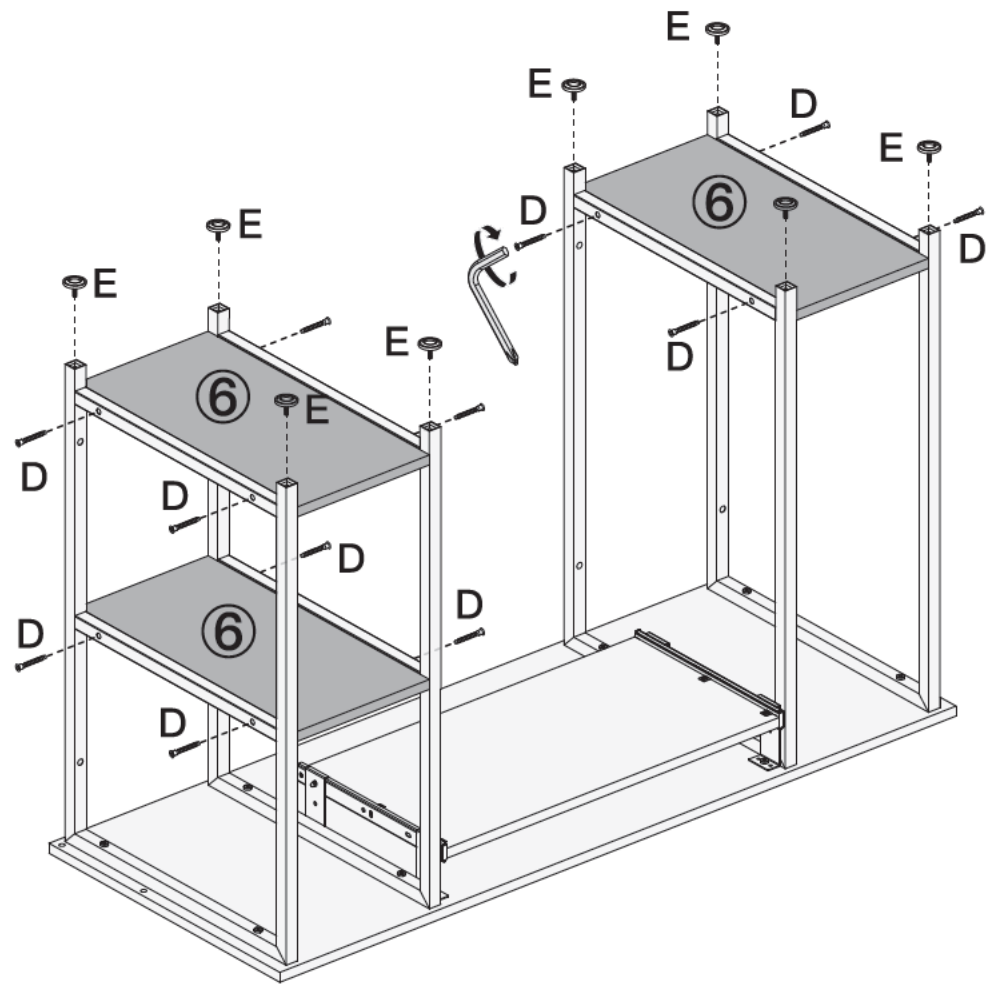

During assembly, first loosely align all bolts with the corresponding pre-drilled holes and then tighten the bolts one by one.

