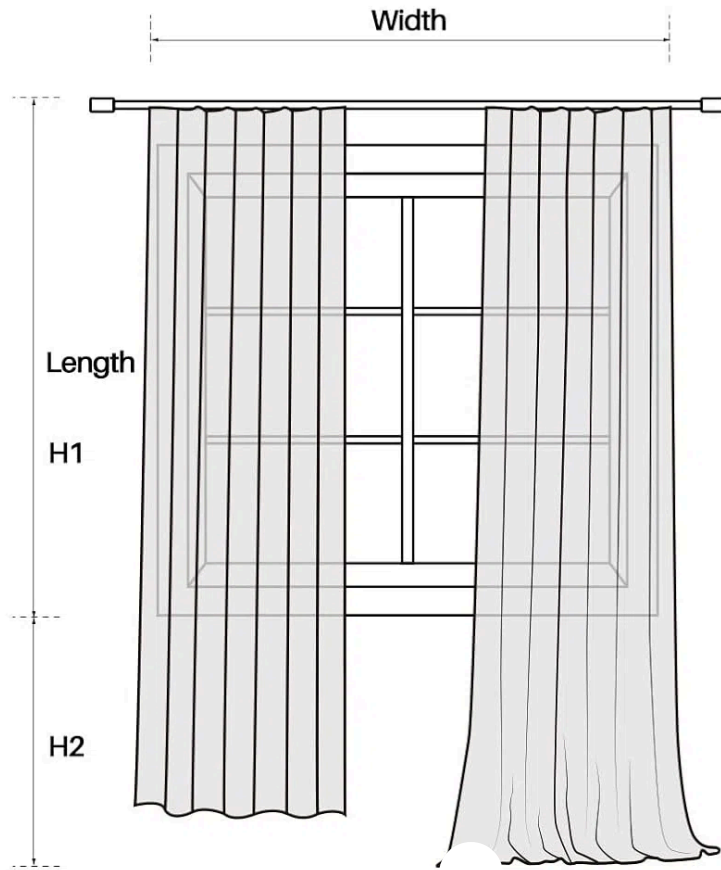


How to choose the proper curtain size?



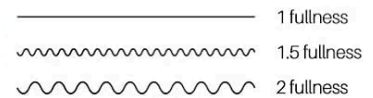
Curtain Width

We recommend that you choose a curtain width 1.5-2 times wider than the width of the pole to create folds.

Curtains width = Rod width x 1.5-2 times

Example: If your curtains are 40 inches, 60-80 inches width would be better.

Folds Effect



Curtain Length

Measure the distance from the pole to where you the curtains to finish.

The curtain length can be tailored to just cover the height of the window, extend below the window, reach down to the floor, or pool gently at the floor.

Example: **H1**: Distance from the curtain rod to the bottom edge of the window

H2: Distance from bottom edge of window to the floor
If H1=65 inch, H2=20 inch, and you want curtains to be close to the floor, then the 84 inch length would be better.

Notes

- Please allow +1-1.5 inch measuring error.
- If you're certain about using curtains that are 60-80 inches wide, you need to confirm whether they are sold individually or in pairs.
- The measurement for curtain length can vary slightly depending on the top style, such as rod pocket, back tab, ring hooks, or grommet tops.
- If your window is irregularly shaped or you're experiencing installation issues, please confirm the size and installation details with us.
