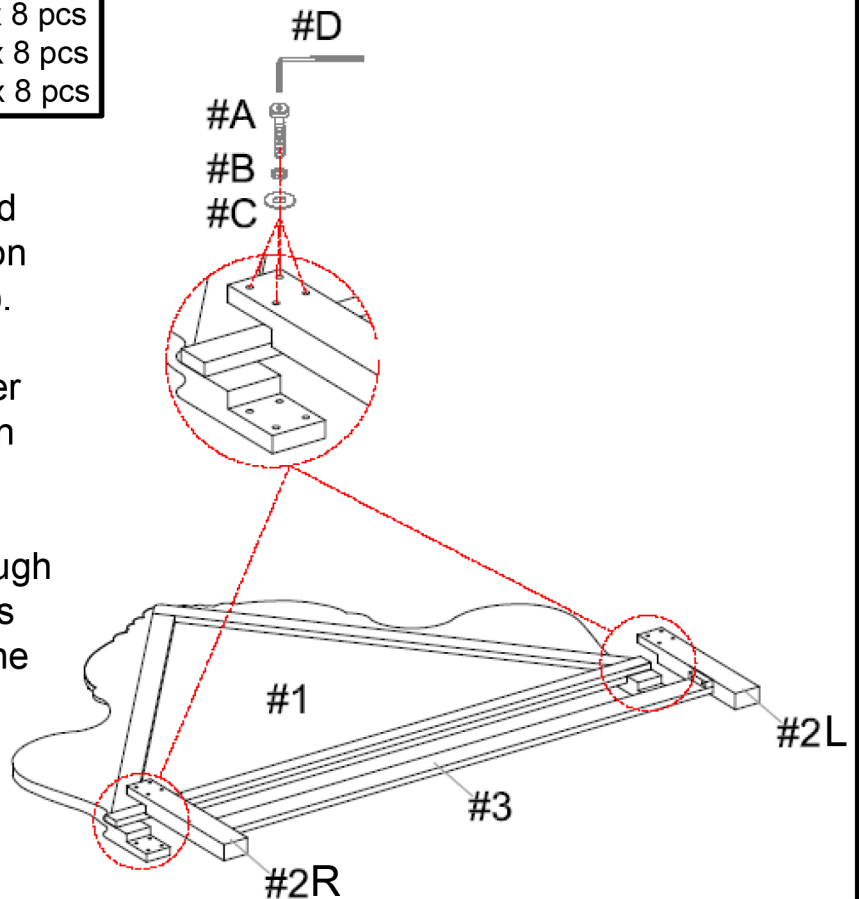

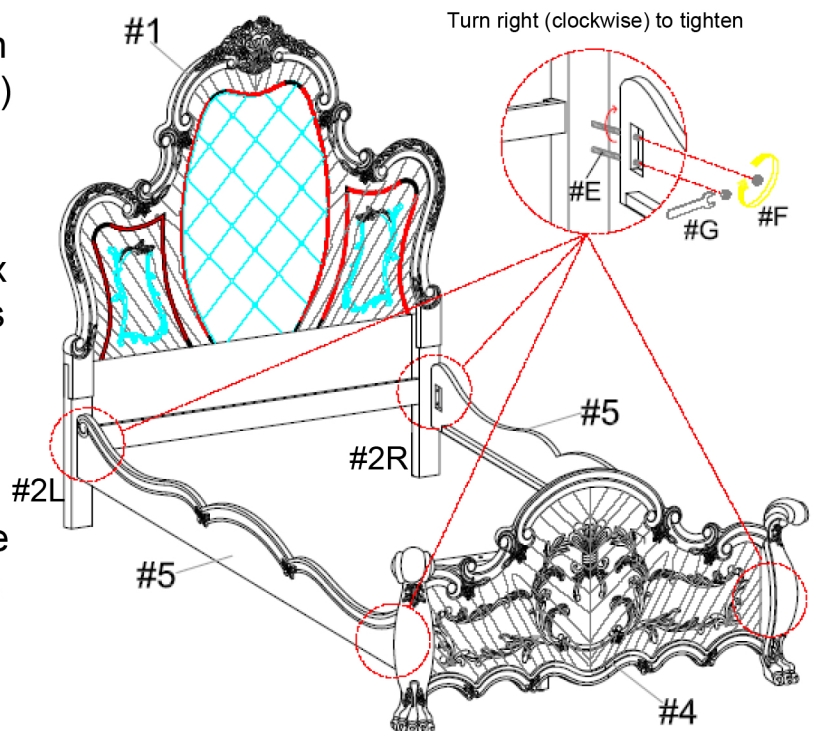
Turn right (clockwise) to tighten

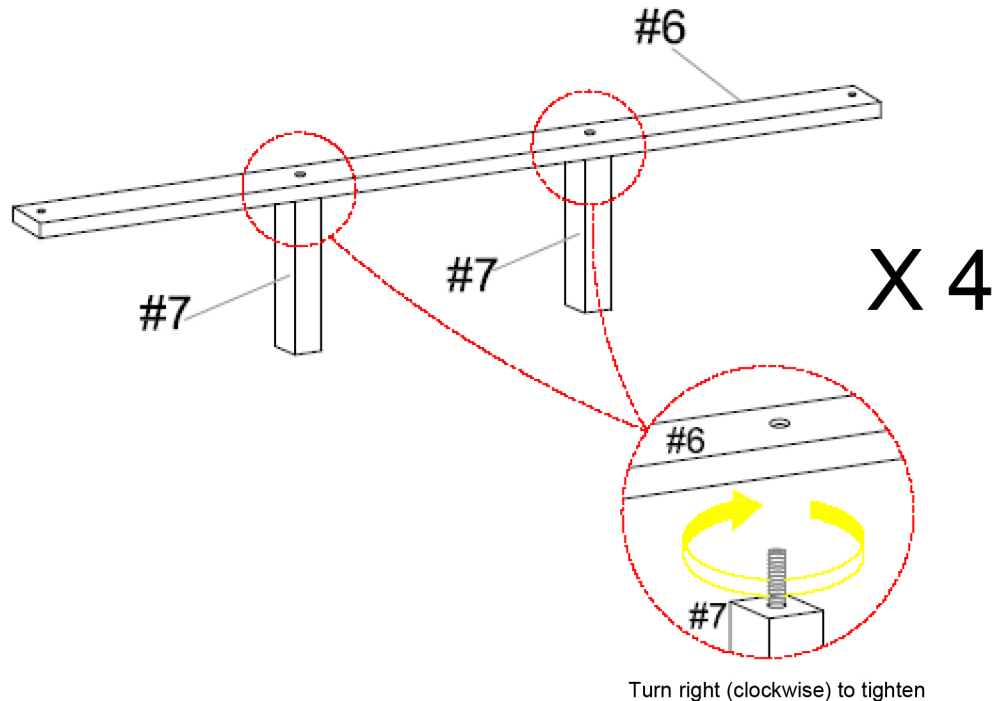
- I. Insert 4 threaded studs (#E) each into the right headboard leg (#2R) and the left headboard leg (#2L).
- II. Insert 2 side rails (#5) onto the threaded studs (#E) of the headboard legs and secure 4 hex nuts (#F) onto the threaded studs (#E) using the wrench (#G) to tighten.
- III. Insert 4 threaded studs (#E) into the footboard (#4).
- IV. Insert the other ends of the 2 side rails (#5) onto the threaded studs (#E) of the footboard (#4) and secure 4 hex nuts (#F) onto the threaded studs (#E) using the wrench (#G) to tighten.