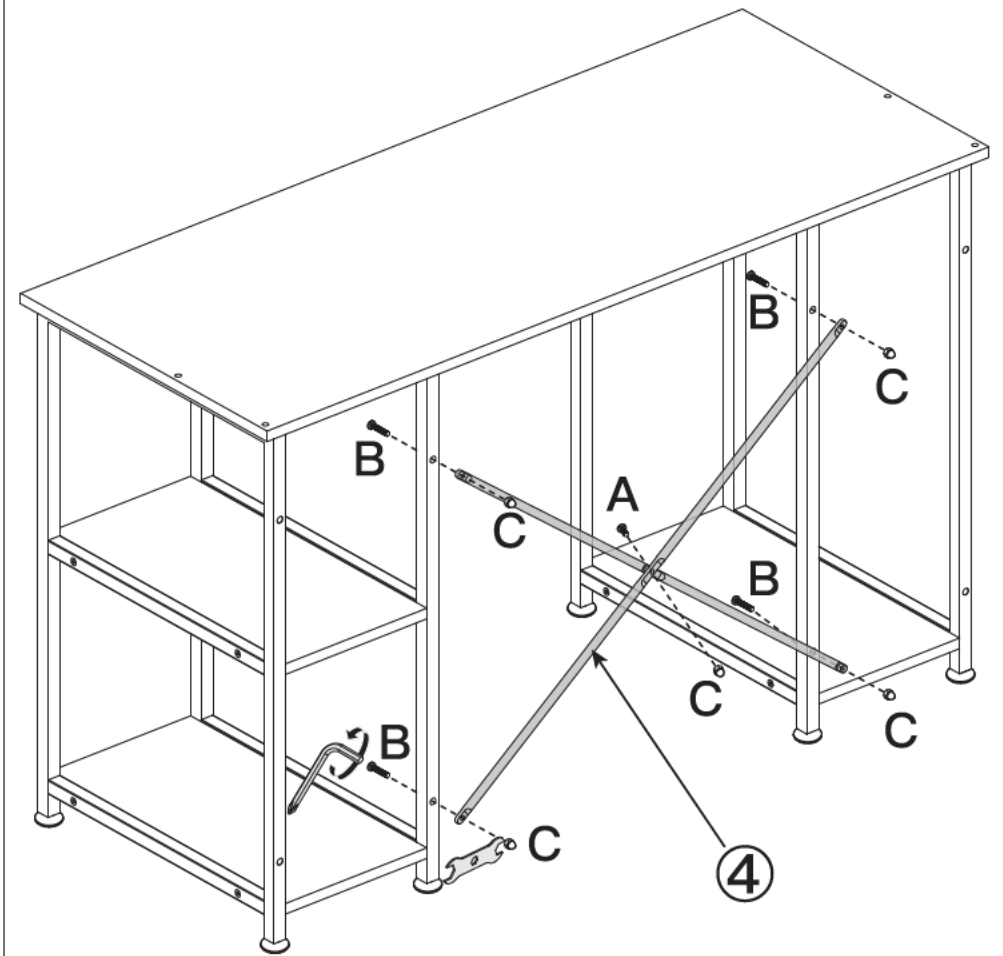

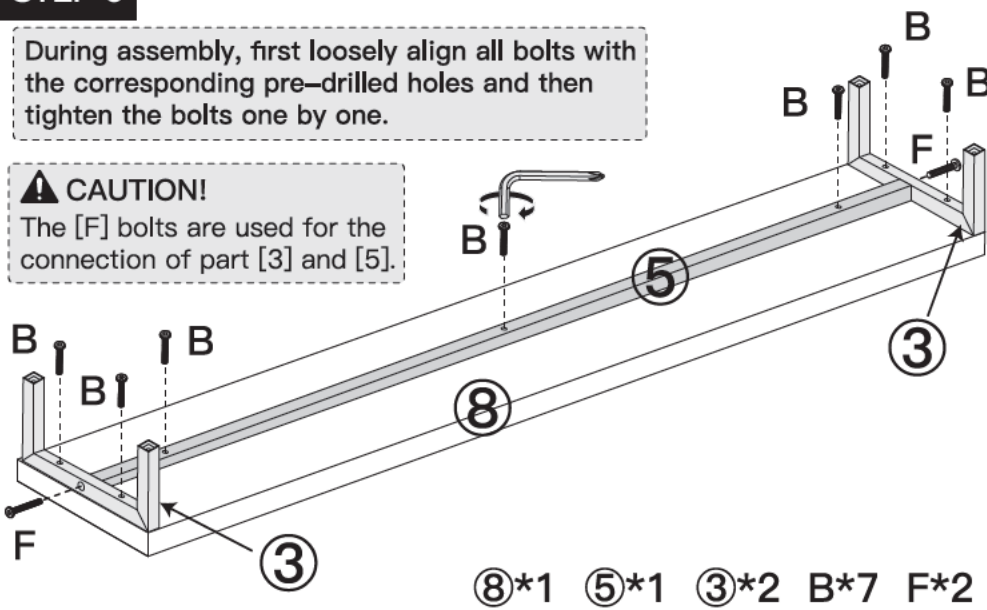

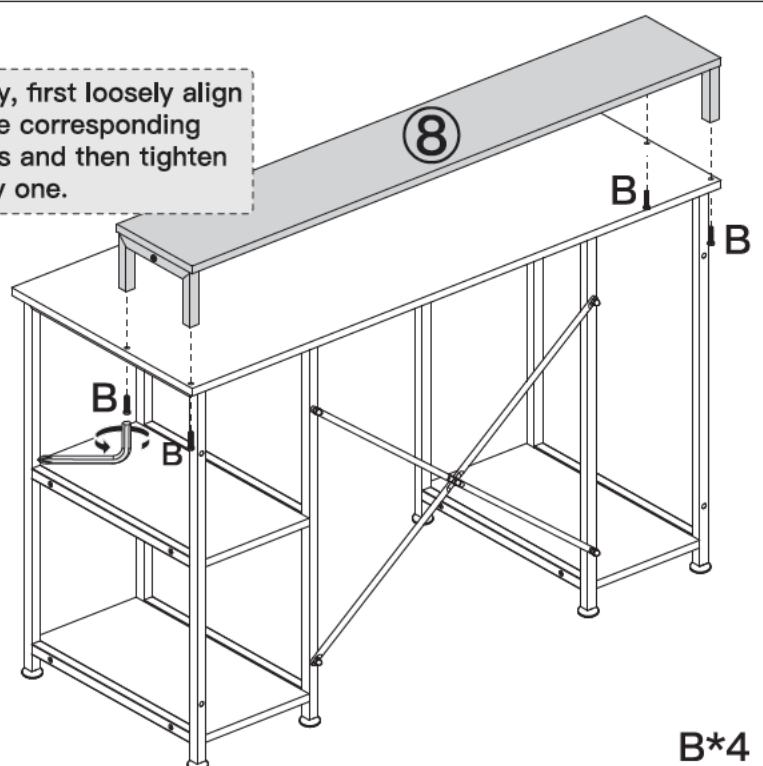
The [F] bolts are used for the connection of part [3] and [5].

