## HANGING THE FIXTURE (Fig. 1)

- 1. Shut off the power at the circuit breaker and remove the old fixture including the mounting hardware.
- 2. Carefully remove the fixture from the carton and check that all parts are included as shown in the illustration.
- Attach the mounting plate (A) to the junction box using screws (B). The side of the mounting plate marked "GND" must face out.
  The junction box is not included.
- 4. Determine the desired hanging height and thread rods (E,F,G) to fixture body (H).
- 5. Feed fixture wires through center tube (G,F,E,) .Connecting center part (G,F,E) to fixture body (H) and turn clockwise until firmly tightened.
- 6. Connecting canopy (C) to part (E) and turn clockwise until firmly tightened.

## **CONNECTING THE WIRES (Fig. 2)**

7. At this point, connect the electrical wire as shown in figure 2, making sure that all wire connectors are secured. If your outlet box has a ground wire (green or bare copper), connect the fixture's ground wire to it. Otherwise connect fixture's ground wire directly to the mounting plate with the ground screw provided. After wires are connected, tuck them carefully into the ceiling junction box.

## COMPLETING THE INSTALLATION (Fig. 1)

- 8. Place the canopy (C) over the mounting plate (A) and secure with brass ball (D).
- 9. Hang the crystals (I) to the hole of the fixture body (H).
- 10. Install the light bulb (not included) in accordance with the fixture's specifications: DO NOT EXCEED THE MAXIMUM WATTAGE RATING! (NE PAS DEPASSER LA PUISSANCE NOMINALE MAXIMALE!)

Your installation is now complete. Return power to the junction box and test the fixture.