Each slat (#6) has two slat support legs (#7). Align the threaded end of the 2 slat support legs (#7) with the pre-drilled holes of the slat (#6) and tighten by hand until secured. Repeat the process to assemble the remaining 6 slat support legs (#7) onto the remaining 3 slats (#6).



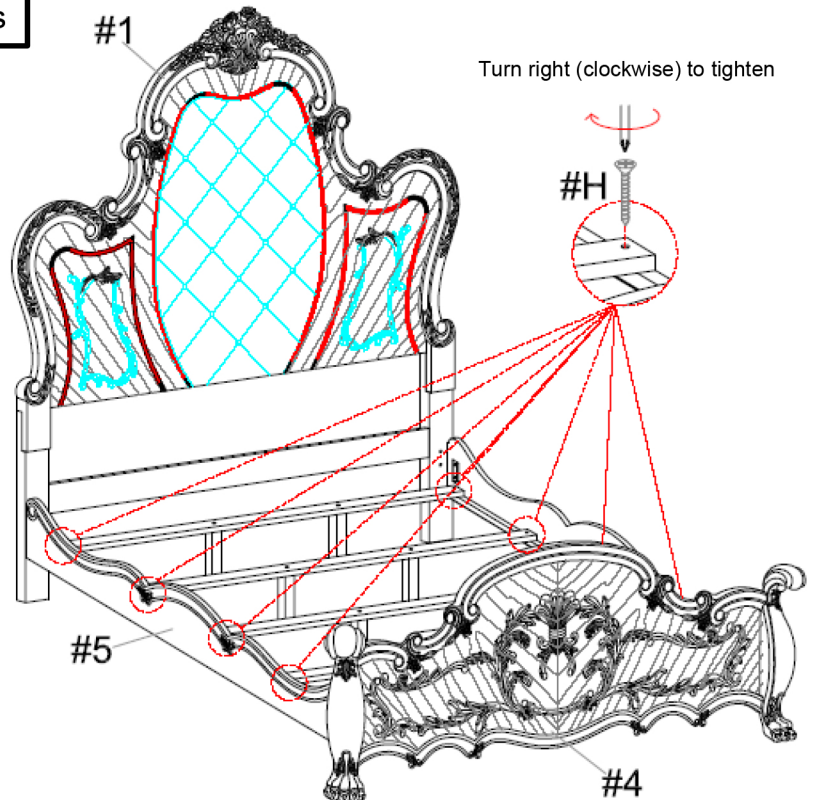
Turn right (clockwise) to tighten

- I. Align the ends of the assembled slat (#6) with the pre-drilled holes on each side of the side rails (#5).
- II. Secure 2 screws (#H) onto each end of the slat (#6) by using a Phillips screwdriver to tighten them down to the side rails (#5). Repeat the process to assemble the remaining slats (#6).
- III. Make sure the bed is rested on a flat surface and does not feel loose or wobbly. If it does, double check that the bolts/screws are secured and properly tightened.
