

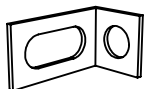
Wall Anchoring Instructions

Read all instructions and review illustrations before assembly.

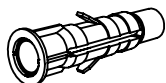
Before you begin:

Open, identify, and count all parts prior to assembly. Two people are required to safely anchor bookcase to the wall.

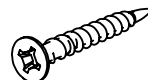
Components and Hardware:



(2) Mounting Brackets



(2) Wall Anchors



(2) Wood Screws

NOTE: For added stability and safety, it is recommended that the bookcase be anchored to the wall. For securing the bookcase to the wall it is necessary to use wall anchors appropriate for your wall material. The basic anchoring hardware provided is for drywall material. If your wall material is not drywall, consult your local hardware retailer for the right wall anchoring hardware for your specific wall material.

Mount to Wall:

1. Position the bookcase against the wall in the desired location.

2. Mark the location of the holes in the Mounting Brackets.
3. Gently pull the bookcase away from the wall.
4. Drill two holes that are slightly smaller than the Wall Anchors.
5. Insert the Wall Anchors into the holes until flush.
6. Attach a Mounting Bracket to each Plastic Anchor with a Wood Screw using a Phillips Head Screw Driver. **Figure 2**
7. Remove a Hex Screw, a Hex Nut, and a Small Spring Washer on either side of the bookcase and from the second shelf from the top.
8. Place bookcase back into desired location between the Mounting Brackets.
9. Attach bookcase to Mounting Bracket with a Hex Nut, a Hex Screw, and a Small Spring Washer.
10. Repeat Step 9 for the remaining Mounting Bracket.