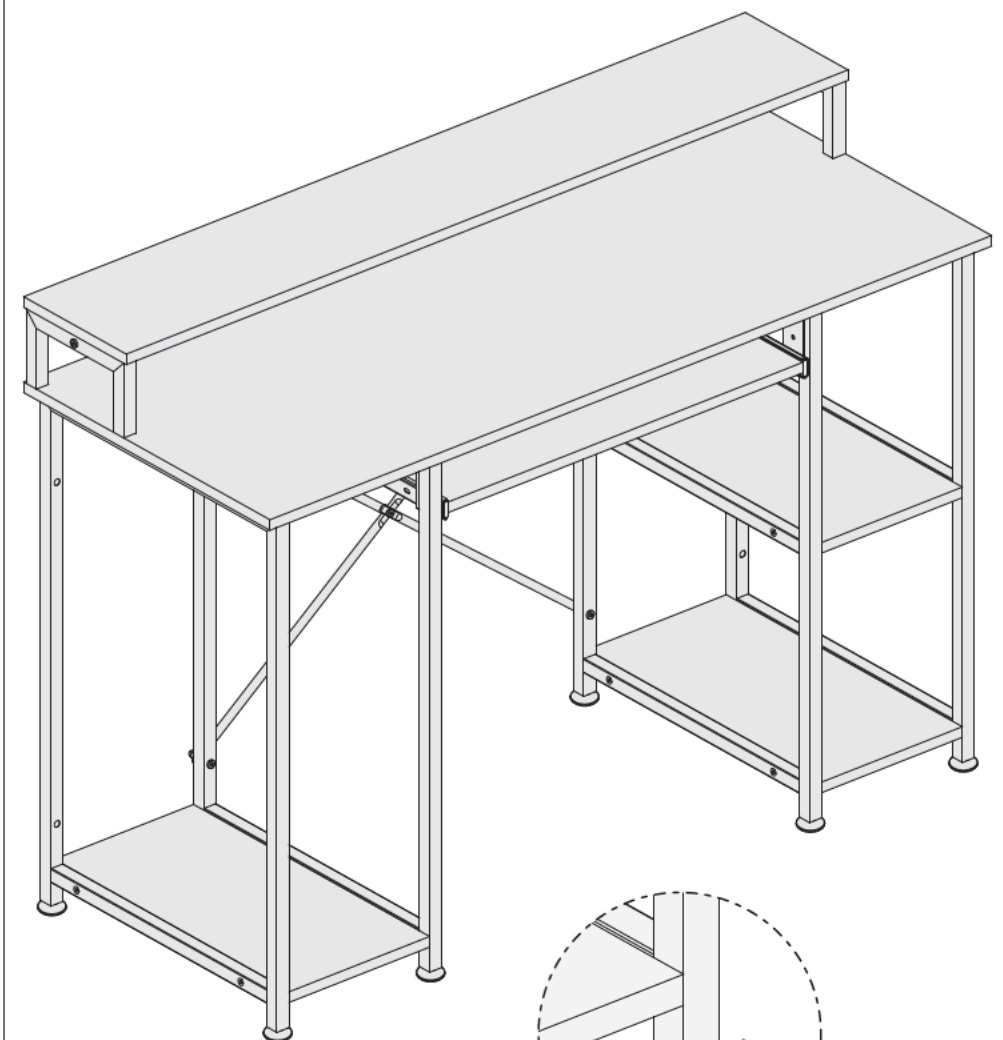
During assembly, first loosely align all bolts with the corresponding pre-drilled holes and then tighten the bolts one by one.
